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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip today through Toronto (1-1, 1 to play) and New York-NL (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-5 homestand, having been swept in a four-game set by the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Guardians...Baltimore is 3.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (1.0 GB) and Texas (2.0 GB) also in the mix.

👉 **Pete Alonso** hit his 299th career home run yesterday...He looks to become one of 19 active players in the majors to reach 300 career home runs, led by NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (456) and LAA's Mike Trout (425).

👉 The Birds struck out 11 times in yesterday's defeat...Baltimore has double-digit strikeouts in each of its last three games and in seven of its last nine contests...The O's have 10+ strikeouts in 66 games, tied for the second-most such games in franchise history (since 1954) behind the 2021 club (67 G)...The 66 such games are fifth most in the majors ahead of the Angels (72 G), Reds (71 G), White Sox (70 G), and Pirates (69 G).

BIRDS ON THE MEND: Last night, **Ryan Helsley** began a rehab appearance with Triple-A Norfolk and threw a scoreless inning with one strikeout.

👉 **Félix Bautista** also tossed an inning last night for the Tides, allowing one run on one hit (1 HR) and one walk with one strikeout...He is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (2 ER/6.2 IP), four walks, and eight strikeouts across seven appearances with Norfolk.

MR. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD: Over his last two starts, **Trevor Rogers** owns a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) with 17 strikeouts.

👉 He has not permitted a walk or home run in each of the outings...Today, he looks to become the eighth starter in franchise history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat in three straight starts, including the first since Dave Schmidt from July 10-19, 1987.

BLUES CLUES: **Colton Cowser** has hit safely in each of his last eight games against Toronto since May 29, batting .458 (11-for-24) with two doubles, three home runs, six runs, and nine RBI...The last Oriole to hit safely in nine straight opposite the Blue Jays in a single season was **Adley Rutschman** (11 G) from August 9-October 3, 2022.

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 16 straight games, slashing .286/.355/.625 (16-for-56) with one double, six home runs, 13 runs, 13 RBI, and five walks.

👉 It is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in MLB, including tied for second longest in the AL behind HOU's Isaac Paredes (19 G).

👉 Mayo's .576 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is second highest in the AL (min. 100 AB) behind TB's Victor Mesa Jr. (.581).

👉 Since August 31, he is 6-for-20 (.300) with three home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.

👉 Mayo is batting .316/.380/.735 (43-for-136) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.115) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole trailing Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

POLAR VORTEX: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 99), total bases (3rd, 277), home runs (4th, 35), OPS (5th, .860), slugging percentage (5th, .498), extra-base hits (6th, 59), runs (8th, 89), and hits (9th, 148).

👉 Alonso has started all 149 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with PHI's Bryce Harper and ATL's Matt Olson...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.

👉 He's played in 565 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (931 G).

👉 Alonso leads HOU's Yordan Alvarez (96) for the most RBI in the AL...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 45 homers since August 9, third most in MLB during that time behind the Cubs (60) and Mets (47).

👉 During its most recent road series in Colorado, Baltimore hit only one homer during the three-game set...Prior to that, the Orioles had homered in 13 of their last 15 road games, totaling 27 long balls from August 8-30.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 550 walks this season behind the Cubs (625 BB), Brewers (617 BB), and Dodgers (567 BB)...The White Sox are second in the AL with 535 free passes.

👉 The team's 31 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).

👉 The Birds are averaging 3.97 pitches per plate appearance, ranking second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.98).

'PEN PALS: Oriole relievers own a 2.34 ERA since August 21, second lowest in MLB behind the Braves (2.26)...Their nine saves during that period lead the majors ahead of the Astros and Pirates (both 8).

👉 **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 16 games (14.0 IP) since August 6...It's the longest scoreless streak, by games, by an Oriole since **Yennier Cano** (17 G) from April 14-May 17, 2023.

👉 Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 48-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, the second -most such games in the majors this year benind the Guardians (100 G, 52-48)...The .485 winning percentage in those games ranks 18th in the majors.

👉 Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage is tied for 26th in the majors.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 28th start of the season and 130th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on September 7 vs. Cleveland after throwing a season-high 7.1 innings of one-run ball, scattering six hits with zero walks and six strikeouts...Threw a season-high 104 pitches, 78 strikes.

👉 The 7.1 innings marked his most since August 1, 2025 at Chicago-NL (8.0), while the 104 pitches were his most since September 19, 2025 vs. New York-AL (106).

👉 Has not permitted a walk or home run in each of his last two starts covering 13.2 innings.

FLYING NORTH: Rogers is set to make his fifth career start opposite Toronto, having gone 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (9 ER/21.0 IP).

👉 Did not factor into the decision earlier this season at Camden Yards on May 29, allowing four runs on six hits (2 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts across 6.0 innings.

ATTACKING THE ZONE: Rogers owns a 69.5 percent first pitch strike rate, the highest clip in the majors ahead of SEA's Bryan Woo (69.4%).

👉 The 69.5 percent mark would signal the highest figure by an Oriole pitcher since tracking began in 1988, outpacing Wei-Yin Chen (68.3%, 2015).

👉 On July 24 vs. Atlanta, Rogers' 81.8 percent strike rate (72-of-88) marked the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of MIL's Jacob Misiorowski on August 2 at Los Angeles-AL (79.5%, 66-of-83).

👉 Under the same parameter, it was the highest strike rate by an Oriole pitcher in the pitch tracking era (since 2008), ahead of Kevin Gausman's 80.4 percent clip (86-of-107) on May 11, 2018 vs. Tampa Bay.

👉 From July 24-August 5, Rogers recorded 6+ strikeouts while issuing zero walks in three consecutive starts, tying the longest streak by an Oriole pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) along with Scott McGregor's three-start stretch from July 13-24 (G2), 1979.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Rogers owns a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in the first inning, allowing two home runs and five walks.

👉 In the second inning, however, he has posted a 5.40 ERA (16 ER/26.2 IP), allowing two long balls and seven free passes.

EBBS AND FLOWS: Over his last 17 starts since June 4, Rogers is 8-3 with a 2.88 ERA (33 ER/103.0 IP) and 1.05 WHIP.

👉 He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

👉 Over his first three starts of the season, Rogers went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) and a 1.05 WHIP.

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In 14 starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 26.5 percent strikeout rate and 25.4 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.

👉 Over his last 14 starts, he owns a 30.8 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 26.2 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

THORN IN THE SIDE: Opposing nine-hole hitters are 17-for-55 (.309) off Rogers, the second-highest batting average of any spot in the batting order behind the leadoff spot (.316, 24-for-76).

👉 Rogers has had the most success against two-hole batters, limiting them to a 9-for-71 (.127) clip.

RISPY BUSINESS: Rogers has a 1.031 opponent OPS with runners in scoring position and two outs, the fourth-highest mark in MLB (min. 50 BF) ahead of ATH's Jeffrey Springs (1.332), WSH's Jake Irvin (1.206), and STL's Michael McGreevy (1.054).
