TDDAY'S GAME: Is game 2 (1-0) of a 6-game road trip to Washington (1-0) and Atlanta [3g]....following this trip and an off day next Thursday, the Brewers return home for 6 games against New York-NL (3g) and Pittsburgh (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

AT HOME: The team is 36-20 at home, going 13-5-0 in series play.....are 24-11 in the last 35 home games and 13-4 in the last 17.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 29-24 on the road, going 8-7-2 in series play....are 19-6 in the last 25 road games and 7-1 in the last 8 contests.....have had three season-high 5-game road winning streaks, coming from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager. 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), hitting coach Eric Theisen (1st season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 19 replay challenges this season, going 12-7.....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/30 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at first base involving William Contreras stood.

<u>BREWING SUCCESS</u>: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6)....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons [2017-24].....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 731 wins since 2017 [4th in MLB/2nd in National League].

WDDDRUFF AT A GLANCE: Brandon Woodruff, 32, makes his fifth start of the season and second vs. Washington.....he last started last Sunday vs. Miami and had no decision in a 3-2 win (6ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 85 pitches).....the team is 4-0 in his starts.....he has 3 quality starts.....opponents are batting .163 (13-for-80, 4hr).....he missed the 2024 season as he recovered from right shoulder surgery.....he is 17-3 with a 2.31 ERA in his last 36 starts dating back to May 2022 (214ip, 146h, 58r, 55er, 50bb, 256k)..... Woodruff was selected by Milwaukee in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026.

SORRY I'M LATE: Woodruff's return to a Major League mound was delayed twice while on rehab assignment.....the team returned Woodruff from rehab assignment at Triple-A Nashville on May 12 due to right ankle tendinitis and again on June 5 due to a right elbow contusion suffered in a start on 6/3 vs. Gwinnett (struck by line drive).

SIMPLY THE BEST: Woodruff is the all-time franchise leader with a 3.06 ERA (min. 500ip).....his 817 strikeouts rank seventh in franchise history.....Corbin Burnes ranks sixth [870].....4 48-26, his .649 career winning percentage ranks second in franchise history (min. 50 decisions), trailing only Brent Suter (36-19, .655).

CAREER: Has gone 48-26 with a 3.06 ERA in 134 games/119 starts (702.2ip, 239er).....is in his ninth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2017-25).....was a 2019 and 2021 All-Star.....underwent surgery on 10/13/23 to repair the anterior capsule in his right shoulder, performed by Dr. Keith Meister.....missed the entire 2024 season.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 26-9 with a 2.83 ERA in 67 games/60 starts (359.2ip, 113er).....is 0-0 with a 3.48 ERA in 2 starts this season (10.1ip, 4er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 22-17 with a 3.31 ERA in 67 games/59 starts (343ip, 126er).....is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA in 2 starts this season (12ip, 1er).
