- Opened the season with 29.0 homerless IP (March 31-April 30); His HR/IP ratio (1.80) is lowest since 2018 season (0.72).
- 13 of his 20 walks (65.0%) issued this season and 12 of his 56 strikeouts have come on 3-2 pitches.
- At age 36 (turns 37 on August 28), Miles is the oldest player on the team's active roster.
- Has entered his 8th season (was injured for all of 2020) with the Cardinals in 2025; Leads active pitchers in innings pitched (1,086.0), wins (64), strikeouts (789) and games started (188) as a Cardinal.
- The Cardinals are 103-85 in his 188 career starts with St. Louis and Miles holds a 64-63 mark as a Cardinal.
