## Double-Digit Runs

The Braves scored 10 times on Wednesday, their 19th game this season with doubledigit runs.
That total is the club's most since 2006, when they had 21 double-digit run games.
It also marked the second time this season the Braves scored double-digits without the benefit of a home run...Only five other teams (WSH, StL, PHI, MIL, BOS) have multiple such games.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets begin a three-game series tonight with the 17th of 19 meetings between the clubs this season...Both clubs will finish the regular season with these three games, and this marks the first time the teams will close out the year against each other since 2002...The Braves took three-of-four games in that series here in Flushing.

A The Braves have won five of six over New York after sweeping a three-game set here at Citi Field, August 23-25, in the clubs' last match-up against each other.

A The Braves are 11-5 against New York this year and can tie the franchise record for most singleseason victories against the Mets with a sweep in these three games...The 1964 and 1966 Braves both beat the Mets 14 times.

A The Braves are also two victories shy of their most single-season wins at Citi Field in franchise history...The 2009, 2016, and 2018 teams all won seven games here.

A LHP Dallas Keuchel faced the Mets for the first time in his career this season, going 1-0 with no runs allowed over a two-start stretch, August 14 and August $25 \ldots$ He went 6.0 innings on the 14th in Atlanta, before tossing 7.0 innings here at Citi Field on the 25 th...The Braves won both games.

A RHP Marcus Stroman is 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (3 ER/18.0 IP) in three career starts against the Braves, including 1-0 this season...The righty beat the Braves, $10-8$, on August 15 at SunTrust Park, after going 5.1 innings and allowing three runs, two earned.

100 WINS?: The Braves won their 97th game of the season on Wednesday, and need to sweep this series to reach triple-digit victories in a single season for the ninth time in franchise history and for the first time since 2003.

A Wednesday's win also gave the Braves their most single-season victories since that 2003 team.

A The 2003 club went 101-61 on their way to a five-game NLDS loss to Chicago...It marked the team's second-consecutive season of 100 wins; the 2002 also won 101 games.

A The Braves won triple digits in three consecutive seasons from 1997-1999, while the ' 93 went 104-58.

A The other two 100-win seasons came prior to the modern era in 1892 (102-48) and 1898 (102-47).

500 DOUBLES: OF Nick Markakis needs one more double to become the 64th player in major league history to reach 500 two-base hits.

A Only three active players have reached this milestone: Albert Pujols (661), Miguel Cabrera (577) and Robinson Canó (561).

DONALDSON VS. THE METS: 3B Josh Donalson enters tonight's game with nine home runs against the Mets this season, tied for the most any Braves player has ever hit in a single season against New York; Hank Aaron also had nine in 1962.

A The major league record is 10, done twice before and last Philadelphia's Dick Allen in 1968.. Pittsburgh's Willie Stargell did it first in 1966.

A There have only been nine instances in franchise history of a player hitting double-digit home runs against a single opponent in a season...It happened last in 1983 with Dale Murphy hitting 11 against San Francisco.

A The record is 13 by Joe Adcock in 1956 against Brooklyn.

A Eddie Mathews (11, 1953 vs. Cin; 10, 1955 vs. Phi; 10, 1958 vs. Pit; 10, 1959 vs. Cin) did it four times, while Hank Aaron (10, 1957 vs. Pit) and Earl Torgeson (11, 1950 vs. Cin) did once.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves enter this series with the best road record in the National League at 47-31 (.603)... They trail only Minnesota (53-25, .679) for the major league lead...Tampa Bay is also 47-31 (.603).
A The Braves finished 47-34 (.580) away from SunTrust Park last season, tied for the best road record in the National League with Los Angeles.

OZZIE HITS: 2B Ozzie Albies enters tonight's game with 187 hits, tied for the National League lead with Arizona's Ketel Marte...With Marte out for the remainder of the season, Albies is looking to become the fifth Atlantaera player to lead the league in hits, joining Freddie Freeman (2018), Terry Pendleton (1991 and 1992), Ralph Garr (1974) and Felipe Alou (1966 and 1968).

A The Braves are looking to become the first National League team to have consecutive hit leaders since Chicago in 2005-2006...Derek Lee had 1999 in 2005 before Juan Pierre had 204 in 2006.

A Colorado's Nolan Arenado is in third place with 184 hits, while his teammate, Charlie Blackmon has 180.

LOOKING AHEAD TO THE NLDS: The Braves are set to open the postseason at SunTrust Park as the National League's No. 2 seed on Thursday, October 3 against the winner of the National League Central.

A The Braves have lost nine consecutive playoff rounds, dating to the 2001 League Championship Series against Arizona.

A That streak is the second longest in MLB history.. The Braves last won a playoff round in 2001, sweeping Houston in the NLDS.

A Only Chicago (NL) owns a longer such skid, losing 10 consecutive rounds from 1910 through 1998.

## Tonight's Game

A Makes his 19th start of the season and the 202nd of his career...Is his 211th career appearance.
A Faces New York for the third time in his career, all of which have come this season. Has pitched 13.0 scoreless innings against the Mets so far.
A Is one of two pitchers in the majors to throw at least 10.0 scoreless innings against the Mets this season...The Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu held New York scoreless over 14.2 innings.
A Started at Citi Field, August 25, and held New York to just four hits and three walks over 7.0 innings, fanning seven.
A Atlanta has won each of his two starts against New York this season.
A Has lost each of his last two starts, combining to allow eight runs (seven earned) over 11.0 innings against the Phillies (September 17) and Giants (September 22).
A Despite the two games, has pitched to a 3.13 ERA in September, and has a 2.06 ERA (11 ER/48.0 IP) over his last eight starts.

A Since August 14, his 2.06 ERA is 11th lowest in baseball and seventh best in the National League...Tomorrow's starter, Mike Foltynewicz, has the secondlowest ERA in the NL in that span.
Since his season debut on June 21 has induced 15 double plays, most in the National League and second most in the majors... The White Sox' Ivan Nova has 16.
A Keuchel has 197 ground balls against him since his debut this season, easily most in the majors...Arizona's Mike Leake has 168 ground balls in that span to rank second.
A Is allowing opponents to bat 262 (108-for-413) against him on the season, with a .331 on-base percentage and .414 slugging.
A With runners in scoring position, is holding opponents to a .176/.292/.341 line, with 16 hits in 91 at-bats...Opponents are batting .106 points lower with runners in scoring position than they are with no one on base (.282, 64-for-227).

A In 45 opponent at-bats with runners in scoring position and two outs, has allowed just eight hits (.178) and 10 RBI.

## 2019 Recap

A Lost, $9 / 17 \mathrm{vs}$. PHI, to stop a streak of five consecutive starts in which he won.
A Allowed just four earned runs during the stretch, pitching to a 1.16 ERA (4 ER/31.0 IP)...Struck out 28 in 31 innings.
A Won five consecutive starts for the first time in his career...Had previously won four straight on five occasions, last in 2018...No Braves starter has won six straight turns since Kris Medlen in 2012, and no Atlanta lefty has done so since Mike Hampton in 2003.
Started, 8/20 vs. MIA, and allowed six hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth win of the season.
A Struck out opposing pitcher Elieser Hernandez leading off the third inning for the 1,000th strikeout of his major league career.
A Became the 49th active pitcher to have 1,000 career strikeouts, and the second on the Braves staff (Julio Teheran).
A Pitched against the Mets, 8/14 at SunTrust Park, and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings.
A With that start, has pitched against 27 of the 30 major league clubs... Has never faced either ATL or HOU, the two teams he has played for, and LAD.
E Started, 7/23 vs. KC, and logged his sixth career double-digit strikeout game.. Fanned 12 Royals over 6.0 innings, one off his career high.
A The last Atlanta pitcher to fan more batters in a single start was Kris Medlen, who struck out 13 Nationals over 7.0 innings on September 14, 2012.
A Beat the Padres on $7 / 12$, allowing just six hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
A Earned the win in Atlanta's final start before the All-Star break, $7 / 7 \mathrm{vs}$. MIA, and in Atlanta's first game after the break, $7 / 12$ at SD...Became the third Braves pitcher to start and win consecutive regular season games for the Braves in the modern era (since 1900) and the first since Johnny Sain on $9 / 6$ and $9 / 11 / 48$.
Pitched at least 7.0 innings in each his three starts from 7/2-12, going 2-1 with a 2.11 ERA (5 ER/21.1 IP) in that span.

A Was the first Atlanta starter to pitch at least 7.0 innings in three consecutive turns since 2017, when Jaime García did so from 5/31 to 6/11.
Signed by the Braves to a one-year major league contract on $6 / 7 \ldots$ Was recalled to Atlanta on 6/21.
A Became the first former Cy Young winner to join Atlanta midseason since the Braves acquired reliever Mark Davis from the Kansas City Royals in 1992.

Selected by the Houston Astros in the seventh round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft...Signed by Jim Stevenson.
Is a four-time Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner (2014-16, 18), two-time American League All-Star $(2015,2017)$ and the 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner. Has pitched in parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues (2012-18).
