

EARLY BIRD SPECIAL: As reminder, tomorrow's finale against the Rangers will begin at 6;40 p.m.

LITTLE BLACK BACKPACK: Earlier today, Mets shortstop Francisco Lindor teamed up with the Amazin' Mets Foundation to donate New Balance backpacks to local students from the Tommie L. Agee Educational Campus. P.S. 419 in East Elmhurst, Queens...The backpacks contained brandnew school supplies including folders, notebooks, pencils, markers, and crayons, to help prepare these students for the new school year.

TAKE THE TRAIN TO THE GAME: The Mets are encouraging all fans attending the games taking place August 25 - September 3 to take the train to the game...With the capacity crowds expected at both Citi Field and the US Open, using mass transit and rideshare will be the most efficient ways to arrive to the ballpark...The LIRR and the 7 train have added additional trains for baseball and tennis fans...If you drive, please arrive early to avoid traffic delays.

I DON'T WANT TO ROCK, DJ: In 35 games this year, DJ Stewart is batting .268 (22-82) with 10 runs, five doubles, seven home runs, 14 RBI, nine walks, a .351 OBP and a .585 SLG...Stewart recorded a career-high 12 home runs in 100 games with Baltimore in 2021.

DINGERS!: The Mets have socked 169 home runs this season...That is the fourth-most in the National League...The 2022 Mets hit 171 home runs.

INVADER NIM: Brandon Nimmo snapped an 0-21 streak with a two-run homer in the third inning...It was his 19th home run of the season...That's a career-best...He is batting .284 (46-162) with 11 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, 12 walks with a .352 OBP and a .401 SLG against lefthanded pitchers this year...His .282 average is the 11th-best in the majors by a left-handed hitter against fellow lefties.

AW SNAP: Francisco Lindor had his hitting streak snapped at 13 games last night...He batted .358 (19-53) in that span with 13 runs, four doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, three walks and four steals during the streak...It was tied for his longest streak as a Met, which he also accomplished from September 14-28, 2022...Over his last 60 games, he is batting .301 (68-226) with 47 runs, 12 doubles, two triples, 12 home runs, 35 RBI, 28 walks, 17 steals with a .385 OBP, a .531 SLG and a .916 OPS...Lindor has stolen 23 bases in 130 games this season, exceeding his total from 2022 (16 steals in 161 games)...His career-best is 25 steals 158 games in 2018.

I DECLARE fWAR: Francisco Lindor ranks sixth in the majors and fourth in the National League with a 5.1 fWAR...Since he joined the Mets, Lindor has posted a 16.0 fWAR...Only Freddie Freeman (18.7) and Mookie Betts (17.7) have posted a higher mark in the Senior Circuit...His 16.0 fWAR since 2021 ranks fifth in the majors in that span.

OUCH: The Mets have been hit by 86 pitches this season...That is the second-most in the majors and the most in the National League...Since the start of last season, the Mets have been plunked 198 times, that's 17 times more than the second-place team the Mariners...It's 32 more times the next place team in the NL, the Cincinnati Reds who have been hit by 166 pitches in that span.

THIS IS ALMOST 40: Pete Alonso is third in the majors and second in the National League with 39 home runs...Alonso is one home run shy of recording his third season of 40 or more home runs...He socked 53 in 2019 and 40 last season...He is the only player in franchise history with multiple seasons of 40 or more home runs...Since he entered the league in 2019, only two other players have recorded multiple seasons with 40 or more home runs (Shohei Ohtani and Mike Trout)... Only one active player (Nelson Cruz, four) has more than three 40-HR seasons...Alonso's 185 home runs since he entered the league in 2019 are the most in the major leagues... With one more long ball, he'll become the fifth player in MLB history with three or more seasons with 40+ home runs in a player's first five years... He would join Ralph Kiner (4), Ryan Howard (3), Albert Pujols (3) and Eddie Matthews (3).

RANGERS-METS NOTES: The Mets have not lost back-to-back games against the Rangers since the two teams began playing each other in 2003.

MONTHLY REPORT: Pete Alonso has recorded nine home runs in 27 games this month...His career-best for any single month is 11 home runs, which he recorded in 27 games in September of 2019...He has recorded five months with at least 10 home runs in his career...His next home run would mark the second time this year that Alonso has hit 10 homers in a single month...He hit 10 home runs in May...He also hit one home run in March and nine in April.

THE ROAD TO 100: Pete Alonso is third in the majors and is second in the NL with 96 RBI...He has previously recorded two seasons with 100 RBI (120  $\,$ in 2019 and 131 in 2022)...He is seeking to become the fourth player in Mets history to record three or more seasons with 100 or more RBI...David Wright is the franchise leader with five such seasons...Carlos Beltrán and Darryl Strawberry recorded three seasons each.

ADAM'S SONG: In 17 games following the All-Star break, Adam Ottavino is 1-1 with one save and a 1.72 ERA (3 ER/15.2 IP) with nine strikeouts...In 21 games since the start of July, Ottavino has posted a 1.40 ERA (3 ER/19.1 IP) with 12 strikeouts.

STEAL MY SUNSHINE: New York has recorded 94 steals in 105 attempts... The team's 89.5 percent success rate is the best in the majors...It is the best percentage in franchise history....The last time the Mets stole more than 100 bases in a season was in 2014 when the team swiped 101 bags.

**GIMME A BREAK:** Alonso is hitting .242 (36-149) with 21 extra-base hits, 35 RBI, 23 runs, 20 walks and a .914 OPS in 42 games following the All-Star break...He batted .211 (64-304) with 50 runs, seven one triple, 26 home runs, 61 RBI and an .807 OPS in the 82 games before the break.

JEFF McHITS: Jeff McNeil has safely hit in 19 of his last 23 games, batting .322 (29-90) with 15 runs, four doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, and five walks with a .467 SLG in that span...In 42 games following the All-Star break, McNeil is batting .285 (47-165) with 24 runs, seven doubles, one triple, three home runs, 21 RBI, eight walks with a .335 OBP...He has struck out only 14 times in 179 plate appearances following the All-Star break.

THIS DAY IN METS HISTORY: On this day in 2008, the Mets entered the top of the ninth down 2-1 to the Florida Marlins... After the Mets recorded two outs, José Reyes, Luis Castillo and David Wright all reached base, setting it up for Carlos Beltrán...The outfielder hit a grandslam to right field giving the Mets the lead...New York would surrender two more runs, but go on to hold on and win 5-4 in Miami...Beltrán hit five grand slams with the Mets, which is tied for the second-most in franchise history.

DOWN ON THE FARM: INF/OF Jett Williams is batting .326/.568/.593 with 16 runs, eight doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, nine steals and 22 walks in 24 games with the Brooklyn Cyclones...In 103 games between two levels in 2023, Williams is batting .268/.433/.455 with 67 runs, 20 doubles, six triples, 11 home runs, 49 RBI, 41 steals and 91 walks...His 91 walks are seventh in all of the minors.

#### QUINTANA NEWS & NOTES

RECENTLY: Quintana made his first start with the Mets on July 20 against his former team, the Chicago White Sox....Quintana signed a two-year contract with New York on December 9, 2022...The southpaw began the season on the IL due to a stress fracture in his rib cage...Underwent surgery on March 17.

LAST TIME OUT: Quintana made his seventh start of the season on August 23 against the Braves at Truist Park...He threw 5.1 innings and allowed five earned runs on a season-high nine hits and three walks while striking out five batters... Saw his streak of 20 straight starts allowing three earned runs or fewer come to an end...Was the longest such streak in the majors among starting pitchers (excluding openers) at the time and the longest such streak by a starter since Max Fried allowed three earned runs or fewer in 21 straight starts from June 22, 2022 - April 18, 2023.

REHAB ASSIGNMENT RECAP: Made five appearances across St. Lucie (A), Binghamton (AA) and Syracuse (AAA) as part of his rehab assignment after being placed on the 60-day IL with a left rib fracture...Threw 15.2 innings in five games, four of which were starts, pitching to a 4.60 ERA (8 ER/15.2 IP) while tallying 16 strikeouts compared to eight walks.

PARK RANGERS: Today, Quintana will make his ninth career start against the Rangers...Quintana last faced Texas on August 2, 2021 at Globe Life Field in relief with the Angels...Quintana currently owns a 2.01 ERA (7 ER/31.1 IP) against the Texas squad at home.

ACROSS LEAGUE LINES: For his career, Quintana owns a 3.43 ERA (85 ER/223.0 IP) in 41 Interleague games...That is the 11th-lowest mark among active pitchers in the majors (Min. 200.0 IP)...This season, Quintana has made four starts against Interleague opponents, including three quality starts.

HOT STREAK: Quintana's homerless inning streak came to an end at 97.1 innings in his start on August 12 after allowing a solo homer to Tyler O'Neill to lead off the bottom of the seventh inning...The last pitcher before Quintana to reach 90.0+ homerless innings was Tyson Ross (100.0 IP) in 2015...Courtesy of Elias... Last season Quintana owned the lowest ERA (0.89) in Major League Baseball during the month of September last year and is the lowest ERA in any month in his career.

LEFT 'EM SPEECHLESS: Reached 1,500 career strikeouts in his start vs. Colorado on August 16, 2022. Currently ranks fifth among active MLB lefties in strikeouts (1,562) behind Clayton Kershaw (2,922), Chris Sale (2,160), Madison Bumgarner (2,070) and Patrick Corbin (1,570).

2022 SEASON: Quintana allowed two earned runs or fewer in 26 starts in the regular season...Posted a season-high 19.1-inning scoreless streak from September 11-28, the longest scoreless streak in by a Cardinals pitcher in 2022... NL Ranks 2022: ERA (2.93, 8th), Games Started (31, T10th), HR/9 IP (0.43, 1st), GIDP/9 IP (1.25, 1st), GIDP (25, T1st).
