Second baseman **Jeff Kent** will be officially inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, NY on Sunday. The best years of his 17-year Major League career came with the Giants from 1997-2002, when he posted a 31.6 of his career 55.4 bWAR as one of the pillars of the Giants' offense. He was a three-time All-Star, the 2000 NL MVP and won three of his four Silver Slugger awards as a Giant.

TODAY'S GAME: SF will try and make it two in a row and claim a series victory this afternoon after winning last night's game in 10 innings, 7-6.

- ▶ At 43-60 (.417), SF has the fifth-lowest win percentage in MLB and third-lowest in the National League ahead of the Mets (43-61, .413) and Rockies (42-63, .400).
- ▶ SF has won three straight home games, four of its last five and is 10-5 (.667) in its last 15 games here at Oracle Park dating to June 14...SF began the year 13-20 through its first 33 home games.
- ▶ The Giants' .667 home winning percentage since June 14 is tied for best in the Majors with Milwaukee (12-6, .667) and Tampa Bay (12-6, .667).

HALO TOP: The Giants are 29-20 (.592) all-time vs. the Angels... the .591 winning percentage vs. LAA is SF's third-best against all active teams, behind only its mark vs. the Guardians (17-10, .630) and Rangers (29-18, .617).

- ▶ SF faces Interleague opponents in eight of its 11 series following the All-Star break, also visiting the Rangers, Guardians and Red Sox and hosting the Tigers and Astros within the next month...SF's 10-18 (.357) Interleague record is lowest in the NL this year and second-lowest in the Majors ahead of only the Angels (11-20, .355).

RAY DAY: **LHP Robbie Ray** starts this afternoon for his 21st game (20th start) of the year... the Giants are 6-2 in Ray's last eight games (seven starts) dating to the start of June...Ray himself in that time owns a 1.88 ERA (10er, 48.0ip) that is fourth-lowest in the Majors in that time among players with at least seven starts.

- ▶ Ray is facing the Angels for a sixth time in his career...in his five prior starts he's 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9er, 32.0ip) with 38 strikeouts...four of his five career starts against them came in 2022 while pitching with Seattle and he hasn't faced them since then.

BIZ DEV: **IF Rafael Devers** slugged his 21st homer of the year last night and drove in three runs, including the game-winner with his walk-off single (the sixth walk-off hit and RBI of his career and first w/SF).

- ▶ Two of Devers' three RBI last night were go-ahead RBI, giving him 19 for the season... the 19 go-ahead RBI are tied for most in the Majors with Boston's Willson Contreras, the Dodgers' Shohei Ohtani, the Yankees' Ben Rice and St Louis' Jordan Walker.
- ▶ Since the start of May, Devers leads the Majors with 42 extra-base hits (72 games played)...the next closest players are Chicago-NL's Pete Crow-Amrstrong and Washington's James Wood (37 apiece).

CRACKED THE CASE: **IF Casey Schmitt** followed suit and slugged his 21st homer of the year later in last night's game to re-tie him with **IF Rafael Devers** for the team lead... Schmitt's 54 RBI are two shy of Devers' team-leading 56.

- ▶ Schmitt's homer last night came with two on for his ninth homer this year with runners on base...his nine homers with runners on lead the team ahead of **IF Willy Adames** (six).
- ▶ Five of SF's seven runs last night came via the home run...the Giants have scored 192 runs since June 1, with 99 coming via a home run (51.6%)...the 51.6% mark is fifth-highest in MLB over that span and second-highest in the NL behind only the Reds (59.1%).

ARROW UP: SF's highly-touted infield prospects **IF Josuar González** (SF's #1 prospect according to *MLB.com*) and **Luis Hernández** (#2) were both officially promoted to Single-A San Jose yesterday...both González and Hernández are also in *MLB.com*'s top-100 prospects overall checking in at #15 and #31, respectively.

- ▶ González, 18, only appeared in 30 games due to injuries but in those games he slashed .343/.451/.515 (.966 OPS) with seven doubles, two triples, two homers, 24 RBI and eight stolen bases.
- ▶ Hernández, 17, slashed .298/.382/.535 (.917 OPS) with 19 doubles, five triples, six homers and 45 RBI in 54 games for the ACL Giants...he ranked among the ACL leaders in doubles (1st), extra-base hits (30, T-3rd), triples (T-3rd), RBI (7th), total bases (106, 7th), OPS (T-8th) and SLG (9th).

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 19 at Seattle...threw 4.0 innings and allowed three runs (one earned) on eight hits and two walks with six strikeouts in the Giants 6-3 loss to the Mariners...hasn't suffered a loss since May 18, 2026 at Arizona.

SOLID STRETCH: Over his last eight outings, Ray has posted a 5-0 record with a 1.88 ERA (10er, 48.0ip), 37 strikeouts and a .198 opponents average against...he's been even better over his last six appearances, as he's held opponents to just five earned runs over 37.1 innings of work (1.21 ERA) and a 1.15 WHIP...this solid stretch came on the heels of a rough three games from May 13-24 where he posted a 0-2 record with an 11.08 ERA (16er, 13.0ip) and a .370 opponents average against.

LIMITING THE LONGBALL: Over his last nine games, Ray has allowed just two home runs over 52.0 innings (0.35 HR/9.0ip)...in his first 11 games, he allowed 13 homers over 58.2ip (1.99 HR/9.0ip).

WALK IT OUT: Has issued 54 walks over his 110.2 innings pitched this year, tied for the second-most walks in the Majors and his 4.39 walks per 9.0 inning ratio is the highest in the Majors.

SLIP AND SLIDE: Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 87.9 mph last year to 86.0 mph this year...opponents are 7-for-14 over his last three games...however, opponents were 1-for-17 off him in his previous five games.

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: Ray's changeup has a +5 run value this season (his best of any pitch in his arsenal) compared to a -1 run value a season ago...this year, hitters have an xBA of .206 on the offering while hitting .194 off it overall...it's been his second-best put away pitch (16.7%) behind his knuckle curve (24.0%)...in his last eight starts, hitters are 6-for-47 in at-bats that end with Ray's changeup.

AGAINST THE ANGELS: Is scheduled to face the Angels for the six time in his career...is 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9er, 32.0ip) with 38 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP over his five starts...he hasn't faced the Angels since 2022 when he faced them four times while pitching with the Mariners.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers are 11-for-27 (.407) off him over his last four games and hitting .324 (24-for-74) off him with four doubles, a triple and home run since May 13...prior to this stretch, lefties were 6-for-36 (.167) with no extra-base hits through his first eight starts of the year.
