TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Court Berry-Tripp's Guardians** and the fifth game (2-2) of a 6-game homestand that includes a 1-2 series loss vs the **White Sox** (Tue-Thu).
- Following tomorrow's game vs their **Ohio Cup** rivals, the Reds will hit the road for a brief 3-game series at **Pit** (5/19-5/21).
- The Reds are coming off a 2-5 road trip at **Atl** (1-3) and **Hou** (1-2).

SERIES NOTES: Cin and Cle are meeting for the first time in 2025...they'll square off again in **The Forest City** from 6/9-6/11.

- Last year, the teams split a 2-game series at **Great American Ball Park** from 6/11-6/12, and **Cle** swept the 2-game series at **Progressive Field** from 9/24-9/25.
- The Reds haven't won a season series since taking 3 of 4 from the **then-Indians** during the 2014 campaign...**Cle** since the start of 2015 is 31-15 vs Cin, including a 16-7 mark here at **GABP**.
- The coveted **Ohio Cup** is awarded to the team that wins each season's series between the Reds and **Guardians**...should the season series end in a tie, the trophy will be retained by the previous year's winner.
- Cle** has won or retained the coveted cup in each of the last 10 seasons.
- The most deserving player in each season's series receives the **Frank Robinson Most Outstanding Player Award**.

RIVALRY WEEKEND: The first installment of "Rivalry Weekend" began yesterday and continues through the weekend...a new addition to the season's calendar, "Rivalry Weekend" features 11 series between prime Interleague rivals, including this one between the Reds and **Guardians**.

THE SKIPPER: Terry Francona was introduced as the Reds' 65th field manager on 10/4/24, agreeing to a 3-year contract through the 2027 season with a club option for 2028.

- Terry** is a 3-time American League Manager of the Year (2013, 2016, 2022) who guided his teams to the Postseason 11 times, including 3 World Series appearances (2004, 2007, 2016) and 2 titles ('04 & '07).
- This season is **Francona's** 24th as a Major League manager, his first with the Reds...he owns an overall record of 1972-1696 (.538) for **Phi** (285-363), **Bos** (744-552), **Cle** (921-757), and **Cin (22-24)**.
- His teams won 90 games in a season 12 times in his career and have posted a .564 winning percentage in the playoffs (44-34)...from 2004-2020, **Francona's** clubs posted a winning record in 16 consecutive seasons...that streak ended when **Cle** finished 80-82 in 2021.
- In 2022, his **Guardians** became the first team in American League history to qualify for Postseason play while having the youngest team in the Major Leagues.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 15 series this season, including this one (4-8-1).

- It marks the longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to begin a season since 2012, when they went 22 straight series before being broomed in a 3-game set from 6/18-6/20 at **Cle**.

ELLY MAKING HISTORY: SS **Elly De La Cruz** on Sun at **Hou** appeared in his 300th career game, becoming the first Major Leaguer since 1900 with at least 115 extra-base hits and 115 stolen bases through his first 300 career games (courtesy Elias).

- Elly** (23 years, 126 days today) is approaching 300 career hits (297)...he's attempting to become the fifth-youngest Red to reach that mark among those who debuted since 1900 (courtesy Elias).
- Is trying to become the fastest Major Leaguer by appearance (currently at 304g) since RBI became an official stat in 1920 to reach 300 hits (297), 150 RBI (151), and 100 stolen bases (117) for his career...would surpass **Fia's Hanley Ramirez** (328g, 2005-2008)...(courtesy Elias).

REHABBERS: Updates on the following Reds who are currently on rehabilitation assignments in the club's minor league system:

- RHP Rhett Lowder** (right forearm strain) in Sun's 7-2 loss for Dayton vs **Great Lakes** made his second rehab app and allowed 5 runs (4er) on 5 hits over 3.0 innings (1bb, 5k, 63TP)...yesterday his assignment was transferred to Louisville where he's expected to pitch today in the first game of a DH at **Indianapolis** (Lou was rained out yesterday).
- LHP Sam Moll** (left shoulder impingement) has made 9 apps on his current rehab assignment with AAA-Louisville (8.2ip, 12h, 7r/7er, 5bb, 10k), including in the Bats' 3-1 loss Tue at **Ind** (0.2ip, 2h, 2r/2er, 2bb).
- RHP Ian Gibaut** (right shoulder impingement) has made 2 apps on his current assignment with Louisville including in Thus's 9-8 loss at **Ind** (1.0ip, 1h, 1bb, 2k, 21TP).

CITY SLICKERS: Reds pitchers have limited opponents to a hard-hit percentage of .391, which ranks fifth-best in the majors (*hard-hit pct measures the pct of pitches put in play at an exit velocity over 95 mph*).

- Reds starting pitchers allowed 161 batted balls put in play at or above 100 mph...only **Det** (160), **Phi** (157), **Tex** (157), **Mil** (157), and **Hou** (152) starters have fewer.
- Cin starters allowed just 8 in-play batted balls with an exit velocity at or above 110 mph this season...only the **Pirates** (7), **Orioles** (7), and **Brewers** (5) have fewer.
- Reds batters rank 27th in the majors with an average exit velocity of 88.7 mph...they've put 291 balls in play at or above 95 mph (20th).

OPEN FOR BUSINESS: The Reds are 9-5 in series openers this season and 42-26 (.618) dating back to last year (**Mets** 45-24, .652; **Padres** 42-26, .618).
