**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and Colorado Rockies play the third game of a four-game weekend series today at Busch Stadium as the Redbirds continue their seven-game, eight-day homestand ... The division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates visit St. Louis for three games beginning on Tuesday ... St. Louis scored four unanswered runs last night to come from behind and top the Rockies, 8-5, as **Dylan Carlson** drove in three and **Ryan Helsley** converted his MLB-leading 21st save of the season.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter today tied with Chicago and Cincinnati for 2nd place in the NL Central, 6.5 games behind Milwaukee and tied for the third Wild Card spot in the National League ... Since Mother's Day (May 12-present), the Cardinals sport MLB's 4th-best winning pct. (.652, 15-8).

**BEST 100-GAME FINISHES:** The Cardinals (30-32) have 100 games remaining in the regular season starting today ... Under the 162-game format (since 1962), the best 100-game finish by any Cardinals team that had a sub-.500 record after their first 62 games was done by the **1996 Redbirds**, who finished 59-41 over their final 100 games, and won the NL Central Division by 6.0 games with an 88-74 record in Tony LaRussa's 1st year as manager (lost to Atlanta in seven games in the NLCS).

- The 1996 Cardinals are the only team in franchise history to make the postseason after sporting a losing record through the first 62 games.
- No Major League team in the Expansion Era (1961-present) has ever reached 100+ wins after starting with sub-.500 record through the initial 62 games.
- The best final 100-game finish by any Major League team was the 2004 Atlanta Braves (30-32), who finished 66-34 and won the NL East by 10.0 games.
- The 2007 and 2009 Colorado Rockies each started 30-32 and made the postseason (chart left).

**TAP THE ROCKIES:** The Cardinals .742 home win pct. (46-16) vs. the Rockies is its best against any opponent since Busch III opened in 2006 ... St. Louis has defeated the Rockies in 20 of its last 24 home games (May 18, 2016-present) and is 37-9 (.804) at Busch Stadium III vs. the Rockies in their last 46 meetings since Sept. 30, 2010 ... The Cardinals have won the season series vs. the Rock Pile in 22 of 30 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993. **WILD, WILD WEST:** Since 2019 vs. the National League West, the Cardinals are 48-23 (.676) at Busch Stadium, but just 29-45 on the road.

**RISING PROSPECTS:** Three Cardinals minor leaguers appear on *Baseball America's* latest Top 100 Prospects update: RHP **Tink Hence** (No. 22), OF **Victor Scott II** (No. 95) and newcomer LHP **Quinn Mathews** (No. 98) ... The 21-year-old Hence made one of the biggest leaps, jumping 42 spots from his No. 64 ranking one month ago ... The 23-year-old Mathews was one of 12 additions to the Top 100 after posting a 2.26 ERA through his first 10 pro starts between Single-A Palm Beach and High-A Peoria.

**CLOSE CALLS:** Forty-four of the Cardinals 62 games (71%) have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with the Cubs for 2nd-most in MLB this season behind the Mets (45).

- St. Louis sports MLB's 2nd-lowest average margin of victory (2.50) ahead of only the Tampa Bay Rays (2.32).
- The Cardinals are 9-7 in one-run games, 7-8 in two-run games, and 8-5 in three-run games.

**GOLD-RUSH:** **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base safely in 24 consecutive games (May 11-present) tied for MLB's 4th-longest active on-base streak and one shy of the Cardinals mark for this season held by **Nolan Arenado** (25)

**Nolan Arenado** played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves...originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for **Austin Gomber**, **Elehuris Montero**, **Tony Loney**, **Mateo Gil** and **Jake Sommers**.

**Nolan Arenado's** cousin, **Josh Fuentes**, played three seasons with the Rockies (2019-21) and college baseball at Missouri Baptist University (2014) in St. Louis.

**Daniel Descalso** played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

**Kyle Leahy** was born in and resides in Boulder, Colo...graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School, where was selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

**Austin Gomber** pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year honors with **Alex Reyes** in 2015.

**Elehuris Montero** signed with St. Louis as an international free agent (Aug. 29, 2014)...played five minor leagues seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2015-19).

**Dakota Hudson** pitched six seasons and the 2019 Postseason (2018-23) with St. Louis, where he made his MLB debut...selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#34) of the 2016 MLB Draft.

**John Mozeliak** began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season...graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher...graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Rockies MLB.com **Thomas Harding** covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer **Anne Rogers**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Holliday** was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

**Daniel Bard** made 10 appearances for Springfield (AA) in 2017.

Rockies Special Assistant to the GM **Clint Hurdle** played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist **Benjamin Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from Boulder, Colo...attended Centaurus High School in Lafayette, Colo...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Rockies Communications Coordinator **Kevin Collins** previously served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Rockies Digital Comm. Manager **Nora Farrell** previously worked in communications and social media for St. Louis for part of seven seasons (2016-22).

Rockies VP Ticket Sales, Operations & Services **Sue Ann McClaren** worked 15 seasons (1978-92) in the Cardinals sales department before joining the Rockies in 1992.

- Logged 6.0+ innings pitched in each of his first seven starts to begin the season (April 1-May 6), longest by a Cardinal to begin a season since 2017 (**Mike Leake** - 11 & **Michael Wacha** - 7). Streak was snapped in his 5/22 start vs. BAL (4.0 IP).
- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in grounded into double plays (213). Has allowed 212 career home runs over that period for comparison.
- Posted career-highs for innings pitched (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month, most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed last off-season.
- Pitching for his fifth Major League team: Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Received a no decision at Minute Maid Park against the Astros in a 7-4 loss. Hurlled 5.2 innings allowing three runs on five hits before exiting with a 4-3 lead. Allowed a two-run home run to Yordán Alvarez in the 3rd inning after a walk to Mauricio Dubón pinch-hitting for an injured Kyle Tucker. Cardinals bullpen allowed four runs in the 8th inning for the loss.

- Durable starting pitcher has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has worked 150+ IP (minors/majors combined) in 10-straight (2013-23) professional seasons, excluding the COVID shortened 2020 season.
- Has posted a 3.24 ERA (25.0 IP) with **Willson Contreras** behind the plate, the 4th-lowest ERA of any of the 25 catchers he has pitched with in his career. **Pedro Pagés** on 5/28 was the 25th catcher of his career.
- Owns career marks of 108-102, one of 14 active pitchers with 100 or more wins. Ranks T-10th among active pitchers with 108 wins with **Wade Miley**, one behind **Carlos Carrasco** (109) for 9th.
- Has posted eight 10-win seasons since his MLB debut in 2013, tied for 4th-most among over that period trailing only **Max Scherzer** (10), **Gerrit Cole** (9) & **Clayton Kershaw** (9).
- Is one of four pitchers since 2014 to record 100 or more strikeouts in 9-of-10 seasons with **Jacob deGrom**, **Clayton Kershaw** and **Max Scherzer**.

**2024**

- Became the 9th active pitcher with 300 or more games started on April 30 [1] at Detroit. **Justin Verlander** leads the active list with 517.
- Pitched four straight quality starts (4/19-5/11), tied with **Sonny Gray** for the longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Jordan Montgomery** ran off five straight (6/9-7/2/2023).
- Posted his career-highs for innings (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
