THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4 (2-1 vs. Boston and 0-3 vs. the Reds), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a win in New York against the Mets last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three games against the Mets at Citi Field...they will conclude the series tomorrow night then travel to Tampa Bay to play the Rays at Tropicana Field over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 1-3 in IL Play this season (1-0 at NYM, 0-3 vs. CIN)...their next opponent in IL Play will be the Nationals in D.C. from May 5-7...last season, they went 20-28 vs. the NL.

HOW DO YOU LIKE THEM APPLES: The Twins beat the Mets last night at Citi Field by a score of 5-3, their fifth come-from-behind win this season...they were down 3-0 until a Byron Buxton two-run homer in the sixth inning, his fourth homer of 2026...Luke Keaschall drove in the game-tying run in the seventh inning...the Twins scored two more in the top of the ninth to secure the lead...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and two strikeouts...his three runs allowed all came on a Francisco Lindor third-inning homer...Cole Sands (1-1) earned the win in relief, pitching 2.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts.

MEET THE CONNOR: The Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp from Triple-A St. Paul...Prielipp, 25, appeared in four games (3 starts) for the Saints from March 27-April 16, going 1-0, 2.30 ERA (15.2 IP, 4 ER), eight walks, 22 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP and a .204 opponent batting average...the 6-foot-2, 229-pound lefty was the 2025 Jim Rantz Award winner for Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 1-9, 4.03 ERA (82.2 IP, 37 ER), 31 walks, 98 strikeouts and a 1.51 WHIP in 24 games (23 starts) between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul...he ranked second among all Twins pitchers in starts and was tied for seventh in strikeouts...the Tomah, Wisconsin native was selected by the Twins in the second round (48th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Alabama...he is currently ranked by MLB.com as the fifth-best prospect in the Twins organization, first among pitchers.

☞ To make room for Prielipp on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned utility player Ryan Kreidler to St. Paul...Kreidler, who was recalled by Minnesota on April 11, played in five games for Minnesota, going 3-for-14 (.214) with one double, two home runs, four RBI, four walks and a .389 on-base percentage.

☞ List of Jim Rantz Award winner (Twins mlb Pitcher of the Year) lower right margin.

TWINS AND METS: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 32nd, 33rd, and 34th times in their history this week...Minnesota is 14-18 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 4-8 at Citi Field and 4-7 at Target Field.

☞ Derek Shelton has a managerial record of 11-17 vs. the Mets, 4-11 at Citi Field.

☞ Twins are just 3-7 in their last 10 at Citi Field and have never won a series in this ballpark in four chances.

NATIONWIDE HE'S ON YOUR SIDE: Since the start of 2024, in 76 Interleague Games, Byron Buxton is hitting .293 (87-for-297) with 24 home runs, 47 RBI, a .340 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a .929 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

MAJORITY REPORT: With a victory tonight or tomorrow, the Twins will earn their fourth series win of the season...they have gone 3-4-0 in series play (series results in the right margin)...they have gone 2-2-0 at home and 1-2-0 on the road.

☞ Twins won their last series against the Mets, taking two of three at Target Field from April 14-16, 2025...they have never won a series at Citi Field...they have won just one series in Queens in six chances, that coming June 18-20, 2007 at Shea Stadium.

☞ The last series the Twins won over a National League opponent was August 29-31, 2025, taking two of three vs. San Diego at Target Field.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: Twins have scored 117 runs on the season, third-most in the AL and eighth-most in baseball, trailing Washington (136), Atlanta (135), Houston (135), Los Angeles-NL (134), Chicago-NL (124), Los Angeles-AL (119) and Milwaukee (118).

☞ 45 of their 117 runs scored (38%) on the season have come via the home run...they have hit 27 home runs this season, tied for seventh-most in baseball.

LIVE AND LARN: Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in seven-straight games, posting a .452 on-base percentage in that span...his career-high is 16, done from August 17-September 5, 2025.

☞ This season, against right-handed pitching, he is hitting .319 (9-for-29) with two doubles, four RBI, 11 walks, a .500 on-base percentage and an .879 OPS.

THIS AND THAT:

☞ Twins rank fourth in baseball in batting average with runners in scoring position at .288 (57-for-198), trailing Atlanta (.299), Detroit (.298) and Milwaukee (.297).

☞ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .500 (7-for-15)...Josh Bell is hitting .450 (9-for-20)...Brooks Lee is hitting .421 (8-for-19)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .400 (10-for-25)...Tristan Gray is hitting .333 (4-for-12)...Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (4-for-12)...Victor Caratini is hitting .313 (5-for-16).

☞ Twins hitters rank fifth in baseball in walk percentage on the season at 11.5%, trailing New York-AL (13.0%), Milwaukee (12.9%), Chicago-NL (12.1%) and Los Angeles-AL (11.8%).

☞ Josh Bell has 196 career home runs, needing four to become the 40th active player in baseball to reach the 200 home run mark...Bell's last homer came on April 9 vs. Detroit, off Jack Flaherty.

☞ Twins have hit nine home runs in their last eight games against right-handed pitching.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1961, the Twins won their first game in Minnesota at Metropolitan Stadium after moving from Washington, D.C...the score was 5-4 over the Washington Senators in 10 innings...they won on a Zoilo Versalles sac fly, scoring Earl Battey...in 1985, Kirby Puckett hit the first of 207 career home runs, a three-run shot off Seattle's Matt Young.

GO SHORTY, IT'S YOUR EARTH DAY: Celebrating Earth Day 2026, the Twins today announced that the organization has received five major sustainability honors: the 2025 Major League Baseball Green Glove Award, recertification at LEED Platinum for Existing Buildings: Operations & Maintenance (the club's MLB-best sixth LEED designation), and three Green Sports Alliance 2026 Play to Zero awards for Energy Efficiency, Water Efficiency and Material Management...Twins are also finalists for the Green Sports Alliance's 2026 Innovation Award and Community Impact Award...the Twins are also 23-24 on Earth Day, including 3-1 on Earth Day since 2022.

- Connor Prielipp will make his major league debut tonight at Citi Field against the New York Mets; Prielipp becomes the second Twin to make their big league debut this season (Andrew Morris, April 12 at Toronto).
- Prielipp is currently listed as the fifth ranked prospect and top-ranked pitching prospect in the Twins' system, per MLB.com; he is the no. 81 prospect in all of baseball and ranked fourth in the Twins' system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per *Baseball America*.
- In 2025, he was the winner of the Jim Rantz Award for Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year after splitting the season between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul...combined to go 1-9 with a 4.03 ERA (82.2 IP, 37 ER), 31 walks, 98 strikeouts and a 10.7 SO/9 in 24 appearances (23 starts).
- Attended the University of Alabama, where he pitched for two seasons, before being drafted by the Twins in the second round (48th overall) in 2022 First-Year Player Draft.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW, MR. PRIELIPP: 25-year-old Connor Prielipp, the Twins top pitching prospect, will make his major league debut tonight in the Big Apple against the Mets...Prielipp will be the second Twins prospect to make their MLB debut in 2026, following fellow pitcher Andrew Morris, who debuted on April 12 at Toronto...Connor will be the first Twins pitcher to start in his major league debut since Pierson Ohi on July 29, 2025 vs. Boston and first left-handed Twins starter (excluding openers) since Dallas Keuchel on September 13, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay.

LAST TIME OUT: In his last start on April 16 for Triple-A St. Paul, Prielipp earned the win, going 5.0 innings, while giving up one run on four hits with one walk and eight strikeouts in a 5-1 home win for the Saints over Lehigh Valley.

☞ **COMING UP STRONG:** Prielipp's eight strikeouts were a minor league career-high and he was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week (April 12-19) for his performance.

TWO STARTS AGO: Prielipp did not factor into the decision on April 10 at Toledo after throwing 3.1 innings and allowing two runs on four hits with three walks and five strikeouts...his 77 pitches were the most he has thrown this season and third most in his minor league career.

GET TO KNOW CONNOR: Prielipp was born in Tomah, WI and quickly became one of the best high school pitching prospects in the country after going 6-2 with a 0.85 ERA and 118 strikeouts (21.7 SO/9) against just five walks (23.60 SO/BB) in 49.0 innings as a senior...as a result he was named the Gatorade Wisconsin Player of the Year and Collegiate Baseball News First Team All-American.

☞ **TO TUSCALOOSA WE GO:** Despite being selected by Boston in the 37th round of the 2019 draft, Prielipp decided to attend the University of Alabama, where he earned National Freshman Player of the Year, and was named a first team All-American and Freshman All-America by Collegiate Baseball News...his final lines as a freshman during the pandemic shortened season were as follows: 3-0 record in four starts with a perfect 0.00 ERA (21.0 IP), six walks, 35 strikeouts, a 0.52 WHIP and .068 (5-for-73) BAA.

☞ **BATTLING THROUGH ADVERSITY:** Following his accolade-filled freshman season, Prielipp suffered an elbow injury during his sophomore season (2021) that required Tommy John surgery...in 2023 he would require the surgery a second time and be out 13 months.

☞ **WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY:** Despite Tommy John surgery, the Twins drafted Prielipp in the second round (48th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft...since being drafted, Prielipp has stormed through the minor leagues to the tune of a 3.72 ERA (128.1 IP, 53 ER) with 50 walks, 168 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: Prielipp is widely regarded as one of the best left-handed pitching prospects in the game...here is where he is ranked by *Baseball America*, MLB.com and FanGraphs.

2025 WAS AWARD SEASON: Prielipp broke out in 2025, pitching a minor league career-high 82.2 innings (previous high: 23.1 IP in 2024) with a 4.03 ERA, 31 walks and 98 strikeouts between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul...he ranked second among all Twins pitchers in starts and was tied for seventh in strikeouts...for his efforts, Prielipp was a staple on the Twins minor league awards pages.

☞ **PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on May 11 after tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with just three hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts on May 8 at Northwest Arkansas while pitching for Double-A Wichita; then on September 21 named for a second time while pitching with Triple-A St. Paul, posting a .211 opponent batting average and 10 strikeouts over two starts and 11.0 innings pitched.

☞ **PITCHER OF THE MONTH:** Named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after recording a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks (9 BB%) and 17 strikeouts (29 K%) across four starts.

☞ **PITCHER OF THE YEAR:** Following the season, was named the Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year, becoming the fifth left-hander to win the award, joining Francisco Liriano (2005), Andrew Albers (2013), Stephen Gonsalves (2016) and Lewis Thorpe (2018).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In the minors so far this season, lefties are slashing .100/.250/.200 (1-for-10) with one double, one RBI, two walks and five strikeouts against Prielipp, while righties are slashing .227/.320/.341 with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, six walks and 17 strikeouts...in his minor league career, lefties are slashing .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties are slashing .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

☞ Upon his callup, led St. Paul pitchers in BAA vs. lefties at .100 (1-for-10); next closest was Raul Brito, .200 BAA (min. 10.0 IP).

DIXIELAND DELIGHT: With his start tonight, Prielipp will become the first left-handed pitcher from the University of Alabama to start in their major league debut since Adam Morgan started for the Phillies on June 21, 2015 vs. St. Louis...he will also be the first Alabama player to throw in the majors since Dylan Smith (Detroit) pitched on June 2, 2025 at Chicago-AL.

☞ **ONE OF ONE:** With his callup, he becomes the only current player in MLB to go to the University of Alabama.

THE ARSENAL: Prielipp relies on a five-pitch mix...here is his pitch usage and average velocities through four minor league appearances (3 starts) this season, per FanGraphs.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2026: 2-2, 3.29 ERA // CAREER: 48-38, 3.77 ERA)

Joe Ryan will make his sixth start of the season tomorrow night in the series finale against the Mets...he has made one career start against New York-NL on April 14, 2025; did not factor into the decision after pitching 5.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits with two walks and eight strikeouts in a 5-1 Twins loss...in his last start this season on April 17 vs. Cincinnati, took the loss while pitching 6.0 quality innings and giving up two runs (one earned) on three hits with zero walks and six strikeouts...tomorrow will be his 120th career start.
