### Bryce Elder

Starts tonight and enters play 3-0 with a majors-best 1.92 ERA (14 ER/65.2 IP). His ERA is the lowest by an Atlanta pitcher through 11 starts since 2015, when Shelby Miller pitched to a 1.89 ERA in his first 11 turns.

No Atlanta pitcher has won the N.L. ERA title since Greg Maddux compiled a 2.22 ERA in 1998.

Through the first 20 starts of his career, Elder's 2.30 ERA (30 ER/117.1 IP) is lowest in franchise history in the live-ball era (since 1920).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Mets tonight open a three-game series with what is the fourth of 13 games between the teams this season...The two will next meet from August 11-13, playing a four-game set at Citi Field in Queens.

*A* Atlanta has won two of the first three games this season against New York, winning a series at Citi Field, April 28 to May 1.

*A* The Braves went 10-9 against the Mets last season, taking the season set from their N.L. East rivals for the fifth consecutive season...They also went 10-9 in 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 53-36 (.596) against New York overall.

*A* The Braves have won eight of the last 10 games with New York dating to last season, outscoring the Mets 58-32 (+26) over the stretch...Atlanta is 6-1 against New York here at Truist Park in that span.

*A* Atlanta and New York tied atop the N.L. East with identical 101-61 record last season, with the Braves winning the title based on the head-to-head tiebreaker...The Braves were a season-worst 10.5 games behind the first-place Mets on June 1...From that date through the end of the season, Atlanta played to a 78-34 (.696) record, the best mark in baseball...New York went 67-44 (.604), the sixth-best mark in the majors.

*A* RH Bryce Elder has never started against New York, but did face the Mets in his only career relief appearance last season...The 6-foot-2, 225-pound right-hander went 2.1 innings out of the bullpen in that game, allowing five hits and three runs... Through 11 starts this season, Elder is 3-0 with a majors-best 1.92 ERA (14 ER/65.2 IP).

*A* RH Carlos Carrasco has pitched in five games and made four starts against Atlanta in his career, going 2-2 with a 4.30 ERA (11 ER/23.0 IP)...Three of his four starts came last season, when he went 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA (6 ER/16.0 IP) versus the Braves...The 6-foot-3, 212-pound Venezuela native is 2-2 with a 5.74 ERA (20 ER/31.1 IP) in six starts this season.

**WIN:** Atlanta scored four ninth-inning runs to rally and defeat Arizona, 8-5, on Sunday afternoon...All four scored on a two-out grand slam from Eddie Rosario.

*A* Rosario's grand slam was the fifth in Atlanta history (since 1966) to come with two outs in the ninth inning and give the Braves the lead, and the first since Jeff Francoeur hit a walk-off grand slam off Washington's Chad Cordero on May 13, 2006.

*A* Rosario's was the first such slam to come on the road...The other four all came in the bottom of the ninth and gave Atlanta a walk-off win.

*A* Atlanta's win on Sunday was its first of the season in which it entered the ninth inning trailing...The Braves were 0-19 when losing after eight innings prior to Sunday's victory.

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE:** Atlanta took two-of-three from Arizona over the weekend...The D-backs entered the series tied for the best record in the National League with Los Angeles.

*A* With the wins, Atlanta improved to 16-14 in games against teams .500 or better this season...Per Codify, the Braves are the only N.L. team with a winning record against competition at or above .500.

*A* New York enters tonight with a 30-30 (.500) record.

**BULLPEN:** Four Atlanta relievers combined to pitch 5.1 scoreless innings on Sunday and the Braves' bullpen has not allowed a run since May 30 at Oakland, a scoreless streak of four games and 13.0 innings...The club is 3-1 in that span.

*A* That scoreless stretch is the longest active in the majors by both games and innings, and the Braves' longest this season in both regards.

*A* The Braves' bullpen last posted four straight scoreless games from October 1-4, 2022, in contests against the New York Mets (2 games) and Miami Marlins (2 games).

*A* Every National League club, except for Atlanta, has allowed at least one run in relief this month...In June, Chicago is the only A.L. club with a scoreless bullpen.

*A* The Atlanta bullpen pitched to a 4.11 ERA (90 ER/197.2 IP) prior to the start of its current streak, ranking 18th in the majors...Its current scoreless run has lowered the collective ERA to 3.86 (90 ER/213.2 IP) for the season, 12th best in baseball.

**OFFENSE:** Braves batters have combined for 13 runs and 25 hits in their last two games, both wins, after compiling just nine runs and 24 hits in the previous four games.

*A* Atlanta is batting .342/.410/.534 and has seven extra-base hits in its last two games...In the previous four, the club hit .188/.246/.344 and went 1-3.

*A* The Braves lead the National League with a .791 OPS on the season, and rank second in homers (97) and tied for second in total runs (297).

*A* Atlanta's offense has combined to produce a wRC+ of 112, the fourth-best mark in baseball and trailing just the Dodgers (115) for highest in the National League.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Braves today recalled RHP Roddery Muñoz to Atlanta after optioning RHP Michael Soroka to Triple-A Gwinnett yesterday...Atlanta today also acquired RHP Ben Heller from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for international bonus pool money and optioned him to the Stripers.

*A* Additionally, RHP Michael Tonkin tonight begins a rehabilitation assignment with the Stripers, LHP Lucas Luetge was outrighted to Gwinnett, and OF Nick Solak was designated for assignment.

### Tonight's Game

Set to make his second appearance, first career start against New York (NL) and 12th on the season.

Enters play with 16 consecutive outings of at least 5.0 innings pitched.

Scattered five hits and three walks over 7.1 innings pitched of one-run ball with five strikeouts in his last start at Oakland.

With his last outing, Elder now has 15 games of at least 5.1 innings pitched in 20 career starts; tied for second most in Atlanta franchise history through as many games started...Tommy Hanson has the most with 16 through 20 career starts.

His 1.92 ERA on the season is the lowest in the lowest in the majors among qualified starters.

No Braves pitcher was won the ERA title since Greg Maddux (2.22) in 1998.

Elder's 2.84 ERA with runners on base is the lowest in baseball among qualifiers.

Opponents are hitting .173 against him with runners on base, the second lowest rate in the NL and third in MLB (among QS).

His 57.7 LOB% is the third lowest in the majors (among QS).

His groundball rate of 57.5% of balls put in play is the fifth highest in the majors among qualified starters.

Has recorded an out on 65.9% of those grounders put in play, also the fifth highest rate in baseball among qualifiers.

Is 4-1 with a 1.83 ERA over his last 16 games started after being recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett for the second time, dating to August 14, 2022.

His 1.83 ERA is the lowest among pitchers with at least 15 starts during that span.

In that stretch, Elder is averaging 6.0 innings pitched per outing, the fourth highest rate in the National League (min. 15 starts).

He has five starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Atlanta franchise history (since 1966) in a player's first 15 starts...Larry McWilliams ('78) and Ian Anderson ('20-'21) both had four such starts.

### 2023 Recap

Elder's 2.30 ERA through 20 career starts is the lowest in Atlanta franchise history to begin a career.

His 117.1 innings pitched through his first 20 games started are the most by an Atlanta player to begin their career since Julio Teheran in 2011-13.

His 30 earned runs allowed are also the fewest during that span.

Elder has held opponents to one run or less in seven games this season while pitching at least 5.0 frames in every outing.

His 11 appearances of at least 5.0 innings pitched while holding opponents to one run or less are the most through a player's first 21 outings in Atlanta franchise history.

### 2022 Recap

Made nine starts and pitched in 10 total games during his debut season, compiling a 2-4 record with a 3.17 ERA (19 ER/54.0 IP)...Surpassed his rookie innings limit in his final start of the season, but was rated as Atlanta's No. 4 prospect during the season.

Pitched the first shutout of his career, September 26 at Washington, allowing just six hits and one walk...Struck out six...The Braves beat the Nationals, 8-0.

The outing is the only shutout by a Braves pitcher on the season.

Elder became the first Braves rookie to throw a shutout since Paul Marak in 1990.

Started on August 14 at Miami...He pitched 7.0 innings in that start, allowing three hits and one run in the no-decision, and fanned a career-most 10 batters...The Braves beat the Marlins, 3-1.

Became just the third Braves player in the live-ball era (since 1920) to log a double-digit strikeout effort within the first six games of his career...He joined LHP Mike Minor (12 strikeouts at the Cubs in his third career game) and RHP Ryan Weber (10 strikeouts vs. Washington in his fifth appearance).

### Career

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.

Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.

Made his professional debut during the 2021 season and pitched across three levels of the Braves' farm system...Went a combined 11-5 with a 2.76 ERA (41 ER/133.2

# Braves Bullpen Briefs

**Nick Anderson • RHP • 6-4 • 205 • 32 yrs • #61**

**Saves/Opp: 1/3 Holds: 10 1st Batter/Retired: 23/22 Inherited Runners/Scored: 5/1**

- Per FanGraphs, has held opponents to a .111 batting average in high-leverage situations...Among pitchers with at least 10 high-leverage appearances, that average ranks second in the National League and fifth in MLB.
- On May 24, the first batter he faced (Will Smith, LAD) hit an opposite-field single...Marked the first time Anderson had let his first batter reach this season...Had retired the first batter in each of his first 19 outings... Anderson was one of two pitchers in the majors to retire the first batter every time (min. 19 appearances)...Also Wandy Peralta (NYY, 23 games)...The last Braves reliever to retire the first batter in each of his first 19 appearances was Brandon Cunniff in 2015...Cunniff retired the first batter in each of his first 24 outings.
- Has induced a swing and miss on 29 curveballs this season, tied for third most by an MLB reliever on the pitch.
- His save on April 11 was the ninth of his career and his first since September 26, 2021, versus Miami, the last major league game he pitched before undergoing right elbow surgery.
- 2023 is his fourth major league season...Prior to this season, owned a 2.89 ERA (28 ER/87.1 IP) and 137 strikeouts in 93 career games over three major league seasons, pitching for the Marlins (2019) and Rays (2019-21).
- Did not appear in the majors in 2022 after undergoing right elbow surgery in October of 2021.

**Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 39 yrs • #60**

**Saves/Opp: 1/3 Holds: 11 1st Batter/Retired: 26/18 Inherited Runners/Scored: 11/6**

- Among pitchers with at least 25 appearances, his 1.80 ERA (5 ER/25.0 IP) ranks third in the N.L. and 10th in MLB.
- His 11 holds are tied for eighth in Major League Baseball.
- Is the sixth-oldest player in the major leagues, and the fourth-oldest pitcher.
- Before giving up three earned runs on April 21, Chavez was one of three Braves since 2014 with 10 scoreless appearances to start the season, joining Hunter Cervenka (15 games, 2016) and Shane Greene (10 games, 2020).
- His first 10 appearances were scoreless for the first time in his 16-season MLB career.
- Posted a 2.42 ERA in 45 relief appearances with Atlanta (52.0 IP)...Had a 6.35 ERA in three appearances (5.2 IP) with Chicago (NL) and a 7.59 ERA in 11 appearances (10.2 IP) with Los Angeles (AL).
- His 67.7% strand rate between the Braves and Cubs was the sixth highest in the NL (min. 30 inherited runners).
- At the trade deadline was traded to the Los Angeles Angels along with LHP Tucker Davidson in exchange for RHP Raisel Iglesias before returning for his fourth stint with Atlanta after being claimed off waivers from LA... Was also acquired earlier in the season from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for LHP Sean Newcomb on 4/20.

**Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 33 yrs • #26**

**Saves/Opp: 6/7 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 12/9 Inherited Runners/Scored: 0/0**

- Prior to May 30, hadn't walked three batters in an outing since September 2, 2018 while with Cincinnati... Marked the first time he'd walked multiple batters while with Atlanta.
- On May 10, allowed a home run for the first time since June 12, 2022 with the Angels – a homerless span of 45 games and 42.2 innings...It was the fifth-longest active homerless streak by a reliever in the majors.
- On May 5 was activated from the IL after missing Atlanta's first 32 games with a strained right shoulder...Pitched in four spring training games, compiling a 4.50 ERA (2 ER/4.0 IP) in four outings.
- In 2022, had a 2.47 ERA in 67 games with 17 saves and 15 holds between Atlanta and Los Angeles (AL)...After the trade deadline, led N.L. with a 41.7% chase rate (swings out of the zone)...Traded only CLE's E. Clase.
- Allowed just one earned run in 28 relief appearances after becoming a member of the Braves...His 0.34 ERA during that span dating to the trade deadline is the lowest in baseball (min. 20 appearances)...Tied with teammate A.J. Minter for the most appearances out of the bullpen dating to his first outing on August 5.

**Joe Jiménez • RHP • 6-3 • 277 • 28 yrs • #77**

**Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 2 1st Batter/Retired: 20/16 Inherited Runners/Scored: 10/4**

- Pitched 62 games for DET last year, going 3-2 with a 3.49 ERA (22 ER/56.2 IP), striking out 77 and walking 13.
- Acquired from Detroit on Dec. 7, 2022 in exchange for OF Justyn-Henry Malloy and LHP Jake Higginbotham.
- Named to the A.L. All-Star team in 2018 during his first full major league campaign.
- Last season, his 12.23 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ranked fifth in the American League among pitchers with at least 50.0 innings, and his 1.4 fWAR for the season matched his career high.

- Atlanta's relievers have not allowed a run since May 30 at Oakland, a scoreless streak of four games and 13.0 innings...The club is 3-1 in that span...That scoreless stretch is the longest active in the majors by both games and innings, and the Braves' longest this season in both regards...The Braves' bullpen last posted four straight scoreless games from October 1-4, 2022, in contests against the New York Mets (2 games) and Miami Marlins (2 games)...That streak spanned 16.2 innings...Every National League club, except for Atlanta, has allowed at least one run in relief this month...In June, Chicago is the only A.L. club with a scoreless bullpen.
- Atlanta is one of three teams with a sub-3.00 bullpen ERA on the road (2.69)...Only the New York Yankees (2.16) have been better.
- Atlanta's 'pen didn't allow a baserunner across its 3.2 innings on May 31 at OAK...Marked the second time this season that the unit has gone at least 3.0 perfect innings in a game...The Braves' 'pen pitched 3.1 perfect innings on April 2 at WSH in a loss, 4-1...Only three other teams had multiple 3.0-plus-inning perfect spans by their bullpen in a single game: MIA, SEA and TOR.
- The Braves' 38 holds are the third most in the National League (tied) and fifth most in baseball.
- Atlanta's bullpen has issued the second-fewest walks in the major leagues (tied, 72)...Texas has issued the fewest (70)...For comparison, Oakland's bullpen leads baseball with 149 walks.
