TODAY'S CHILDHOOD CANCER AWARENESS DAY FEATURES CUSTOM TEAM CLEATS:

Today the D-backs and Phoenix Children's celebrate young patients, survivors and their families during the 13th annual Childhood Cancer Awareness Day... for the first time, custom cleats designed by child patients at Phoenix Children's will be worn by D-backs' players and staff...these cleats are currently up for auction through today at dbacks.com/auction, with proceeds benefiting childhood cancer research programs.

- During pregame, the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation will present a \$100,000 donation to Phoenix Children's in support of their critical programs and research efforts...patients from Phoenix Children's will take the field alongside D-backs players, serve as the "play ball" kid, and more.
- Kaden Bell, a 17-year-old Queen Creek native who battled childhood cancer at the age 4, will throw the ceremonial first pitch...Kaden now runs "Kaden's PJ Days for Kids," a fundraiser that benefits Phoenix Children's Center for Cancer & Blood Disorders.
- The Foundation also donated 350 game tickets to patients and families to Camp Rainbow, an annual summer camp for patients of Phoenix Children's.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs' 72-71 record is 1.0 game over .500 for the first time since July 1 when they were 43-42 after an 8-2 win vs. Giants...the last time they were 2.0+ games over was June 25 (41-39).

- Since August 1, the D-backs are 21-13 (.618), the third-best record in the Majors, behind the Brewers (24-11, .686) and Phillies (22-12, .647), ahead of the Red Sox (19-14, .576).
- On August 1, the D-backs were a season-high 13.0 games back in the division and 10.0 games back in the NL Wild Card. . . now the D-backs are 6.5 back in the division and 4.5 back in the NL Wild Card.
- The D-backs have won 4 straight games, 8 of their last 10 games, since Aug. 27, and 12 of their last 17 games, since Aug. 19.
- The D-backs have 5 straight home series wins (vs. Rangers, Reds, Guardians, Rockies and Red Sox), 6 straight series wins or splits, and 8 series wins in their last 11.

ROSTER MOVES: Reinstated RHP **Anthony DeSclafani** from the 15-day injured list (right thumb inflammation) and optioned RHP **Bryce Jarvis** to Triple-A Reno following last night's game.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-1 vs. Red Sox to take their second straight series against Boston and second ever @ Chase Field (also: 2-1 from April 5-7, 2019).

- Brandon Pfaadt** had a quality start, allowing 1 run on 6 hits and 0 walks with 7 strikeouts over 6.0 innings.
- Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 10 straight games, including 5 straight home games and 17 of his last 18 home games.
- James McCann** had a season-high 3 hits for the first time since Aug. 4, 2023 vs. Mets with the Orioles...has hit safely in 6 of his last 10 games and in 5 of his last 7 home games (with a PA).
- Tyler Locklear** has hit safely in 5 straight games.
- Adrian Del Castillo** has hit safely in 3 of his last 5 games.

- The D-backs bullpen combined for 3.0 scoreless innings. . . was their 11th occurrence of 3.0+ scoreless innings since Aug. 1, tied for second most in MLB (also: 5 others), behind the Braves (12).

VS. RED SOX: The D-backs have won 6 consecutive games vs. Red Sox and 8 of their last 11 since 2019...are going for their second straight sweep vs. Boston (3-0 from Aug. 23-25, 2024 on the road) and first-ever home sweep in their fourth series all-time @ Chase Field (6-5 all-time record; 2-0 in 2025, 1-2 in 2023, 2-1 in 2019 and 1-2 in 2007).

QUALITY STARTS: D-backs starting pitchers have quality starts in a MLB-best 5 straight games, 7 of their last 8 games and 8 of their last 10 games.

- D-backs starting pitchers' streak of 5 straight quality starts is their second longest this season to 6 straight from April 8-15, 2025, and tied for the third longest (fourth time) such streak since 2017: 8 straight – Sept. 9-16, 2017; 6 straight – April 8-15, 2025; 5 straight – Sept. 1-present. . . July 3-12, 2019. . . Aug. 4-9, 2017. . . May 19-23, 2017

TRENDING OFFENSE: Since August 8, the D-backs' 5.43 runs per game rank fourth in MLB, behind the Mets (6.70), Yankees (5.85) and Athletics (5.73).

- The D-backs lead the Majors with 44 homers this season in the 8th inning or later while their 163 runs are tied for the most in the same category with the Blue Jays.
- Since August 1 among teams in the first 3.0 innings, the D-backs' 48 walks are tied for second most with the Athletics, behind the Yankees (56), while their 68 runs rank fifth, behind the Mets (80), Brewers (75), Athletics (75) and Blue Jays (70).
- Since August 1, the D-backs' 76 RBI with 2 outs rank third in MLB, behind the Mets (82) and Phillies (79).

OPPOSING STARTERS VS. D-BACKS OFFENSE: Since August 1, opposing starters vs. D-backs' offense have combined for a 6.09 ERA (113 ER in 167.0 IP), .269 AVG/.807 OPS with 31 doubles, 6 triples, 28 homers, 65 walks (3.50 BB/9.0 IP) and 156 strikeouts.

CARROLL'S ON-BASE STREAK: **Corbin Carroll**'s 23-game on-base streak (since Aug. 13) is the longest active streak in the Majors and second longest of his career, behind a 27-gamer from Sept. 23, 2024-April 19, 2025.

CARROLL NEARING A 30-30 SEASON: **Corbin Carroll**, at 30 homers and 24 stolen bases, is looking to become the first-ever D-back to have a 30+-homer/30+-stolen base season...since his debut year in 2022, only 6 players have accomplished the feat: Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2x - 2023-24), José Ramírez/CLE (2024), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2024), Ronald Acuña Jr./ATL (2023), Francisco Lindor/NYM (2023) and Julio Rodríguez/SEA (2023).

- In 2023, Carroll became the first D-back in franchise history to have a 25+-homer/30+-stolen base season (25 HR, 54 SB).
- In 2023, Carroll also became the fifth D-back all-time (first since 2016) to record a 20+-homer/30+-stolen base campaign.
- Is the only D-back to have multiple 20+-homer/30+-stolen base campaigns (2023-24).
- Since 2022, he is 1 of 3 players with 2+ consecutive 20+-HR/30+-SB seasons: **Corbin Carroll** (2 - 2023-24), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4 - 2022-25) and José Ramírez/CLE (2 - 2024-25).

SPREADING THE SAVES: The D-backs' **8 pitchers with 2+ saves** are tied for the most all-time/since 1969 (*when saves became an official stat*) with the 2024 Rays, 2022 Rays, 2003 Tigers, 1979 Dodgers, 1973 Braves and 1970 Indians...the D-backs' **6 pitchers with 3+ saves** are tied for second most all-time/since 1969 with the 2022 Rays, 2021 Reds, 1992 Braves, 1991 Brewers, 1991 Pirates, 1990 Pirates, 1984 Mariners, 1983 Athletics, 1973 Braves, 1980 Angels and 1970 Indians...the record is 7 pitchers set by the 2003 Tigers [source: Elias Sports Bureau]:

- 2+ SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3), Anthony DeSclafani (2), Taylor Rashi (2).

ON DECK - SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS: Following today's game, the D-backs head to San Francisco to start the first of 6 games in 10 days vs. Giants (Sept. 8-10 on road, Sept. 15-17 at home).

- Entering today, the D-backs (72-71, fifth in NL Wild Card) sit a 0.5 game back of the Giants (72-70, fourth in NL Wild Card) in the standings.
- The D-backs went 2-1 in their initial road series from May 12-14 before splitting their 4-game home series from June 30-July 3.

NEXT STARTER: RHP NABIL CRISMATT (2-0, 2.14)

- In 3 starts, has gone 1-0 with a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP), 3 walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Logged a career-best 6.1 innings pitched in his last start on Sept. 2 vs. Rangers, allowing 2 runs on 7 hits and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts.
- Will be his first career start vs. Giants...has faced San Francisco 13 times in relief (1 time with the Dodgers in 2024, 12 times with the Padres from 2021-22).

SNAKEBITES

HOW HE STARTED: D-backs’ second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Named D-backs’ 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP) with 163 strikeouts (T-4th in MiLB) over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo.
- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: In his last 5 home starts (4 quality), is 2-0 (team is 3-2) with a 2.93 ERA (10 ER in 30.2 IP), opponent .196 AVG (22-for-112), 0.91 WHIP, 6 walks and 30 strikeouts.

- Has thrown 6.0+ innings in 4 straight starts and in 8 of his last 12 (team is 6-2).
- Has not walked a batter in 3 of his last 5 starts (0.91 BB/9.0 IP) and 4 of his last 7 (1.11 BB/9.0 IP).

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision on Sept. 1 vs. Rangers, allowing 3 runs on 4 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

VS. RED SOX: Second career start, first @ Chase Field.

- Won in a quality start @ Fenway Park on Aug. 23, 2024, allowing 2 runs on 5 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

VS. AL EAST: In his last 3 starts (2 quality) vs. AL East, is 2-0 with a 2.00 ERA (4 ER in 18.0 IP), opponent .172 AVG (11-for-64), 0.78 WHIP, 3 walks and 17 strikeouts.

- Last home start vs. an AL East opponent was on July 12, 2024 vs. Blue Jays (ND; 3 ER in 7.0 IP, 5 H, 0 BB, 5 K).

HOME COOKIN: In 9 home starts (6 quality), is 4-1 (team is 6-3) with a 2.36 ERA (15 R-14 ER in 53.1 IP), opponent .206 AVG (40-for-194), 0.96 WHIP, 11 walks and 46 strikeouts.

- Has consecutive quality home starts (team is 1-1) and 5 quality home starts in his last 6 (team is 4-2)...in those 5, faced the Giants on June 30, Royals on July 5, Cardinals on July 19, Reds on Aug. 22 and Rangers on Sept. 1...was just shy of a quality start on Aug. 5 vs. Padres when he allowed 2 ER in 5.2 IP.
- Has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in 7 of his 9 starts, including 2 starts with 1 earned run and 2 starts with 0 runs allowed.
- Has walked 1 or fewer batters in 6 of his 9 starts (0.72 BB/9.0 IP).

FREE PASSES ARE LIMITED: Has allowed 1 walk or fewer in 11 of his 19 starts.

- Has yielded 2 walks or fewer in 30 of his last 34 starts since June 14, 2024 (1.97 BB/9.0 IP, 196.1 innings, 783 BF).

LIMITING LEFTIES & RIGHTIES: In his last 19 starts, is holding lefties to a .195 AVG (33-for-169)/.573 OPS with 36 strikeouts and righties to a .232 AVG (51-for-220)/.740 OPS with 52 strikeouts.

- In his last 3 starts, lefties are batting .107 (3-for-28)/.286 OPS with 10 strikeouts.

SLIDE TO THE LEFT: Throwing his slider 13.2% of the time and holding opponents to a .200 AVG (13-for-65).

- Has held lefties hitless in his last 45 starts (7 BF, 25 P) dating back to Sept. 17, 2023.

GIVE 'EM THE HEATER: Throwing his fastball 62.5% of the time and holding opponents to a .210 AVG (67-for-319), his highest and lowest marks respectively since 2022.

- Among NL starting pitchers on 4-seam fastballs (min. 100 BF), his .210 opponent AVG ranks ninth lowest.

GETTING SWINGS: His 51.9 swing pct. since June 13 ranks second among NL starters (7th in MLB), behind Shota Imanaga/CHC (53.1%).

INNING INSIGHT: From innings 3-5, has a 1.69 ERA (13 R-10 ER in 53.1 IP), and is holding opponents to a .180 AVG (34-for-189)/.545 OPS with 42 strikeouts.

FROM THE SECOND TIME THRU: From the second time thru the order on, is holding opponents to a .195 AVG (45-for-231) with 51 strikeouts.

RISPY BUSINESS: In his last 9 starts, with runners in scoring position, opponents are hitting .189 AVG (7-for-37)/.562 OPS.

EARLY RISER: In his last 4 day starts, is 3-1 with a 1.50 ERA (7 R-4 ER in 24.0 IP), opponent .174 (15-for-86) AVG, 0.75 WHIP, 3 walks and 21 strikeouts...has allowed 1 earned run or fewer in each of the 4 starts.

AUGUST RECAP: In 5 starts in August, went 1-0 with a 4.60 ERA (15 ER in 29.1 IP), opponent .265 AVG, 4 walks and 27 strikeouts.

JULY RECAP: In 5 starts in July, went 2-1 with a 2.22 ERA (7 ER in 28.1 IP), opponent .210 AVG, 1.02 WHIP, 7 walks and 22 strikeouts.

JUNE RECAP: In 5 starts in June, went 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11 ER in 25.1 IP), opponent .189 AVG and 24 strikeouts.

IN THE PEN: Began the season in the bullpen and made 10 relief appearances.

- Pitched 2.0+ innings 8 of his 10 relief appearances.
- Tossed 4.0 scoreless innings twice (April 29 @ Mets and May 31 vs. Nationals)...has worked 4.0+ innings in relief five times in his career.
- In April, led D-back relievers in innings (15.1) and strikeouts (17).
- Recorded his third career win in relief on April 12 vs. Brewers (last: May 22, 2024 @ Dodgers).
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings on April 7 vs. Orioles.
