**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles continue a six-game, seven-day homestand this evening against the Pirates, having taken two of three over the weekend from the NL West-leading Dodgers... Tonight kicks off a stretch of 13 games in 13 days for the Birds, who, following the current three-game series, will travel to face the Blue Jays (9/12-14) and White Sox (9/15-17) for three-game sets before returning to Camden Yards to face the Yankees (9/18-21) for four games.

Despite dropping the final game of the series to Los Angeles-NL, Baltimore is 47-41 (.534) since May 30, the fifth-best winning percentage in the AL behind Toronto (54-33, .621), Boston (53-34, .609), and Houston/Texas (both 48-40, .545).

After Tomoyuki Sugano left Sunday's game in the third inning due to right foot discomfort, Baltimore's bullpen combined to throw 6.0 innings of one-run ball...Over the past six games, O's relievers have posted a 1.26 ERA (4 ER/28.2 IP) while limiting the opposition to a .172 (17-for-99) average.

The Birds have swiped 15 bags in 18 chances (83.3%) since August 22, tied for the third-most steals in MLB during that stretch behind the Mets (29 SB) and Twins (27 SB).

O's batters have struck out 10+ times in a franchise-record-tying eight straight games, joining an eight-game run from April 3-11, 2021...It is the longest streak by any MLB club since the 2024 Tigers struck out 10+ times in 12 consecutive games from September 15-28.

**WALK THE PLANK:** The Orioles are 6-0-0 (1.000) against the Pirates all-time at Camden Yards, the best home series record by any active MLB franchise against a single opponent, per *Stats Perform*...It is tied for the third-longest series win streak at Camden Yards against a single team behind an 11-series run against the Yankees (2014-2017) and nine straight against the Twins (1997-2002).

**THE RIGHT ANSWERS:** Gunnar Henderson (.302 AVG, .515 SLG) is one of three MLB players who have a .300+ batting average and .500+ slugging percentage against right-handed pitchers this season (min. 300 AB), joining NYY's Aaron Judge (.318 AVG, .631 SLG) and TOR's George Springer (.319 AVG, .563 SLG)...The last Oriole to complete the feat during the course of a full season was Chris Davis in 2013 (.316 AVG, .728 SLG).

Jackson Holliday owns a .452 on-base percentage against right-handed pitchers since August 17, the fifth-highest mark in MLB (min. 60 PA) behind NYM's Juan Soto (.515 OBP), TOR's Bo Bichette (.493 OBP), CWS' Kyle Teel (.465 OBP), and CHC's Ian Happ (.455 OBP).

**HOLIDAY SEASON:** Jackson Holliday paces the Birds with 17 home runs, one ahead of Gunnar Henderson (16 HR)...The only Oriole under 22 years old to finish the season leading the club in homers is Eddie Murray (27 HR, 1977).

Holliday's 17 long balls are fifth-most by an Oriole in their age-21 season or younger (as of age of July 1 of season) in franchise history (since 1954), per *Stats Perform*, trailing Cal Ripken, Jr. (28 HR, 1982), Eddie Murray (27 HR, 1977), Boog Powell (25 HR, 1963), and Curt Blefary (22 HR, 1965).

He has seven multi-walk performances in 24 games since August 10, tied for the MLB lead with NYY's Aaron Judge, NYM's Juan Soto, and LAA's Mike Trout/Taylor Ward...Prior to August 10, Holliday had two multi-walk performances in 169 career games.

**ACTION JACKSON:** Since making his MLB debut on August 1, Jeremiah Jackson is slashing .305/.333/.492 (36-for-118) with six doubles, two triples, four home runs, 15 runs, and 17 RBI across 32 games, ranking among all qualified MLB rookies during that stretch in hits (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), triples (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), total bases (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 58), extra-base hits (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 12), RBI (T-7<sup>th</sup>), batting average (8<sup>th</sup>), and slugging percentage (T-9<sup>th</sup>).

Jackson has 35 hits through his first 29 career starts, becoming the sixth Oriole in team history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat along with Curtis Goodwin (40 H, 1995), Bob Hale (40 H, 1955), Billy Ripken (38 H, 1987), Hyun Soo Kim (36 H, 2016), and Chito Martínez (36 H, 1991).

His 55 total bases through 29 starts are tied with Don Baylor (1970-72) for fourth most in club history (since 1954) behind Trey Mancini (69 TB, 2016-17), Chito Martínez (66 TB, 1991), and Jim Traber (60 TB, 1984-86).

**LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS:** Dylan Beavers has reached base safely in 15 of his first 18 career games since debuting on August 16, slashing .291/.426/.418 (16-for-55) with four doubles, one homer, 10 runs scored, six RBI, 13 walks, and one stolen base.

He has reached base safely 29 times to begin his career, fifth most in franchise history (since 1954) through an O's first 18 games behind Ryan Mountcastle (31 TOB, 2020), Curtis Goodwin (31 TOB, 1995), Billy Ripken (30 TOB, 1987), and Don Baylor (30 TOB, 1970).

He is the second Oriole to draw 13+ walks in his first 18 career games, joining Glenn Gulliver (16 BB, 1982)...Since making his MLB debut on August 16, his 13 walks are third most by all MLB rookies behind ATH's Nick Kurtz (19 BB) and TB's Hunter Feduccia (14 BB).

**NIP AND TUCK:** Since August 10, 10 of Baltimore's 15 home games have been decided by one run, with the O's going 4-6 in those contests...Overall, the O's have won each of their last three one-run games, their second-longest streak of the season behind a five-game run from May 24 (G2)-June 5.

Following the All-Star break, Baltimore has played an MLB-high 22 one-run affairs (10-12), ahead of Chicago-NL, Cleveland, Seattle (all 17 G)...The Birds opened the year playing 22 one-run games (12-10), tied for second fewest in MLB ahead of the Tigers (21 G).

The O's 10 one-run wins since the All-Star break are second most in the majors behind the Guardians (11 W).

**IT TAKES A VILLAGE:** Baltimore has used a franchise record 67 players this season, surpassing the previous team record held by the 2021 Orioles (62 players)...The 67 players used are tied for the MLB lead along with the Braves.

Samuel Basallo became the 23<sup>rd</sup> different player to homer for the team this season, breaking the franchise record (since 1954) previously shared by the 2018 and 2012 Orioles...The current number leads the majors this season and is the most by an MLB club since the 2024 Giants (also 23).

Dylan Beavers became the 19<sup>th</sup> Oriole to swipe a base this year, marking the most players to steal 1+ base in team history, surpassing the previous record of 17 shared by the 2018, 2001, 1990, 1988, and 1955 Orioles.

Samuel Basallo became the seventh player to appear at catcher for Baltimore this year, setting the franchise record...The previous record of six was shared by the 1986, 1962, and 1960 O's...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The last to use eight were the 2022 Pirates.

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his third start of the season tonight...Made six rehab appearances between Triple-A Norfolk (4 GS), Double-A Chesapeake (1 GS), and High-A Aberdeen (1 GS), going 1-0 with a 4.91 ERA (12 ER/22.0 IP) and 25 strikeouts... Opened the 2024 campaign on the 15-day Injured List with a right UCL sprain...Was reinstated on May 2 and made eight starts before his June 15 placement on the 15-day Injured List (right ulnar collateral ligament sprain)...Underwent right elbow UCL reconstruction (Tommy John) with internal brace performed by Dr. Keith Meister in Arlington, Texas on June 19, ending his season...Was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 11.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bradish allowed two runs on four hits and two walks with five strikeouts on September 1 at San Diego...Surrendered both runs in the second inning after issuing consecutive walks to start the inning...Following back-to-back RBI singles by Bryce Johnson and Luis Arraez, retired the final seven batters of the game with three strikeouts...Threw a season-high 84 pitches, 51 strikes.

**SEASON DEBUT:** He made his first start in 438 days on August 26 vs. Boston, taking an MLB mound for the first time since June 14, 2024 vs. Philadelphia...He suffered the loss after allowing two runs on four hits (2 HR) with no walks and 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Trevor Story (2<sup>nd</sup> inning) and David Hamilton (3<sup>rd</sup> inning) both hit solo homers... Threw 81 pitches, 51 strikes.

📌 Generated 16 swings and misses, tied for the fourth most of his career and his most in a game since setting a career high with 18 on September 20, 2023 at Houston.

📌 Fanned 10+ batters for the fifth time in his career, (last: 11 K, 5/26/24 at CWS).

📌 Became the fifth Oriole (since 1954) to strike out at least 10 batters in his season debut, joining **Corbin Burnes** (11 K, 3/28/24 vs. LAA), **Sidney Ponson** (10 K, 4/4/01 vs. BOS), **Mike Mussina** (11 K, 3/31/98 vs. KC), and **Dave McNally** (13 K, 4/7/70 at CLE).

**A PIRATE'S LIFE:** Bradish is making his second career start against Pittsburgh...In his lone start, allowed one unearned run on three hits and a walk with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings on May 12, 2023 at Oriole Park...Threw 89 pitches, 61 strikes.

📌 **Cedric Mullins** hit for the cycle for the Orioles in that game.

**ACE UP THE SLEEVE:** Bradish has a 2.85 ERA (69 ER/218.0 IP) in 40 starts since the beginning of 2023...Among starting pitchers during that time, he has the sixth-lowest ERA in the majors (min. 200.0 IP) behind PIT's Paul Skenes (1.97 ERA), DET's Tarik Skubal (2.35 ERA), LAD's Blake Snell (2.65 ERA), SD's Michael King (2.75 ERA), and LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (2.82 ERA).

**HOME COOKING:** In 30 career home starts, Bradish's 3.666 ERA (66 ER/162.0 IP) is the second lowest by any MLB pitcher in the history of Camden Yards (min. 30 GS), edging out **Kevin Gausman** (3.671 ERA/64 GS) and **Mike Mussina** (3.675/157 GS) by percentage points...The only pitcher with a lower career ERA at Camden Yards is **David Wells** (3.43 ERA/32 GS).

**SINK OR SWIM:** Since the beginning of 2023, Bradish has used his sinker 26.7 percent of the time while holding opponents to a .199 average (47-for-236) with six home runs.  
 📌 He's held opponents to .111 (2-for-18) against the sinker this season, but one of those hits is a home run (David Hamilton, 8/26 vs. BOS).

**A LOOK BACK:** On May 24, 2024 at Chicago-AL, Bradish tossed 7.0 no-hit innings with four walks and a career-high 11 strikeouts...After allowing five runs in 2.2 innings in his next start on June 1 vs. Tampa Bay, he tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on one hit with no walks and nine strikeouts on June 8 at Tampa Bay.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** In 2023, finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, the first Oriole to receive a Cy Young vote since **Zack Britton** in 2016...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 QS)...Became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since **Mike Mussina** posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0IP) in 1992.

📌 In 2022, made his MLB debut on April 29 vs. Boston (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K).

📌 Earned his first career win on May 10 at St. Louis after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts...Became the first Oriole to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since **John Means** threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Was only the second pitcher in MLB history to have an outing with 11+ strikeouts and no walks in one of his first three career starts, joining WSH's Stephen Strasburg on June 8, 2010 vs. Pittsburgh (14 K).
