JUMPIN' JUPITER: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) as they welcome the Houston Astros to Jupiter tonight, the 20th of 28 scheduled Spring Training games for the Redbirds ... The Cardinals are in Jupiter for six of their final nine Grapefruit League games.

• On Monday, March 23, the Cardinals break camp in Florida and fly to Springfield, Mo. to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field ... First pitch is scheduled for 6:05 p.m. CT.

PLAYING FOR KEEPS: On Thursday, March 26, the Cardinals will host the Tampa Bay Rays on Opening Day, the earliest game in franchise history ... St. Louis played on March 27 last season vs. Minnesota, a 5-3 Redbirds winner at Busch Stadium.

FRIDAY THE 13TH: The last Cardinals opportunity to play a Grapefruit League game on Friday the 13th was 2020, also in Jupiter against the Astros, but Spring Training was cancelled/postponed the night prior due to the COVID-19 outbreak ... The last Cardinals Grapefruit League game on Friday the 13th was March 13, 2015 at Miami, a 6-3 loss in Jupiter.

• St. Louis is 53-43 all-time in the regular season on Friday the 13th, including a 2-3 record against the Astros ... Their most recent spooky faceoff was September 13, 2002 at Minute Maid Park, a 3-2 Redbirds winner in 10 innings.

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: Tonight is the second of two Spring night games for the Cardinals in 2026.

- Since 2006, St. Louis is 19-16-5 overall in Spring Training night games, including a 7-4-0 record in Jupiter.
- Since 2006, the Cardinals have played 40 Grapefruit League games at night, fewest in Major League Baseball (thanks to **C.J. Cherre** & **Ernie Moore**) ... The White Sox (46 games) rank 29th, while the Dodgers (153 games) lead MLB.

RED JACKETS: 12 Cardinals Hall of Famers scheduled to be present on 2026 Opening Day at Busch Stadium include **Ozzie Smith**, **Édgar Rentería**, **Tony La Russa**, **Ray Lankford**, **Ted Simmons**, **Vince Coleman**, **John Tudor**, **Jason Isringhausen**, **Willie McGee**, **Mark McGwire**, **Al Hrabosky**, and **Scott Rolen**.

SPRING BREAKOUT: As part of MLB's third annual Spring Breakout showcase, the top Cardinals prospects will host the Nationals top young talent on March 19 at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, following the Cards-Nats Grapefruit League game at 1:05 p.m.

- The exhibition will be streamed live and for free on MLB.TV, MLB.com, and on the MLB App.
- St. Louis will have 25 of its top 30 prospects participating, including eight of the top 10.

IN FULL BLOOM: The Cardinals introduced **Chaim Bloom** on Sept. 30 as the team's new President of Baseball Operations taking the post that had been held by **John Mozeliak** who headed the team's baseball operations since Oct. of 2007 ... Bloom, who worked previously with the Boston Red Sox (2020-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2005-19) had served as an advisor for the Cardinals the past two seasons.

WHITE NAMED BUCK O'NEIL AWARD WINNER: The National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum's Board of Directors selected **Bill White** as the 2026 recipient of the John Jordan "Buck" O'Neil Lifetime Achievement Award, presented to an individual for extraordinary efforts to enhance baseball's positive impact on society ... The 92-year-old White will be honored at the Awards Presentation on July 25, as part of 2026 Hall of Fame Weekend ... White played eight seasons in St. Louis (1959-65, '69) and was inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Fame in 2020.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS

#62 KYLE LEAHY · RHP · 6-4 · 225 LBS · AGE 28

- Makes his 4th Grapefruit League start tonight.
- Started in his final appearance of the 2025 season at Chicago (NL) and will open Spring Training competing for spot in the Cardinals rotation.
- Has pitched parts of three Major League seasons for the Cardinals (2023-25), making 97 relief appearances and one start.
- Made his Major League debut for St. Louis at the Chicago White Sox on July 7, 2023, taking the loss in a relief appearance.
- Has allowed 10 home runs in his 98 career outings, the fewest by a Cardinal through his first 98 career games since Génesis Cabrera allowed eight homers from 2019-21 and fewest by a St. Louis right-hander since Jordan Hicks gave up three HRs from 2018-19.
- Spent the entire 2025 season with St. Louis and led MLB with 32 relief appearances of at least 1.1 innings, the most by a Cardinals reliever since John Frascatore had 32 such appearances in 1998.

#55 RYNE STANEK · RHP · 6-3 · 235 LBS · AGE 34

- Signed as a free agent in January, returning to the city he was born. The Cardinals become his 6th Major League organization.
- Originally a 1st round draft pick (29th overall) by the Tampa Bay Rays out of the University of Arkansas in 2013.
- Member of the 2022 World Champion Houston Astros.
- Ranks 25th among active pitchers with 466 career appearances since 2017. Since his career began in 2017, ranks 15th among all pitchers in appearances.
- Is one of four pitchers in Major League history with a perfect fielding percentage (1.000) to have made 400 career appearances and pitched 400.0 career innings; joining Hector Rondon, Hunter Strickland and Luis Vizcaino.
- Appeared in 30 career postseason games, going 4-0 with a 2.89 ERA. Ranks 9th among active pitchers with 30 career postseason appearances and T-26th in MLB history.
- His 1.15 ERA during the 2022 regular season set the Astros' franchise record for lowest mark by a reliever and was tops among American League relief pitchers that season.
- Pitched for Team USA in the 2016 Futures Game at Petco Park in San Diego.

#59 JOJO ROMERO · LHP · 5-11 · 215 LBS · AGE 29

- Acquired at the 2022 trade deadline from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for infielder Edmundo Sosa on July 30.
- Set career highs in 2025 in innings pitched (61.0), strikeouts (55), saves (8)
- Has appeared in a career-high 65 games in each of the last two seasons, the first Cardinals pitcher with 65+ outings in back-to-back seasons since Kevin Siegrist from 2015-16, and his team-leading 130 outings in that span rank 13th in the National League.
- His 30 holds in 2024 ranked 2nd among Cardinals relief pitchers and T-5th all-time for single-season in franchise history with Kyle McClellan (2008). Only Ray King (31 in 2004) had more among Cardinals southpaws all-time. Also led all left-handed pitchers with 54 holds from 2024-25, ranking second, overall, in the NL (5th in MLB), behind Tyler Rogers (65). Ranks T-6th with Randy Flores in Cardinals history with 57 holds.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .185 BA (48-259) with four home runs allowed in his career (Last: 8/8/24 to Brandon Lowe vs. TB). Since 2022, his .175 opponent BA (38-217) vs. LH batters ranks 4th in NL (min. 200 batters faced).RHP Riley O'Brien

#47 JUSTIN BRUIHL · LHP · 6-0 · 215 LBS · AGE 28

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Guardians for cash considerations, January 6, 2026.
- Former non-drafted free agent looking to appear in games with fifth Major League club, previously appearing in 94 total games with the Dodgers (65), Blue Jays (15), Rockies (7) and Pirates (7). Signed as a free agent with the Reds in 2024, but did not pitch in a Major League game.
- Pitched in 15 games in relief for the American League Champion Blue Jays.
- Appeared in four career postseason games, three with the Dodgers in the 2021 National League Championship Series and one with the Blue Jays vs. NYY in the 2025 American League Division Series. Did not allow a run in his three appearances vs. ATL with one hit and five strikeouts.
- Played college baseball at California Polytechnic State University at San Luis Obispo (Cal Poly-SLO), the same college that produced Cardinals Hall of Fame shortstop Ozzie Smith and former Cardinals relief pitcher Bud Norris.
