**HELLO FRIDAY:** The Giants look to get back in the win column in tonight's series opener vs. the Marlins...thanks to their homestand-opening series win over their rival Dodgers (2-1), the Giants have won two straight series and five of their last seven games.

- ▶ SF has outscored its opponents 26-18 and out-hit its opponents 61-41 over this seven-game span that started with a win at Cincinnati on April 16...Giants pitchers have allowed four or more runs just twice in those games.
- ▶ The Giants are 8-7 in night games this season (.533)...offensively, SF's .269 batting average in night games is fourth-highest in MLB while its 41 extra-base hits rank T-9th.
- ▶ SF has just two comeback wins this season when trailing at any point in the game (April 2 vs. NYM and April 18 at WSH), tied with Boston for fewest in MLB...the Giants are 5-3 (.625) in their last eight games decided by three or fewer runs.

**CLUB CAN'T HANDLE ME:** SF lost last year's season series vs. the Marlins (2-4), having won the three-game series at Miami (2-1) from May 30-June 1 before getting swept at home in late June.

- ▶ SF has lost five straight home games vs. the Marlins, with its last home win coming on August 30, 2024...the Giants' last home series win vs. Miami was May 19-21, 2023 (2-1).
- ▶ Five Giants on the active roster have history vs. today's Miami starter Sandy Alcantara... **IF Luis Arraez** is 2-for-5 with an RBI while **IF Matt Chapman** has a double and a walk.

**MY HOUSE(R):** RHP **Adrian Houser** draws the start for SF in tonight's series opener... Houser is SF's lone starter without a win this season.

- ▶ The right-hander received a no-decision in his last start (April 18 at Washington) after allowing five runs over the first two innings...he was able to limit the damage there, however, as he gave SF a key 5.2 innings in a long, 12-inning comeback win for the Giants.
- ▶ Houser has strong numbers against the Marlins, going 3-0 with a 3.22 ERA (8er, 22.1ip) and 31 strikeouts over five games (three starts)...Esteury Ruiz (2-for-3 with an RBI) and Xavier Edwards (1-for-3) are the only active Marlins with hits in their careers vs. Houser.
- ▶ Right-handed batters are slashing just .211/.250/.237 with one double, three RBI and a .487 OPS vs. Houser this season while lefties are slashing .352/.417/.611 with eight doubles, two homers, nine RBI and a 1.028 OPS.

**LOW:** The Giants were shut out for the fifth time (most in MLB) and were held to one hit for the second time in 2026 in yesterday's defeat...it's the first time the Giants have been held to one hit or fewer in multiple games during a season since 2010 (also two).

- ▶ The team's 81 runs scored and .286 on-base percentage this season are both 30th in MLB...this marks just the third time in the SF era that SF's OBP was .286 or lower through the team's first 25 games, surpassed by only the 2019 and 1985 seasons (.272 OBP in both).
- ▶ At home, SF's .560 OPS, three home runs and 2.62 runs per game are all 30th in MLB.

**GDFR:** **IF Rafael Devers** has hit two of SF's three homers at Oracle Park this season.

- ▶ Devers has a career slash line of .358/.434/.627 with 11 runs, seven doubles, a triple, three home runs, 14 RBI and a 1.061 OPS in 17 career games vs. the Marlins...the 1.061 OPS is second-best among active MLB players (min. 75 plate appearances).

**GOOD FEELING:** SF pitchers have allowed 33 runs after the 5th inning in 2026, which is tied with Atlanta for fewest runs allowed in that inning range this season (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ On the mound, SF has induced 21 double plays, tied for third-most in MLB...the high volume of double plays can partly be attributed to SF's MLB-leading 48.0% ground ball rate...Miami has a 44.7% ground ball rate at the plate, 10th-highest in MLB.

**RIGHT ROUND:** The Giants' bullpen has allowed just two earned runs over their last nine games (0.61 ERA, 29.1ip, 31 strikeouts and 11 walks).

- ▶ Since April 7, the SF bullpen has a 1.66 ERA (8er, 43.1ip) over its last 14 games...opponents have hit .171 in that time with a .524 OPS...the 1.66 ERA in that span is best in the Majors, with the next closest team being the Reds (2.34).
- ▶ Overall, the Giants' bullpen has a 3.20 ERA (29er, 81.2ip) for the season, sixth-lowest in MLB and fifth-lowest in the NL entering play today (Miami is just ahead with a 3.13 ERA).
- ▶ Giants relievers have allowed a .217 batting average this season with runners in scoring position, which is eighth-best in MLB.

**Willie Mays** hit his 511th home run, a 415-foot, two-run shot off Jim Owens at Houston. The homer tied the National League record of **Mel Ott**, as the Giants won 4-2.

# ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

**2026 RECORD: 0-2, 5.40 ERA**

**Height/Weight:** 6-4/227      **Bats/Throws:** R/R  
**Hometown:** Locust Grove, OK  
**Age:** 33 (February 2, 1993)      **Signed Through:** 2027

**YO ADRIAN:** Enters his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Got a no decision with five runs (four earned) on seven hits and two walks across 5.2 innings at Washington on April 18...was blitzed for five runs over the first two innings...struck out only one batter in the game.

**AGAINST THE MARLINS:** This will be Houser's sixth career game (fourth start) vs. the Marlins...he is 3-0 with a 3.22 ERA (8er, 22.1ip), 31 strikeouts and a 0.94 WHIP in the five previous outings...Esteury Ruiz (2-for-3 with an RBI) and Xavier Edwards (1-for-3) are the only active Marlins with hits in their careers vs. Houser.

**SINK OR SWIM:** Houser's sinker had a run value of +6 last season per *Baseball Savant*, which is the pitch's best mark since it had a +23 run value in 2021...so far in 2026, the pitch has a run value of -3 with opponents are batting .317 (13x41)...his sinker saw a slight uptick in usage vs. Washington (32) after a low of 25 in his previous start at Baltimore.

**LEFT ON READ:** Lefties have taken advantage of Houser this season, slashing .352/.417/.611 with eight doubles, two homers, nine RBI and a 1.028 OPS...righties on the other hand have a .211/.250/.237 slash line with one double, three RBI and a .487 OPS.

**CONTACT:** With just one strikeout over 5.2 frames last time out, the start was the second-longest outing in Houser's career with one or fewer strikeouts (behind 6.0 innings with zero strikeouts on September 10, 2022 vs. Cincinnati)...Houser's 10.9% strikeout rate is third-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 20.0ip, better than only Baltimore's Chris Bassitt (9.3%) and LAD's Justin Wroblewski (9.8%)...the Marlins' 20.7% strikeout rate is sixth-lowest in MLB.

**CHANGING THE PACE:** Threw his changeup a season-high 33 times last game (previous high was 18)...limited the Nats to just a double in five at-bats ending in the pitch...overall, his changeup has a 31.1% whiff rate, which is his highest among all pitches...the Marlins' .720 OPS vs. changeups is sixth-best in MLB this season.

**2025 RECAP:** Had a well-traveled 2025...he originally pitched in Spring Training with Texas on an MiLB deal...after not making the Rangers out of camp, he pitched nine games (eight starts) with Triple-A Round Rock before opting out of his contract to sign an MLB deal with Chicago-AL...he promptly went 6-2 with a 2.10 ERA (16er, 68.2ip) with the White Sox before being traded to the Rays at the deadline...he went 2-3 with a 4.79 ERA (30er, 56.1ip) in 10 starts to end the season with Tampa Bay.

- ▶ Suffered his second straight loss last Sunday in Washington in the Giants 3-0 loss to the Nationals...threw 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits with seven strikeouts.
- ▶ Is slated to make his 12th career appearance (11th start) against the Marlins tomorrow...has pitched very well against them over his career posting a 4-5 record with a 2.29 ERA (16er, 63.0ip), 75 strikeouts and a 1.05 WHIP...seven of his 10 career starts against Miami have been quality outings.

### #47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-17 (.117) with two walks and six strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (69-for-386) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 8-for-15 with four XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/19 at WSH; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ Eight of his nine appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has issued at least one walk in six of nine contests (6.35 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-27 (.333) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-13 (.077).
- ▶ Three of his nine appearances thus far have been 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 0.2ip, bb (14 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are just 1-for-12 (.083) against him this season, and 18-for-95 in his career (.189).
- ▶ Has appeared in 11 of SF's 24 games, tossing 10.0 innings and allowing two earned runs (1.80 ERA).
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 4/22 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h (13 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first MLB win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief last Saturday...stranded the free base runner in both the 11th & the 12th.
- ▶ Allowed one run on three hits in 11.0 innings with 14 strikeouts and six walks in 11 games.
- ▶ Has a 33.3% strikeout rate early on that is in the top 8% of MLB...his .168 xBA ranks in the top 6% of MLB.
- ▶ Batters are 0-for-13 with four Ks in ABs that end with his four-seamer...eight of his 14 strikeouts have come w/his knuckle curve.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in his last five appearances dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (5.0ip, 2h, 3bb, 9k).
- ▶ Has appeared in nine of SF's 24 games, allowing four runs in 8.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 53.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fourth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

### #46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/23 vs. LAD; 2.0ip, h, bb, 2k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in six of his seven outings (2er, 10.0ip) and posted a 0.80 WHIP and .182 BAA.
- ▶ Has only walked two batters in 10.0ip this season (5.6% walk rate).
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with **RHP José Buttó** being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Played for Giants **MGR Tony Vitello** while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside **RHP José Buttó** and **OF Drew Gilbert** in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

### #74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/22 vs. LAD; SV, 1.0ip, bb (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in 11 of SF's first 25 games and converted three of his four save opportunities.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB...this season it sits at 83.1 mph, which is eighth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ Batters are 3-for-18 in ABs that end with his slider and 6-for-23 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider.
- ▶ In his 44 career save opportunities, Walker owns a 5.74 ERA (27er, 42.1ip)...in his 160 games in a non-save situation, Walker owns a 2.31 ERA (44er, 171.1ip).

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 0.1ip, k (5 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with four holds on the season.
- ▶ Nine of his 11 appearances this year have been scoreless...opponents are just 4-for-33 (.121) off him this year.
- ▶ Struck out 13 batters in 9.2 innings of work.
- ▶ Batters are just 1-for-19 with 11 K's off his splitter this season.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

- ▶ Is hitting .328 (20-for-61) vs. right-handers, compared to a .258 average (8-for-31) vs. lefties.
- ▶ Has been worth +2 Defensive Runs Saved and +4 Outs Above Average in 200.0 innings at 2B this year.
- ▶ Spent parts of two seasons with the Marlins from 2023-24...was an All-Star and won a Batting Title winner...overall, he had a 4.7 WAR and hit .343 with an .834 OPS in 180 games with MIA.
