**TODAY'S GAME:** The Atlanta Braves and San Francisco Giants today commence a three-game midweek series with the first of six scheduled games between the clubs this season...The Braves will travel to San Francisco to round out the season set during their next road trip, from June 26-28.

- A* Atlanta dropped two-of-three games to the New York Mets over the weekend...After losing two games to the Chicago White Sox during the series prior, the Braves have lost back-to-back sets for the first time this season.
- A* The Braves went 1-5 against the Giants last season, with their only win occurring at Truist Park, 9-5...Atlanta struck out 61 times across those six matchups.
- A* Before going 1-5 last year, Atlanta had won or tied the season series with San Francisco in seven consecutive seasons.
- A* RH Adrian Houser will take the ball for San Francisco as he faces the Braves for the ninth time (seventh start) in his major-league career... Overall, the right-hander is 0-5 with a 5.19 ERA (20 ER/34.2 IP) against the club...The 6-foot-4, 227-pound, 10-year veteran is pitching for his fifth team in the last four seasons...He spent his first seven campaigns with the Milwaukee Brewers... The native of Tahlequah, OK, is 2-6 with a 5.54 ERA (40 ER/65.0 IP) this year.

**GRANT HOLMES:** Earns the start for the Braves as he's 4-2 with a 4.05 ERA (30 ER/66.2 IP)...His last outing came against the Chicago White Sox on June 9, when he pitched 3.2 innings and surrendered three runs...The right-hander only whiffed two batters, tied for the second-lowest total of any of his starting assignments.

- A* The 6-foot-0, 226-pound native of Conway, SC, has twice faced the Giants, going 1-1 with a 1.86 ERA (2 ER/9.2 IP) between one start and one relief appearance...In his lone start, he pitched 7.0 innings and surrendered just two runs...He struck out six in a Braves win, 13-2.
- A* Holmes has generated 39 of his 59 strikeouts this season with his slider, the third most among National League starters...Hitters are missing 41.0% of their swings against the pitch, the third-highest slider whiff rate among pitchers with at least 400 thrown.

**RISP:** The Braves went 1-for-5 with runners in scoring position on Sunday, and have hit below their season average in five of their last six games...Dating to June 7 versus Pittsburgh, the team is batting .200 (8-for-40) with RISP.

- A* Despite the downturn, Atlanta's .285 batting average with RISP is still the best in MLB...The Milwaukee Brewers rank second (.281).
- A* Ozzie Albies is tied for sixth in the National League with a .357 RISP batting average.

**BULLPEN:** Dylan Dodd, James Karinchak, Reynaldo López and Anthony Molina emerged from Atlanta's bullpen on Sunday to cover 4.0 one-run innings... The cohort lowered Atlanta's ERA in relief to 2.82 (79 ER/252.1 IP), the best in Major League Baseball by a significant margin.

- A* The Boston Red Sox rank second in the majors with a bullpen ERA of 3.09...In the National League, San Diego is the next-closest with a 3.10 mark.
- A* Among National League pitchers with at least 10 appearances, four of the top six ERAs belong to Braves: Robert Suarez (1st, 0.59), Dylan Lee (4th, 1.14), Raisel Iglesias (5th, 1.16) and Dylan Dodd (6th, 1.17).
- A* San Diego's Mason Miller (2nd, 0.90) and Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (3rd, 1.06) are interjected between them.
- A* Through 70 games, the last NL team to own four of the top six ERAs (min. 10 games) was the 1933 San Francisco Giants: Hal Schumacher (1st, 1.58), Hi Bell (3rd, 1.74), Dolf Luque (4th, 1.79) and Carl Hubbell (5th, 1.84).

**OPENERS AT HOME:** The Braves return to Truist Park 10-1 in series-opening games here, the most wins and highest winning percentage at a home venue in Major League Baseball...The Tampa Bay Rays rank second, going 9-2 (.909) in such games.

- A* On average, the Braves have scored 5.27 runs per game in series openers at Truist Park, while limiting opponents to 3.09 runs per game...The team has pitched to a 2.91 ERA (33 ER/102.0 IP).
- A* The club's lone loss in a home series opener occurred on April 13 versus the Miami Marlins... Atlanta has won seven straight series openers here since that date.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves yesterday returned C Drake Baldwin from his rehabilitation assignment and reinstated him from the injured list, and outrighted C Austin Wynns to Triple-A Gwinnett...Additionally, the Braves today selected INF Brewer Hicklen to the major league roster and optioned him to Gwinnett.

- A* Baldwin returns to action after missing 23 games due to a strained right oblique muscle...He homered in the only game of his rehabilitation assignment on June 13 at Jacksonville.
- A* The left-handed-hitting native of Madison, WI, is percentage points away from qualification...Among NL batters with at least 200 plate appearances, though, he ranks highly in multiple stat categories: OPS (4th, .931), slugging percentage (6th, .543) and batting average (7th, .303).
- A* In Baldwin's absence, Atlanta catchers slashed .110/.108/.123 (8-for-73) with a .231 OPS, zero runs and three RBI...The cohort logged one extra-base hit in that time.

#### Today's Game

- Makes his 14th start of the season and the 42nd of his career in the opener of a series against San Francisco at Truist Park.
- Received a no-decision in his most recent outing June 9 at Chicago (AL), allowing three runs on four hits over 3.2 innings with two walks and two strikeouts on 67 pitches in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings at Rate Field.
- Has posted five quality starts over 13 turns this season, going 4-2 with a 4.05 ERA (30 ER/66.2 IP) and 59 strikeouts...Is holding opposing hitters to a .235 average (60-for-255).
- Has issued 29 walks and surrendered 13 home runs through 13 starts, equating to a 3.92 BB/9 and a 1.75 HR/9.
- Has generated 39 of his 59 strikeouts this season with his slider, the third-most among National League starters.
  - Hitters are missing 41.0 percent of their swings against the pitch, the third-highest slider whiff rate among pitchers with at least 400 thrown.
- Has held opponents 0-for-8 with the bases loaded in 2026.
- Over his last five starts since May 17, owns a 3.55 ERA (10 ER/25.1 IP) with 25 strikeouts.
- Enters with a streak of 34 consecutive appearances issuing at least one walk, dating to March 31, 2025, the 17th-longest active such streak in the majors.
- His 41 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.

#### 2026

- Received a no-decision June 9 at Chicago (AL), allowing three runs on four hits over 3.2 innings with two walks and two strikeouts on 67 pitches in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings at Rate Field.
  - Made his first career start against the White Sox and his first appearance at Rate Field...Surrendered a two-run home run to Vargas in the third.
- Earned the win June 3 against Toronto, allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 89 pitches in Atlanta's 7-3 victory at Truist Park...Stranded the bases loaded with no outs in the first inning and surrendered a leadoff home run to Lukes in the third...Logged his fifth quality start.
  - Recorded his 250th career strikeout within the start.
- Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career and his first of 2026 on May 23 against Washington, fanning the side in order in the first inning - the first such frame by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.
- Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.
- Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.

#### Career Recap

- Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- In his MLB debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.
- In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Stripers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.
- Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
