THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (0-3 at Cleveland, 2-1 at Washington), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a win over the Rangers last night. Minnesota will continue the series and homestand today with the second of three vs. Texas...they will wrap the series tomorrow afternoon, then begin a four-game series against the Royals from Monday-Thursday.

☞ Minnesota has gone 20-10 in their last 30 games since April 22, tied with Kansas City (20-10) and Los Angeles-NL (20-9) for the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (23-7) and New York-AL (21-10).

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHT SABER FIGHTS: The Twins beat the Rangers last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2, extending their winning streak to three games. Bailey Ober (5-2) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts. Jhoan Duran earned his fifth save and 20th of his career at Target Field, passing Brandon Kintzler and moving into sole possession of fourth on the ballpark's all-time saves list...the offense recorded 10 hits, two apiece from Carlos Correa, Jose Miranda and Christian Vázquez...Alex Kirilloff hit his fourth home run of the season and second in his last six games.

MAX PRODUCTION: Max Kepler is hitting .365 (31-for-85) with 12 doubles, four home runs, 10 walks, 18 RBI, a .433 on-base percentage, a .647 slugging percentage and a 1.080 OPS in his last 27 games, dating back to April 22...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in batting average, third in OPS, fourth in slugging percentage, and sixth in on-base percentage. Kepler has 10 doubles this month, trailing only Aaron Judge (11) for the most in baseball. He is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with a .397 OBP and a .950 OPS in 17 home games this season.

KEP ON KEPPING ON: Max Kepler enters today with 999 career games played and looking to become the 18th Twin to reach the 1,000 games played mark...Joe Mauer was the last Twin to reach 1,000 games — all in a Twins uniform, having done so on July 17, 2012 vs. Baltimore...Carlos Correa was the last player to do it while wearing a Twins uniform, having done so on August 22, 2023 (after playing a majority of his career with Houston)...below are the Twins all-time leaders in games played:

I PLAY RIGHTFIELD: Kepler has played in 855 games in rightfield, 159 have been in centerfield, 16 at designated hitter and three at first base...Max ranks second on the club's all-time list (since 1961) in games in rightfield, trailing Tony Oliva (1137)...he ranks fifth on the all-time list (since 1961) in games in the outfield, behind Kirby Puckett (1696), Torii Hunter (1319), Oliva (1178) and Bob Allison (1020)...Kepler will be the second German-born player to reach the 1,000 games plateau, joining Bill Kuehne, who played in 1,087 games from 1883-1892.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins are 6-2 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, outscoring them 50-35...a win today would give the Twins their third straight series victory over Texas. ☞ Since the start of 2021, 18 of 22 games between these two have been decided by three runs or fewer, while 11 games have been decided by one run. ☞ Since the start of 2019, the Twins have scored 5.5 runs-per-game in 29 games against the Rangers...marks the second most against any AL club in that span, trailing Seattle (5.9). ☞ The Twins have gone 7-1 vs. AL West opponents, going 3-0 at Los Angeles, 3-1 vs. Seattle and 1-0 vs. Texas.

DALLAS DINGERS: The Twins have homered in eight consecutive games against the Rangers, tied for their second-longest active homer streak against any team (also Los Angeles-NL)...their current longest is 10 against Washington...in the current eight-game stretch, the Twins have homered 16 times.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa has reached safely in 14 straight games since May 8, tied for the 12th-longest streak of his career (27 is his long — 2017)...in that span, he has posted a .357 on-base percentage, with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, five RBI, five walks, nine runs scored and a .945 OPS.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis is beginning his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul tonight in Buffalo at 5:05 pm (CT)...Lewis was injured on Opening Day, March 28 at Kansas City, while running the bases and has missed the club's last 50 games with a right quad strain.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1997, the Twins retired Kirby Puckett's number 34...it was the fifth number to be retired by the Twins and now one of nine: Harmon Killebrew (#3), Rod Carew (#29), Tony Oliva (#6), Kent Hrbek (#14), Bert Blyleven (#28), Tom Kelly (#10), Joe Mauer (#7), Jim Kaat (#36) and Jackie Robinson (#42). Puckett is the Twins all-time leader in hits (2,304), doubles (414) and at-bats (7,244).

DOMINANT IN CLEVELAND: Last pitched May 19 at Cleveland, opposite Tanner Bibee, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 loss...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) in a career-high 8.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts...outing began with a Tyler Freeman leadoff single and Andrés Giménez two-run home run...retired 24 of the next 25 batters, the only baserunner being a Gabriel Arias on a fifth-inning double...Minnesota tied the game 2-2 in the top of the ninth but lost on a walk-off three-run home run by Will Brennan.

- ☞ Threw 100 pitches, his most in a start since July 27, 2021 vs. Oakland (102 pitches).
- ☞ Induced 14 whiffs on 56 swings (25%)...ranks in MLB's 48th percentile with a 24.9 percent whiff rate.
- ☞ Allowed 10 hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Cleveland went 3-for-10 on those swings...Paddack ranks in MLB's 34th percentile with a 41.2 percent hard-hit rate.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched May 14 vs. New York-AL, opposite Carlos Rodón, and took his second loss of the season in Minnesota's 5-1 defeat...allowed five runs on a career-high-tying 12 hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed four hits and two runs in the second inning, then a Giancarlo Stanton solo home run in the third...Alex Verdugo added a two-out, two-run double in the fourth.

- ☞ Yankees went 4-for-10 with runners in scoring position vs. Paddack, stranding five runners in 5.0 innings.
- ☞ Induced 13 whiffs on 51 swings (25.5%).
- ☞ Allowed eight hard-hit balls, including his two hardest-hit balls of the season — a 115.1 mph Aaron Judge lineout and Stanton's 114.0 mph, 427-foot home run.

SHERIFF VS. RANGERS: The Austin, TX native has made two career starts vs. the Rangers, going 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER), three walks and eight strikeouts...first matchup came August 19, 2020 at Petco Park; allowed one run on four hits in 6.0 innings...last faced Texas on April 10, 2021 at Globe Life Field, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings.

- ☞ Paddack and Corey Seager faced each other 10 times in Padres-Dodgers matchups from 2019-21; Seager went 4-for-10 with two doubles, a home run and two strikeouts.
- ☞ Was teammates with Texas reliever Kirby Yates in San Diego in 2019; then-rookie Paddack won nine games that season and Yates saved 41.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making sixth home start of the season...has gone 3-1 with a 2.57 ERA (28.0 IP, 8 ER), 0.96 home-runs-per-9.0 innings and 11.25 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 1-1 on the road with a 6.85 ERA (22.1 IP, 17 ER), 2.01 HR/9 and 4.84 K/9...has allowed a .388 batting average on balls in play at home, compared to .312 on the road...five of his eight runs allowed at home came in the last start, May 14 vs. New York-AL.

PLATOON SPLITS: On May 19, Cleveland's left-handed hitters went 1-for-18 with a home run and four strikeouts vs. Paddack, while its righties went 2-for-9 with a double and two strikeouts...through nine games vs. Paddack, lefties have hit .303 (33-for-109) with a .748 OPS and 17.7 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .297 (30-for-101) with an .812 OPS and 25.0 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Has induced a 22.2 percent whiff rate vs. lefties, 27.9 percent vs. righties.

THE ARSENAL: Has thrown a four-pitch mix through nine starts, per Baseball Savant...here are his pitch usage and results thus far in 2024:

- ☞ May 19 at Cleveland, hitters went 1-for-7 vs. the changeup with six whiffs on 18 swings...pitch has a career-low 22.8 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ 4-seamer has a 41.4 percent whiff rate when Paddack's ahead in the count...opponents have hit .278 (10-for-36) with 17 strikeouts in those situations...the pitch's 29.8 percent putaway rate ranks fourth in baseball (min. 50 PA).
- ☞ 4-seamer is averaging 10.8 inches of arm-side horizontal break, the sixth highest among right-handed pitchers this season (min. 250 4-seamers)...teammate Joe Ryan ranks fifth on that list with an 11.5-inch average.

IN CONTROL: Ranks in baseball's 88th percentile this season with a 4.5 percent walk rate...has issued two-or-fewer walks in 38-straight appearances (35 starts); last three-walk outing came April 4, 2021 vs. Arizona...has issued 1.8 walks-per-9.0-innings in his career (2019-present), the ninth lowest in baseball during that span (min. 350.0 IP).

PITCHING DEEP: Paddack's start in Cleveland was Minnesota's first of 8.0-or-more innings this season and fourth since the beginning of 2023.

Right-hander Pablo López is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale vs. Texas...last pitched May 20 at Washington, allowing a season-high seven runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts, taking the loss in a 12-3 Twins setback...was tied with July 15, 2023 at Oakland for his most runs allowed in a start with Minnesota (2023-present)...has made two career starts vs. Texas, going 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (10.0 IP, 10 ER), four walks and 10 strikeouts...last faced Texas on August 24, 2023 at Target Field and allowed a career-high-tying three home runs in a 7-5 Twins win.
