## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (25-24) vs. ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (28-20)

May 21, 2026 - Busch Stadium - St. Louis, MO - 12:15 CDT - Game #50/Road #24

RHP Braxton Ashcraft (2-2, 3.09 ERA) vs. RHP Dustin May (3-4, 4.81 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** have split the first two games of this six-game road trip to St. Louis (Tuesday-Thursday) and Toronto (Friday-Sunday) after losing, 9-6 (10 innings), on Tuesday and winning, 7-0, on Wednesday at Busch Stadium...Will begin a seven-game homestand vs. Chicago-NL (May 25-28) and Minnesota (May 29-31) following this road trip... Are in the final game of a stretch of 25 consecutive games against the National League (their last game against an American League opponent came on April 23 at Texas)...Have the seventh-best run differential (+22, 242-220) in Major League Baseball, behind Atlanta (+98), Los Angeles-NL (+98), Milwaukee (+75), New York-AL (+69), Tampa Bay (+40) and Chicago-NL (+28).

**THE AMERICAN WAY:** Pittsburgh will depart for Toronto following today's game to begin a three-game series at Rogers Centre (Friday-Sunday)...It marks the Pirates' fifth trip to "The Six" (also 2003, 2011, 2017 and 2024)...Pittsburgh is 6-3 vs. the American League this year...The Pirates went 3-0 vs. Baltimore (April 3-5), 2-1 vs. Tampa Bay (April 17-19) and 1-2 at Texas (April 21-23).

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Pirates would win their fourth consecutive road series against the National League Central to begin the season with a win today at St. Louis (they won two of three games from March 30-April 1 at Cincinnati, won two of three games from April 10-12 at Chicago and won two of three games from April 24-26 at Milwaukee)...The only other time Pittsburgh won at least each of its first three road series against the division in a season (the division formed in 1994) came in 2011 (it won two of three games from April 1-3 at Chicago, two of three from April 4-6 at St. Louis and three of four from April 15-18 at Cincinnati).

**SHUT 'EM DOWN:** Pittsburgh recorded its sixth shutout of the season with Wednesday's 7-0 win at St. Louis...The Pirates also picked up shutouts on April 10 at Chicago-NL (2-0), April 15 vs. Washington (2-0), April 24 at Milwaukee (6-0), May 3 vs. Cincinnati (1-0) and May 6 at Arizona (1-0)...Pittsburgh's six shutouts are tied with Boston and Los Angeles (NL) for the second-most in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Texas (seven)...The Pirates' 25 shutouts since the start of last year lead Major League Baseball.

**STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM:** The Pirates' No. 6-9 hitters in the lineup combined to go 10-for-18 with five runs scored in Wednesday's 7-0 win at Busch Stadium...Konnor Griffin (No. 6) was 4-for-5 with three runs, Endy Rodríguez (No. 7) was 2-for-3 with two walks and a run, Jhostynxon García (No. 8) was 2-for-5 with an RBI and Jake Mangum (No. 9) was 2-for-5 with an RBI and a run...It was the first time Pittsburgh got at least 10 hits from the bottom four spots of the batting order since April 7, 2023 vs. Chicago (AL), when Connor Joe (No. 7, four hits), Ji Hwan Bae (No. 8, three hits) and Jason Delay (No. 9, three hits) did that in a 13-9 win...The last time the Pirates did that in a road win prior to Wednesday was on May 15, 2008 at St. Louis, when Doug Mientkiewicz (No. 6, three hits), Ronny Paulino (No. 7, two hits), Chris Gomez (No. 8, three hits) and Jason Bay/Raúl Chávez (No. 9, pinch hitters, one hit apiece) accomplished that in an 11-5 win.

**KING KONNOR:** Konnor Griffin went 4-for-5 with three runs scored in Wednesday's 7-0 win at Busch Stadium...It was his second four-hit game (also May 2 vs. Cincinnati)...He was the first Pittsburgh rookie with at least four hits and three runs scored in a game since Jared Triolo on September 23, 2023 at Cincinnati...Griffin is batting .348 (32-for-92) with nine extra-base hits, 12 RBI, 16 runs scored and a .918 OPS over his last 24 games, dating back to April 24 at Milwaukee (his 20th birthday)...He ranks tied for third among all Major League hitters in hits and fifth in batting during that stretch.

**LET'S GO REYNOLDS:** Bryan Reynolds had a two-run double on Wednesday at St. Louis, marking his second straight multi-RBI game (also had a two-run double on Tuesday at Busch Stadium)...Reynolds has never had multiple RBI in three straight games (the last Pirate with a double and multiple RBI in three consecutive contests was Starling Marte from September 21-23, 2015).

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 21, 1959: Harvey Haddix allowed two runs and struck out seven batters while tossing a complete game in Pittsburgh's 7-2 win over St. Louis at Busch Stadium. Don Hoak went 3-for-4 with two doubles, two RBI, a walk and a run scored, while Bill Virdon also collected three hits in the victory. Bill Mazerowski gave the Pirates the lead for good with a two-run single during the team's three-run first inning.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the second round of the 2018 Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ashcraft had a no-decision after allowing four runs over 6.2 innings of work in Pittsburgh's 11-9, 10-inning loss on May 15 vs. Philadelphia...He left in line for the win (Pirates were up, 8-3) before the Phillies tied it in the ninth/won it in the 10th.

**AGAINST THE CARDINALS:** Ashcraft has a 6.30 ERA (10.0ip/7er) and 12 strikeouts in two career starts against St. Louis...He had a no-decision after allowing one run over 5.2 innings last year on August 28 at Busch Stadium (the Pirates lost, 4-1)...Ashcraft lost an 11-7 decision after giving up six runs in his 4.1 innings on April 28 at PNC Park.

**ON THE ROAD:** Ashcraft is 1-1 with a 2.16 ERA (25.0ip/6er) in four road starts this season...He has allowed a combined three runs over 14.0 innings and has posted a 0.86 WHIP over his last two road starts (April 22 at Texas and May 9 at San Francisco).

**PRIME NINE:** Ashcraft has a 3.09 ERA (55.1ip/19er) and 56 strikeouts (issued 14 walks) over his first nine starts...He is one of five Pirates (six instances) with a sub-3.05 ERA, at least 56 strikeouts and 14 or fewer walks issued over his first nine starts of a season since earned runs became an official statistic in the National League in 1912, joining Gerrit Cole (2015), Mitch Keller (2023), Jared Jones (2024) & Paul Skenes (2024, 2026).

**RISPY BUSINESS:** Ashcraft has limited opposing hitters to a .086 batting average against (3-for-35) with runners in scoring position...He has allowed just two hits in 26 at-bats with runners in scoring position over his last six starts, dating back to April 16 vs. Washington (single from Jordan Walker and double from Alec Burleson on April 28).

**AND THE WHIFF:** Ashcraft's 36 strikeouts during April ranked sixth in the National League, behind Los Angeles' Tyler Glasnow (41), Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (40), Philadelphia's Cristopher Sanchez (40), teammate Paul Skenes (38) and New York's Nolan McLean (37)...The 36 strikeouts also ranked 12th in all of Major League Baseball.

**HISTORIC STRETCH:** Ashcraft had at least eight strikeouts while issuing one/zero walks and allowing one/zero runs in back-to-back starts on April 5 vs. Baltimore and April 11 at Chicago (NL)...He joined Bob Friend (Aug. 20-24, 1959), Rick Rhoden (June 21-27, 1986), Joe Musgrove (Sept. 20-26, 2020), Mitch Keller (May 8-14, 2023) and Paul Skenes (Sept. 4-10, 2025) as the only Pirates in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have consecutive starts with at least eight strikeouts, one/zero hits and one/zero walks.

**A BIT OF BOTH:** Ashcraft went 1-2 with a 2.16 ERA (33.1ip/8er) in eight starts last season, while also going 3-2 with a 3.22 ERA (36.1ip/13er) in 18 relief appearances...His lone win as a member of Pittsburgh's starting rotation came on August 22 vs. Colorado, when he allowed one hit and struck out six batters over 5.0 scoreless innings.

**THREE'S COMPANY:** Ashcraft pitched at least 3.0 innings and allowed one or zero runs in each of his first six Major League starts, joining Los Angeles' Fernando Valenzuela in 1981 (seven starts) as the only pitchers in the Modern Era (since 1901) to accomplish that...The streak was snapped last year on Sept. 15 vs. Chicago-NL (gave up three runs).

**REMARKABLE ROOKIES:** Ashcraft struck out six batters over 3.0 perfect innings of relief during his penultimate appearance last season, which came on September 20 vs. the Athletics...He became the third Pirates reliever during the Modern Era (since 1901) to accomplish that feat, joining Bob Patterson (May 25, 1991 vs. Philadelphia) and Chan Ho Park (October 1, 2010 at Florida)...Ashcraft also joined starter Bubba Chandler, who had six strikeouts and zero walks, as the only pair of Pirates pitchers in the Modern Era to each have at least six strikeouts while also issuing zero walks in the same game.
