THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JULY 21
2024 - DH Yordan Alvarez goes 4x4 with a double, triple, single and home run at Seattle to record his first career cycle and the 10th cycle in Astros franchise history.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros and Marlins will play the middle game of their three-game series tonight at Daikin Park in Houston, TX...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (5-4) will get his first start of the second half and his first start in two weeks tonight opposite the Marlins and **RHP Tyler Phillips** (2-4).

ABOUT IMAI: RHP **Tatsuya Imai** joined the Astros this offseason as a free agent signing out of Japan...he's made 13 MLB starts this year, in which the Astros have gone 8-5, around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10)...he's flashed brilliance at times, including four starts with eight-plus strikeouts, and 6.0 innings of no-hit ball in the Astros no-hitter on May 25 at TEX.

MOVING UP THE LIST: Manager **Joe Espada** has 223 managerial wins as the Astros skipper, which ranks 11th in franchise history...with his next win, he will match **Terry Collins** (224 wins) for 10th on the Astros all-time managerial wins list.

GET 'EM EARLY: The Astros rank first in the AL and second in the Majors in 1st-inning runs (67)...overall, the Astros rank 12th in the Majors in runs (463) immediately ahead of the Marlins (452).

THE LINEUP: The Astros have used 101 different lineups in their 102 games, repeating a lineup just once on the season...**DH Yordan Alvarez** has the most starts at any spot in the lineup among Astros, hitting second 89 times.

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Astros rank second in the AL in fielding pct. (.988) and their 43 errors are the second-fewest in the AL...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in his 97 games played at 1B...dating back to last season, Walker has not made an error in his last 125 games at 1B (last error was Aug. 23, 2025 at BAL).

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise this series in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2...**Enrique Vasquez** and **Danny Gonzales** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast this series.

TRAE DAY: The Astros will help to celebrate **Trae Day** tonight at the ballpark...Trae Day, put on by legendary Houston rapper **Trae Tha Truth**, is an annual Houston celebration honoring Trae, combining community service, entertainment, and philanthropy...in addition to a pregame ceremony and a ceremonial first pitch from Trae himself, a portion of the proceeds from Tuesday's Share-2Care 50/50 Raffle will go to Trae Day and the nonprofits it supports.

LAST NIGHT'S WIN: The Astros picked up a much-needed win last night, downing the visiting Marlins by a score of 8-5...**SS Jeremy Peña** (1x4, HR, 4RBI) and **DH Yordan Alvarez** (3x4, 2HR, 2RBI) were the story as the two went back-to-back with a grand slam and a solo shot to post a six-spot in the 2nd inning...**RHP Ronel Blanco** (4ER/4.2IP) made his long-awaited return from elbow surgery, fanning eight in his 4.2 innings.

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is a strong AL MVP candidate as he enters tonight as the AL's Triple Crown leader, ranking first in batting average (.324), HR (33), and RBI (75)...he currently leads all of baseball in OPS (1.083), OBP (.432), SLG (.651), extra-base hits (53), and total bases (237), and in the AL, he ranks first in hits (118), third in runs (67), and fourth in walks (66)...AL leaders below:

CHASING BAGWELL: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has hit 33 homers in the Astros first 102 games, which ties as the second-most in that span in club history, trailing only **1B Jeff Bagwell**, who homered 34 times through the club's first 102 games in 1994...Alvarez is on pace to hit 52 homers on the season, which would represent a new franchise record, topping the 47 homers hit by Bagwell in 2000.

KEYSTONE FLIGHTS: **2B Jose Altuve** has 246 career homers as a second baseman and per Elias that ties him with **2B Joe Gordon** and **2B Ian Kinsler** for eighth all-time in homers by a second baseman in MLB history...on that all-time list, the trio immediately trails **2B Bret Boone** (251), who happens to be the father-in-law of **IF Nick Allen**.

TAP FOR SUCCESS: Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 72 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (61%)...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 15-of-23 challenges (65%), ranking third in the Majors in challenges won...**3B Isaac Paredes** (11-for-12) has been the most efficient regular challenger for the team and was successful in his first 11 challenges this year.

RIDING THE LAMBO: **RHP Peter Lambert**, who will start tomorrow night, leads the Astros in wins and among AL pitchers he ranks second in opponent average (.197) and sixth in ERA (3.03) (min. 90IP)...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 starts.

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 3-1 with 10 saves (in 10 chances), has a 1.56 ERA (3ER/17.1IP), 28 strikeouts in 17.1 innings, a .148 (9x61) opponent average, and a 0.98 WHIP in 19 appearances...he has not allowed a hit in 14 of his 19 appearances.

VS THE MARLINS: The Astros and Marlins are playing their first series against each other since Aug. 4-6, 2025 in Miami, with the Astros winning two of three games...this is the Marlins first series in Houston since July 9-11, 2024, a three-game sweep for the Astros.

DOWN ON THE FARM: All three of the Astros minor league teams in action yesterday won, which includes the Astros FCL affiliate and their two Dominican Summer League teams...all three teams have had huge success this season, combining for a 78-37 record (.678), including a 39-11 record by the FCL Astros entering today.

LAST START, JULY 7 at WSH: Allowed 2 runs on 4 hits and 3 walks with 3 strikeouts in 3.2 innings...didn't factor into the decision but the Astros went on to defeat the Nationals, 6-3 at Nationals Park.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE: In consecutive starts, June 19 vs. CLE and June 25 at DET, he struck 10+ batters...went 2-0 and posted a 2.25 ERA (3ER/12IP) with 21 total strikeouts, a .182 opponent average and a 0.75 WHIP over those starts...became the 3rd rookie in Astros history with 10+ strikeouts in back-to-back games, joining **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (2024) and **RHP Tom Griffin** (1969)...was also the first Astros pitcher in general to do so since **LHP Framber Valdez** on June 5 and 12 of 2025 (11 K at PIT, 12 K vs. CWS, respectively).

ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY): Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 13 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue...the Astros are 8-5 in his 13 starts.

HARD TO HIT: Has proven to be tough to hit at the Major League level, as he's held opponents to a .243 (52x214) average with 68 strikeouts in 57.0 innings...is averaging 10.90 strikeouts per 9.0, which leads the Astros and ranks 7th in the AL (min. 50 IP)...has held right-handed hitters to a .192 average (15x78) and a .670 OPS.

IMAI'S ARSENAL: Has thrown 44.8% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (43.3%) and sinkers (6%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, has heavily featured his four-seamer over his last 8 starts, throwing the pitch 345 times compared to just 11 sinkers...has also worked in select split fingers (4%), changeups (1.3%) and curveballs (0.6%)...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 4.3 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

A NO-HITTER!: On May 25 at TEX, Imai tossed the first 6.0 innings of the 18th no-hitter in Astros franchise history, the 5th combined no-hitter...navigated 6.0 scoreless, hitless innings despite walking 4 batters, including the first 2 batters of the game and 3 total walks in the 1st inning...retired 15 of the next 16 batters he faced to finish the outing, striking out 2...was relieved in the no-hitter by **LHP Steven Okert** (1 IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2 IP), with Santa making his MLB debut in the outing...marked the Astros first combined no-hitter since **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Bryan Abreu**, **RHP Rafael Montero** and **RHP Ryan Pressly** combined to no-hit the Phillies in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series at Citizens Bank Park.

NO HITTER HISTORY: Imai became the 4th Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to start a no-hitter, joining **RHP Hideo Nomo** (1996, 2001), **RHP Hisashi Iwakuma** (2015) and **LHP Shota Imanaga** (2024)...both of Nomo's no-hitters and Iwakuma's no-hitter were complete-game efforts...the Astros no-hitter ended a 630-day drought between the last no-hitter thrown in the Majors when the Cubs tossed a combined no-hitter vs. the Pirates on Sept. 4, 2024...coincidentally, that no-hitter was started by Imanaga, who was relieved by **RHP Porter Hodge** and Imai's current Astros teammate, **RHP Nate Pearson**...was the longest no-hitter drought in the Majors since a span of 841 days between the 2004-06 seasons.

2025 RECAP: Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/20 vs. MIA): Allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 2 strikeouts in 1.0 scoreless inning last night vs. MIA.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.66 ERA (7ER/23.2IP) with 26 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .200 opponent batting average in his last 25 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind **LHP Steven Okert** (14-game streak).

VS. MIA: In 7 career appearances vs. the Marlins, he's posted a 1.13 ERA (1ER/8IP) with 10 strikeouts and a .207 opponent batting average...has recorded 5 consecutive scoreless outings vs. MIA (5.0 IP), dating back to July 11, 2024, at Daikin Park.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has recorded 353 career relief appearances with the Astros...recorded his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing **LHP Joe Sambito** for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history...now trails **RHP Brad Lidge** (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (490) and 10th in IP (362.2).

CAREER: In 353 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.90 ERA (117ER/362.2IP) with 490 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.16 K/9 and a 0.79 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/18 vs. BAL): Allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts in 2.0 scoreless innings on Saturday vs. BAL.

TWO STRONG: Ranks 1st among MLB relievers with 11 scoreless outings of 2.0+ innings this season ...are also the most scoreless appearances of 2.0+ innings in a single season by an Astros reliever since **RHP Chris Devenski** logged 11 such appearances in 2017.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Leads MLB relievers with 62.0 IP and 24 multi-inning apps...among AL relievers, ranks T-4th in K's (63).

VS. MIA: Recorded the longest relief outing in his career in his lone career appearance vs. the Marlins on Aug. 5, 2025 at MIA, tossing 5.0 innings while allowing 2 runs on 3 hits with 1 walk and 5 strikeouts.
