TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to get back in the win column and even the series with a victory tonight in West Sacramento.

- ▶ SF took the first two games of its four-game series vs. the Dodgers by a combined score of 15-5 to open the week before dropping each of its last three games by a combined score of 4-14.
- ▶ The Giants are now 8-22 (.267) when allowing the game's first run...their 30 total games of allowing the first run are most in MLB (no other team has more than 27 such games).

ROSTER MOVES: SF made the following roster moves today.

- ▶ **OF Will Brennan** (#7) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP Tristan Beck** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **OF Heliot Ramos** placed on the 10-day IL with a right quad strain.
- ▶ **LHP Erik Miller** (#68) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List.

TODAY'S STARTER: **RHP Trevor McDonald** will make his third start of the season...he allowed three runs while striking out four across 5.1 innings at LAD last Monday.

- ▶ This is McDonald's seventh career MLB game (fifth start) dating back to the last game of the 2024 season...he is 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (7er, 30.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.96 WHIP.
- ▶ McDonald's 1.78 ERA (5er, 25.1ip) in his first four career starts is the best ERA for a Giants starter over their first four career starts (non-openers) since **Ty Blach** had a 1.57 ERA (4er, 23.0ip) in his first four starts (2016-2017)...the last SF righty to have a better ERA over their first four career starts was in 1960 with **Juan Marichal** (1.56 ERA, 6er, 34.2ip).
- ▶ The righty's most-used pitch is his sinker (54.9% usage rate) followed by his slider (31.3%)...both pitches have +2 run values per *Baseball Savant*...the A's have a .752 OPS vs. sinkers this season (22nd in MLB) and a .748 OPS vs. sliders (fourth in MLB).
- ▶ McDonald has pitched 20 games (16 starts) at Sutter Health Park with the River Cats, going 5-6 with a 4.87 ERA (51er, 94.1ip).

SAC-TOWN: The Giants are 5-2 vs. the A's since the start of last season, including a 2-2 mark at Sutter Health Park...since the start of the 2022 season, SF is 12-7 vs. the A's, outscoring them 75-56 (+19) over that span.

- ▶ SF is just 1-9 (.100) in interleague games in 2026, which is the lowest winning percentage in interleague games this season...to date, the Giants have faced the Yankees (0-3), the Orioles (1-2), the Rays (0-3) and the Athletics (0-1) from the American League.
- ▶ Dating back to the start of last season, SF is 25-33 (.431) vs. AL opponents.

LOOK AT LUIS: **IF Luis Arraez** hit his first homer as a Giant yesterday as part of a four-hit game...since the start of the 2019 season, Arraez' 102 games of three or more hits are most in the Majors (next closest is Freddie Freeman with 98 such games).

- ▶ Arraez's 53 hits through his first 42 games this season are the most by a Giant in their first 42 games of a season since **Thairo Estrada** had 53 in 42 games to start the 2023 season.
- ▶ His 53 hits in his first 42 games with the Giants are the most in a player's first 42 games with SF since **Marco Scutaro** had 56 hits after being acquired at the 2012 trade deadline.

HOMER HAPPY: With homers by both **IF Luis Arraez** and **OF Harrison Bader** last night, SF has homered at least once in 10 of its last 11 games.

- ▶ In this 11-game span, SF has 17 doubles, 14 homers and 43 runs scored (3.91 runs per game) with nine different Giants logging a homer.
- ▶ The Giants have six homers this season out of the ninth spot in their batting order (including four over this 11-game span)...the six homers by the ninth spot are tied with Toronto for second-most in MLB behind only Atlanta (eight homers).

DAN THE MAN: Rookie **C Daniel Susac** returned from the IL (right elbow ulnar neuritis) yesterday in time to start in front of his hometown fans (from nearby Roseville) and the team that originally drafted him back in 2022.

- ▶ Yesterday, Susac threw out A's outfielder Henry Bolte trying to steal second base in the 4th inning with a throw that registered at 84.7 mph.
- ▶ It was the hardest-thrown catcher's assist by a Giant since **C Patrick Bailey** (85.4 mph) on a stolen base attempt vs. TEX on August 13, 2023, and ranks as the third hardest-thrown caught stealing assist by an SF catcher in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) behind the Bailey throw and an assist by **C Joey Bart** (85.8 mph) on April 12, 2023 vs. LAD.

The Giants defeated the A's 9-1 at Oracle Park behind a three-homer game by **Wilmer Flores**...Flores became the fourth in franchise history to hit 3+ homers with 8+ RBI in a game, joining **Joc Pederson** (May 24, 2022), **Willie Mays** (April 30, 1961) and **George Kelly** (June 14, 1924).

TREVOR McDONALD RHP #72

2026 RECORD: 1-0, 2.92 ERA

T-MAC: Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...was originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

LAST TIME OUT: Took RHP Logan Webb's spot in the rotation (1L) and started the series opener in Los Angeles on Monday night...took a no-decision after allowing three runs on nine hits in 5.1 innings...he struck out four and walked two in the 101-pitch effort...SF went on to open up the game late in a 9-3 win.

THERE AND BACK: Despite his solid outing on May 4 vs. San Diego he was optioned back to Triple-A the next day so he could remain stretched out as a starter in case a need arose...the need arose rather quickly with RHP Logan Webb hitting the IL retroactive to May 6 with right knee bursitis...McDonald was recalled to take Webb's spot in the rotation.

VS. THE ATHLETICS: Has not faced the A's in his brief MLB career.

THAT'S A KAWINKIDINK: Despite never facing the A's he does have extensive experience pitching here at Sutter Health Park in Sacramento as a member of the River Cats in each of the last three seasons dating to 2024...in 20 career games here (16 starts) he owns a 4.87 ERA (51er, 94.1ip) with a 1.37 WHIP.

IN TRIPLE-A IN 2026: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (9er, 15.0ip), 12 strikeouts and a 1.53 WHIP in five Triple-A games (four starts) for Sacramento...was much better at home (1-0 with a 2.79 ERA in three games) compared to on the road (0-1 with a 10.13 ERA in two games).

LAST SEASON IN TRIPLE-A: Spent the majority of the 2025 season pitching for Triple-A Sacramento, going 9-9 with a 5.31 ERA (84er, 142.1ip), 144 strikeouts and a 1.45 WHIP over 29 games (24 starts) in the hitter-friendly PCL.

IN THE MAJORS: When his number has been called at the Major League level he's been incredibly effective...he made his MLB debut on the last day of the season in 2024, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...in three games (two starts) last year he went 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (3er, 15.0ip) with SF winning both of his starts...in his brief MLB career thus far he owns a 2.08 ERA (7er, 30.1ip) with 27 strikeouts in six games (four starts).

A MEMORABLE OUTING: In his second career MLB start (September 26, 2025 vs. Colorado) he earned his first career win and recorded the first double digit strikeout (10) game of his career while allowing three unearned runs in 7.0 innings...became one of five Giants in the SF era to have a 10+ strikeout game in career game four or fewer, joining Kyle Harrison (2023), Tim Lincecum (2007), Shawn Estes (1996) and Juan Marichal (1960).

GROUNDING: Albeit a small sample size, McDonald posted a 54.5% groundball rate in 2025...in his two starts this year he's logged a 68.6% groundball rate...for comparison's sake, PHI's Christopher Sánchez currently leads all qualified starters with a 59.1% groundball rate.

SLIDE OVER: His slider was his most-used pitch in the Majors last season (50.5% usage rate), with a .125 opposing batting average (4x32), a 36.4% whiff rate and a +4 run value while accounting for 12 of his 14 strikeouts...through two starts w/ SF this year, McDonald has worked off his sinker (54.9% usage rate) while using his slider 31.3% of the time (his most used secondary pitch)...hitters are 0-for-11 with five strikeouts in ABs that end with his slider in 2026.

ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

2026 RECORD: 1-4, 5.79 ERA

▶ Earned his first win as a Giant, turning in a solid performance against the Dodgers...pitched 5.2 innings, allowing just three hits and two earned runs while striking out four.

▶ Will be Houser's third career start against the A's, and first since June 9, 2023 as a member of the Brewers...in those two starts, he's 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA over 9.0 innings pitched

▶ Over his last two starts, holds an ERA of 2.31 with a 0.86 WHIP over 11.2 IP compared to a 7.12 ERA with a 1.71 WHIP in 30.1 IP over his first six starts.

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP *(bohr-RUCK-ee)*

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/15 at ATH; 1.0ip, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has now allowed a run over his last three games (4.1ip).
- ▶ Has allowed runs in seven of his 17 appearances (4.41 ERA)... however, he's 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip) in his last 11 games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-33 (.152) with four walks and nine strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (72-for-402) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-28 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP *(BROO-baker)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/14 at LAD; 1.0ip, bb, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ In his last six outings, he has a 5.40 ERA (5er, 8.1ip) and .313 BAA (10x32)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has thrown 10.1 scoreless innings in eight appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in nine of 15 contests (5.49 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-44 (.295) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-28 (.250).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/14 at LAD; 0.1ip, 2h, r, er, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered four runs (three ER) in 18.1ip this year (1.47 ERA).
- ▶ His 1.47 ERA is tied for the 10th-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-23 (.087) against him this season, and 19-for-106 in his career (.179).
- ▶ His 25.5% hard hit rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB.
- ▶ Has issued 11 BBs in 18.1ip...his 14.7 walk rate is in the bottom 9%.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP *(HENT-chiss)*

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/15 at ATH; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has made three appearances with SF, logging 2.1-scoreless innings with three walks and three strikeouts.
- ▶ This is his first MLB action since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP *(kill-EE-en)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; SV, 1.1ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Earned second career save on Tuesday night.
- ▶ His 1.40 ERA (3er, 19.1ip) is 8th-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Owns a 24.1% strikeout rate and .138 BAA (9x65) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.59 BB/9ip...his 15.2% BB rate ranks in the bottom 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-39 (.128) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-26 (.154) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 4/30 (G1) at PHI; 1.0ip, k (19 pitches)

- ▶ Activated today after missing the last 14 games out with a low back strain...pitched in two rehab games (May 10 and 13), striking out three over 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Had not allowed a run in his last eight appearances prior to injury dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (8.1ip, 2h, 0r, 0er, 4bb, 13k).
- ▶ Lefties are 4-for-18 (.222) off him with one double.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 56.2 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the second-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP *(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/13 at LAD; 1.1ip, bb (12 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 5.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in five games so far.
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-12 with a single off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 51.5% of the time...he threw it 34.3% of the time in his stint w/SF last season.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/11 at LAD; H; 1.0ip, h, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with nine holds, which is tied for the fourth-most in the Majors.
- ▶ 15 of his 19 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 9-for-61 (.148) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 5-for-36 (.139) with 13 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 84.8 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 5% of the league while his 25.5% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 3%.
- ▶ His 1.66 xERA is third-best in the Majors behind Mason Miller (0.82) and Dylan Lee (1.46).
