- Corbin Carroll** recorded his MLB-best-tying 14th homer and 17th multi-hit game.
- Josh Naylor** hit his fifth homer and had a season-high 4 RBI.
- Tim Tawa** recorded his first career 3-hit game and made his first start in center field.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** went 2-for-3 with 1 walk.
- Eugenio Suárez** went 1-for-3 with 1 double, 1 RBI and 1 walk.

NL WEST STRETCH: The D-backs are 3-3 in a 13-game stretch vs. NL West's Giants (3 G; 1-1), Rockies (3 G; May 16-18) and Dodgers (7 G, 2-2; May 19-21).

HERE COMES THE SLUG: The D-backs' 15 homers since May 5 (9 games) are second in the Majors, behind the Yankees (17) while their 31 extra-base hits are third, behind the Yankees (38) and Dodgers (32).

DAY BASEBALL: The D-backs have won 3 straight day road games (11-9 on May 4 @ Phillies, 4-2 on May 1 @ Mets and 3-2 on April 20 @ Cubs) and 4 of their last 6 day games overall.

CARROLL AMONG THE BEST: **Corbin Carroll**, among the Majors, ranks in homers (T-1st, 14), triples (1st, 5), extra-base hits (2nd, 27), total bases (2nd, 111), SLG (4th, .620), runs (4th, 35), OPS (7th, .977) and hits (8th, 51).

- His career-high-tying 3 multi-homer games are tied for the Majors' most with Tyler Soderstrom/ATH.
- His 17 multi-hit games are most in the NL and tied for third in MLB with Steven Kwan/CLE, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (20) and Paul Goldschmidt/NYY (19).

YOUNGEST SNAKE: **Corbin Carroll**, at 24-years-old, is the youngest D-back all-time (fifth overall) to reach 14+ homers thru the team's first 43 games and first since Luis Gonzalez (20) and Reggie Sanders (15) in 2001.

MULTI ROUND-TRIPS: The D-backs' 17 multi-homer games are tied for fourth in MLB with the Angels, behind the Dodgers (23), Yankees (18) and Cubs (18).

- The D-backs are 11-6 when hitting 2+ homers.

IT STARTS AT THE TOP: D-backs' 1-4 batters combined .843 OPS ranks fifth in the Majors, behind the Dodgers (.981), Yankees (.911), Mets (.883) and Padres (.867).

VS. GIANTS: **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 18 straight starts since June 24, 2023, batting .380 (27-for-71)/.970 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 5 walks.

- Corbin Carroll**, in his last 9 starts since June 5, 2024, is hitting .324 (12-for-37)/.990 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 5 RBI, 4 stolen bases and 4 walks.
- Ketel Marte**, in his last 12 starts since Sept. 19, 2023, is hitting .347 (17-for-49)/.860 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 6 walks.
- Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 9 games since Sept. 19, 2023, is hitting .324 (11-for-34)/.395 OBP with 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 4 walks, including 5 multi-hits.

TRENDING ROAD BATS: **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his last 10 road games, is hitting .400 (16-for-40)/1.142 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks, including 7 multi-hit games.

- Josh Naylor** in his last 14 road games, is batting .309 (17-for-55)/.951 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 10 RBI and 7 walks.
- Geraldo Perdomo** in his last 11 road games, is batting .350 (14-for-40)/.942 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 11 RBI and 6 walks.
- Alek Thomas** in his last 9 road games, is batting .333 (9-for-27)/.357 OBP with 2 doubles and 1 RBI.

SOMETHING EXTRA: The D-backs' 32 games with 3+ extra-base hits lead the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (29), Mets (28) and Yankees (25).

- The D-backs have recorded 3+ extra-base hits in 9 of their last 13 games (since May 1).
- With 2 outs, the D-backs' 52 extra-base hits are most in the Majors, ahead of the Red Sox, (49), Yankees (48) and Cubs (48).

AMONG TOP PRODUCERS: The D-backs rank in the NL in walks (1st, 167), sac flies (1st, 17), extra-base hits (1st, 151), SLG (2nd, .439), OPS (2nd, .770), runs (3rd, 214), homers (3rd, 58), total bases (3rd, 635) and OBP (6th, .331).

TACKING ON LATE: The D-backs have scored in the seventh to ninth inning in 15 of their last 18 games.

- Their 83 runs in the seventh inning or later (excl. extra-innings) are most in MLB.

WAR MACHINES: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 2.4 bWAR ranks third among NL position players, behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (3.1) and Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (2.6), behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD 2.9), and second among all shortstops, behind Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2.5).

- Corbin Carroll's** 2.1 offensive bWAR is fourth in the NL, behind Tatis Jr./SD (2.4), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2.1) and Pete Alonso/NYM (2.1).

ON DECK - COLORADO ROCKIES: The D-backs welcome the Rockies to Chase Field for a weekend series from May 16-18.

- Last season, the D-backs went 9-4 (6-1 @ home)...swept their last home series 3-0 from Aug. 12-14.

NEXT STARTER: RHP CORBIN BURNES (2-1, 2.95)

- In his last 3 starts, is 2-0 with a 0.98 ERA (2 ER in 18.1 IP), opponent .188 AVG, 10 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- Will make his first start vs. Rockies since July 22, 2022...in 3 career starts is 0-0 with a 3.86 ERA (7 ER in 16.1 IP), 6 walks and 18 strikeouts.
