NATIONALS NEWS

WINNING WAYS

The Washington Nationals continue this homestand with a three-game series against the Minnesota Twins starting on Tuesday night...Washington has won five of its last eight games dating back to April 25.

- In the battle of franchise that have called Washington, D.C. home, the Nationals (2005-pres.) are 6-3 over the Minnesota Twins (1901-60) since 2005 when playing in the nation's capital.

PITCH PERFECT

Simon Mathews' pitching staff leads the National League (3rd in MLB) with a 2.44 ERA in nine games since April 24... The staff has pitched to a 3.67 ERA in 19 games since April 14 after entering play that day with a 6.21 ERA through the first 15 games of the season.

- The starters lead the National League (3rd in MLB) with a 2.63 ERA (12 ER/41.0 IP) also lead the NL (2nd in MLB) with a .212 opponents' batting average in nine games since April 24.
- The bullpen has pitched to a 1.23 ERA (4 ER/29.1 IP) in seven games since April 26, the best mark in the National League and the second-best in Major League Baseball.
- The bullpen has not allowed a home run in 37.2 innings pitched since the fifth inning on April 24 at Chicago (AL)...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the bullpen's streak of 115 consecutive outs recorded without surrendering a home run is the longest active streak in Major League Baseball.

SPECIFICALLY...

Some pitching performances of note include:

- Foster Griffin** ranks sixth in the National League with a 2.27 ERA, while **Cade Cavalli** ranks fifth in the NL (min. 30.0 IP). with 11.15 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- Richard Lovelady** has offered scoreless relief in his last six games (6.0 IP), going 1-0 with a save, two holds, six strikeouts, three walks (all intentional) and five hits allowed.
- Left-handed batters are 3-for-19 (.158) with zero extra-base hits against **Mitchell Parker** this season.
- PJ Poulin** has been The Opener five times...He's allowed just one earned run on five hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.
- Over his last nine games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.93 ERA (2 ER/9.1 IP) with three holds, three saves, nine strikeouts and one walk.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams is 9-for-21 (.429) with a double, homer, six RBI, four walks, one stolen base and four runs scored over his last six games...He's reached safely in all six (.520 OBP) and has hits in five of the six.

- He ranks among National League hitters in on-base percentage (5th, .406), OPS (7th, .940) and RBI (17th, 27).

HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.5 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington has faced 23 teams with a record of .500 or better, the most in Major League Baseball.

- 13 of the Nationals 16 home games have come against teams .500 or better.
- Washington is 10-13 (.435) against teams .500 or better this season and has already played four teams in the top six in wins in Major League Baseball.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank tied for sixth in Major League Baseball (T4th in NL) with 180 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 32 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 66 runs in the seventh inning or later, the most in the National League and third-most in Major League Baseball.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 21 times this season, third-most in Major League Baseball.

HOME SWEET HOMERS

The Nationals are averaging 1.31 home runs per game at home, good for fifth in Major League Baseball and second in the National League...Washington is tied for ninth in MLB in home runs at home with 21 despite playing only 16 games at Nationals Park.

- James Wood's** eight home runs at home are tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood ranks second in MLB with an average exit velocity of 96.2 MPH behind **O'Neil Cruz** (96.4).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 43 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for fifth in Major League Baseball.

FARM REPORT

KING ME

Harrisburg shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 25 games this season, the fourth-longest streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest active streak...He's hitting .306 with a .408 on-base percentage and a .561 slugging percentage this season...He ranks tied for third among Nationals farmhands with 14 extra-base hits, while his .561 slugging and his .969 OPS each rank fourth.
