QUICK HITS: Set to make his fourth start of the season and the 19th of his career... Spun 4.2 innings in his last start on April 13 vs. Toronto, allowing two earned runs on seven hits with two strikeouts against one walk...Did not factor in the decision... Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his major league debut in 2024 when he started on June 6 at Toronto...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL and the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, along with Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12, 2024 vs. Atlanta, became the 11th Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP)...At 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23-249) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24-144) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martinez (24-081) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nuñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

AGAINST CINCINNATI: Will be facing the Reds for the first time in his major league career...Also marks the first time in his career he will be facing a NL Central opponent... Owns an 0-1 record with a 4.82 ERA (5 ER/9.1 IP) in two career starts against NL opponents (June 12, 2024 vs. ATL, August 29 at Los Angeles-NL).

LATE BLOOMER: In the first three innings of his starts this season, opponents are hitting .419 (18-for-43) compared to just .273 (6-for-22) in innings four through six...All nine of his runs allowed this season have come in innings one through three.

DAY AND NIGHT: Povich was 0-4 with a 9.15 ERA (21 ER/20.2 IP) with 17 walks (1 IBB) and 19 strikeouts in five day starts last season...He went 3-5 with a 3.81 ERA (25 ER/59.0 IP) with 17 walks and 50 strikeouts in 11 night starts in 2024...Tonight will be the first night game Povich has started in 2025.

FOREVER YOUNG: At 25 years, 6 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the third-youngest player overall behind Jackson Holliday (21-135) and Gunnar Henderson (23-293).

GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE: Povich went 2-1 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER/14.2 IP) with nine hits (1 HR), four walks, and 15 strikeouts in four starts in Spring Training...In his last outing on March 18 vs. Toronto, working 5.0 no-hit innings with three walks and six strikeouts... Retired 15 of the final 16 batters faced after walking the first two batters of the game.
