HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 2-2 vs. Cardinals with 2 to play at Chase Field and the upcoming July 23 makeup of the postponed June 25 game @ Cardinals.

- The D-backs have won 5 of their last 6 home games vs. Cardinals.
 - The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 overall games vs. Cardinals.
- Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 14 straight games and 33 straight starts.
- Gabriel Moreno** has an 8-game hitting streak since July 6, including 6 multi-hit performances, batting .452 (14-for-31)/1.063 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 RBI and 4 walks.
- Tim Tawa** has homered in consecutive games and in 3 of his last 4, hitting .529 (9-for-17)/1.765 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers and 8 RBI.
- Brandon Pfaadt**, in his last 3 starts since being recalled from Triple-A Reno on June 30, is 3-0 with a 1.72 ERA (3 ER in 15.2 IP), opponent .220 AVG (13-for-59)/.555 OPS, 1 walk and 10 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-4 vs. Cardinals.

- Corbin Carroll** evened the game at 4-4 in the eighth inning with his 2-run homer (14).
- Tim Tawa** homered (4) for a second consecutive game in the third inning.
- Gabriel Moreno** had his sixth multi-hit game in his last 8.
- Merrill Kelly** went decisionless after allowing 3 runs (1 earned) on 4 hits in 5.0 innings (2 BB, 3 K).

MORENO'S ON-BASE STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 33 straight starts (C: 27, DH: 6), since June 2, hitting .353 (42-for-119)/.942 OPS with 7 doubles, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 21 walks (15 K).

- Majors' longest active streak and tied for the second-longest streak this season with 33 by Bryan Reynolds/PIT (May 23-June 29), behind 48 by Nick Kurtz/ATH (April 3-May 25).
- Is tied for the third-longest streak in club history with Orlando Hudson (2007), Mark Grace (2001) and Luis Gonzalez (1999), behind Jay Bell (39 in 1998) and Corbin Carroll (44 in 2024).

ARENADO CLOSING IN ON 2,000 HITS: **Nolan Arenado** (1,996 hits) looks to become the fifth player since 1998 to get their 2,000th career regular season hit against a team they previously played for [source: Elias Sports Bureau]:

- Aramis Ramirez/MIL June 26, 2013 vs. Cubs

- Will become the sixth active player with 2,000+ hits: Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (July 7, 2025), Paul Goldschmidt/AZ-STL-NYY (July 26, 2024), Jose Altuve/HOU (Aug. 20, 2023), Freddie Freeman/ATL-LAD (June 25, 2023) and Andrew McCutchen/PIT-SF-NYY-PHI-MIL-TEX (June 11, 2023).
- Will become the third player to record their 2,000th career hit while with the D-backs, joining Steve Finley (Sept. 13, 2002 vs. Brewers) and Luis Gonzalez (May 22, 2004 @ Marlins) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

DAY GAMERS: Gabriel Moreno has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 day games, hitting .375 (15-for-40)/1.150 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 5 RBI and 8 walks.

- Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 day games, batting .344 (11-for-32)/.964 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 3 walks (2 K).
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 9 straight day games, hitting .333 (10-for-30)/.940 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 7 walks.

IT STARTS WITH STARTING PITCHING: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 10 starts, have a 3.59 ERA (21 ER in 52.2 IP), opponent .246 AVG (50-for-203)/.713 OPS, 16 walks and 38 strikeouts.

- Since July 4, their 3.59 starter ERA ranks sixth in the NL, behind the Mets (1.74), Marlins (2.16), Cardinals (2.81), Cubs (3.00) and Dodgers (3.31).

THE PEN: The bullpen, in their last 5 games, has a 1.45 ERA (3 ER in 18.2 IP), opponent .119 AVG (7-for-59)/.317 OPS, 5 walks and 19 strikeouts.

- Among all bullpens, the D-backs rank fifth with a 1.20 WHIP and inherited runners scored percentage (26.5, 31-of-117), seventh with 1.64 runs per game, eighth with a .681 OPS, ninth with an opponent .235 AVG and .680 OPS, and 12th with a 3.92 ERA.

GARCIA HANGING ZEROES: Brandyn Garcia has held opponents scoreless in 13 straight (10.2 IP) and held 38 batters faced to 2 hits and 3 walks with 17 strikeouts.

- Has held opponents scoreless in 27 of 29 games this season (5 R in 24.1 IP, 12 H, 6 BB, 28 K).

LOÁISIGA BLANKING FOES: Jonathan Loáisiga has held opponent scoreless in career-best 12 straight games overall (12.1 IP, 42 BF, 5 H, 1 BB, 10 K) and 7 consecutive home games (7.1 IP, 25 BF, 4 H, 1 BB, 5 K).

VS. CARDINALS: The D-backs still lead the 4-game set @ Cardinals from June 22-25, dropping the first game then winning the next 2 games, before the fourth game was postponed due to rain and rescheduled in St. Louis for July 23 at 2:15 p.m. AZ.

- The D-backs split each of their last 3 season series (3-3 in 2023, '24 and '25).

- Ketel Marte** has a 7-game hitting streak, batting .323 (10-for-31)/.977 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 2 RBI, 1 walk and 2 stolen bases...has reached 2+ times in 4 of those games.
- Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 9 straight home games, batting .394 (13-for-33)/1.232 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 triples, 1 homer, 7 RBI, 3 walks and 4 stolen bases.

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (8-3, 2.29)

- The first-time All-Star's 2.29 ERA ranks fourth among qualified starting pitchers.
- The D-backs are 14-3 in his last 17 starts.
- Tossed a quality bid in his June 23 start vs. Cardinals (ND, 0 ER in 6.2 IP, 3 H, 3 BB, 5 K).
