THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

JULY 17

2017 - For the first time in club history an Astro is named the All-Star Game MVP, with the award going to **3B Alex Bregman**, who homered to lead off the 10th inning in the AL's 8-6 victory...**CF George Springer** followed Bregman with a homer of his own, as the two became the first pair of teammates to hit back-to-back homers in an All-Star Game since 1975.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will open the second half of play tonight at Daikin Park as they welcome in the Orioles for a three-game series...**RHP Peter Lambert** (8-5), the Astros most consistent starter of the first half, will get the start for Houston opposite **RHP Dean Kremer** (1-2) and the Orioles.

RIDING THE LAMBO: **RHP Peter Lambert**, who was a minor league free agent signing this offseason, leads the club in wins and among AL pitchers ranks third in opponent average (.201) and eighth in ERA (min. 85IP)...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 K's in 23 starts.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 27-20 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

JP'S NIGHT: **SS Jeremy Peña** will host little leaguers from East End Little League today for July's Peña's Pals, which is a program that celebrates kids and their development in academics, character building and making healthy choices... additionally, 10,000 fans in attendance will receive a **Jeremy Peña Short Sleeve 90s Hoodie Jersey**, presented by Sire Spirits, as tonight's giveaway.

THIS WEEKEND'S TELECASTS: All three games of this series will be televised by Space City Home Network with **Todd Kalas**, **Geoff Blum** and **Lauren Callender** on the call...sideline reporter **Julia Morales** will rejoin the broadcast next week.

GET 'EM EARLY: The Astros rank first in the AL and second in MLB in 1st-inning runs with 60...overall, the Astros rank fifth in the AL in runs (428) immediately behind tonight's opponent, the Orioles (432).

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Astros rank third in the AL in fielding pct. (.988) and their 42 errors are the second-fewest in the AL...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in his 94 games played at 1B...dating back to last season, Walker has not made an error in his last 122 games at 1B (last error was Aug. 23, 2025 at BAL).

THE 2027 SCHEDULE: The 2027 regular season schedule was announced by Major League Baseball yesterday, which revealed Astros Opening Day as Thursday, March 25 vs. TEX...the Astros schedule is also highlighted by weekend series against the Yankees (April 23-25), Cubs (May 14-16), Mariners (June 25-27), Padres (July 30-Aug. 1), Phillies (Sept. 17-19), and others.

WEDNESDAY'S TRADE: Announced on Wednesday, the Astros traded **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.**, **LHP Colton Gordon**, and cash considerations to the Brewers in exchange for prospect **OF Jady N Fielder**...McCullers leaves behind a legacy as one of the most-accomplished postseason pitchers in Astros history, making 19 postseason appearances (12 starts) and posting a 3.47 ERA (28ER/72.2IP) en route to two World Series championships.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have selected **OF Lucas Spence** (#28) to the Major League roster and have reinstated **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** from the 15-day IL...additionally, **OF Brice Matthews** has been placed on the 10-day IL with a left knee sprain.

ON THE MEND: The Astros have seven players on the Major League Injured List...updates on a few:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) has made five rehab appearances, last starting on July 12 vs. ABQ (0ER/4.1IP), in which he tossed 68 pitches.
- **RHP Mike Burrows** (rt. elbow neuritis) has reported to West Palm Beach to begin a throwing progression.
- **LHP Bennett Sousa** (lt. elbow inflammation) made two rehab appearances for the FCL Astros over the All-Star break, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning in each outing...he last pitched on Wednesday (16 pitches).
- **OF Brice Matthews** (lt. knee sprain) is currently participating in light baseball activities in Houston.
- **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) is scheduled to pitch at Triple A tonight...he has made three rehab appearances so far, last pitching for Triple A Sugar Land on July 11 vs. ABQ (1ER/4.2IP)...he fanned seven in the outing on a season-high 61 pitches.

ALL-STAR ALVAREZ: **DH Yordan Alvarez** started and hit second for the AL in this week's All-Star Game, going 1x2 with a single and a run scored... this marked the fourth All-Star selection for Alvarez (2022-24, 2026) and the second time that he was voted as a starter (also in 2024).

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is a strong MVP candidate, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.059), OBP (.426), SLG (.633), and total bases (221)...additionally, he ranks first in the AL in HR (31), first in RBI (70), first in XBH (48), tied for first in hits (111), second in batting average (.318), second in runs (65), and fourth in walks (63).

WHAT A HALF!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit 31 homers prior to the break, which are the most in a first half in club history, topping **OF Lance Berkman**, who hit 29 homers in the first half of the 2002 season... Alvarez is on pace to hit 51 homers on the season, which would represent a new franchise record, topping the 47 homers hit by **1B Jeff Bagwell** in 2000.

TAP FOR SUCCESS: Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 70 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (61%)...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 15-of-21 challenges (71%), ranking second in the Majors in challenges won...**3B Isaac Paredes** (11-for-12) has been the most efficient regular challenger for the team and was successful in his first 11 challenges on the season.

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 3-1 with 10 saves (in 10 chances), has a 1.17 ERA (2ER/15.1IP), 25 strikeouts in 15.1 innings, a .115 (6x52) opponent average, and a 0.91 WHIP in 17 appearances...he has not allowed a hit in 13 of his 17 appearances.

THE 2026 FUTURES GAME: The Astros top two prospects, **OF Kevin Alvarez** and **IF Xavier Neyens**, represented the club in the All-Star Futures Game, which was played last weekend in Philadelphia... both prospects, which played the first half of the season for Class A Fayetteville, are considered top 100 prospects per MiLB.com, with Alvarez ranking 69th and Neyens 87th overall.

LAST START, JULY 11 at TEX: Allowed 1 run on 3 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...marked his 6th quality start of the season, which is tied for the team lead with **RHP Spencer Arrighetti**.

THE LAMBO: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has become a stabilizing force in the Astros rotation since making his season debut in mid-April...has recorded a quality start in 6 of his 15 outings, including 2 scoreless outings...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 7 of his 15 starts...among AL pitchers with 80.0+ innings pitched this season, Lambert ranks 2nd in H/9IP (6.59) and 3rd in opponent batting average (.201)...began the year at Triple A Sugar Land before being added to the Major League roster on April 17.

VS. BAL: In lone start vs. the Orioles, he allowed 2 runs on 2 hits and 3 walks with 3 strikeouts in 4.1 innings...this start occurred in Game 1 of a doubleheader earlier this season on April 30 at Camden Yards.

STREAK SNAPPED: Had his career-long 4-game winning streak snapped on June 29 vs. MIN, spanning 6 starts from May 24-June 23...within the streak, he's posted a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...the streak ties as the longest by an Astro this season, also reached by **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (April 15-May 2).

HIGH FIVE: Has worked 5.0+ innings in 11 of his last 12 starts (since May 5) and 13 of his 15 starts this season...worked 5.0+ innings in a career-best 8 consecutive starts from May 5-June 17, surpassing a 6-game streak from Aug. 12-Sept. 10, 2023.

SLIDER COMBO: Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .182 average on the pitch (8x44)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO': Logged the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **RHP Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/12 at TEX): Allowed 1 run on 1 hit and 1 walk with 2 strikeouts in 1.0 inning on Sunday at TEX.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.91 ERA (7ER/21.2IP) with 24 strikeouts, a 1.20 WHIP and a .205 opponent batting average in his last 23 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (14-game streak).

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has recorded 351 career relief appearances with the Astros...recorded his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history...now trails RHP Brad Lidge (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (488) and 10th in IP (360.2).
