TODAY'S GAME: Down 2-1 in the series, the Giants will try and salvage a split in the final game of this four-game set this afternoon.

- ▶ With last night's defeat, the Giants are 1-5 through their first six home games to start the 2026 campaign...it's the fourth time since this ballpark opened in 2000 SF has gone 1-5 (or worse) through the first six home games of the season...it also happened in 2015 (1-5), 2007 (1-5) and 2000 (0-6).
- ▶ It's also the fifth time in the last 12 seasons that SF has started a year with three (or fewer) wins through its first nine games...it's also happened in 2024, 2019, 2017 and 2015 (all 3-6 through nine games).
- ▶ SF is now 1-6 versus the Mets in its last seven games here at home dating to April 24, 2024...they have been outscored 44-17 in those seven games.
- ▶ Giants batters are 11-for-39 combined against today's Mets starter Kodai Senga...**IF Matt Chapman** leads that charge as he's 3-for-4 with a double, two homers, three RBI and three walks in seven plate appearances against Senga.

ACE IN THE HOLE: RHP Logan Webb heads to the hill this afternoon to make his third start of the campaign.

- ▶ Webb picked up his first win of the season last time out in San Diego last Tuesday in SF's 9-3 win...Webb uncharacteristically walked four batters through the first 3.0 innings in that outing while also allowing three runs in the 3rd inning...he bore down after that to finish 6.0 innings with just the three runs allowed.
- ▶ He'll try and do his part to pitch the Giants into the win column today following the club's two straight losses...in 2025, Webb went 11-6 with a 2.94 ERA in 20 starts following a Giants loss the game before...SF as a team went 11-9 in those 20 games.
- ▶ This afternoon's start will be the eighth of Webb's career against the Mets...in his previous seven starts he's 3-2 with a 3.21 ERA (15er, 42.0ip)...in his lone start against New York last year on July 25 here at Oracle, Webb was touched up for six runs on eight hits over 4.0 innings in an 8-1 Giants loss.

FEAST...OR FAMINE: SF's offense has been a bit all or nothing through the first nine games...in three wins the Giants have scored 19 runs on 35 hits, while in six losses they have scored five total runs on 25 hits, averaging 0.83 runs per game and 4.2 hits per game.

- ▶ In the wins, the trio of **IF Willy Adames**, **IF Matt Chapman** and **IF Rafael Devers** are slashing .359/.405/.641 (14-for-39)...in losses, they are slashing a combined .108/.183/.138 (7-for-65).
- ▶ Here at home in the early going the Giants have been held to three runs or fewer in five of their six games (one run or fewer in four of the six and shutout three times).
- ▶ Through nine games, SF's offense overall is slashing .206/.269/.296 for a .565 OPS...the .206 clip is fourth-lowest in the National League ahead of only Arizona (.204), Cincinnati (.203) and San Diego (.190)...the .565 OPS is second-lowest in the NL ahead of only the Padres (.553).

- ▶ The Giants' 24 runs through nine games are their fewest in a season since 2015 when they also scored 24 runs through their first nine games...overall, the 24 runs are tied for the fourth-fewest by a Giants club through nine games to start a season since 1898.

ALL THE PHEELS: SF's homestand continues tomorrow with the first of three against the visiting Philadelphia Phillies, an opponent the Giants have played extremely well against here at home in recent history.

- ▶ The Giants have not lost a home series to the Phillies since 2013 and have won seven consecutive home series over the Phillies dating to 2018 (excludes 2020 when the two teams did not play).
- ▶ More recently, the Giants are 12-3 against the Phillies at home dating to the beginning of 2021 with a +16 run differential (79-63)...last season, SF went 2-1 against the Phillies here in early July.

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his first win of the campaign last Tuesday in San Diego in SF's 9-3 win...Webb gutted through 6.0 innings after giving up three runs in the 3rd inning and walking four batters through the first 3.0 innings...Webb ended up retiring the final 10 batters he faced and mentioned to media postgame he was "searching for it" a bit and ended up going back to his regular windup sometime after the troublesome 3rd inning.

VS. NEW YORK-NL: Faces the Mets for an eighth time in his career today and for a sixth time here at home...was roughed up by New York in his only start against them last season here at Oracle Park on July 25...in that outing, Webb allowed six runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings in an 8-1 Giants loss...prior to that outing he'd been 3-0 with a 1.98 ERA (6er, 27.1ip) in his four career starts against the Mets at Oracle Park...overall, Webb is 3-2 with a 3.21 ERA (15er, 42.0ip) in his seven starts against them.

***FLIPS OPEN SIGN AROUND*:** Was SF's Opening Day starter for a fifth consecutive season in 2026...Webb's five consecutive Opening Day starts are now second-most in team history trailing only **Juan Marichal's** six straight Opening Day starts from 1964-69...Webb is also one of five pitchers in team history to make at least five Opening Day starts...the others are: Marichal (10), **Carl Hubbell** (six), **Larry Jansen** (five) and **Madison Bumgarner** (five).

HE POSTS: Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 831.0 innings...the next closest pitcher is Detroit's **Framber Valdez**, who has logged 779.2 innings...Webb's 86 quality starts since 2022 are also tops in the Majors ahead of Valdez' 85...lastly, his 134 starts in that span are most in MLB ahead of the WSH's **Miles Mikolas** and TOR's **Dylan Cease** (132 apiece).

DO IT FOR WEBBY: The Giants were only 18-16 in Webb's 34 starts last year, which was actually an improvement over them going 16-17 in his 33 starts in 2024...since 2022, SF as a team is 68-66 in Webb's 134 starts yet his 3.27 ERA in that time is 11th-best in MLB among starters who have made at least 75 starts...his 2.94 FIP in that span in best in the National League and trails only DET's **Tarik Skubal** (2.52).

DO NOT PASS GO, DO NOT COLLECT \$200: Webb enters today having not allowed a homer in 30.1 innings dating to the 4th inning on September 11 of last year, the fourth-longest active streak for a starter in MLB behind **Shane Bieber** (39.1), **Tyler Glasnow** (33.2) and **Joe Boyle** (30.2)...in 2025, Webb's 0.61 HR/9ip ratio was fourth-best in the Majors.

STARS & STRIPES: The Giants' ace suited up for USA in the World Baseball Classic and made two terrific starts in their win over Brazil plus their quarterfinal win over Canada...in the two outings, Webb was 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1er, 8.2ip) with five hits allowed, one walk and 11 strikeouts...Webb was one of two Giants named to the WBC All-Tournament Team (also **Luis Arraez** at 1B for champion Venezuela).

CACTUS LEAGUE: With his time at the WBC, Webb only made three Cactus League starts and was 2-0 with a 6.75 ERA (7er, 9.1ip) with 10 strikeouts to one walk...six of the seven runs he allowed in Cactus League play came in his final start upon returning from WBC action.

LET'S LOOK BACK: The Rocklin, CA native finished fourth in the NL Cy Young Award voting in 2025 after leading the Majors in innings pitched (207.0) and the National League in strikeouts (224) while going 15-11 with a 3.22 ERA...*the last Giant prior to Webb to lead the NL in both innings pitched and strikeouts was Bill Voiselle in 1944*...Webb garnered his second All-Star selection, eclipsed the 200-inning threshold for a third straight season, made a career-best 34 starts and set a career-high with his 224 strikeouts.

HELPING THE CATCHER: Webb improved his ability to keep runners in check in 2025 and limit steals...he had +5 Net Bases Prevented (a sum of advanced prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher)...he had scores of -5 in 2024, -9 in 2023 and -4 in 2022, -1 in 2021 and -3 in 2020...from 2020-2024, Webb allowed an average of 14 stolen bases/year (72 in five seasons)...in 2025, Webb allowed nine stolen bases.

ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

2026 RECORD: 0-1, 1.69 ERA

▶ Will be making his first home start for the Giants after signing a two-year contract with SF this offseason.
 ▶ Had a solid season debut despite receiving a loss...a couple of errors led to two unearned runs...overall he allowed three runs (one earned) over 5.1 innings.
 ▶ Is coming off a strong 2025 season in which he went 8-5 with a 3.31 ERA (46er, 125.0ip) and 92 strikeouts...started the year with a 2.10 ERA (16er, 68.2ip) in 11 starts for the White Sox before struggling with Tampa Bay (4.79 ERA).

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 4/4 vs. NYM; 1.1ip, 3h, r, er, k, hr (22 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 0-for-6 against him early in 2026 while righties are 4-for-8 with two homers...has held lefties to a .179 clip (67-for-375) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Made his fourth career Opening Day roster (also with the Pirates in 2025 and 2024 and with the Blue Jays in 2021).
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with the Sox as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 1.1ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 2k, hr (38 pitches)

- ▶ His homer allowed to NYM's Francisco Alvarez Friday night was the first he'd allowed since October 4, 2022 (also vs. the Mets), a span of 35.2 innings at the MLB level in that time.
- ▶ Made his fourth career OD roster (also: 2020-2022 with Pittsburgh).
- ▶ Began 2025 on NYY's injured list with left rib fractures...made six rehab appearances before appearing in 12 games with NYY (3.38 ERA, 6er, 16.0ip)...was then DFA'ed on Aug. 5.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 1.2ip, 2h, bb, 2k (37 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster...has appeared in four of SF's first nine games, tossing 4.2-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 38.1 innings dating to June 11, 2023, the 12th-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Went 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11er, 25.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP in 27 games (two starts) for the Giants last season.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/4 vs. NYM; 1.0ip, k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Appeared in four games for SF (all lopsided losses) but has thrown 4.0 total innings with no hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts.
- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster after returning to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 0.2ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, bb, k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Made his third career Opening Day roster (all with San Francisco).
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 47.2 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the seventh-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.
- ▶ Walked 20 batters in 30.0 innings in 2025 (15.6% walk rate).

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

Last Game: 4/2 vs. NYM; SV, 3.0ip, 2h, 2k (37 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled Thursday with **RHP José Buttó** being placed on the IL... logged his first career save in his Giants debut Thursday night pitching against the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants **MGR Tony Vitello** while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 Draft.
