## New York Mets (22-31)

Fifth Place, NL East, 13.5 GB



**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets lost on a walk-off grand slam, 4-0, yesterday at Miami...New York has lost five of its last six games...The Mets are 12-10 over their last 22 games...The team is in a stretch of 17 straight games (7-6)...The Mets start a six-game homestand today as they host Cincinnati (three games) followed by the Marlins (three games).

**MEMORIAL DAY:** The Mets are 30-32 all-time on Memorial Day.

**ONE IS A LONELY NUMBER:** New York has scored one run or less in 15 games this year, including three straight games, the most such games in the majors.

**HOME COOKING:** The Mets are 11-13 at home this year.

**WALK-OFFS:** The Mets suffered their fourth walk-off loss of the year yesterday when Heriberto Hernández hit a walk-off grand slam for Miami...Prior to Sunday, the last walk-off grand slam the Mets allowed was by Jacob Stallings on July 17, 2021 at Pittsburgh.

**THREE AMIGOS:** Carson Benge (right), A.J. Ewing (center) and Nick Morabito (left) started in the outfield on Friday...It was the earliest the Mets ever started an all-rookie outfield...The previous earliest was July 24, 1977...Lee Mazzilli, Steve Henderson and Joel Youngblood...Saturday was the first time the three have played together in the same outfield in the same game (at any level).

**MAY FLOWERS:** The Mets are 12-10 in May...The team has posted a 3.38 ERA (74 ER/197.0 IP) with 198 strikeouts...Their 198 strikeouts are the seventh-most in the majors this month...Their 3.38 May ERA is 12th in the majors...They are hitting .226/.293/.349 in the month of May...Their .226 average is 27th in the majors.

**BENGE WATCH:** Carson Benge has hit in six of his last nine games (12-40, .300) and 10 of 14 (20-62, .323) and 15 of his last 20 with a .325/.386/.425 slashline with one home run, five doubles, 11 RBI and 16 runs during that span...He has recorded multiple hits in six of his last 12 games, including three hits in three of his last nine contests...He had a career-high three RBI and scored a career-high three runs Monday night.

**CARSON CONNECTS:** Benge has a .312 batting average since April 23, ranking ninth in the majors (min. 89 PA)...He also is tied for 11th in the majors with 19 runs during that stretch...Over 26 games during that span, Benge is batting .312 (34-109) with 19 runs, six doubles, two homers, 14 RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and an .781 OPS.

**SOLO SLUGGING:** Juan Soto has six homers and 10 RBI in his last 10 games...He has four homers in his last five games...He is tied for third in the majors with seven homers this month.

**REALLY RARE:** Juan Soto stole his 100th career base Thursday in his 1,131st career game...That is the fewst games to 100+ SB, 200+ HR & 900+ walks...The previous fewest: 1,257 games by Mickey Mantle...Research courtesy of Sarah Langs.

**250:** Juan Solo hit his 250th career homer on May 14...He is the fifth-youngest player to reach 250 home runs, only Alex Rodríguez, Jimmie Foxx, Eddie Matthews and Albert Pujols reached the milestone at a younger age...He reached the milestone in his 1125th career game making him the seventh-quickest active player to accomplish the feat, only trialing Aaron Judge, Shohei Ohtani, Pete Alonso, Kyle Schwarber, Matt Olson and Mike Trout...Overall, he is the 16th player to reach 250 homers before turning 28...Per *Elías*.

**ON THE MARK:** Mark Vientos has 15 RBI this month, tied for 10th in the NL

**BO KNOWS:** Bo Bichette has three homers, nine RBI, one double, five runs scored while slashing .257/.278/.543 over his last eight games...Bichette has hit in six of his eight games, .257 (9-35)...His two home run game Tuesday was his 10th career multi-homer game...His last game with two long balls was August 4, 2025 against the Rockies.

**BATY BALL:** Brett Baty has at least one hit in 11 of his last 14 games with an at-bat...During that span, Baty is batting .306 (15-49) with two home runs, two doubles, four runs scored and nine RBI...In his last 29 games dating back to April 19, has a .266/.378/.404 slashline.

**NOLAN McLEAN:** Among qualified NL pitchers, he is fourth in strikeouts, ninth in WHIP (1.03) and tied for eighth in opposing batting average (.204)...Among all qualified rookies in the majors, he ranks second in strikeouts, first in WHIP and third in innings pitched (58.0 IP)...McLean is one of four pitchers in Major League history to strikeout 126+ batters and allow 34 or fewer earned runs through their first 18 starts (also: Hideo Nomo 161 K and 27 ER, Matt Harvey 132 K and 27 ER, and Paul Skenes 136 K and 27 ER).

**DREAM WEAVER:** Over his last 14 games, Luke Weaver is 1-1 with a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) allowing 10 hits, five walks and striking out 19...He has stranded all seven inherited runners in that span.

**HUASCAR BRAZOBÁN:** Has not allowed an earned run in 18 of his 22 appearances...Out of the bullpen, Brazobán is 3-0 with a 1.19 ERA (3 ER/22.2 ER) in 19 games...He is seventh in the NL among qualified relievers in ERA and tied for eighth in wins.

**THIS DAY IN 1986:** The Mets scored two runs in the 11th, including a sacrifice fly by Jesse Orosco to beat the Padres, 4-2, at Jack Murphy Stadium..Bobby Ojeda struck out six over 9.0 innings and Orosco worked the final two frames for the win...This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions.. The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 title on Saturday, August 1 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Additional information for the 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration is available at [Mets.com/1986](https://mets.com/1986).

**METS HALL OF FAME CEREMONY:** Outfielder Lee Mazzilli and manager Bobby Valentine will be inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in a pre-game ceremony on Saturday, May 30 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Mazzilli had two stints with the Mets (1976-1981 and 1986-1989) and combined to slash .264/.357/.396 during his 10 years in Queens...The Brooklyn native was named to the 1979 All-Star team and hit the first home run by a Met during the Midsummer Classic...Mazzilli ranks sixth in franchise history with 152 stolen bases and is tied for fifth in team history with 38 pinch-hits...Valentine ranks third in team history with 536 wins guiding the Mets from 1996-2002. In 1999, he led the Mets to the Postseason for the first time since 1988...The following year, Valentine took the team to the World Series, becoming the first manager in Mets history to lead the team to consecutive playoff appearances...Valentine was a key contributor to the club's immediate volunteer response to the 9/11 attacks.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his third loss of the season after allowing career-highs in hits (8) and runs (9) on May 19 in Washington (5.2 IP, 8 H, 9 R, 6 ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, HB, 5 K)...Was just the fifth game in his career he allowed three or more earned runs and has now allowed three or more earned runs in consecutive games for the first time in his career.

**AHEAD OF THE PACK:** This season, McLean is 2-3 with a 3.57 ERA (23 ER/58.0 IP), 69 strikeouts and is holding opponents' batters to a .204 (43-211) over 10 starts...Among qualified NL pitchers, he is fourth in strikeouts, eighth in opposing batting average and ninth in WHIP (1.03)...Among all qualified rookies in the majors, he ranks second in strikeouts and in WHIP, third in innings pitched and in batting average against, and seventh in ERA.

**SPIN THAT THING:** This season, he has thrown his curveball 12.3% of the time and he is generating an average of 3,287 RPM on the pitch...That is the highest average RPM on any qualified pitch in the majors this season...He is posting a 44.2% whiff rate on his curveball...It is the ninth-highest whiff rate on a curveball this season (min. 100 pitches)...Batters are hitting just .063 (2-32) in at-bats ending with his curveball, which is the fourth-lowest opponents' batting average in at-bats ending with a curveball in the majors (min. 100 pitches)...Over his first 18 career starts, opposing batters are hitting .068 (4-59) in at-bats ending with McLean's curveball, and he has recorded a career 47.1% whiff rate on the pitch.

**SINK SINK BABY:** McLean has thrown his sinker 35.5% of the time this season, up from 27.9% last season...His sinker has produced a 10-run value, which is tied for the second-highest run value on any pitch in the Majors this season and is the highest mark on any sinker this season...Batters are hitting just .179 (15-84) in at-bats ending with his sinker.

**RECORD BOOKS:** Through 18 career starts, McLean is 7-4 with a 2.89 ERA (34 ER/106.0 IP) and 126 strikeouts...His ERA is the seventh-best in franchise history through a player's first 18 career starts...His 126 strikeouts are the fourth-most in franchise history through a pitcher's first 18 career starts, only trailing Dwight Gooden's 143, Matt Harvey's 132 and Nolan Ryan's 127...Per *Elias*...He is one of four pitchers in Major League history to strikeout 126+ batters and allow 34 or fewer earned runs through their first 18 starts (also: Hideo Nomo 161 K and 27 ER, Matt Harvey 132 K and 27 ER, and Paul Skenes 136 K and 27 ER).

**IN THE CITI:** Over nine starts at Citi Field he has posted a 1.99 ERA (12 ER/54.1 IP)...It is the seventh-best mark by a Met through their first nine home starts with the franchise...He has struck out at least six batters in all nine of his home starts, and he is only the second player in Major League history to accomplish the feat (also: Kerry Wood, 6 K's in each of his first 11 career home starts in 1998 with CHC)...His first three home starts were scoreless and he became the first Met pitcher to not allow a run in their first three career starts at home and the seventh pitcher in Major League history not to allow a run in each of their first three home starts (min. 15.0 IP)...His 19.1 inning scoreless streak at home is the longest to start a career since Robert Suarez didn't allow a run through all 24.0 innings he threw at home during the 2022 season...Per *Elias*.

**PERFECT FIVE:** He has retired each of his first 15 batters faced twice this season (4/21 vs. MIN and 4/3 at SF) ...He is the third pitcher in franchise history to be perfect through 5.0 innings multiple times in a season (also: Steve Trachsel, 2002 and Rick Reed, 1998)...His is the first pitcher in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to retire each of his first 15 batters multiple times in his first 13 career starts...Per *Elias*...When he was perfect through 5.0 innings on April 3 he became the first Mets pitcher to retire each of their first 15 batters faced since Sean Manaea retired each of the first 17 batters he faced on August 21, 2024, vs. Baltimore.

**ROOKIE SENSATION:** McLean was called up to the Majors on August 16, 2025, and he finished the season with the big-league club...Last season he made eight starts for the Mets, and he finished 5-1 with a 2.06 ERA (11 ER/48.0 IP) and 57 strikeouts...The Mets went 6-2 as a team in games started by McLean...His ERA is the third-best in franchise history through a player's first eight career starts, only trailing Terry Leach's 1.68 ERA and Rick Aguilera's 1.92 ERA...His 57 strikeouts are the third-most in franchise history through a pitcher's first eight career games, only trailing Nolan Ryan's 64 and Dwight Gooden's 59...He became the first pitcher in Major League history to throw at least 5.0 innings, strikeout five or more, and allow two or fewer earned runs in each of his first seven career starts...He is one of four players in Major League history to record 57 or more strikeouts and allow 11 or fewer earned runs through their first eight career games...He joins Nolan Ryan, Stephen Strasburg, and Paul Skenes as the only other pitchers to do so...Because McLean threw less than 50.0 innings last season, he is still considered a rookie under MLB's eligibility criteria...He entered the season as the No. 6 prospect in all of baseball, the No. 1 pitching prospect in baseball, and the No. 1 prospect in the Mets system according to *MLBPipeline.com*.

**MC-USA:** He represented the USA in the WBC...He made two starts and he finished with a 5.87 ERA (5 ER/7.2 IP) with eight strikeouts...He held opposing batters to a .222 (6-27) batting average during the event...He got the ball in the championship game vs. Venezuela on March 17 and he tossed 4.2 innings and allowed two earned runs while striking out four.

**DAZZLING DEBUT:** Made his Major League debut on August 16 vs. Seattle...Earned his first Major League win after tossing 5.1 scoreless innings and striking out eight...He joined Matt Harvey as the only pitchers in Mets history to earn a win, strike out eight or more batters, and allow zero runs in their Major League Debut...His eight strikeouts are tied for the third-most by a Met in their Major League debut (also: Tom Seaver, Bill Denehy, and Kodai Senga)...The only Mets who have recorded more strikeouts in their Major League debut are Harvey (11) and Collin McHugh (9)...Became the second pitcher in franchise history to throw at least 5.0 scoreless innings, allow two or fewer hits and strike out eight or more batters in their Major League debut (also: McHugh).

**MINOR LEAGUE RECAP:** Last season, he appeared in 21 games between Double-A Binghamton and Triple-A Syracuse and posted a 2.45 ERA (31 ER/113.2 IP)...He recorded 127 strikeouts over those 113.2 innings, good for a K/9 of 10.06...His 127 strikeouts were the second-most among Mets minor leaguers and the 18th among all minor leaguers at the time of his callup...He only surrendered two or more earned runs in one of his last 14 appearances prior to being called up...Overall from 2023-2025, he made 48 minor league appearances (44 starts) and finished 12-15 with a 3.10 ERA (78 ER/226.2 IP) and 245 strikeouts.

**TWO-WAY COWBOY:** The Willow Spring, North Carolina native, was a two-way player during his time at Oklahoma State and during the beginning of his professional career...During his final collegiate season he pitched in 14 games and posted a 3.30 ERA (11 ER/30.0 IP) while batting .250 (31-124) and having a .911 OPS...Overall he finished he career at Oklahoma State with a career .957 OPS and 36 home runs...Was originally drafted by Baltimore in the third round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft but decided to return to school and was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft...He hit in his first two professional seasons and overall he finished as a .185 (27-146) hitter with nine home runs and 24 RBI.
