THE TWINS: The Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a 2-1 series win over the Red Sox this week, winning Monday and Tuesday, followed by a loss on Wednesday... tonight, Minnesota will begin a three-game weekend series with Cincinnati... they will play games two and three on Saturday and Sunday, both starting at 1:10 pm (CT).
 ☞ Twins have 11 wins through 19 games... in 2025, Minnesota didn't earn its 11th win until game 27 on April 26.
 ☞ Twins have won four of their last five, eight of their last 10 and 10 of their last 14.

SOX FLIP THE STORY ON MINNESOTA: The Twins lost to the Red Sox on Wednesday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 9-5, missing the three-game sweep... Simeon Woods Richardson (0-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs (6 earned) on 10 hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts, including a fifth-inning three-run homer from Trevor Story... the offense recorded six hits, two from Austin Martin, who homered for the first time this season and third time in his career... Ryan Kreidler added a home run, his second of the season and fourth of his career.

SEEING RED: Minnesota and Cincinnati are playing each other for the 41st, 42nd and 43rd times in their history this weekend... the Twins are 19-21 all-time against the Reds, going 8-12 in Cincinnati (7-7 at Great American Ball Park and 1-5 at Cinergy Field) and 11-9 in Minnesota (4-7 at Target Field and 7-2 at the Metrodome).

☞ These two last met for three games at Great American Ball Park from June 17-19, 2025 as the Twins won game three of the three-game series... the middle game was a rain-shortened six-inning game.
 ☞ The last time the Twins hosted the Reds was for three games from September 13-15, 2024 as the Twins won the third of the three games.
 ☞ Derek Shelton has a career managerial record of 37-41 against the Reds, his most wins vs. any opponent.

☞ Josh Bell has hit safely in nine of his last 10 vs. Cincinnati, hitting .308 (12-for-39) with four doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI, an .872 slugging percentage and a 1.229 OPS in that span.
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with a 1.121 OPS in his last 10 games vs. the Reds.
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with five home runs, six RBI, a 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.407 OPS in seven career games vs. the Reds.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with three home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a .436 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.103 OPS in 11 career games vs. Cincy.

BUCK NATIONAL: In his last 37 Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .304 (45-for-148) with six doubles, three triples, 13 home runs, 23 RBI and a .994 OPS... below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins are playing their first National League opponent of the season this weekend... their next opponent in IL Play will be the Mets at Citi Field, from Tuesday-Thursday... last season, they went 20-28 vs. the NL, their last series was September 26-28 at Philadelphia, winning one of three... Twins last winning season in IL Play was in 2023, when they went 25-21.

WINNESOTA: Twins have gone 7-3 at home this season for a .700 winning percentage, tied with Houston (.700, 7-3) for third-best home winning percentage in the AL, trailing Detroit (.889, 8-1) and Cleveland (.714, 5-2)... Minnesota has won six of their last seven games here.
 ☞ In nine home games, Byron Buxton is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with two doubles, three home runs, 12 runs scored and a 1.029 OPS.

RUN THE WORLD: Twins have scored 103 runs on the season over 19 games, for an average of 5.42 runs-per-game... that figure ranks fourth in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (5.83), Washington (5.63) and Atlanta (5.58)... 103 runs scored are tied for ninth-most in club history through the first 19... their most was 122 in 1996.

LONG MINNESOTA GOODBYES: The Twins have homered in a season-long seven-straight games, their longest streak since August 25-September 1, 2025 (also 7)... their last streak of eight-plus games came July 3-12, 2025, when they homered in nine consecutively.
 ☞ Minnesota ranks third in baseball in home runs (26), trailing Los Angeles-NL (33) and Los Angeles-AL (32)... 26 home runs are their fifth-most all-time through the club's first 19 games; their most being 33 in 2019.

THE LEFTY STARTER TOUR CONTINUES: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 12th time in 20 games... they have gone 5-6 against left-handed starters this season... their five wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Iarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framber Valdez (8-6), Saturday at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4) and Monday vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6).

☞ In the first seven games vs. lefties, the Twins hit .169 (21-for-124) with a .530 OPS and two home runs, but have hit .269 (45-for-167) with an .833 OPS and seven home runs over their last 10.
 ☞ The 11 lefty starters are the most any team has faced this season.
 ☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .390 (30-for-77) with a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.032 OPS vs. left-handed pitching... since that date, his batting average ranks second in all of baseball (min. 80 PA)... his OPS ranks seventh.

WELCOME BACK: Fans who purchased tickets directly from the Twins for the club's Home Opener will receive complimentary tickets to tonight's game vs. the Cincinnati Reds... tonight will also feature a pregame happy hour and the season's first postgame fireworks show.
 ☞ **Pregame Happy Hour Details:** From 5:00 pm-7:10 pm, featuring \$2 beers, \$2 hot dogs, \$2 snacks and a live performance by Minneapolis-based singer/songwriter Tim Mahoney and his band.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2018, the Twins played host to Cleveland in San Juan, Puerto Rico at Hiram Bithorn Stadium... it was game one of a two-game series on the island... the Twins lost by a score of 6-1 as Jake Odorizzi was the starter and loser, allowing four runs in 5.0 innings pitched, including a home run to Puerto Rico native Francisco Lindor... the game was played in front of 19,516 fans... in 2009, Jason Kubel became the ninth Twin (12 now) to hit for the cycle against Los Angeles-AL in the Metrodome... he went 4-for-5 in the game, doubling in his first at-bat (1st inning), singling in his second at-bat (3rd inning), tripling in his third at-bat (6th inning) and completing the cycle with a grand slam in his fifth at-bat (8th inning), capping off a seven-run inning and giving the Twins an 11-9 lead and eventual win... he became the third player in 100 years to finish a cycle with a grand slam (Yankees Tony Lazzeri in 1932 and Oakland's Miguel Tejada in 2001).

- ☞ Making his fifth start of 2026 and 119th start (120th game) of his career.
- ☞ Is 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (5.0 IP, 4 ER), three walks, five strikeouts and a .263 (5-for-19) BAA in one career start against Cincinnati.
- ☞ Took the win his last time out on April 11 at Toronto, allowing two runs on two hits with one walk and five strikeouts across 7.0 innings of work in a 7-4 Twins victory; was his first quality start of the season.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his fourth start of the season on April 11 at Toronto opposite left-hander Eric Lauer...earned the win, his second of the season and first time recording back-to-back wins in consecutive outings since he defeated Kansas City at Target Field on August 8, 2025, and then followed with a win at Yankee Stadium against New York-AL on August 13...made his first quality start of the season, allowing two runs on two hits (1 HR) across 7.0 innings of work with one walk and five strikeouts.

- ☞ Snapped a seven-start stretch without recording a quality start spanning from September 6, 2025-April 6, 2026, tied for the longest such streak of his career (also 7 from July 6-August 15, 2022).
- ☞ Surrendered his first home run of the season, a two-run, first-inning blast off the bat of Blue Jays outfielder Daulton Varsho.
- ☞ After allowing his first two batters to reach base (George Springer walk, Daulton Varsho home run), Ryan went on to retire 20 of his remaining 22 batters faced, with his only blemishes being a hit batter (Nathan Lukes) in the second inning and a leadoff single (Vladimir Guerrero Jr.) in the fourth inning.

TWO STARTS AGO: In his penultimate start on April 6 vs. Detroit, Ryan toed the rubber for the third time this season opposite right-hander and former number one overall pick Casey Mize...earned his first win of the 2026 campaign, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...his 101 pitches were the most he's thrown in an outing this season and the most since firing 104 pitches on August 31, 2025 vs. San Diego.

- ☞ Seven strikeouts matched his season-high, previously done in his first start of the season on Opening Day, March 26 at Baltimore.
- ☞ Marked the first time Ryan has recorded a win in his home season debut since 2023, when his start helped defeat Houston on April 8, 2023 at Target Field.

RY-LINE CHILI: In his career, Ryan has faced Cincinnati one time; the Reds are one of four teams that he has not made multiple starts against in his career (Los Angeles-NL, Miami, New York-NL, Philadelphia)...in his lone start against the Reds on September 18, 2023, Joe took the loss, surrendering four runs on five hits (1 HR) with three walks and five strikeouts at Great American Ballpark.

NATIONAL TREASURE: Ryan is set to make his 33rd start vs. a National League opponent, which would tie Brad Radke for the most Interleague starts in Twins history, since the dawn of Interleague play in 1997...below are some more of his numbers against the National League, compared to other pitchers in Twins history since 1997:

- ☞ Is 11-13 with a 4.56 ERA (169.2 IP, 86 ER), 40 walks, 193 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .241 (158-for-655) BAA in 32 career starts against the National League.
- ☞ In 2025, went 5-5 with a 2.74 ERA (72.1 IP, 22 ER), 14 walks and 87 strikeouts (6.21 K/BB) against National League opponents.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 59 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.92 ERA (325.2 IP, 142 ER), 72 walks and 344 strikeouts, compared to 27-17 with a 3.66 ERA (337.0 IP, 137 ER), 82 walks and 397 strikeouts in 60 home appearances (59 starts).

- ☞ Posted a 7-5 record and a 3.48 ERA (85.1 IP, 33 ER) with 21 walks and 103 strikeouts through 15 starts (16 games) at Target Field in 2025.
- ☞ His 103 strikeouts at home ranked fifth in the American League; 390 strikeouts at Target Field are third most all-time, trailing Kyle Gibson (436) and José Berrios (432).
- ☞ His start on April 6 vs. Detroit marked his first win at Target Field since August 31, 2025 vs. San Diego.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .262/.295/.452 (11-for-42) with five doubles, one home run, no walks and 10 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .118/.244/.118 (4-for-34) with no extra-base hits, six walks and 12 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .218/.277/.388 (264-for-1,213) with 83 walks and 303 strikeouts (3.65 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .224/.273/.414 (285-for-1,270) with 71 walks and 438 strikeouts (6.17 K/BB).

- ☞ Ryan's .118 (4-for-34) opponent batting average this season against righties is the ninth lowest in Major League Baseball (min. 30 batters faced).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP TAJ BRADLEY (2026: 3-0, 1.25 ERA // CAREER: 22-27, 4.67 ERA)

Right-hander Taj Bradley is slated to start tomorrow's game vs. Cincinnati...his 1.25 ERA (21.2 IP, 3 ER) ranks fourth among qualified pitchers in the American League and seventh in baseball, walking eight batters with 29 strikeouts to start his 2026 campaign...won his most recent start on April 12 at Toronto with 5.0 innings pitched, allowing one run on five hits with four walks and seven strikeouts in an 8-2 Twins victory...became the first Twins starter to win at least three of his first four starts without a loss with an ERA of 1.25-or-lower since Ervin Santana started 3-0 with a 0.64 ERA through his first four starts in 2017...in his only career start against Cincinnati on April 18, 2023, Bradley, who was with Tampa Bay, earned the win, pitching 5.1 scoreless innings with three hits, one walk and nine strikeouts en route to a 10-0 Rays victory at Great American Ballpark.
