**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles secured their first series win of the year last night, beating the Guardians, 6-2...The homestand wraps up this weekend with a three-game set against the Reds...Baltimore went 3-2 in the first five games against Toronto (1-1) and Cleveland (2-1).

⚾ Entering Thursday, the O's were one of four teams in the majors without a series victory along with the Astros, Braves, and Rockies.

⚾ **Tomoyuki Sugano** surrendered two solo home runs in 7.0 innings, the longest outing by an Oriole of the season...He's the 17<sup>th</sup> different Japanese-born pitcher to earn a win at Oriole Park and the first since CHC's Shota Imanaga on July 10, 2024.

⚾ Baltimore homered three times for the second straight night...Marks the first time the club has hit at least three in back-to-back games since July 19-20, 2024, and the first time at home since June 25-27, 2024.

⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** ripped his first homer of the year in the opening frame...He started in the second spot of the order for the first time since September 14, 2023...Henderson set the team record for home runs by a shortstop last season with 37.

⚾ **Ryan O'Hearn** hit a go-ahead, three-run homer in the third inning...He's homered in at least two straight games for the eighth time in his career (last: 2 G, 9/27-28/24).

⚾ The Orioles have not won three straight games since capping off the 2024 regular season with a three-game sweep at Minnesota from September 27-29.

**CED AND DONE:** **Cedric Mullins** is one of three MLB players leading their team in hits (16), homers (4), RBI (17), and walks (13) along with NYY's Aaron Judge and CHC's Kyle Tucker, per *Stats Perform*.

⚾ He ranks among AL leaders in on-base percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .443), RBI (3<sup>rd</sup>, 17), walks (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 13), OPS (5<sup>th</sup>, 1.043), and slugging percentage (6<sup>th</sup>, .600).

⚾ Mullins has walked at least once in five straight games, matching the longest such stretch of his career (also 9/7-11 [G1]/21)...He's drawing a walk every 5.4 plate appearances this season and his 18.6 percent walk rate ranks in the top four percent of MLB.

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The O's are 8-2 when scoring four or more runs this year and winless (0-8) when scoring three or fewer.

⚾ Since 2024, Baltimore is 88-21 (.807) when scoring four or more runs, the fourth-best winning percentage in MLB during that stretch behind San Diego (89-14, .864), Cleveland (84-15, .848), and Houston (80-19, .808)...During that same period, the Birds are 11-60 (.155) when scoring three runs or fewer, the fourth-worst mark in the majors ahead of the White Sox (12-106, .102), Rockies (14-79, .151), and Diamondbacks (9-50, .153).

⚾ The O's have lost 18 straight games when scoring three runs or fewer dating to September 7, 2024, with their last such victory coming on September 6, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (2-0).

**LONG BALL LIVING:** The Birds have hit 11 homers during the five games on this homestand, tallying multi-homer performances in four of the five contests...This follows a 10-game stretch from March 30-April 9 in which they hit an MLB-low two homers.

⚾ Tonight, Baltimore looks to homer in a sixth straight game for the first time in a single season since doing so in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024...The team set a club record by going deep in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, 2024.

⚾ The O's have received 10 long balls from their 6-9 hole hitters, second most in MLB behind the Angles and Yankees (both 11 HR).

**'PEN PALS:** **Seranthony Domínguez** has thrown 7.1 scoreless innings across eight appearances to open the season, allowing one hit and six walks with nine strikeouts...He has not allowed a hit in a career-high-tying seven straight appearances (also 5/29-6/16/24)...His seven-game run is tied for the longest active streak in MLB with AZ's Shelby Miller and Adam Ottavino, who last pitched for the Yankees on April 7.

⚾ **Matt Bowman** owns a 1.08 ERA (1 ER/8.1 IP) with three strikeouts across seven appearances...He has not issued a walk in a career-best 13 straight appearances since September 24, 2024...The 13-outing run is the third-longest active run in MLB behind TB's Manuel Rodríguez (17 G) and STL's Phil Maton (14 G).

⚾ **Yennier Cano** has yet to allow a run across 7.1 innings, scattering four hits and one walk while fanning seven...**Bryan Baker** owns a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) over nine outings.

⚾ Overall, O's relievers have allowed 0.42 home runs per 9.0 innings, the third-lowest mark in the majors behind the Mets (0.37) and Cardinals (0.38).

**ADVANCED TALK:** O's batters have produced a collective 45.8 percent hard-hit rate, ranking third in the majors behind the Yankees (47.1%) and Red Sox (46.4%).

⚾ On Wednesday, Baltimore collected a season-high 17 hard-hit balls (95+ mph exit velocity), its most since September 25, 2024 at New York-AL (18).

⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** has recorded a 69.0 percent hard-hit rate, second best among batters (min. 25 batted balls) behind ATL's Drake Baldwin (70.4%)...**Ryan Mountcastle** (55.6%), **Ryan O'Hearn** (52.5%), and **Heston Kjerstad** (51.5%) are all above 50 percent.

**NO RISP, NO REWARD:** In their eight wins, the O's are batting .365 (23-for-63) with three doubles, one triple, and four home runs with runners in scoring position...In their 10 losses, they own a .113 (6-for-53) RISP average with one extra-base hit.

⚾ Baltimore pitching has limited the opposition to a .212 (35-for-165) RISP average, the fourth-lowest mark in the AL and sixth in MLB.

**SEEING RED:** The Orioles and Reds meet for their only series of the season this weekend at Camden Yards...Baltimore swept a three-game set at Great American Ball Park last year from May 3-5...Entering this series, the O's and Redlegs have only squared off in the regular season 21 times, tied with the Cardinals and Dodgers for the fewest against a single opponent by Baltimore in team history...The clubs first met in the 1970 World Series, with the Orioles defeating the Big Red Machine, 4-1, to win their second title...The teams met in the regular season for the first time in 2005.

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his fourth start of the season and the 19<sup>th</sup> of his career... Spun 4.2 innings in his last start on April 13 vs. Toronto, allowing two earned runs on seven hits with two strikeouts against one walk...Did not factor in the decision... Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his major league debut in 2024 when he started on June 6 at Toronto...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL and the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, along with Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12, 2024 vs. Atlanta, became the 11<sup>th</sup> Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP)...At 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23-249) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24-144) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martinez (24-081) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nuñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

**AGAINST CINCINNATI:** Will be facing the Reds for the first time in his major league career...Also marks the first time in his career he will be facing a NL Central opponent... Owns an 0-1 record with a 4.82 ERA (5 ER/9.1 IP) in two career starts against NL opponents (June 12, 2024 vs. ATL, August 29 at Los Angeles-NL).

**LATE BLOOMER:** In the first three innings of his starts this season, opponents are hitting .419 (18-for-43) compared to just .273 (6-for-22) in innings four through six...All nine of his runs allowed this season have come in innings one through three.

**DAY AND NIGHT:** Povich was 0-4 with a 9.15 ERA (21 ER/20.2 IP) with 17 walks (1 IBB) and 19 strikeouts in five day starts last season...He went 3-5 with a 3.81 ERA (25 ER/59.0 IP) with 17 walks and 50 strikeouts in 11 night starts in 2024...Tonight will be the first night game Povich has started in 2025.

**FOREVER YOUNG:** At 25 years, 6 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the third-youngest player overall behind Jackson Holliday (21-135) and Gunnar Henderson (23-293).

**GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE:** Povich went 2-1 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER/14.2 IP) with nine hits (1 HR), four walks, and 15 strikeouts in four starts in Spring Training...In his last outing on March 18 vs. Toronto, working 5.0 no-hit innings with three walks and six strikeouts... Retired 15 of the final 16 batters faced after walking the first two batters of the game.
