### THE LATEST:

★ The Blue Jays took the loss in the opener of their three-game series against the Minnesota Twins at Target Field on Thursday night, by a 7-1 final score... Dropped to 14-17 overall this year, 4-9 on the road, and 4-7 in series openers... Despite the loss, have still won seven of the last 11 games following a four-game losing skid.  
 ★ Need a victory today to avoid moving to 1-4-0 in series played on the road and 4-7-0 in series play overall on the year... With a win, can improve to 8-4 over their last 12 contests.

### THE VAR-SHOW:

★ Daulton Varsho drove in the Blue Jays lone run of the game on Thursday night, with a solo home run off a 1-1 fourseamer from RHP Bailey Ober in the 4th inning... Marked his fourth home run of the season, travelling 397 feet to right field with a 107.4 MPH exit velocity, finishing the game 1-for-4... Of his 24 home runs since last season, 19 have gone to the pull side... In the month of April, the 29-year-old slashed .250/.326/.463 with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, 10 runs scored, seven walks, and a .788 OPS... In four contests against the Twins this season, has gone 7-for-18 (.389) with two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, three runs scored, and a 1.389 OPS.

### FEELING GEORGE-OUS:

★ George Springer led off the game with a 105.4 MPH single in the top of the 1st inning, before singling again in the 3rd inning, finishing the night 2-for-4, his second multi-hit game of the season (also: April 8 vs. LAD)... In his 60 career games against the Twins, is slashing .317/.416/.604 with 17 doubles, 16 home runs, 43 RBI, 37 walks, and a 1.020 OPS... Against right-handed pitching since last season, is slashing .314/.400/.564 with 25 doubles, a triple, 26 home runs, 70 RBI, 54 walks, and a .965 OPS... Has posted a 159 wRC+ since last season, the 4th-best mark among MLB hitters (min. 600 PA), trailing only Aaron Judge (199), Shohei Ohtani (168), and Nick Kurtz (163).

### ERN DAWG:

★ Ernie Clement singled off RHP Bailey Ober in the 7th inning, before .drawing an eight-pitch walk in the 9th inning, finishing the game 1-for-3, reaching base safely multiple times in a single game for the 14th time this season... Over his last 13 games, is slashing .321/.357/.528 with eight doubles, one home run, four RBI, four runs scored, and an .885 OPS.  
 ★ Entering tonight's contest, ranks T-4th in the AL in hits (38), trailing only Jordan Alvarez (42), Shea Langeliers (41), and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (40)... Also ranks T-1st in doubles (13) and T-7th in multi-hit games (11).

### PLAY THE HITS:

★ Vladimir Guerrero Jr. singled in the 8th inning in yesterday night's contest, finishing the game 1-for-4... Became the 2nd player in franchise history to record 40+ hits before May 1st in a single season, trailing only Melky Cabrera (41 hits in 2014)... Over his last 20 contests, Guerrero Jr. is slashing .413/.470/.547 with seven doubles, a home run, 11 RBI, 15 runs scored, and a 1.017 OPS... Entering play on Friday, Guerrero Jr. ranks 2nd in the AL among qualified hitters in AVG (.354), trailing only Jordan Alvarez (.356), while also ranking 3rd in hits (40), and 3rd in OBP (.438).

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

★ The Blue Jays are in the midst of a seven-game road trip, that begins with this four-game series at Target Field against the Minnesota Twins (13-18), before heading to Tropicana Field for a three-game set against the Tampa Bay Rays (18-12).  
 ★ The Blue Jays have a 4-9 record on the road... Blue Jays hitters rank 2nd among AL teams in road strikeout rate (17.6%) while also ranking 3rd in road AVG (.251), 12th in road OPS (.650), 12th in road SLG (.353), 14th in road R/G (3.54), and... On the pitching side, Toronto hurlers rank 6th in the AL in road ERA (4.07), 4th in road chase rate (30.4%), 6th in road walk rate (9.4%), 6th in road strikeout rate (21.4%), 6th in road WHIP (1.37), and 7th in road whiff rate (25.7%).

### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

★ Tommy Nance tossed 1.1 scoreless innings yesterday, striking out three of the four batters he faced on the night... Among pitchers with min. 10 IP this season, his curveball is posting a Stuff+ of 148, the 2nd-highest among curveballs in MLB, trailing only José Alvarado (171)... His 37.4% chase rate this season ranks 5th among AL pitchers (min. 60 BF), trailing only Anthony Nunez (41.9%), Jeff Hoffman (40.1%), Cam Schlichter (39.7%), and Grant Taylor (38.7%).

### THE GAUS-MAN:

★ Kevin Gausman made his seventh start of the season on Thursday, surrendering four runs over 5.2 innings on four hits and two walks with two strikeouts... Entering tonight's contest, Gausman's fourseamer ranks as the T-4th most valuable pitch in MLB according to run value (7), trailing only Nathan Eovaldi's splitter (8), Shohei Ohtani's fourseamer (8), and Tyler Rogers sinker (8).

### On This Day In Blue Jays History

On May 1, 2004, Frank Catalanotto became the first player in franchise history to record six hits in a single game, in a 10-6 victory over the Chicago White Sox in the second game of a doubleheader. The left-handed hitter recorded singles in the 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, and 8th innings with a double in the 7th, finishing the game 6-for-6 with two RBI and two runs scored. The only other Blue Jay in team history to record six hits in a single game is Lourdes Gurriel Jr., who did so on July 22, 2022 at BOS.

★ The Blue Jays went 1-2 in a three-game series against the Minnesota Twins at Rogers Centre earlier this month, from April 10-12... Minnesota outscored Toronto by a 19-16 margin, with the teams combining for 22 extra-base hits... In their last trip to Target Field last season, the Blue Jays won two of three games.  
 ★ George Springer hit safely in all six games against the Twins last season, notching multiple hits in all three games in Toronto... Slashed .458/.519/1.000 in 2025 vs. MIN with a double, four homers, seven RBI, and three walks (1.519 OPS)... Is a career .317 hitter (72-for-227) over 60 games against Minny, recording 17 doubles, 16 home runs, 43 RBI, and 37 walks for a .604 SLG and a 1.020 OPS... In his 30 career contests at Target Field, is slashing .325/.410/.658 with 10 doubles, 10 home runs, 26 RBI, and a 1.068 OPS.  
 ★ Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit safely in all three games against the Twins earlier this month, going 6-for-12 (.500) with two doubles, an RBI, three runs scored, two walks, and a 1.238 OPS... In his 37 career contests against Minnesota, is slashing .284/.348/.419 with five doubles, five home runs, 21 RBI, 19 runs scored, 14 walks, and a .766 OPS.

**TODAY'S GAME:**

- ✦ Making his 5th start of the season...In his last time out, on 4/26 vs. CLE, pitched 4.2 innings surrendering a pair of runs on 6 hits and 2 walks with 4 strikeouts...Threw 54 strikes on 82 pitches (63% strike rate) while throwing a first-pitch strike to 13 of the 21 batters he faced (63% first-pitch strike percentage)...Notched 12 whiffs on the day, including 6 with his slider on 12 swings (50% whiff rate).
- ✦ Has pitched 5.0+ innings in 220 starts since the 2017 season, tied with Luis Castillo for the 2nd-most among starters during that span, trailing only Aaron Nola (225).
- ✦ Has made 30+ starts for 5 consecutive seasons...Is 1 of just 4 pitchers in MLB to make 30+ starts in each of the last 5 seasons (2021-25), joined by teammates Dylan Cease, José Berríos and Kevin Gausman.

**2026 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- ✦ Threw 5.0 innings of one-run ball on a pair of hits and a pair of walks with 3 strikeouts on 4/21 at LAA...Recorded 40 strikes on 65 pitches (63% strike rate) while throwing a first-pitch strike to 15 of the 18 batters he faced on the night (83.3% first-pitch strike percentage).
- ✦ Tossed 5.2 innings of one-run ball on 4 hits and a walk with 6 strikeouts, throwing 50 strikes on 79 pitches (63%) on 4/16 at MIL...Notched 10 whiffs on the day, including 7 with his slider on 10 swings.
- ✦ Made his Blue Jays debut, throwing 4.0 innings surrendering 4 runs on 6 hits and a walk with 3 strikeouts... Threw a first pitch strike to 15 of the 21 batters he faced on the day (71% first pitch strike percentage).
- ✦ Made his Blue Jays debut on 4/10 vs. MIN, throwing 4.0 innings surrendering 4 runs on 6 hits and a walk with 3 strikeouts... Threw a first pitch strike to 15 of the 21 batters he faced on the day (71% first pitch strike percentage).
- ✦ Recalled from Single-A Dunedin on 4/7...Made one start with Single-A Dunedin on 4/4, throwing 5.0 innings surrendering a run (0 ER) on 4 hits and a walk with 9 strikeouts.

**2025 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- ✦ Started 30 games (31 appearances) for the Texas Rangers in 2025, posting a 4.40 ERA with a 1.36 WHIP across 155.1 innings.
- ✦ Made 14 starts at home (15 appearances) going 3-6 while posting a 3.36 ERA (28 ER/75.0 IP) with a 1.23 WHIP, a 21.7% strikeout rate, and a 7.1% walk rate, while holding batters to a .247 opponent AVG.
- ✦ Threw a complete game but was the losing pitcher on 6/6/25 at WSH against his former club, tossing 8.0, allowing 2 runs on 5 hits with 2 strikeouts (89 pitches/60 strikes), in a 2-0 TEX loss...Was his 7th career CG, and his 1st since 5/4/22 at COL (L, 8.0 IP, 5 R-3 ER)...Marked the 1st CG by a TEX SP since Jon Gray on 6/7/23 vs. STL.
- ✦ Signed a one-year Major League contract with TEX on 3/18/25.

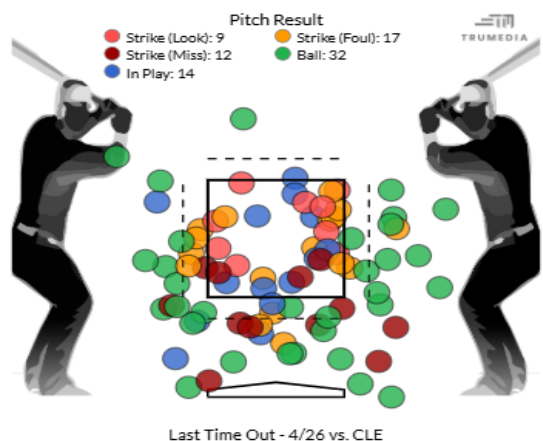
- ✦ Signed a one-year deal with the Blue Jays on 4/3.
- ✦ Two-time National League All-Star selection (2013 and 2018 with ARI) and accrued N.L. Cy Young Award votes, finishing 5th in 2018 and 11th in 2019.
- ✦ Member of the 2019 World Series Champion Washington Nationals, earning the win in Game 7.
- ✦ Is the only pitcher in MLB to make at least 30 starts in each of the last 8 full seasons (excluding 2020).
- ✦ Ranks 4th among active pitchers in starts (357), 5th in innings pitched (2,062.1), and 12th in wins (110).
- ✦ Originally selected by the Los Angeles Angels in 2nd round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of Chipola College.

**VS. THE TWINS:**

- ✦ Making his 7th career start against the Twins, and 2nd this season...Last faced Minnesota on 4/10 at Rogers Centre...Has made 3 career starts at Target Field, going 2-1 surrendering 9 earned runs over 17.0 innings (4.76 ERA) with 15 strikeouts.
