**THE PIRATES:** were shut out, 3-0, in Tuesday night's series opener vs. Houston (the first game of a nine-game homestand)....Went 3-3 on their recent six-game road trip to Arizona (2-1) and San Diego (1-2) from May 26-June 1...Have gone 4-9 during interleague play this season...Have gone 10-13 since Don Kelly took over as manager on May 8.

**FAMILIAR FOE:** Tonight is the second game of a three-game set between former National League Central foes...The two teams shared the division from 1994 to 2012 and met every season from 1962 (Houston's inaugural season) to 2013...Since the teams met for the first time during interleague play in 2013, each team is 8-8 (Pittsburgh won two of three games in Houston last season).

THE DAY IT ALL BEGAN: Sixteen years ago, Andrew McCutchen made his Major League debut here at PNC Park vs. New York (NL)...He batted leadoff and singled off the Mets' Mike Pelfrey in his first plate appearance...McCutchen finished the game, an 11-6 Pittsburgh win, with two hits, an RBI, a walk and three runs scored...Since the day of his debut, McCutchen's 2198 hits are third-most in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Los Angeles (NL)'s Freddie Freeman (2336) and Houston's Jose Altuve (2292).

**22 CLOSING IN ON 2200:** Andrew McCutchen comes into tonight's game vs. Houston two hits shy of 2200 for his career (he will become the 190th player in Major League Baseball history to record at least 2200 hits)...McCutchen has recorded 1713 hits as a member of the Pirates, the ninth-most in team history...His 240 home runs with Pittsburgh are tied for third-most in team history.

**QUALITY STUFF:** Paul Skenes turned in Pittsburgh's 29th quality start of the season when he allowed just one run over 8.0 innings of work on Tuesday vs. Houston...The Pirates' 29 quality starts are the fourth-most in Major League Baseball, trailing Philadelphia (32), Tampa Bay (31) and Kansas City (30)...Pittsburgh's 0.83 home runs per 9.0 innings from its starters are fourth-fewest in MLB.

**SHORT HOPS:** Isiah Kiner-Falefa collected two hits on Tuesday vs. Houston, raising his season average to .310 (52-for-168)...His .310 average ranks 12th in all of Major League Baseball among players with at least 180 plate appearances...Kiner-Falefa's .309 (51-for-165) average as a shortstop is the third-highest in MLB, behind the Athletics' Jacob Wilson (.355) and Houston's Jeremy Peña (.310)...His .353 (24-for-68) average since returning from the injured list on May 12 ranks seventh in Major League Baseball.

**SUPERB SKENES:** Paul Skenes gave up just one run while striking out eight batters over 8.0 innings on Tuesday vs. Houston, his second start this season of 8.0-plus innings, one or zero runs allowed and eight-plus strikeouts (also May 18 at Philadelphia)...He's the first Pirates pitcher to have two-such starts in a season since A.J. Burnett in 2012 (he's also the only Major Leaguer with two-such starts this season)...Skenes has also made four consecutive starts of 6.0-plus innings, one or zero runs allowed and seven-plus strikeouts (since May 18)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he's the only Pittsburgh pitcher to ever do that in four straight starts (he also did it in four straight last season from June 11-29)...Skenes' 2.05 ERA (83.1ip/19er) is the second-lowest in the National League.

**WELCOME BACK:** Nick Gonzales recorded an infield single on Tuesday vs. Houston, his first game back with Pittsburgh since suffering a non-displaced fracture in his left ankle on March 27 at Miami, the same day he hit a two-run homer...Gonzales,

the Pirates' first-round selection in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State University, reached base safely in 21 of his 25 games last September...He hit .297 (33-for-111) in his final 29 games of the 2024 season.

**ON THE MEND:** Dauri Moreta (right elbow surgery) tossed a scoreless inning for Triple-A Indianapolis on Tuesday at Memphis...In 13 rehab outings between Low-A Bradenton and Indianapolis, Moreta has posted a 2.31 ERA (11.2ip/3er).

**BUCS ON THE BASES:** Isiah Kiner-Falefa stole his ninth base of the season on Tuesday night vs. Houston...His stolen base was also Pittsburgh's 59th of the season, fourth-most in Major League Baseball, behind Tampa Bay (84), Milwaukee (81) and Chicago-NL (79)...The Pirates have 12 different players who have stolen at least one base (including Oneil Cruz, whose 20 steals are tied for third-most in MLB)...The only teams with more-such players are Milwaukee (14), Seattle (14), Tampa Bay (14), Texas (14) and the A's (13).

# TONIGHT'S STARTER RHP MIKE BURROWS #53

# 2025 RECORD: 0-1, 8.64 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-1/200 BATS/THROWS: R/R

**BORN:** November 8, 1999

**AGE:** 25 (turns 26 on November 8) **SIGNED:** Thru 2025 **HOW ACQUIRED:** Selected in the 11th round of the 2018 Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Burrows allowed five runs (four earned) on five hits and two walks over 3.1 innings on May 27 at Arizona, having a no-decision in Pittsburgh's 9-6 victory...lt was his second Major League start (third appearance), having made his first start on May 22 vs. Milwaukee, when he allowed four runs across his 5.0 innings.

**DEBUT DAY:** Burrows made his MLB debut in relief of Paul Skenes last season on September 28 at Yankee Stadium...In that game, he earned the win, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits, three walks, two strikeouts and one home run in 3.1 innings...He was recalled from Triple-A Indianapolis this April 24, but did not pitch before being optioned back to Triple-A after the team's April 25 victory in Los Angeles.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Burrows went 2-1 with a 2.51 ERA (32.1ip/9er) and 41 strikeouts over eight appearances (seven starts) at Triple-A Indianapolis...In his start on May 11 vs. Columbus, he struck out a career-high 11 batters in 4.2 scoreless innings...At the time of his promotion to Pittsburgh on May 21, he ranked second in the International League with a 1.02 ERA, 28 strikeouts and a 0.85 WHIP, as well as third with a .175 batting average against, in the month of May (four games/three starts).

**TALK OF THE TOWN:** Burrows is currently rated as the Pirates' No. 13 prospect, according to Baseball America (No. 15, according to MLB Pipeline)...Burrows has been a top-30 prospect for Pittsburgh, per Baseball America, in every preseason since 2020.

**WHERE I'M FROM:** Burrows is a native of Waterford, Connecticut, roughly two hours from Yankee Stadium, where he made his Major League debut last September 28.

**THE LONG ROAD BACK:** Burrows began the 2023 season at Triple-A Indianapolis and made two starts for the Indians, but left his start on April 8 at Louisville with a right forearm injury...He was placed on the injured list on April 11 before undergoing "Tommy John" surgery on April 26, which forced him to miss the remainder of the season...He began the 2024 season on the injured list while recovering before beginning his rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Pirates in mid-June...He made two starts there, as well as four starts at Low-A Bradenton before heading back to Indianapolis in late July, where he made 10 appearances (nine starts).

**LOOKING TO THE FUTURE:** Burrows represented Pittsburgh at the 2022 All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium...He pitched a scoreless fifth inning in the National League's 6-4, seven-inning win, allowing a hit and a walk (one strikeout)...He was the first Connecticut native to be selected to the game since George Springer (2013).

**THE BURROWS FILE:** Burrows was drafted by Pittsburgh in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Waterford High School (Waterford, Connecticut)...He has a 3.58 ERA (291.1ip/116er) over 78 career games (73 starts) in the minor leagues... He's pitched for the Gulf Coast League/Florida Complex League Pirates (rookie), West Virginia (short-season), Low-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro, Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis over his seven professional seasons in the Pirates' organization.
