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PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-28) vs. NEW YORK METS (27-15)

May 13, 2025 - Citi Field - Queens, NY - 7:10 EDT - Game #43/Road #21

RHP Mitch Keller (1-4, 4.40 ERA) vs. RHP Kodai Senga (4-2, 1.16 ERA)

THE PIRATES: opened their six-game, seven-day road trip with a 4-3, walkoff loss against the Mets last night...Promoted Don Kelly from bench coach to manager on Thursday after relieving Derek Shelton of his duties...Are in the 17th game of a stretch of 34 straight games against National League opponents (April 25-June 1)...Are also in the fifth game of a stretch of nine consecutive games against the National League East (have gone 6-6 against the division so far this season).

NEW YORK STATE OF MIND: Isiah Kiner-Falefa connected for his first home run of the season in his first at-bat on Monday against the Mets...It was his first home run since August 17, 2024 vs. Seattle (off Luis Castillo) and the first of his career against the Mets... He has hit safely in seven of his nine career games against the Mets, going 10-for-27 (.370) with two doubles and a home run.

THE ARMS RACE: Earlier today, Paul Skenes was announced as a member of Team USA's roster for next year's World Baseball Classic by manager Mark DeRosa...Since making his Major League debut on May 11, 2024, the 22-year-old Skenes ranks first in all of MLB in ERA (2.16), second in batting average against (.199) and fourth in WHIP (0.96)...Skenes also has 223 strikeouts through the first 32 starts of his career, tied with the Mets' Kodai Senga for the 10th-most by any MLB pitcher through his first 32 games.

SETTING THE TONE: Over their last seven games (since May 5 at St. Louis), Pirates starting pitchers have posted a 2.23 ERA (40.1ip/10er), the fifth-lowest mark in Major League Baseball (the Mets rank sixth with a 2.50 ERA)...Pittsburgh starters have pitched 5.2-plus innings in six consecutive games, the longest-such streak since doing that in eight straight from April 3-11, 2024.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Mitch Keller will start tonight for Pittsburgh in the middle game of this three-game series against the Mets...He enters tonight with 722 career punchouts, tied with Francisco Liriano for 20th-most in Pirates history (Gerrit Cole is 19th on the list with 734 strikeouts)...In four career starts vs. the Mets, Keller has a 2.00 ERA (27.0ip/6er) and four quality starts.

LOCK IN, KE': Ke'Bryan Hayes went 1-for-4 on Monday night against the Mets at Citi Field and has now hit safely in 18 of his last 21 games (since April 19 vs. Cleveland)... During that stretch, Hayes has gone 25-for-83 (.301) with two doubles, seven RBI and seven multi-hit games...Hayes' .301 average in that span ranks sixth in the National League and 14th in all of Major League Baseball among those with at least 80 at-bats.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH: Andrew McCutchen enters tonight's game three hits shy of 1700 as a member of the Pirates...He is also 12 hits away from tying Arky Vaughan (1709) for ninth place on Pittsburgh's all-time hits list...McCutchen is third among all active players with 2182 hits, behind Freddie Freeman (2308) and Jose Altuve (2272).

CLOSE CALLS: The Pirates have played in four consecutive one-run games for the second time this season (also from March 27-30, first four games of season)... Pittsburgh has played in 16 one-run games so far this season (7-9 record), which are third-most in all of Major League Baseball, behind only the Braves (18) and Mets (17).

PIRATING: Pittsburgh enters today with 46 stolen bases, fifth-most in all of Major League Baseball, behind Milwaukee (54), Chicago-NL (50), Cincinnati (47) and Tampa Bay (47)...Since the start of last season, Pittsburgh's 84.0 stolen base percentage (152-for-181) is tops in MLB (Los Angeles-NL, 83.8, ranks second).

PHAM-TASTIC: Tommy Pham has a .339 average (39-for-115) and .437 on-base percentage in 35 career games against the Mets...According to OptaStats, those are his best marks against any Major League team...His .539 slugging percentage against New York is his second-best against any opponent, behind only San Diego (.556)...Pham, who played 79 games with the Mets in 2023, has a .331 average (56-for-169) with nine doubles, 10 home runs and 27 RBI in 55 games played here at Citi Field...As a visitor in Queens, Pham is 23-for-61 (.377) with six extra-base hits and 10 RBI over 17 games.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 13, 2024: Bryan Reynolds posted the first five-hit game of his career as Pittsburgh defeated Milwaukee, 8-6, at American Family Field. Reynolds hit two doubles and a solo home run while also driving in two runs. Mitch Keller earned the win after striking out seven Brewers over his 6.0 scoreless innings of work. David Bednar secured his eighth save with a perfect ninth inning.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the second round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 29-year-old Keller is in his seventh Major League season...He signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 23, 2024... He earned Opening Day honors in both 2023 and 2024, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16... He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed three runs on seven hits and three walks (six strikeouts) over 6.0 innings, losing a 5-0 decision on May 7 at St. Louis...He’s lost four consecutive decisions since earning a win in his season debut on March 28 at Miami... Since pitching 7.0 scoreless innings (three hits, nine strikeouts) last August 20 at Texas, Keller has lost nine of 10 decisions (including a five-game losing streak to end 2024).

AGAINST THE METS: Keller is 3-1 with a 2.00 ERA (27.0ip/6er) in four career starts vs. the Mets...His last start against New York came last July 8 at PNC Park, when he allowed just two runs in 8.0 innings while winning an 8-2 decision...His lone start at Citi Field came on September 16, 2022, when he pitched 6.0 innings in a 4-3 loss.

SUPPORT SYSTEM: The Pirates have scored one or zero runs while Keller was in the game in five of his eight starts this season, including scoring zero in his last outing on May 7 at Busch Stadium...His 2.40 average run support is the ninth-lowest among qualified Major League starters (teammate Andrew Heaney, 2.36, is seventh-lowest).

THE 700 CLUB: With his strikeout of St. Louis’ Pedro Pagés in the seventh inning of his start on April 9, Keller notched his 700th career strikeout...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the fastest pitcher in club history to reach 700 strikeouts with Pittsburgh by innings (718.1)...The previous record was held by Bob Veale (740.0 innings)...Per Elias, he also became the third-fastest pitcher in team history to reach the 700-strikeout mark with Pittsburgh by games (136), behind only Gerrit Cole (126) and Veale (135).

KEEPING IT 100: Heading into the 2024 All-Star break, Keller was 10-5 with 105 strikeouts in 114.1 innings pitched...He became the fourth pitcher in club history to have 10-plus wins, 100-plus strikeouts and 100.0-plus innings pitched prior to the All-Star break, along with Gerrit Cole in 2015, Bob Veale in 1966 and Bob Friend in 1960.

AS A PIRATE: The Pirates selected Keller in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa...He was rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh’s No. 1 prospect in each season from 2018-20...He was also recognized by the same publication as a top-100 prospect in the game from 2017-20.
