IT'S A NICE NIGHT FOR A BALLGAME: The Detroit Tigers last night collected a 5-3 win to begin this three-game set at the Baltimore Orioles, reaching 20 games above .500 for the first time since finishing the 2013 campaign with a 93-69 record and improving to a major league best 18-4 in series openers this season ... the Tigers are now 26-12 in their last 38 games starting April 30.

- At 44-24, the Tigers have the best record in all of baseball, half a game ahead of the Mets, as the Tigers are off to their best start through 68 games in 19 years when also beginning 44-24 in 2006 ... into this week, the Tigers are 15-5-1 in their first 21 series to start the season.
- The Tigers have posted a 44-21 record, a .677 winning percentage, in their last 65 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 44-21 record, which is a 110-win pace over 162 games, starting March 31 is the best in all of baseball in that span and 5.5-games up on the Yankees, the next closest A.L. team.
- The Tigers tonight continue with their lone road games within a stretch of playing nine out of 12 games at Comerica Park, a span that then extends to 15 of 21 home games to conclude June ... on Friday, the Tigers begin a six-game N.L. Central homestand vs. Cincinnati and Pittsburgh.

NO PANIC! AT THE DISH, OH?: Including a two-strike, two-run homer last night, Spencer Torkelson has now hit 10 home runs with two strikes this year, the most in the majors ... Torkelson also leads the A.L. and is tied for second in the majors with 19 RBI with runners in scoring position and two outs ... his seven extra-base hits with RISP/two outs lead the A.L. and tie for most in the majors.

- Torkelson has 16 homers, 31 extra-base hits and 47 RBI this season, joining Aaron Judge and Cal Raleigh as the three players in the A.L. to reach those totals (seven players overall in MLB).
- Torkelson ranks fourth in the A.L. in homers and RBI and is tied for sixth in extra-base hits ... Torkelson's .341 on-base percentage is currently 46 points higher than last year's .295 mark and his .509 slugging is 135 points higher than last year's .374 mark.

WE CHOSE MIZELY: Tigers starter Casey Mize is one of only nine pitchers in the A.L. to have six or more wins and a sub-3.00 ERA ... Mize is joined by Tarik Skubal (6-2, 2.16 ERA) in achieving this feat as they are one of only three pairs of A.L. teammates to each be in this category, joining the Yankees' Max Fried and Carlos Rodon and the Rangers' Jacob deGrom and Tyler Mahle.

TRIPLE ME THIS: Zach McKinstry yesterday stroked his sixth and seventh triples of the season, a new single-season career high and now tied with Boston's Jarren Duran for the major league lead ... McKinstry now has more than half of Detroit's 13 triples this season ... the last Tiger to have

- seven triples in an entire season, let alone by mid-June, was Akil Baddoo with seven triples in 2021.
 McKinstry is the first Tiger to have seven triples before the All-Star Break since Rajai Davis had seven in 2015 ... McKinstry is the first Tigers left-handed hitter with at least seven triples before the Break since Curtis Granderson had 15 triples in 2007.
- Last night marked McKinstry's second two-triple game in the last three years (also August 28, 2023 vs. the Yankees) ... he's the only major leaguer with a pair of two-triple games in the last five seasons, let alone the last three seasons.

BEAST VS. THE EAST?: The Tigers enter tonight's game having gone 16-2 in their last 18 games against A.L. East foes ... the Tigers have won at least 16 times in an 18-game stretch against members of their former division for the first time in more than 50 years and only the second time ever since divisional play began in 1969 (18-2 vs. the A.L. East from June 26-August 1, 1973).

STREAK'S ALIVE: Gleyber Torres went 2-for-5 last night and has now reached base safely in 17-consecutive games, the sixth-longest active streak in the majors ... Torres now boasts the longest streak to reach base safely by a Tiger this season and longest overall since Justyn-Henry Malloy's 17-gamer from June 29-July 25, 2024 ... the last Tiger to reach base safely in at least 18-consecutive games?: Kerry Carpenter in 24-straight games from August 2-28, 2023.

Torres has turned in a .775 OPS this season, the best OPS by any second baseman in the A.L. and second to only St. Louis' Brendan Donovan (.819) in the majors ... Torres leads all major league second basemen with a .381 on-base percentage, is second in the A.L. with 30 RBI and a .273 batting average and third in the A.L. with a .394 slugging.

PRODUCE SECTION: Spencer Torkelson (16 homers, 47 RBI) and Riley Greene (13 homers, 44 RBI) are the most dynamic duo on offense in the American League, as they remain the only set of teammates in the A.L. to have each reached 13 homers and 40 RBI.

THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE: The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the majors on the strength of a +94 overall run differential this year, trailing only the Yankees (+103) for the best mark in the A.L. ... in the A.L. Central, the Tigers have a +69 edge on the second-place Twins (+25), are +117 on the third-place Guardians (-23) and are +111 on the fourth-place Royals (-17).

AND FINALLY: Zach McKinstry leads all left-handed hitters with five triples off left-handed pitchers this season ... he's the first lefty to hit five triples off fellow lefties within an entire season, let alone by mid-June, since Shohei Ohtani do so in all of 2021.

- Held a 1.89 ERA in six games (four starts) over Spring Training this year...led the team with 25 strikeouts, including seven over 3.0 innings in his final outing on March 25.
- In his first MLB action since 2022, Mize appeared in 22 games (20 starts) and posted a 2-6 record with a 4.49 ERA (51ER/102.1IP) and 78 strikeouts last season.

- Made his postseason debut on Oct. 1 at Houston, walking one in a scoreless two-thirds of an inning to pick up the save...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first pitcher in franchise history to record a save in his first career playoff game.
- Started his postseason career with 5.1 no-hit innings with two walks and six strikeouts in his first four outings.
