FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Pirates play the finale of a three-game series today at PNC Park as the Cardinals continue their seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (1-1) and Washington D.C. (4G) ... The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 7.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis (29-17, .630) is tied with Philadelphia for MLB's 3rd-best record.

HAPPY FLIGHT: The Redbirds have won 11 of their last 12 series finales since May 22 (vs. Orioles, vs. Cubs, at Cincinnati, at Philadelphia, at Houston, vs. Rockies, vs. Pirates, at Cubs, vs. Giants, vs. Braves, & vs. Reds), and are 13-14 overall in the final game of series this season.

INDEPENDENCE DAY: The Cardinals are 94-97-2 all-time on the 4th of July (42-55-1 on the road), including a 15-8 mark since 2000 (won eight straight from 2000-07, but dropped their last three from 2021-23) ... Today is the Cards 6th straight Independence Day road game (2018-24).

- The Cardinals and Pirates face off for the first time since 2016 in St. Louis (4-2 STL loss), and celebrate Independence Day together in the city of Pittsburgh for the first time since **1996** at Three Rivers Stadium (7-1 STL win), coinciding with **Tony La Russa's** first and **Jim Leyland's** final seasons with their respective franchises.
- St. Louis is 11-19-1 all-time against the Pirates on our Nation's birthday, including a 10-16-1 mark in Pittsburgh that has included 13 doubleheaders (1898, 1907, 1911, 1913, 1917, 1921, 1923, 1927, 1929, 1931, 1933, 1977, & 1983).
- The 2024 and 1996 matchups in Pittsburgh are the only times that St. Louis haven't played doubleheaders in the Steel City.

HOT DOGS & SPARKLERS: Some past Cards July 4th games to remember:

- **1945: Augie Bergamo** had eight hits, helping the Cardinals sweep a twinbill from the Giants, 8-4 and 19-2 ... The Redbird right fielder had 11 total bases & 8 RBI at the Polo Grounds in the nightcap when he had three singles, a two-run homer, and a grand slam.
- **1984: Ricky Horton** strikes out five Giants in 7.0 innings in the Cardinals 4-3 win at Candlestick Park in G1 of a doubleheader.
- **1992: Todd Zeile** rips an RBI single off **Rod Beck** to score **Félix José** in the top of the 13th inning for a 1-0 win over the Giants at Candlestick Park ... **Bob Tewksbury** tossed 8.0 scoreless in the no-decision.
- **2000:** Becoming just the third Cardinal in history to homer in his first career plate appearance, **Keith McDonald** collects a pinch hit home run in a 14-3 win over the Reds.
- **2007: Chris Duncan & Brendan Ryan** homer as **Brad Thompson** hurls 7.0 IP & singles in the Cards 5-4 win over Arizona at Busch.
- **2008: Albert Pujols** hits 300th career HR off the Cubs **Bob Howry** for the Redbirds lone run in a 2-1 loss at Busch Stadium.
- **2019:** Rookie leadoff hitter **Tommy Edman** hits a GW 2-run single in the 7th inning at Seattle for a come-from-behind 5-4 win.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO THE SECRET WEAPON: Happy 61st birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer & Minor League Instructor **José Oquendo** ... Other notables sharing America's birthday include former All-Star third baseman **Vinny Castilla** (57), 1986 Manager of the Year **Hal Lanier** (82), former Yankees owner **George Steinbrenner** (b. 1930), former Orioles owner **Peter Angelos** (b. 1929), former Raiders owner **Al Davis** (b. 1929), mobster **Meyer Lansky** (b. 1902), & 30th President **Calvin Coolidge** (b. 1872).

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT!: **Brendan Donovan's** has reached base safely in 16 consecutive games since June 16 (.355/.412/.548, 22-62), tied for MLB's 4th-longest active on-base safely streak.

HEL'S BELLS: Reigning NL Reliever of the Month **Ryan Helsley** has nailed down a Cardinals record 31 straight save opportunities since April 1, MLB's longest active save streak since MIL's **Josh Hader** (32 straight from July 18, 2021-June 5, 2022) ... Helsley has recorded a team-record 31 saves prior to All-Star break, T-8th in MLB single-season history & most since SEA's **Edwin Diaz** (36 in 2018).

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Michael Siani's younger brother, **Sammy Siani**, was selected by Pittsburgh with the 37th overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft and is an outfielder for Altoona (AA) in the Pirates organization.

Nolan Arenado (2009) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

David Bednar was teammates of **Miles Mikolas**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, and **Nolan Arenado** on Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (SS).

Wilson Contreras (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Sonny Gray** (July 10, 2013 at PNC Park), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Drew Rom** (Aug. 21, 2023 at PNC Park) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Marco Gonzales pitched parts of three seasons in St. Louis (2014-15, '17)...was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#19) of 2013 MLB Draft...2014 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year...traded to Seattle for **Tyler O'Neill** (July 21, 2017).

2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58).

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill...caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois Univ.

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22)...traded to Pittsburgh with **Malcom Nunez** for **José Quintana** and **Chris Stratton** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 7th start of the season and 17th career. It's his first career start vs. the Pirates after facing them 13 times in relief to begin his career.
- Pitching on Independence Day for the first time in his MLB career (2022-24) and 2nd time as a professional. Started July 4, 2019 with Rookie State College at Mahoning Valley (3.0 IP) in his 2nd career outing after being drafted by St. Louis.
- Had seven days between starts prior to his last outing vs. CIN (6/28) after starting the game at Rickwood Field on June 20.
- Started and earned the win vs. SF (6/20) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala. Joined **Alan Benes** (4/19/1997 vs. SD) as the only two Cardinals starting pitchers to earn a win at a neutral site game.
- Has been involved in the decision in all six of his starts this season alternating wins and losses over the first five games before winning back-to-back decisions (W-L-W-L-W-W).
- Made six starts this season and has thrown three scoreless starts (5/29 at CIN - 6.0 IP; 6/9 vs. COL - 5.0 IP; 6/28 vs. CIN - 5.1 IP).
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP last Wed. (5/29) in start at CIN.
- Is 7-5, 3.94 ERA in 16 career starts (82.1 IP/36 ER) and 4-1, 2.52 ERA (39.1 IP/11 ER) in seven career home starts at Busch Stadium. Has won his last three straight home starts dating back to 2022.
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine MLB relief appearances before his option on April 21.
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Since his 7/31/22 start at WSH, was 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA over 90 relief appearances with 19 Holds and 63 strikeouts over 104.0 innings pitched. Leads Cardinals with 90 appearances since his 7/31/22 start at WSH. Giovanni Gallegos ranks 2nd with 89.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 100 vs. PHI on July 10, 2022.

LAST TIME OUT

- Threw 5.1 innings allowing just four hits (one double) in a 1-0 win over the Reds, the Cardinals first 1-0 win of the 2024 season.
- Extended his consecutive scoreless inning streak against the Reds to 11.1 innings.

- Making his first career start after appearing in relief in his first 13 career games against the Pirates.
- Pitched 1.1 innings for a Hold on Aug. 23, 2023 at PNC Park en route to a 6-4 Cardinals win, bridging the gap for the Cardinals lone win in Pittsburgh last season avoiding a season sweep in the City of Bridges.
- Has faced the Pirates 2nd-most of any MLB team in his career (Cincinnati, 14).

CAREER

- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Was the only player from the Cardinals non-roster invite list to make the Opening Day roster in 2022. Made the Opening Day roster in St. Louis each year from 2022-24.
- Pitched over 50.0 IP as both a starting pitcher and relief pitcher during the 2022 season, making him one of two pitchers in MLB to do so in that season along with Nick Martinez (SD). Was the first Cardinals rookie pitcher since John Urrea in 1977 to accomplish the feat and the first rookie in MLB since Hisanori Takahashi for the New York Mets in 2010.
- Ranked 3rd among National League rookies with 108.0 innings in 2022.
- Led all MLB rookies with 17 ground into double plays in 2022.
- Finished the 2021 Arizona Fall League season with 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings. Named an Arizona Fall League All-Star with a 1.29 ERA, 2nd in the league.
