THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 3
2018 - Prior to the Astros 10-6 win over the Orioles, members of the 2017 World Series Championship team received their Championship Rings in a pregame ceremony...MLB Commissioner **Rob Manfred** and Astros Owner and Chairman **Jim Crane** were on hand as the presenters.

ASTROS AFTER DARK: The Astros are on their first road trip of the season as they face the Athletics at Sutter Health Park in West Sacramento, CA... **RHP Cristian Javier** will be on the mound for the Astros tonight opposite **LHP Jeffrey Springs** and the Athletics.

GOIN' STREAKING: The Astros have won five straight games, which matches their season high from 2025 (reached twice last June)...Houston is looking to extend their winning streak to six games, which would be their longest winning streak since they recorded an eight-game winning streak from Aug. 6-14, 2024.

OUT OF THE BLOCKS: The Astros are off to a 5-2 start, their best start since going 6-1 in their first seven games of 2021...should the Astros win today, it would be their best eight-game start since they also went 6-2 to open the 2021 season.

TONIGHT'S ASTROS STARTER: RHP Cristian Javier is coming off a strong Spring Training in which he posted 1.69 ERA (2ER/10.2IP) in three official appearances...In his first start of the regular season on March 28 vs. LAA, he allowed six runs on four hits and four walks with one strikeout in 4.2 innings...the Astros went on to defeat the Angels, 11-9...Javier, who was limited to just eight starts in 2025 while recovering from Tommy John surgery, is 35-22 in his career with a 3.73 ERA (225ER/542.2IP).

SWEEPSTAKES: In their last series, The Astros swept the Boston Red Sox, their first three-game sweep of the season and their first since Sept. 15-17, 2025 vs. TEX...it is their first sweep of the Red Sox since a three-game sweep from Aug. 9-11, 2024, at Fenway Park...is the Astros' first sweep of the Red Sox at Daikin Park since a three-game sweep from July 21-23, 2015.

JOE'S RETURN TRIP: This series is a return trip to West Sacramento for Astros manager **Joe Espada**, who played for the Triple A Sacramento River Cats for part of the 2000 season as an A's minor leaguer...this series is especially unique for Espada, who played in the first-ever game at Sutter Health Park on May 15, 2000...Espada started at second base that game, going 1x3 with a double in the River Cats 2-1 loss to the Edmonton Trappers, then the Triple A affiliate of the Angels.

AGAINST THE ATHLETICS: The Astros and A's are facing each other tonight for the first of 13 scheduled games in 2026...the Astros went 5-8 vs. the A's in 2025, including a 3-4 record at Sutter Health Park...the Astros have won a 120-106 all-time record against the Athletics.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (981), trailing only the Dodgers (1,040).

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have placed **IF Isaac Paredes** on the Bereavement List...to take his place on the active roster, Houston has recalled **IF Shay Whitcomb**.

ON THE MEND: RHP Enyel De Los Santos had his rehab assignment transferred to Double A Corpus Christi...in his outing, he tossed one scoreless innings with one hit and a strikeout.

A WIN ON A WEDNESDAY: The Astros picked up their fifth consecutive win on Wednesday, this time by a score of 6-5 over the visiting Red Sox...RHP Mike Burrows had a solid start, allowing two runs on five hits with three walks and six strikeouts in five innings...**SS Carlos Correa** (1x3, HR, 3 RBI) recorded his first home run at Daikin Park since being traded back to the Astros in 2025...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (2x3, 2B, 2 R) and **C Christian Vázquez** (1x4, HR, RBI) were the catalysts on offense.

THE LUCKY 6: The Astros have scored six-plus runs in five straight games for the first time since July 26-31, 2021...the offense has scored 43 runs in their last five games, while hitting .306 (52x170) with 16 doubles and eight homers in that span...the Astros franchise record is 11 straight games with six-plus runs, accomplished just once, from Aug. 27-Sept. 7, 2004.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the American League in runs (45), doubles (19) total bases (109), hits (63), OBP (.366), SLG (.464) and OPS, while ranking second in walks (32)...individually, **2B Jose Altuve** and **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads AL in runs scored (8) and **1B Christian Walker** leads the AL in doubles (5).

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: LF Yordan Alvarez (499 RBI) is one RBI shy of reaching 500 career RBI, a mark only 14 players in franchise history have reached...Alvarez also checks in with 173 career homers, which makes him just one homer shy of matching franchise icon **OF George Springer** (174HR) for seventh on the Astros all-time list.

SHOWRREA: IF Carlos Correa went 1x4 with a three-run home run on Wednesday vs. BOS...was his 140th career homer as an Astro, breaking a tie with **Bob Watson** for the 11th-most in franchise history...was his 65th career home run at Daikin Park, tying **IF Morgan Ensberg** for the 9th-most in the venue's history.

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in **RHP Roddery Muñoz**, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

JOSE, JOSE, JOSE, JOSE!: 2B Jose Altuve went 4x4 with four runs scored and a pair of homers on Monday night, giving him 42 four-hit games since he debuted in 2011, which are by far the most in the Majors in that time frame (**1B Freddie Freeman** ranks second with 31)...Altuve's four runs scored matched his career high, which he's accomplished seven times, most recently on July 4, 2025 at LAD.

SEASON DEBUT: Started the Astros' 3rd game of the season last Saturday vs. the Angels (W, 11-9)...took a no-decision, allowing 6 runs on 4 hits with 1 strikeout and 4 walks (74 pitches, 41 strikes).

NO. 600: Enters tonight's start 1 strikeout away from 600 for his career...would become the 27th pitcher in Astros history to record 600 strikeouts with the club...is 10 strikeouts from matching **RHP Bob Bruce** (609) for the 26th-most strikeouts in Astros history...with a strikeout tonight, he would also become just the 10th player in Astros history (for a player who began his career with the club) to record 600 strikeouts within their first 126 career appearances...with a strikeout tonight, Javier would also become the 56th Dominican-born pitcher in MLB history to record 600 career strikeouts.

VS. THE ATHLETICS: Set to make his 16th career appearance and 12th start vs. the A's, going 4-5 with a 4.06 ERA (29ER/64.1IP), .202 opponent batting average and 72 strikeouts (10.07 SO/9IP)...with tonight's start, the A's will constitute his most starts vs. a single opponent and will match TEX for his most appearances vs. a single opponent...made his lone start vs. the A's last season on Sept. 23 at Sutter Health Park and allowed 4 runs (3ER) on 6 hits with 4 strikeout and 1 walk, taking the losing decision in a 5-1 loss (79 pitches, 48 strikes)...has held **OF Brent Rooker** to an 0x8 mark with 3 strikeouts in their career meetings...has also held both **C Shea Langeliers** and **OF Tyler Soderstrom** to 1x6 marks in their career.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican pitcher is in his 7th MLB season with the Astros and has gone 35-22 with a 3.73ERA (225ER/542.2IP) and 599 strikeouts in 125 appearances, including 91 starts...among AL pitchers since 2022 (min. 300 IP), he ranks 4th in opponent batting average (.210), behind only **DET LHP Tarik Skubal** (.207), **SEA RHP Bryan Woo** (.209) and **NYN RHP Gerrit Cole** (.210)...also ranks 14th among AL pitchers strikeouts per 9.0 innings at 9.65...including his time as a reliever, has held opponents to a .203 opponent batting average (401x1971) throughout his career (2020-25)...it's the 5th-lowest opponent batting average in the Majors over that stretch (min 500 IP)...among Astros pitchers with at least 500 innings pitched with the club, his .203 career opponent batting average ranks 3rd, behind only **LHP Billy Wagner** (.186) and **RHP Justin Verlander** (.199)...was signed by the Astros as a non-drafted free agent from the Dominican Republic on March 19, 2015...signed a 5-year contract extension in Feb. 2023 that will keep him in Houston through the 2027 season.

SPRING TRAINING: Made 3 official Spring Training starts, recording a 1.69 ERA (2ER/10.2IP)...also recorded 10 strikeouts and a .184 opponent batting average in his 3 starts.

2025 RECAP: Returned from Tommy John surgery in early August...went 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP)...also recorded 34 strikeouts, a .230 opponent batting average and a 1.27 WHIP in eight starts...made five rehab starts on his way back from surgery...in the five starts, had a 5.14 ERA (8ER/14IP) with 15 strikeouts and a .208 opponent average.

POSTSEASON CAREER: Has been a strong postseason performer in his career, posting a 6-2 record with a 2.68 ERA (13ER/43.2IP) with 4 holds in 17 appearances, including 5 starts...has allowed just 22 hits in his 43.2 innings of work for a .146 opponent average, while striking out 60 hitters...his opponent batting average is the lowest opponent batting average in MLB history (min. 40 IP).

LAST APPEARANCE: recorded his 1st save of the season (and 17th of his career) on Wednesday vs. BOS, striking out 3 batters through 1.0 inning while allowing his lone run and via a solo homer by **OF Roman Anthony** (16 pitches, 12 strikes)...averaged 96.1 mph with his 4-seam fastball, his highest mark among his 3 appearances this season.

MILESTONE WATCH: is 1.0 inning from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** for the 11th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...is also 5.0 innings from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** for 10th-most.

VS. ATH: has made 31 career appearances vs. the Athletics, which are the most by a reliever among active MLB players, just 1 ahead of former teammate **RHP Ryan Stanek**...has gone 3-3-1 with a 1.98 ERA (8ER/36.1IP), .151 opponent batting average, 0.85 WHIP and 42 strikeouts (10.4 SO/9IP) in his regular-season career vs. the A's.

SPRING TRAINING: finished Spring Training with a 3.86 ERA (3ER/7IP), 7 walks and 5 strikeouts with a .200 opponent average.

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-12 record with 17 saves, a 2.77 ERA (102ER/332IP) and 454 strikeouts in 332.0 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks fourth in strikeouts (454), seventh in appearances (320) and 12th in innings (332.0).

LAST APPEARANCE: worked a perfect 1.0 inning on Wednesday vs. BOS, striking out 1 batter (14 pitches, 10 strikes)...has posted a 0.37 ERA (1ER/24.1IP), 0.66 WHIP and .100 opponent batting average (8x80) over his last 11 appearances dating back to last season (since Aug. 31, 2025).

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season...pitched on Opening Day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing his only run on a solo homer by Mike Trout...dazzled hitters with an uptick in velocity, including throwing a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of Yoan Moncada...marked the hardest pitch thrown in his career.
