**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue a six-game, seven-day homestand against the Reds (0-2, one to play) and Twins (three to play) at Tropicana Field...have lost a season-high-tying three games in a row on the heels of a 10-3 stretch, which followed a 5-2 start...are 4-4 on a span of 27 games in 29 days from April 14-May 13, with off days coming on April 23 and April 30...are above .500 through 23 games for the fourth time in five seasons and sixth in the last eight...are 2.0 games behind the Yankees for first place in the AL East...have spent six days in first, eight in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays dropped the second game of their three-game set with the Reds, 12-6, last night...have lost back-to-back series (also April 17-19 at PIT) after sweeping the Yankees (April 10-12) and the White Sox (April 14-16)...today, they will look to avoid being swept for the first time since Sept. 26-28, 2025 at TOR and for the first time at Tropicana Field since Aug. 12-14, 2024 vs. HOU.
- ★ **Jonathan Aranda** launched a home run in the 6th inning, his first since April 6 vs. CHC, as part of a 3-RBI game...his six multi-RBI games are tied with HOU **Yordan Alvarez** and HOU **Christian Walker** for the AL lead, trailing only MIA **Liam Hicks** and LAD **Andy Pages** (both 7G) in all of MLB.
- ★ The Rays have scored first only three times in their last 15 games, including none of their last six contests, despite a 9-6 record in that span...their AL-best-tying seven comeback wins are tied for the fifth most in the majors...they have posted a 6-8 (429) record in games when opponents score first, fifth best in the AL.
- ★ The Rays snapped an 0-for-18 skid with the bases loaded after a **Jonny DeLuca** double in the 9th inning plated two runs...despite this stretch, the Rays have the third-best average (.279/60-for-215) with runners in scoring position in the AL and fifth best in the majors.
- ★ The Rays also drew a pair of bases-loaded walks in last night's contest...they have walked home a run five times in their last six games, and six times this season...in franchise history, the club has walked home a run 42 times in the 9th inning or later, with five of the 42 coming this season...six of the Rays 19 RBI with the bases loaded this season have come via walks, tied for the most in the majors with the Angels.
- ★ **Nick Martinez** takes the mound today for his fifth start of the season and his first opposite the Reds since pitching for them between 2024-25...his 2.45 ERA is the lowest by a Ray through their first four starts of a season (min. 15.OIP) since **Ian Seymour** (1.21, Aug. 25-Sept. 17, 2025) made his first four starts for the club last season.

**THE GREAT YANDINO**—**Yandy Diaz** singled in the 8th inning last night for his 911th hit with the Rays, surpassing **B.J. Upton** for fourth on the club's all-time list...with 102 HR, he is also two homers shy of matching seventh-ranked **Carl Crawford** (104HR) (see tables to the right)...he has reached in 21 of 23 games this season while hitting safely in 18 of 23...Diaz ranks highly in the AL in average (4th, .322/.29-for-90), hits (T4th, 29), on-base pct. (5th, .413), RBI (T7th, 17), OPS (9th, .891), and total bases (T11th, 43).

- ★ From the 7th inning on, Diaz is batting .538 (14-for-26), best in the majors...he also paces the majors with a .531 (17-for-32) average against relievers...he also has the second-best average with RISP (.476/10-for-21) in the AL behind DET **Kevin McGonigle** (.500/8-for-16) and CLE **Brayan Rocchio** (.500/9-for-18).
- ★ Diaz has reached base safely 43 times, tied for eighth in the majors behind and tied for second most in club history through the Rays first 23 games with **Jonny Gomes** (2006), trailing only **Fred McGriff** in 1998 (45)...the record through 24 games is held by McGriff at 48 times in 1998...with seven games left, Diaz is on pace to reach safely 56 times by the end of April, which would best **Tommy Pham** (52) in 2019 for the most TOB over such a span in Rays history.
- ★ He is 14 hits shy of reaching 1,000 for his career, which would make him the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history to reach the milestone.

**TWO-WAY?**—**Ben Williamson** was called upon to pitch in the 9th inning last night, the first position player to pitch for the Rays since **José Caballero** on June 27, 2025 at BAL, and the 21st different position player to toe the rubber in franchise history (36x)...he spun 1.0 inning and allowed one run on a solo home run...he remained in the lineup in place of designated hitter **Yandy Diaz** and drew an RBI-walk, becoming the first Rays pitcher to tally an RBI since **Luke Raley** (April 27, 2023 at CWS - 3RBI) and the first to record an RBI and play no other position other than pitcher since **Oliver Drake** (Aug. 12, 2019 at SD - 1RBI).

**SMALL BALL**—The Rays pace the majors in contact rate (80.0%), singles (149), infield hits (37, per Baseball-Reference), ground-ball hits (82), and sacrifice hits (9, T1st with MIL) while ranking second in strikeout rate (18.8%) to the Blue Jays (17.9%)...they are tied for the AL lead in bunt hits (6 with CWS) while ranking second in stolen bases (25)...they have gone from first to third or scored on singles 16 times, tied with the Guardians for fourth in the AL to the Tigers (23), Mariners (17), and Astros (17)...they also are fifth in the AL with 26 "productive outs," defined by Baseball-Reference as advancing any runner with none out or driving in a baserunner with the second out of an inning.

- ★ **Chandler Simpson** leads baseball with 12 infield hits while **Yandy Diaz** is tied for fifth in the AL with five...**Jonny DeLuca's** 5 RBI as a pinch hitter are the most in MLB, and he is one of four players in the AL with multiple hits as a pinch hitter (2-for-5).
- ★ Seven Rays have recorded multiple stolen bases, tied with the Brewers for second most in the majors and only behind the Rockies (8)...seven have tallied a hit as a pinch hitter, second most in MLB to the Rockies (8).
- ★ The Rays have won the second-most games in the AL without the benefit of a home run (5), behind the Red Sox (6)...they have scored five runs or more without homering an MLB-best six times and have scored only 28 of their 110 runs via their 19 HR...the club is undefeated (4-0) when out-homering opponents.

**THE NATIONAL PASTIME**—The Rays have started the year 4-10 against the NL, with all games coming against NL Central opposition...MLB began scheduling teams to play each of the other 29 major league clubs every season in 2023, with the Rays holding an 85-69 (552) record in Interleague games over that span, third best in the AL behind the Astros (.557/83-66) and Blue Jays (.553/84-68)...since AL and NL teams began facing off during the regular season in 1997, the Rays have the fourth-best Interleague winning pct. (.531/330-292) in the majors.

**ON DECK**—The Rays are set to host the Twins in a three-game set this weekend (April 24-26) to close out the homestand...the Rays have won or split the season series each of the last three seasons and are 2-1 so far this season after claiming a three-game set in Minnesota (April 3-5)...the Rays claimed the rubber match on April 5 with a three-run 10th inning powered by a **Richie Palacios** home run to open the frame...including their sweep of the White Sox (April 14-16), the Rays have won five straight against the AL Central, their longest winning streak against the division since a franchise-best nine-game winning streak from March 30-April 29, 2023.

**TRADE TALKS**—On Dec. 19, 2025 the Rays traded **Shane Baz** to the Orioles in exchange for **OF Slater de Brun**, **C Caden Bodine**, **RHP Michael Forret**, **OF Austin Overn**, and a 2026 First-Year Player Draft Competitive Balance Round A draft pick.

- ★ Through 14 games with Class-A Charleston, Bodine ranks ninth among all qualified minor leaguers in average (.397/23-for-58)...he has slashed .397/455/603 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 7 BB, 14 R, 2 SO, and a 1.058 OPS...he has registered a hit in 12 of 14 games and multiple hits in eight of 14.
- ★ Overn has swiped 17 bases on 18 attempts through 14 games with Double-A Montgomery...his 17 SB lead all minor leaguers and is the second most through a full-season team's first 15 games of a season since 2005, behind only **Asbel Gonzalez** (20SB, A-COL) in 2025.
- ★ Forret started for Double-A Montgomery last night and earned the win in a quality start (W, 6.OIP, 3H, R, 2BB, 4SO, HR)...in three starts on the season, he is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (15.OIP, 3ER) and a .149 (7-for-47) opp. average...min. 12.0 IP, he leads all Rays farmhands in wins, ERA, and opp. average and is tied for fewest hits allowed.
- ★ de Brun is currently on the 60-day IL, but is still ranked as the No. 9 prospect and the No. 3 outfielder in the Rays system by MLB.com.

**TODAY'S START**—Nick Martinez will make his fifth start with the Rays and second at home today against his former club...marks his 134th career start and second opposite the Reds...is seeking a team-high third quality start of the season...enters his ninth major league season and first with the Rays...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

- ✦ He is one of three MLB starters age 35 or older to allow six earned runs or fewer in at least four starts this season (also: TEX Jacob deGrom & KC Seth Lugo).
- ✦ Among qualified AL starters, Martinez's .194 opp. batting average against right-handed batters ranks 13th and is one of 15 arms with an opp. batting average under .200.
- ✦ Has not allowed a run in the 1st inning during each of his four starts, one of 10 AL starters to do so...has limited hitters to a .143 (2-for-14) clip in the opening frame, tied for 10th among AL starters.

**LAST TIME OUT**—On April 17 at PIT, Martinez suffered his first loss of the year after allowing two runs on eight hits and three walks over 5.1 innings, recording three strikeouts...until that start, the Rays had won each of his appearances in 2026.

**SEEING RED**—The veteran right-hander is 1-0 with a 4.00 ERA (9.0IP, 4ER) and eight strikeouts in four career appearances (one start) opposite the Reds...in his lone start against Cincinnati on April 28, 2022 (w/SD) at Great American Ball Park, he tossed 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits and two walks while striking out five in the win.

- ✦ Martinez is 7-9 with a 3.67 ERA (149.2IP, 61ER) in 20 career starts vs. NL Central opponents.

**EARLY BIRD**—In day games, Martinez holds a career 18-18 record with a 3.99 ERA (340.1IP, 151ER) and 93 walks against 257 strikeouts...his last day start took place on April 5 at MIN, where he logged a quality start with 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on one hit and one walk while striking out a season-high four batters.

- ✦ Martinez pitched the only complete game of his career in a day game while with Cincinnati on Sept. 27, 2024 at CHC, where he fired 8.0 innings of one-run ball, allowing five hits while striking out three batters in a 1-0 loss.

**INTERLEAGUE**—Martinez will make his 61st Interleague appearance today (25th start) and his third of the season after facing Milwaukee (March 30) and Pittsburgh (April 17) in road outings...has pitched to a 4.02 ERA (179.0IP, 80ER) with an 11-11 record across the 60 previous Interleague matchups, while receiving a 5.13 run support average...his teams are 38-22 during Interleague games, and 10 of his 24 Interleague starts have been quality.

**OFFSPEED MAGIC**—Per Baseball Savant, Martinez's Offspeed Run Value (3) ranks in the 97th percentile among qualified pitchers in 2026...he had a Run Value of -2 on offspeed pitches last year, down from 2024 (7) and 2023 (career-high 14)...his 3 Run Value on the changeup in 2026 ranks sixth in the majors, throwing the pitch a total of 102 times through his first four starts...among AL arms in 2026 (min. 250 pitches), Martinez's .128 xBA (2-for-24) on offspeed pitches is the 10th lowest in the circuit...since the start of 2024, Martinez's 21.0 pct. hard-hit rate on offspeed pitches is the lowest in the majors (min. 200 BF).

**NO FREE 90S**—Since the start of 2024, Martinez has issued only 67 walks, good for the seventh lowest walks per 9.0 IP (1.83) mark in the majors (min. 250.0IP) during that stretch...the veteran right-hander trails only SEA Bryan Woo (1.46), SEA George Kirby (1.54), CHC Shota Imanaga (1.56), DET Tarik Skubal (1.59), WSH Zack Littell (1.72), and SEA Logan Gilbert (1.78) during that span...as exclusively a starter, Martinez's 55 walks are tied for the fewest in the majors during that stretch (also: Woo).

**SOFT CONTACT KING**—Among qualified pitchers last season, Martinez's 34.5 pct. hard-hit rate tied MIL Freddy Peralta for the fifth lowest in the majors, higher than only HOU Hunter Brown (32.2%), DET Tarik Skubal (33.0%), CIN Andrew Abbott (33.7%), and LAA Kyle Hendricks (34.3%).

- ✦ He also ranked fourth among qualified AL pitchers in barrel pct. (6.9%) behind only Brown (5.9%), ATH Luis Severino (6.0%), and HOU Framber Valdez (6.7%).

**CAREER RUNDOWN**—In 2024, set career marks in ERA (3.10), bWAR (4.0), WHIP (1.03), strikeouts (116), strikeout rate (23.0%), walk rate (3.2%), opp. average (.237), FIP (3.21), barrel rate (5.1%), and chase rate (33.9%) in his first season with the Reds...received the Johnny Vander Meer Award from the Cincinnati chapter of the BBWAA as the Reds most outstanding pitcher.

- ✦ In 2023, paced the Padres staff with a career-high 63 appearances and recorded the highest strikeout (23.0%) and whiff (28.6%) rates of his career...also held opponents to a career-best .354 slugging pct.
- ✦ Returned to the majors in 2022 after signing a one-year deal with the Padres March 16...made 47 appearances, including 10 starts, and became the first pitcher since holds became an official statistic in 1986 to record a season with four holds or more, eight saves or more, and 10 starts or more.
- ✦ Played his final season overseas in 2021...signed with the Fukoka Softbank Hawks in January and went 9-4 with a 1.60 ERA (140.2IP, 25ER) and 138 SO over 23 starts...led the club and ranked fourth in the Japan Pacific League in strikeouts...min. 100.0 IP, the only JPL pitcher with a lower ERA was Yoshinobu Yamamoto (1.39).
- ✦ Missed the 2019 season due to a right forearm strain...returned to action midway through the 2020 campaign, making 17 appearances for the Nippon-Ham Fighters (NPB).
- ✦ In 2018, started 25 games for the Nippon-Ham Fighters, tied for most on the club...also ranked second on the team in strikeouts (93) and innings pitched (161.2) and threw three complete games.
- ✦ Spent the 2011-17 seasons in the Rangers organization, pitching to a 35-23 record with a 3.28 ERA (510.2IP, 186ER) across 107 minor league appearances (87 starts).
