RAY MATTER—The Rays have lost back-to-back games on the heels of a season-high-tying 5-game winning streak...the Rays would need a win today to avoid a .500 record for the 10th time in 36 games...the Rays are 5-2 in their last 7 games, 5-5 in their last 10 games and 8-9 in their last 17 games...they are tied with the Yankees (pct. points behind) for third place in the AL East and are 3.5 GB of the first-place Red Sox in the division.

- + The Rays have placed CF **Kevin Kiermaier** (left wrist sprain) on the 10-day IL and recalled RH **Louis Head** from Triple-A Durham.
- + Yesterday the Rays fell behind in the 1st inning and never led... they stranded the potential game-tying run on base in the 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th...the Rays fell to 7-2 when recording double-digit hits, with the only other loss coming on April 21 at KC...they out-hit Oakland, 10-6, dropping to 13-4 when out-hitting their opponent.
- + The Rays are 11-7 (.611) on the road this season, 5th in the majors, and 31-13 (.705) on the road since Aug 10, 2020, best in the majors... the Rays have won nine of their last 12 road games after going 2-4 on the season-opening road trip...over this 9-3 span, the Rays have made 5 errors while their opponents have combined for 19 errors.
- + The Rays have used 38 players (4th in the majors), 22 pitchers (tied for 2nd in majors) and 11 starting pitchers (tied for 1st) this season.
- + The Rays are 8-8 and 16-13 so far in stretches of games on 17 consecutive days and 30 games in 31 days...starting tomorrow the Rays have five days off and only 27 games in 32 days through June 10.

NO BROOMS ALLOWED—Today the Rays are attempting to avoid being swept for the second time this season, following April 5-7 at BOS (0-3)... the Rays were swept in a series of 3 games (or more) only once last season: from July 31-Aug 2 at BAL (0-3)...in franchise history, the Rays have been swept by the Athletics in a series of 3 games (or more) nine times—eight as the Devil Rays and once as the Rays: Aug 30-Sep 1, 2013 at OAK (0-3)... eight of the nine times they were swept was at the Oakland Coliseum.

TREAT YOUR MOTHER RIGHT—The Rays are 10-12 all-time on Mother's Day with two straight losses: 7-1 in 2019 vs. NYY and 17-1 in 2018 at BAL...the Rays have won four of their last five road games on Mother's Day (2018 loss, wins in 2017 at BOS, 2016 at LAA, 2012 at BAL, 2011 at BAL)...as has been tradition since 2006, players will continue to swing pink bats and sport pink wristbands in commemoration of the "Going To Bat Against Breast Cancer" initiative...players will wear specially designed pink New Era caps, and uniforms will feature the MLB breast cancer awareness logo, adorned with the pink ribbon, on the left chest.

- + Six years ago, Manager **Kevin Cash** was ejected from a 2-1 loss against the Rangers at home with his mother **Patsy** in the stands.
- + The Rays have faced the A's on Mother's Day once before, when **Dallas Braden** pitched a perfect game on May 9, 2010 at OAK.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—During these back-to-back losses the Rays have combined for 4 runs on 13 hits, 1 HR and 4 BB, are batting .194 (13-for-67) overall and .231 (3-for-13) with RISP...in comparison, during the 5-game winning streak the Rays averaged 6.20 R/G, hit .243 (42-for-173) overall and .240 (12-for-50) with RISP...the Rays have combined for 30 runs on this road trip, compared to 25 runs on the preceding 10-game homestand.

- + In the last 5 games, opposing starters have a 0.92 ERA (29.1-IP, 3-ER) against the Rays...in the last 7 games, opposing starters have a 2.61 ERA (38-IP, 11-ER) and bullpens have a 7.50 ERA (24-IP, 20-ER).
- + In the last 16 games since April 23, the Rays have scored 55 runs (3.44 R/G) on 111 hits and 54 BB, have struck out 176 times and are batting .209 (111-for-530) overall and .163 (20-for-123) with RISP.
- + The Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 22 of 35 games (62.9 pct.), tied with two others for 2nd-fewest in the AL after the Tigers (23).
- + The Rays offense has a majors-most 365 SO this season, ahead of the Tigers (354) and Brewers (346)...they rank 10th in the AL in batting avg. (.224), 9th in on-base pct. (.308) and 11th in homers (35).
- + The Rays have used 35 different batting orders in 35 games.

CHICKEN ON THE BONE—The Rays have scored 30 runs this road trip, batting .250 (13-for-52) with RISP over that stretch...this comes on the heels of a 10-game homestand where they hit .099 (7-for-71) with RISP.

- + This season the Rays are batting .201 (61-for-303) with RISP, last in the majors—in 29th place is the D-backs (.205)...with RISP/2 out, their .154 avg. (22-for-143) is last in the majors (29th: Mets, .167).
- + The Rays are batting .246 (42-for-171) with RISP on the road, com-

pared to a .144 avg. (19-for-132) with RISP at Tropicana Field.

- + The Rays have struck out 105 times with RISP, tied with the Dodgers for most in the majors...**Willy Adames** leads the majors with 15 SO with RISP, while **Randy Arozarena** is tied for 2nd with 14 SO.
- + The Rays have had 70 PA this season with a runner on third and less than 2 outs, and that runner has scored 33 times (47.1 pct.), 19th in the majors...the major league avg. in those situations is 49.1 pct.

PITCHING PROPERLY—Yesterday the Rays allowed 6 runs, their most since April 30 vs. HOU (9)...the Rays have a 2.93 ERA (70.2-IP, 23-ER) in their last 8 games and a 2.96 ERA (133.2-IP, 44-ER) in their last 15 games... this 15-game stretch has lowered the season ERA from 4.62 to 3.83, its fifth straight day under 4.00...the Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) in five of their last 6 games, 12 of their last 15 games and 18 of their last 28.

- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.35 ERA (252.1-IP, 94-ER) in 28 games, which ranks 6th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.82 ERA (70.1-IP, 22-ER) in the last 16 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 4.03...since April 10, the bullpen is 11th in the majors with a 3.33 ERA (127-IP, 47-ER) in 28 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 58 runs in the 7th inning or later, tied for 6th in the majors...this is four shy of matching their total from the abbreviated 2020 season...the Rays have yielded 3 HR in the 7th, 4 HR in the 8th, 3 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras...however, in the last 16 games the Rays have allowed 13 runs in the 7th inning or later, compared to 45 runs in the first 19 games of the season.
- + The Rays are 9-9 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 4-6 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

START ME UP—Rays starters rank 9th in the majors and 3rd in the AL with a 3.64 ERA (163-IP, 66-ER)...since April 10, the starters rank 2nd in the AL with a 3.38 ERA (125.1-IP, 47-ER) behind the White Sox (2.53)... over that stretch, Rays starters have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 16 of 28 starts (57.1 pct.), including 12 scoreless starts...traditional starters (excluding openers) have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 11 of 22 starts since April 10, including nine scoreless starts...this comes on the heels of a 4.54 ERA through the first 7 games this season, which ranked 22nd in the majors.

- + Rays pitchers have made 11 starts this season of 5 IP (or more) and 1 run (or fewer), 2nd in the AL—despite using an opener six times—behind the White Sox (12)...in comparison, Rays starters accomplished that only 11 times in the 60 games (18.3 pct.) last season.
- + Rays starters have gone 6 IP (or more) 13 times this season after doing so nine times in 2020, which tied for fewest in the majors.

RAYS vs. ATHLETICS—The Rays are 2-4 against the A's this season, losing the season series for a second straight time after going 3-4 in 2019...today's game concludes the season series, all coming over a 14-day stretch, after the two clubs split a 4-game series from April 26-29 at TB...five of the 6 games in the season series have been decided by 2 runs (or fewer), incl. four 1-run games...the Rays are 78-113 (.408) all-time against the Athletics, their worst record against an AL opponent...they are 32-62 (.340) at the Oakland Coliseum, their worst winning pct. at a current AL ballpark.

- + Since July 22, 2016, 21 of the 29 games have been decided by 2 runs (or fewer) and 17 of the 29 have been decided by 1-run margins.

YANKEE DOODLES—The Rays are 5-1 this season with a +16 run differential in 6 games against the Yankees, compared to 13-16 with a -16 run differential in 29 games against all other opponents...the Rays offense is averaging 6.00 R/G and 1.50 HR/G against the Yankees and 3.90 R/G and 0.83 HR/G otherwise (113-R, 24-HR)...Rays pitching has a 2.95 ERA against the Yankees and a 4.02 ERA (260-IP, 116-ER) against other opponents.

SUGAR SHANE—Today's starter **Shane McClellan** has reached 100 mph seven times this season, most in the majors among left-handed starters...in fact, no other lefty starter has reached 100 mph since NYY **James Paxton** on July 26, 2019 at BOS, according to StatCast...the closest this season is OAK **Jesús Luzardo**, who has thrown two pitches at 99.1 mph.

- + His 7 pitches of 100+ mph this season rank 4th among all starters behind NYM **Jacob deGrom** (46), LAA **Shohei Ohtani** (9) and TB **Tyler Glasnow** (8)...McClellan has done this in 8 IP, while the starters ahead of him have had 35 IP, 18.2 IP and 49.1 IP, respectively.

LAST START—On Tues at LAA, took no decision after throwing four scoreless innings in his second career start...faced a 2-on, 1-out jam in the 1st inning but got a strikeout and groundout to avoid any damage...retired his next 8 BF before allowing a 2-out double and walk in the 4th, but recorded a flyout to get out of the jam...threw five fastballs that registered velocities of 100 mph (or more), the 2nd-most by a lefty starter since Stat-Cast data is available (2015) behind SEA **James Paxton** (24) on June 6, 2016 vs. CLE...his line: ND, 4 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 2 BB, 5 SO, 63 pitches, 44 strikes.

- + Recorded 8 swings-and-misses with his slider, and his 58.1 pct. whiff rate on the pitch is 9th-best rate in the majors (min. 10 PA).

DEBUT: TAKE 2—Last postseason, he made 4 apps in relief and became the first pitcher in major league history to debut in the postseason...was one of three to make his ML debut last postseason, along with Twins OF **Alex Kirilloff** and Padres LH **Ryan Weathers** (one day after McClanahan).

- + According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the official statistician for Major League Baseball, a player's major league debut—in the case of a player appearing in the postseason before the regular season—is his postseason appearance...therefore, McClanahan's major league debut remains Game 1 of the ALDS on Oct 5, 2020 vs. NYY.
- + Is currently ranked as the No. 75 overall prospect in the minors by MLB.com, and No. 90 by *Baseball America*—which also tabbed him as having the Best Changeup in the Rays organization.

vs. ATHLETICS—Will make his second career start and app against the Athletics after making his regular season debut against them on April 29 at Tropicana Field when he allowed 2 runs in 4 IP... allowed a RBI double in the 3rd inning and solo homer to **Matt Chapman** in the 4th...left in line for the loss before a game-tying homer in the 5th inning...recorded 15 swings-and-misses on 59 pitches (25.4 pct.), according to StatCast.

NOTABLE DEBUTS—Became the 27th pitcher in Rays history to make his first career regular season app as a starter, and the second this season—joining **Brent Honeywell Jr.** on April 11 vs. NYY...was the seventh lefty to make his first career regular season app for the Rays as a starter, joining **Josh Fleming** in 2020, **Brendan McKay** in 2019, **Blake Snell** in 2016, **Enny Romero** in 2013, **Scott Kazmir** in 2004 and **Joe Kennedy** in 2001.

SPRING THINGS—Did not allow a run in three official Grapefruit League apps (1 start) this spring, striking out seven of his 10 BF across 3 IP...made his only start on March 3 vs. PIT, throwing a scoreless inning and stranding a leadoff single...made his next 2 apps at home against the Red Sox, going 1 IP on both March 9 and March 15 and striking out all 6 BF.

FLAME THROWING—His avg. 4-seam fastball velocity in the 2020 postseason was 98.1 mph, according to StatCast, tied for the 4th-fastest in the majors (min 30 fastballs thrown)...among LH pitchers, his avg. 4-seam fastball velocity tied NYY **Aroldis Chapman** for 1st in the postseason.

- + Threw four fastballs that eclipsed 100 mph, including a 101.2 mph heater to **Brett Gardner** in Game 3 of the ALDS at NYY...only three pitchers reached a higher velocity than him last postseason: LAD **Brusdar Graterol** (7), LAD **Dustin May** (2) and TB **Tyler Glasnow** (1).
- + Has thrown 7 fastballs that have registered velocities of 100 mph (or harder) this season...is one of five starting pitchers in the majors this season to throw multiple fastballs at 100 mph (or harder) across all starts, along with NYM **Jacob deGrom** (46), LAA **Shohei Ohtani** (9), TB **Tyler Glasnow** (8) and NYY **Gerrit Cole** (3).

2020 RECAP—Was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate site in Port Charlotte...made his major league debut in Game 1 of the ALDS vs. NYY, becoming the first pitcher in major league history to debut in the postseason...prior to the 2020 postseason, only two position players had made their major league debuts in the post-season: KC **Adalberto Mondesi** in 2015 and OAK **Mark Kiger** in 2006.

- + Became the first pitcher and second player in major league history to appear in a World Series game before appearing in a regular season game, joining Mondesi in the 2015 World Series at NYM.
- + In his debut in Game 1 of the ALDS vs. NYY, entered with 1-on, 2-out in the 9th inning and went single, walk, groundout.

ON THE FARM—In two minor league seasons with the Rays, is 11-6 with a 3.17 ERA (127.2-IP, 45-ER) in 28 career apps (26 starts)...totaled 7 IP over 4 starts after he was drafted in 2018 before going 11-6 with a 3.36 ERA (120.2-IP, 45-ER) in 24 apps (22 starts) between three levels in 2019, his first full season...began the season with Class-A Bowling Green and was named to the Midwest League midseason All-Star Team...promoted to Class-A Charlotte June 8, making 9 apps (8 starts) with them before an Aug 4 promotion to Double-A Montgomery...his 154 SO ranked 2nd among Rays minor leaguers and his 11 wins tied for 5th in the system.

AMATEUR CAREER—Became the second product of the University of South Florida to play for the Rays, joining **Dave Eiland** in 1998-2000...as a redshirt sophomore in 2018, posted a 3.42 ERA (76.1-IP, 29-ER) and 120 SO, and his 14.1 SO/9 IP ratio ranked 2nd in Division I...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 8 overall player in the 2018 Amateur Draft...became the 3rd-highest drafted player in program history.
