ROCKY START TO SERIES FOR TWINS: The Twins lost to the Phillies last night at Citizens Bank Park by a score of 3-1...Joe Ryan (13-10) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded four hits, two from Christian Vázquez, who drove in the club's only run with a solo home run in the sixth inning, breaking up Aaron Nola's perfect game.

TWINS AND PHILLIES: The Twins are playing the Phillies for the 28th, 29th and 30th times in their history this weekend...Twins are 15-13 all-time against Philadelphia, going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium (2002), 1-2 at the Metrodome (2004), 7-5 at Target Field in (2012, '13, '16 & '24), and 5-5 at Citizens Bank Park (2010, '19 and '23).

◆ Christian Vázquez is hitting .467 (28-for-60) with seven doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, a .515 on-base percentage, a .783 slugging percentage and a 1.298 OPS in 20 career regular season games vs. the Phillies...has 14 hits in 31 at-bats in eight career regular season games at CBP.

KINGS OF THE HILL: Over their last five games, Twins starters have combined to go 2-1, 1.86 ERA (29.0 IP, 6 ER) with six walks, 32 strikeouts and a .157 opponent batting average...on the season, Twins starters have struck out 768 batters, sixth-most in club history...next is the 1964 team with 777 (above note).

FOUR-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton enters tonight with 34 home runs on the season, the most for a Twin since 2019, when Nelson Cruz hit 41, Max Kepler hit 36 and Miguel Sanó hit 34...34 home runs are tied for eighth-most in the AL, while his 14.21 at-bat-per-home run ratio ranks fifth... he has 167 career homers, tying Brian Dozier for ninth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

GRAND THEFT: The Twins have 113 stolen bases on the season, tied for 10th-most in club history.

♣ Prior to the July 31 trade deadline, Minnesota stole 55 bases, tied for 24th-most in baseball...
since August 1, they have 58 stolen bases, tied with New York-AL for the most in baseball.

♣ 17 different Twins have stolen a base this season, withic ties the 2004 team for second-most in a season in Twins history (since 1961)...the team record is 18 separate players with at least one stolen base in 2001...active players on the 28-man roster that need a stolen base still are: Ryan Jeffers, Edouard Julien and Carson McCusker.

THE LEFTORIUM: Notable individuals vs. lefties this season:

₱ Byron Buxton is hitting .295 (31-for-105) with nine home runs, a .648 slugging percentage and a 1.014 OPS against left-handed pitching on the season — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career..Buck's .648 slugging percentage ranks fifth-best in baseball this season (min. 100 PA), trailing Aaron Judge (.793), Cal Raleigh (.692), Ivan Herrera (.674) and Shea Langeliers (.655).

₱ Austin Martin is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with an .893 OPS against lefties this season.

₱ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .299 (32-for-107) with a .461 on-base percentage and an .872 OPS against left-handed pitching this season..his on-base percentage is the second-highest in baseball among qualifiers, trailing only Aaron Judge (.491).

MAJORITY RULES: The Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to earn their 19th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 18-31-2 in series play, going 11-13-2 at home and 7-18-0 on the road.

▼Twins' last series win against the Phillies was July 22-24, 2024, taking two of three at Target Field...their last series win at Citizens Bank Park was August 11-13, 2023, taking two of three...their last series loss against the Phillies and at Philadelphia was April 5-7, 2019, dropping two of three.
