TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS:

- Activated from the 15-day IL **RHP Hunter Greene** (right groin strain).
- Signed to a 1-year Major League contract **OF/IF Garrett Hampson** (#6).
- Optioned to AAA-Louisville **OF Rece Hinds**.
- Transferred **RHP Carson Spiers** (right shoulder impingement) to the 60-day injured list.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 1 of a 3-game homestand vs **Joanna Schimmel's Cubs**.
- The Reds are coming off a brief 3-game trip at **Pit** where they went 1-2.
- Following Sun's matinee vs **Chc**, the Reds will embark on a 7-day, 6-game trip at **KC** (Mon-Wed) and against these very same **Cubs** at **Wrigley Field** next weekend.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the first time in 2025...the teams will square off again next weekend at **Wrigley Field** and 2 more times after that (8/4-8/6 at Chc & 9/18-9/21 at Cin).

- Cin went 8-5 last season vs **Chc**, and won 3 of the 4 series.
- The Reds are 188-185 vs **Chc** since 2003 and 85-103 since 2014.
- The Redlegs are 97-85 all-time vs the **Cubs** at **Great American Ball Park**, having won 19 of the last 31g here against their division rival.

REIGNING PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **OF Will Benson** on Mon was named National League Player of the Week for 5/12-5/18...for the week, he batted .526 (10-for-19) with 5 HR, 10 RBI, a .591 OBP and a 1.368 SLG...it's his first career selection and the first award for a Red since **Rece Hinds** last July.

- Since his promotion from AAA-Louisville on 5/9, he has hit safely in 8 of 10 apps (12-for-30, .400/.471/1.000) and has homered 5 times in his last 6 games, including a career-high 4-game HR streak from 5/15-5/18.
- He's collected an extra-base hit in a career-high 6 consecutive games in which he had an at-bat.
- The Reds are 6-5 since his 5/9 promotion.

REDS PITCHING: Over its last 7 games, Cin's pitching staff has allowed just 12 runs (12er), including 7 runs (7er) allowed by Reds starters.

- This current stretch marks just the fourth time since 1992 that Reds pitching has given up no more than 12 runs over a 7-game span.

- Conversely, Reds batters have scored fewer than 2 runs 14 times over their first 51 games of the season for the first time since 1945 (18 times)...have been shut out 8 times over their season's first 51 games for the first time since 1989 (8 shutouts).

ELLY MAKING HISTORY: **SS Elly De La Cruz** on 5/11 at **Hou** appeared in his 300th career game, becoming the first Major Leaguer since 1900 with at least 115 extra-base hits and 115 stolen bases through his first 300 career games (courtesy Elias).

- Elly** (23 years, 132 days today) needs 1 more hit to reach 300 for his career...he's attempting to become the sixth-youngest Red to reach that mark among those who debuted since 1900 (courtesy Elias).
- Is trying to become the fastest Major Leaguer by appearance (currently at 309g) since RBI became an official stat in 1920 to reach 300 hits (299), 150 RBI (153), and 100 stolen bases (118) for his career...would surpass **Fla's Hanley Ramirez** (328g, 2005-2008)...(courtesy Elias).

REHABBERS: Updates on the following Reds who are currently on rehabilitation assignments in the club's minor league system:

- RHP Rhett Lowder** (right forearm strain) on Sun continued his rehab assignment for AAA-Louisville vs Gwinnett (1ip, 1bb, 4bf, 12TP)...he was returned from his assignment today.
- INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand** (low back inflammation) began his rehab assignment yesterday with R-ACL Reds...in his first game vs **ACL Giants**, he played first base, batted second, and went 0-for-3 (2K).

OPEN FOR BUSINESS: Cin is 10-6 in series openers this season and 43-26 (.626) dating back to last year...only the **Mets** (45-25, .643) have a better record in the first game of series since the beginning of 2024.

- Cin is outscoring opponents in series openers this year, 74-52 and holding opponents to a .201/.269/.348 slash line.

ACTIVATED: Today was activated from the 15-day injured list (right groin strain)...was placed on the injured list on 5/9 (retroactive to 5/8) and missed 2 starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Exited the 5/7 game vs Atl with a right groin injury after 2 warm-up pitches in the top of the 4th inning... had pitched 3.0 shutout innings to that point (2h, 6k, 53TP).

- Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 2nd inning...was the third time this season he fanned all 3 batters he faced in an inning...has punched out all 3 batters he faced in an inning 17 times, which ranks second-most among all Major League pitchers since 2022, fewer only to Atl's Spencer Strider (22) and ranks sixth-most by a Cin pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961)...*courtesy Elias*.

ON MAY 2: Earned the 6-1 win on 5/2 vs Wsh (6.0ip, 2h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 12k, 1hr, 114TP).

- Collected his fifth quality start of the season.
- Fanned a season-high 12 batters...the only time he struck out more in a game was on 9/20/23 vs Min (14k).
- Marked his 10th career game w/ 10+ strikeouts.
- Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 2nd inning...has fanned all 3 batters he faced in an inning 16 times, which ranks second-most among all Major League pitchers since 2022, fewer only to Atl's Spencer Strider (22).
- Became the eighth Red since at least 1901 to post an outing of at least 6.0 innings with fewer than 3 hits and 2 walks while striking out at least 12 batters (last: Trevor Bauer, 7/26/20 vs Det).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 3-0 win on 5/18 vs Cle (5.0ip, 4h, 0r, 3bb, 5k, 1hb, 96TP).

- Had not issued a base-on-balls to any of his previous 45 batters until he gave up back-to-back walks to Carlos Santana and Gabriel Arias in the 1st inning...streak started on 5/1 vs StL (walk to Jordan to lead off the 4th inning).
- 28 of his 96 pitches were thrown in the 1st inning.
- It was his ninth career scoreless start of at least 5.0 innings, third-most by a Cin pitcher through their first 53 starts since 1901, fewer than only Gary Nolan (11g, 1967-68) and Ewell Blackwell (11g, 1946-47).

MAY 13: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-1, 10-inning loss on 5/13 vs CWS (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 7k, 96TP).

- Gave up Edgar Quero's 4th inning RBI-single to end his streak of having not allowed an ER in 13.1 straight innings.
- For the second consecutive start did not walk a batter.
- Was his second quality start of the season, his first since 4/18 at Bal...was his 20th career quality start.

MAY 6: Did not factor in the decision in the 2-1, 10-inning loss on 5/6 at Atl (5.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0bb, 8k, 91TP).

- Was his first scoreless outing of the season and his first since pitching 7.0 shutout innings vs Col on 7/8/24.
- Was his first career appearance in which he held his opponent without a run and walk.
- Was the first game in which he pitched that the Reds lost.

NO HITS IN THE FIRST: Has not allowed a hit in the 1st inning in any of his last 9 starts dating back to 8/12/24, it's the longest such streak in the majors... according to *Elias*, the 1st inning hitless streak matches Jim Maloney (9/17/68-4/30/69) for the longest-such run by a Reds pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961)...he last allowed a first inning hit in Mia's 6-4 win on 8/7/24 at loanDepotPark (Derek Hill grand slam).

HE EARNED IT: His 3.54 ERA (282.1ip, 115r/111er) through his first 53 career starts is third-lowest by a Reds left-handed starter behind only Don Gullett (3.09, 1970-73) and Ross Grimsley (3.27, 1971-72).
