BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles complete the 2025 season this weekend at Yankee Stadium (0-1, 2 to play)...Baltimore is 56-49 (.533) since May 30, tied with the Guardians for the fifth-best winning percentage in the AL during that period behind the Blue Jays (.615, 64-40), Red Sox (.598, 61-41), Mariners (.571, 60-45), and Yankees (.543, 57-48).

- $\theta_s$  Jordan Westburg hit a three-run home run while going 3-for-5 last night...Since June 10, his return from his first Injured List stint, he's slashing .285/.333/.478 (65-for-228) with eight doubles, 12 home runs, 46 runs scored, and 34 RBI...He's second on the team during that time in home runs behind **Colton Cowser** (13 HR) despite playing in 62.5 percent (60-of-96) of the team games during that time. **Tyler O'Neill** hit his first homer since returning from the Injured List on September 12
- yesterday...He's hit six home runs in 18 games since July 25, including going deep in four consecutive from July 25-29.
- $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle B}$  Last night was the 30 th time this season that the O's have allowed at least eight runs in a game...That's the most since 2021 (45 G).

RUN AND GUNN: Gunnar Henderson secured his first career 30-steal season last night...At 24 years, 89 days old, he's the youngest player in Orioles history (since 1954) to reach 30 stolen bases, a mark previously held by **Don Baylor**, who was 24 years, 92 days old when he swiped his 29th, 30th, stolen bases on September 28, 1973 (G2) vs. Cleveland...Henderson has stolen 16 of his last 17 attempts since August 4.

- The Orioles have now had a player with 30+ stolen bases for the sixth straight full season (since 2019) for the first time in team history...The longest such streak before this was four consecutive years from 2006-09.
- As a team, the club's 121 stolen bases are the most by the Orioles since 2007 (144 SB). Henderson is the sixth Oriole (10<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in franchise history (since 1954) to record 30+ doubles and 30+ steals in a season, joining **Cedric Mullins** (2021-22), Jonathan Villar (2019), Nate McLouth (2013), Brian Roberts (2006-09), and Delino DeShields (2000)
- He's one of 10 MLB players with 30+ doubles and 30+ steals this season: WSH's CJ Abrams, SEA's Randy Arozarena, AZ's Corbin Carroll, CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong, CIN's
  Elly De La Cruz, NYM's Francisco Lindor, CLE's José Ramírez, PHI's Trea Turner, and KC's
  Team AVG/OBP/SLG

HOLLIDAY SEASON: Jackson Holliday paces the Birds with 17 home runs, one ahead of Colton Cowser and Gunnar Henderson (both 16 HR)...The only Oriole under 22 years old to finish the season leading the club in homers is **Eddie Murray** (27 HR, 1977).

- 6 Holliday can join Bobby Grich (19 HR, 1974) as the only Oriole second basemen in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the team in home runs.
- (2) Holliday's 17 long balls are the fifth most by an Oriole in their age-21 season or younger (as of age of July 1 of season) in team history (since 1954), trailing Cal Ripken, Jr. (28 , 1982), Eddie Murray (27 HR, 1977), Boog Powell (25 HR, 1963), and Curt Blefary
- (22 HR, 1965), per *Stats Perform*.

  Baltimore has not had a player fail to reach the 20 home run mark since 2001, when **Jay Gibbons** and **Chris Richard** each paced the club with 15 homers apiece...Only five teams in Orioles history (since 1954) have not had a player hit 20+ homers ('01, '74, '57, '55, '54).

**LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS**: **Dylan Beavers** has reached base safely in 26 of his first 33 career games August 16...His .383 on-base percentage ranks eighth in the AL during that time.

- $\theta$  His 24 walks are one behind **Glenn Gulliver** (25 BB, 1982) for the most in O's history (since 1954) through a player's first 33 career games...Gulliver also holds the record through 34 games with 26 free passes.  $\theta$ <sub>s</sub> He has reached base safely 49 times (25 H, 24 BB) to begin his career, becoming the
- fourth Oriole in franchise history to reach safely 49+ times through their first 33 career games along with **Billy Ripken** (56 TOB, 1987), **Curtis Goodwin** (54 TOB, 1995), and **Ryan Mountcastle** (51 TOB, 2020).
- Since making his debut, he's averaging 4.43 pitches per plate appearance, the fifth-highest mark in the majors among qualified hitters.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: Baltimore has used 70 different players this season to tie the major league record set by the 2024 Marlins and also matched by the 2025 Braves...The previous O's record was 62 in 2021.

- (b) The O's have used 41 different pitchers this year (including position players), second most in a season in franchise history (since 1954) behind the 2021 Orioles (42)...The AL record for most pitchers used in a season is 42, shared by the 2021 Orioles and 2019
- The Orioles have had 34 different position players appear in a game, the most by a major league team since 2022 (37, SF; 34, LAA, OAK, PIT) and tied for the most in a season in franchise history with 1955.
- The Orioles have had 23 players hit a home run for the team, breaking the team record (since 1954)...That's the most players to homer by one MLB team since the 2024 Giants (also 23).
- Baltimore has had 19 players steal a base, breaking the O's record.
- The Birds have used seven different players at catcher, setting the franchise record...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The 2022 Pirates are the last team to use eight.

YANKEE DOODLES: With last night's loss, Baltimore has lost a season series against the Yankees for the first time since 2022...After opening the year winning three of the first four games against New York, the Birds have dropped six of the last seven meetings between the

teams while being outscored by 31 runs since June 21. **Ryan Mountcastle** missed the series between the teams in the Bronx from June 20-22. He's hit safely in 12 consecutive games at Yankee Stadium, tied for the longest hitting streak by an Oriole on the road against the Yankees in team history (since 1954) with Gunnar Henderson (5/23/23-9/25/24).

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 30<sup>th</sup> career MLB start...Is the third-ever Japanese player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers **Shintaro Fujinami** (2023) and **Koji Uehara** (2009-11)...In his March 30 debut at Toronto, at 35 years, 170 days old, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since NYM's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia...Is the 10<sup>th</sup> Japanese-born rookie pitcher to record 10+ wins in a season (last: CHC's Shota Imanaga in 2024 - 15 W).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on September 20 vs. New York-AL after tossing 3.0 innings, permitting four runs on six hits (2 HR), one walk, and one hit batter with three strikeouts...Threw 87 pitches, 51 strikes.

Also allowed 1+ home run in a career-high five straight starts.

Base failed to throw 4.0 innings in three of his last four starts after doing so in 23 of his first 25 outings.

BATTLING THE EVIL EMPIRE: Set to make his fourth start against the Yankees, having gone 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER/11.2 IP)...Struck out a career-high-tying eight hitters (also 7/27 vs. COL) in his April 28 start opposite New York at Camden Yards.

Ob. NYY'S Aaron Judge has gone 6-for-7 with two homers, two walks, and one strikeout opposite Sugano, accounting for 33.3 percent of the hits (6-of-18) Yankee batters have tallied off him across three starts.

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY: Sugano is set to make his team-high 30<sup>th</sup> start of the season, one ahead of **Dean Kremer** (29 GS)...He will become the fifth Japanese-born pitcher (10<sup>th</sup> occurrence) to make 30+ starts at age 35 or older, joining SD's Yu Darvish (35 years old, 2022), SEA's Hisashi Iwakuma (35 years old, 2016), LAD's/NYY's Hiroki Kuroda (5x, 35-39 years old, 2010-14), and COL's Masato Yoshii (35 years old, COL).

(b) He has made five starts of 7.0+ innings, the most among all MLB rookies ahead of ATH's Jacob Lopez (4 GS).

- TAKING ON THE LEGENDS: From August 31-September 13, Sugano took on a trio of 200+ game winners in SF's Justin Verlander (265 W), LAD's Clayton Kershaw (222 W), and TOR's Max Scherzer (221 W).

  (b) According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last MLB starter to make three straight outings against opponents with 200+ career wins was WSH's Jason Bergmann, who faced Tom Glavine and made back-to-back start opposite Jamie Moyer from September 25, 2007-April 3, 2008.
- The last occurrence in a single season was FLA's Scott Olsen from September 8-24, 2006...Olsen faced both Glavine and Moyer twice during a four-start stretch during that period.

HOME RUN HOMEWORK: Sugano has permitted a total of 24 home runs from innings one through three, the most in MLB ahead of CHC's Shota Imanaga, STL's Miles Mikolas, WSH's Jake Irvin (all 20 HR).

Observed the 30 homers he has allowed overall, 21 have been solo shots and four have

- come with one runner on base...The 21 solo homers are tied for third most MLB behind CIN's Zack Littell (28 HR) and CHC's Shota Imanaga (25 HR). The 21 solo shots are the most allowed by an Orioles starter since **Gabriel Ynoa** (23 HR) in 2019.
- Sugano is the first Oriole to permit 30+ homers in a season since **John Means** (30 HR, 2019) and the first right-handed pitcher to do so since **Dylan Bundy** (41 HR, 2018). 0

TOP OF MIND: Opposing one-hole hitters are slashing .372/.424/.628 (29-for-78) with six home runs off Sugano...His 1.052 OPS allowed against one-hole hitters is tied for fourth highest in the majors (min. 75 BF) ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (1.156 OPS), COL's Germán Márquez (1.113 OPS), and MIN's Taj Bradley (1.110 OPS).

WALKING IT OUT: Prior to issuing a then career-high three walks on June 20 at New York-AL, Sugano had allowed two walks or fewer in each of his first 14 starts, the second-longest career-opening run by an Oriole starter in team history behind Josh Towers (23 GS, 2001-02).

(b) His 5.5 percent walk rate would signal the lowest mark by an Oriole rookie in franchise history (since 1954), outpacing José Bautista (6.2%, 1988) and Jeremy Guthrie (6.5%, 2007)...The 5.5 percent walk rate leads all MLB rookies (min. 100.0 IP), ahead of CHC's Cade Horton (6.9%).
