PITTSBURGH PIRATES (10-15) vs. LOS ANGELES ANGELS (11-12)

April 24, 2025 - Angel Stadium - Anaheim, CA - 6:29 PDT - Game #26/Road #13

RHP Carmen Mlodzinski (1-3, 7.41 ERA) vs. LHP Tyler Anderson (2-0, 2.08 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have a chance to secure their first series sweep of the season with a win in Anaheim tonight (would also mark their first sweep since September 9-11, 2024, vs. Miami)...Are in the third game of a six-game trip that will also take them across town to Dodger Stadium for three games this weekend...Have won eight of their last 11 games at Angel Stadium, dating back to June 21, 2013...Arrived in SoCal following a 3-4 homestand against Washington and Cleveland.

ROSTER MOVES: The Pirates today placed right-handed pitcher Justin Lawrence on the 15-day injured list (retro to April 23) with right elbow inflammation and recalled right-handed pitcher Mike Burrows (#53) from Triple-A Indianapolis...Additionally, Pittsburgh selected the contract of outfielder/first baseman Matt Gorski (#62) from Indianapolis and optioned outfielder Jack Suwinski to Indianapolis...Left-handed pitcher Tim Mayza (left shoulder lat muscle strain) was transferred from the 15- to 60-day injured list to make room for Gorski (pronounced GORE-ski) on the 40-man roster....Gorski would become the third Pirates player to make his Major League debut in 2025 (Thomas Harrington on April 1 at Tampa Bay and Tsung-Che Cheng on April 9 vs. St. Louis).

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS: With a win tonight, Pittsburgh would secure its first series sweep since September 9-11, 2024, vs. Miami, and its first away from PNC Park since July 12-14, 2024, at Chicago (AL)...The Pirates' only other sweep last year was a four-game sweep in Miami to open the season...It would be Pittsburgh's second-ever sweep of the Angels (also 2013, in Anaheim).

SIGNATURE SOUTHPAW: Andrew Heaney struck out nine batters and allowed one hit over 6.0 scoreless innings on Wednesday... He is the first Pirates lefthander to throw 6.0-plus scoreless innings with nine-plus strikeouts since Francisco Liriano on April 3, 2016, vs. St. Louis (struck out 10 over 6.0 scoreless)...He is the first Pittsburgh left-handed pitcher to throw 6.0-plus scoreless innings in consecutive starts since Jose Quintana from May 9-15, 2022...<u>According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Heaney became the</u>

first Pittsburgh southpaw in franchise history to throw 6.0-plus scoreless innings with nine-plus strikeouts while allowing one hit or fewer and issuing zero walks in an outing.

ONEIL, OH YEAH: On Wednesday night, Oneil Cruz hit his sixth home run and stole his MLB-best 11th base of the season...Cruz has successfully stolen 31 consecutive bases since last being caught on April 22, 2024 (by Milwaukee's William Contreras), the longest-active streak in the majors (Milwaukee's Christian Yelich, 22 straight, ranks second), per the Elias Sports Bureau...He is one of four Major Leaguers since 1901 with six-plus home runs and 11-plus stolen bases through his first 22 games of a season, along with Elly De La Cruz (2024 Cincinnati Reds, six homers/11 steals), Rickey Henderson (1987 New York Yankees, six homers/12 steals) and Lou Brock (1967 St. Louis Cardinals, six homers/11 steals).

HOW ABOUT HEANEY?: Andrew Heaney began last night's win by striking out each of the first six Angels he faced...He became the first Pirates left-handed pitcher to strike out six-plus batters in a row at any point during a game since Francisco Liriano on June 1, 2013, vs. Cincinnati (seven straight)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Heaney and Paul Skenes (seven, May 17, 2024, at Chicago-NL) are the only two Pittsburgh pitchers in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to strike out six or more straight batters to begin a game.

CRUZ MISSILE: On Wednesday night, Oneil Cruz hit a 463-foot home run off Angels starter Jack Kochanowicz...<u>The home run was the second-longest of Cruz' career (he hit a 472-foot homer off Arizona's Brandon Pfaadt on July 27, 2024) and the ninth-longest by a Pirates batter in the Statcast Era (since 2015)...It was the fourth-longest home run by any Major League player this season...Only the Angels' Mike Trout (484 feet on April 19 vs. San Francisco), the Yankees' Aaron Judge (468 feet on March 29 vs. Milwaukee) and the Brewers' Christian Yelich (465 feet on April 9 at Colorado) have hit longer ones.</u>

TOTAL TEAM EFFORT: Over its last 13 games (since April 9 vs. St. Louis), Pittsburgh's 2.87 staff ERA (119.0ip/38er) is the fourth-lowest in MLB (the Pirates' 2.25 bullpen ERA in that span is the third-lowest in MLB)...On the offensive side, Pittsburgh batters have recorded 10-plus hits in consecutive wins for the first time since doing that in three straight from July 14-20, 2024.

Wally Backman, Andy Van Slyke and Bobby Bonilla recorded two hits apiece, while Bill Landrum worked the final five outs to pick up his second save of the season.

2025 RECORD: 1-3, 7.41 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-2/220 BATS/THROWS: R/R

BORN: February 19, 1999

AGE: 26 SIGNED: Thru 2025

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in Comp. Balance A round (No. 31) of the 2020 Draft.

STARTING OFF: Last name is pronounced "ma-JINSK-ee"...This was Mlodzinski's first season as a member of the team's Opening Day roster...The 26-year-old righthander is in his third season with the Pirates...Mlodzinski was drafted as the team's Competitive Balance Round A selection (31st overall pick) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Mlodzinski suffered his third loss of the season in his last start on April 18 vs. Cleveland, allowing a career-high five runs over 4.0 innings (allowed nine hits and had no strikeouts)...He also had his first home run of 2025 and first since August 30, 2024, with his solo shot surrendered to Bo Naylor leading off the third inning.

AGAINST THE ANGELS: Mlodzinski will make his second appearance (first start) against Los Angeles (AL) in his career...In his lone outing against the Angels, which came right here in Anaheim on July 22, 2023, Mlodzinski pitched 1.2 scoreless innings in relief (one hit and three strikeouts) as part of Pittsburgh's 3-0 win over the Angels.

IT WAS A WHILE: In his start on April 7 against St. Louis at PNC Park, Mlodzinski set career highs with 5.0 innings pitched and six strikeouts while earning his first Major League victory as a starter in Pittsburgh's 8-4 win...The six strikeouts were his most in a game at any level since also striking out six for Double-A Altoona at Erie on September 10, 2022...It also marked the first time Mlodzinski pitched 5.0-plus innings in an appearance since tossing 5.0 innings for Altoona on September 16, 2022 vs. Reading.

SAVE IT: Mlodzinski has one save in his MLB career, coming on September 23, 2023, at GABP in Cincinnati...The Pirates rallied from being down 9-0 after three innings, staging their largest come-from-behind win in 137 seasons of National League play.

AS A STARTER: Tonight will be Mlodzinski's ninth career Major League start...He opened a total of four times in 2024, where he went 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (6.1ip/1er)... His start of 3.2 innings in his 2025 debut on March 31 at Steinbrenner Field against the Rays marked the first time he pitched more than 2.0 innings in a Major League start.

 He spent his first two professional seasons as a starter from 2021-22, making 36 starts in that time between High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona... Mlodzinski also started 14 of 26 games in college at South Carolina (2018-20).

FINISHING 2024 STRONG: Mlodzinski posted a 1.98 ERA (13.2ip/3er) over his final 12 appearances of the 2024 season...He went 3-0 with a .167 batting average against (8-for-48) during those 12 outings, all of which came in the month of September.

2023 IN REVIEW: Mlodzinski reached the big leagues for the first time in 2023, making his Major League debut that June 16 at Milwaukee...In total, he appeared in 35 games (one start), posting a 3-3 record with 11 holds, one save, 2.25 ERA (36.0ip/9er), 34 strikeouts and 18 walks...He held opponents scoreless in 24 of his 35 outings.

AS A PROSPECT: Mlodzinski entered the 2022 season rated by Baseball America as the No. 10 prospect in Pittsburgh's minor-league system...He began the 2021 season ranked by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's 10th-best prospect...At the end of the 2020 season, he had the "Best Changeup" in Pittsburgh's system, according to MLB Pipeline.

BEFORE THE BUCS: Mlodzinski grew up playing shortstop before beginning to pitch as a junior in high school...ls a 2017 graduate of Hilton Head (SC) High School, where he was a Rawlings-Perfect Game Atlantic All-Region first-team selection in 2017.
