**NATIONALS HISTORY**  
**APRIL 29 (8-8)**  
2011 - Jason Marquis required just 96 pitches (64 strikes) to strike out seven and blank the visiting Giants on five hits and no walks in Washington's 3-0 victory. The shutout was the fourth of Marquis' career as he outpitched Tim Lincecum, who lasted 7.0 innings. Offensively, Ian Desmond went 3-for-3 with two doubles, a stolen base and a run scored, while Laynce Nix (2-for-3) clubbed a two-run homer in the second frame.

## NATIONALS NEWS

**MOVING ON**  
The Washington Nationals and the New York Mets square off in game two of the three-game series tonight at Citi Field.

- Washington is 10-7 (.588) on the road in 2026, tied for second most road wins in Major League Baseball...The .588 road winning percentage is tied for seventh in Major League Baseball.

**START ME UP**  
Washington's starters have posted a 2.35 ERA (6 ER/23.0 IP) with 29 strikeouts and five walks across the last five games.

- Including a career-high 10 strikeouts on Thursday vs. Atlanta, **Cade Cavalli** has struck out 15 batters without issuing a walk over his last two starts.
- Jake Irvin** has 13 strikeouts against zero walks in his last two starts.
- Foster Griffin** set career-highs in both innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8) in his last scoreless start against the White Sox on April 26...He's pitched to a 2.67 ERA with 30 strikeouts in six starts this season.

**PRETTY OFFENSIVE**  
The Nationals rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with 156 runs, the second most by a Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 30 games behind the 2017 National League East champion Nationals (189).

- Washington has scored 30 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 58 runs in the seventh inning or later, tied for most in MLB with San Diego.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 19 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

**HITTERISH**  
Some notes on a few Nationals hitters as of late:

- Luis Garcia Jr.** is 8-for-23 (.348) with two doubles, four RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored over his last seven games...He's hit safely in four of the seven.
- Brady House** has hit safely in seven of his last nine games, going 7-for-31 with a homer, three RBI, three walks, one stolen base and five runs scored.
- Jorbit Vivas** has hit safely in 15 of his 18 starts this season and has reached base safely in 11 consecutive starts.

**WHAT A RELIEF**  
Washington's bullpen has allowed just two earned runs on six hits with 12 strikeouts in the last three games...They've held opponents to a .158 average and have recorded one save and a hold.

- Brad Lord** has allowed just one earned run with four strikeouts and no walks in his last four games (9.0 innings)...He has held batters to a .161 average (5-for-31) in that span.
- Paxton Schultz** recorded his first career save on April 26 at Chicago (AL).
- PJ Poulin** is 2-0, allowing three earned runs on nine hits with three strikeouts in his last nine games (three starts)...Seven of the nine games have been scoreless.

**GOOD WOOD**  
**James Wood** has placed himself among the league leaders...See chart to the right.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball in on-base percentage (.476), home runs (T1st, 9) and walks (T1st, 25) since April 5...This comes after starting the season 4-for-26 (.111) in eight games from March 26 to April 4.
- He is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 40 batted balls over 100 MPH are tied for most in Major League Baseball with **Fernando Tatis Jr.**

**FRAME JOB**  
**Bobby Wilson's** catchers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with three Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 2, **Keibert Ruiz** - 1) along with the New York Yankees, according to Baseball Savant...*"Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike base, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game."*

- For comparison, Washington's catchers ranked 30th in MLB with -18 Catcher Framing Runs in 2025.

**DON'T WALK SIGN**  
Washington's pitching staff ranks ninth in Major League Baseball in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.72) and fifth in walks per 9.0 innings (2.93) since April 15...The staff has fanned 106 batters against 39 walks in 120.0 innings.

- Irvin ranks 11th in the National League with 10.31 strikeouts per 9.0 innings and Cavalli ranks 12th (10.22).

## FARM REPORT

**CRUZIN'**  
Wilmington shortstop **Ronny Cruz** went 3-for-5 with a triple, one RBI and two runs scored last night vs. Asheville...Cruz is 13-for-32 (.406) with a triple, three homers, eight RBI, two walks and seven runs scored in seven games since being promoted to High-A Wilmington on April 21...The 19-year-old Cruz leads Washington's system in average (.361), home runs (6), RBI (11), runs (23), slugging percentage (.675), on-base percentage (.454), OPS (1.129), hits (30), total bases (56) and is second in stolen bases (16).

**GO CLEMMEY!**  
Harrisburgh right-handed pitcher **Alex Clemmey** threw 6.0 scoreless innings of a one-hit ball game with six strikeouts and just two walks last night at Akron...In five starts this season, he has gone 1-1 with a 2.95 ERA (6 ER/18.1 IP) with 23 strikeouts and a .145 opponents' average (9-for-62).

# CAREER

Tall, powerful right-hander was Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Made his Major League debut in 2022 and returned to the mound in 2025.

- 1,076 days passed between his debut on Aug. 26, 2022 vs. Cincinnati and his second career appearance on Aug. 6, 2025 vs. Athletics.
- Was ranked as high as the No. 53 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.com and the No. 61 prospect per *Baseball America* entering the 2023 season.
- Had the "Best Curveball" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, for two consecutive seasons (2024-25)...Had the "Best Slider" in the system in 2021 and 2022.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts in 2021.

## LAST START

Cavalli had a career high in strikeouts with 10 in 5.0 innings of work...He gave up two earned runs on seven hits on April 23 against Atlanta.

## vs. NEW YORK (NL)

Cavalli is set to make his second career start against the Mets...In his first appearance against New York, he gave up no earned runs on five hits and one walk with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work on Sept. 20, 2025.

## THE RIGHT STUFF

Opposing right-handed batters are just 6-for-41 with three extra-base hits off Cavalli so far this season...The .146 opponents' batting average vs. righties is seventh-best in the National League.

- Right-handed batters hit .381/.442/.548 against Cavalli in 2025.

## NO HOMERS CLUB

Cavalli is one of 13 qualified pitchers to not allow a home run so far this season (min. 15.0 IP).

- In his Major League career, Cavalli has allowed 0.81 home runs per 9.0 innings (7 ER/77.2 IP).

## 2026 OPENING DAY

Cavalli made his first career Opening Day start March 26 against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field...He allowed two earned runs on three runs with five strikeouts.

- Became the 10th different pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to start on Opening Day.

## 2025

Returned to the Major Leagues after missing all of 2023 and 2024 recovering from Tommy John surgery.

- Made his return on Aug. 6 against the Athletics...Worked 4.1 scoreless innings with six strikeouts.
- In his third start, Cavalli worked 7.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts against the Philadelphia Phillies on Aug. 16 for his first Major League win.
- Collected all three of his wins against National League East opponents (Miami twice, Philadelphia).
- Went 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA (7 ER/28.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts in five starts against the NL East...The Nationals went 5-0 in those starts.
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** 4-Seam (31.2%) Knuckle-Curve (30.5%) Sinker (18.3%) Change-up (13.6%) Cutter (6.3%) Slider (0.1%)

## 2023-24

Spent the 2024 season rehabbing from 2023 Tommy John surgery...Underwent the surgery in Spring Training 2023.

- Appeared in three rehab outings with the FCL Nationals and Single-A Wilmington in 2024...Returned to throwing/playing catch by the end of the 2023 season.

Steven Cade Cavalli...Graduated from Bixby High School in Bixby, Oklahoma...Attended the University of Oklahoma.
