**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants continue their six-game homestand tonight with the second of three games vs. the Dodgers...SF has won four of its last five, outscoring opponents 23-15 and out-hitting opponents 51-29.

- ▶ Since 2022, SF is 19-40 (.322) vs. the Dodgers, which is the team's fourth-worst winning percentage against any team, and the worst against any NL opponent, over that span.
- ▶ SF will try to beat the Dodgers on consecutive days with a win tonight, something they haven't done in quite a while...the last time the Giants beat the Dodgers on *consecutive days* came June 16-18, 2023 when they swept a three-game series in LA...the last time it happened at home was part of a three-game sweep June 10-12, 2022.
- ▶ Today's game marks the fourth time the Giants will face Shohei Ohtani on the mound (second time as a Dodger)...he's allowed two runs (one earned) in 15.0 innings (0.60 ERA) with 18 strikeouts in the three prior outings with SF going 1-2 in those games.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** RHP Tyler Mahle is set to make his fifth start for the Giants tonight and is looking to rebound from a tough outing last Wednesday in Cincinnati.

- ▶ The former Red was blitzed for eight runs, all of which were earned (matched a career-high), on a career-high four homers while walking a career-high tying five in the Giants' 8-3 loss at Great American Ball Park.
- ▶ Mahle's last start here at home against the Phillies on April 8 was encouraging with 5.2 scoreless innings to go with three hits, four walks and six strikeouts.
- ▶ Against the Dodgers in seven prior starts, Mahle is 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA (16er, 38.2ip)...he faced LA once last season as a member of the Rangers and shut them out over 7.0 innings on April 20 in a tough 1-0 loss at Globe Life Field.

**IT'S THE GRIIIIND:** Last night's win was the Giants' third this season when scoring three or fewer runs...they are now 3-12 in such games with two of the three wins coming since last Thursday (a 3-0 win in Cincinnati before heading to Washington).

- ▶ SF's 15 games this year scoring three or fewer runs are tied for most in the league with the Rockies and just ahead of Kansas City (14) and New York-NL (14).
- ▶ On the flip side, with **OF Jung Hoo Lee** collecting two hits before exiting last night the Giants now have seven players this year who each have 20 or more hits...that's tied with Atlanta and the Dodgers for the most players on a single team this season.
- ▶ The Giants' .251 team average is ninth-best in the Majors (sixth-highest in the NL) while their 197 hits are 10th-most...yet on the flip side SF's 78 runs scored are second-fewest in MLB entering play today just ahead of the Mets (75).

**ON A HEATER...:** **OF Jung Hoo Lee** has been one of the Giants' hottest hitters as of late...dating to the start of the last roadie, Lee is slashing .385/.415/.538 (.953 OPS) with three doubles, a homer, four RBI and five runs scored in 10 games.

- ▶ Lee has raised his batting average nearly 120 points in that time (was hitting .143 entering the trip and enters today hitting .259)...his OPS has jumped nearly 250 points in that same span (.439 to its current mark at .681).

**PEN TO PAPER:** The Giants' bullpen has allowed just two earned runs over their last seven games (0.71 ERA, 25.1ip, 29 strikeouts and nine walks).

- ▶ Since April 7, the SF bullpen has a 1.83 ERA (8er, 39.1ip) over its last 12 games...opponents have hit .174 in that time with a .537 OPS...the 1.83 ERA in that span is best in the Majors, with the next closest team being the Reds (2.33).
- ▶ Overall, the Giants' bullpen has a 3.36 ERA (29er, 77.2ip) for the season, seventh-lowest in the Majors and sixth-lowest in the National League entering play today...in terms of hard-hit rate, the bullpen's 33.5% mark is third-lowest in MLB (S/S).

**IF IT FEELS KIND OF ONE SIDED...WELL?:** Through 23 games, the Giants have a total ABS challenge success rate of 41.0% across their batters, catchers & pitchers...that 41.0% overall success rate is second-lowest in the Majors ahead of only the Nationals (36.1%).

- ▶ Meanwhile Giants' opponents this season have a 75.7% success rate when challenging via the ABS in games against SF.
- ▶ Breaking it down a bit further, Giants hitters have been successful 7-of-17 times (41.2%), which is 23rd of 30 MLB clubs.
- ▶ SF's catchers have a 42.9% success rate (9-for-21), 28th of 30 teams while SF's pitchers have only challenged one call unsuccessfully.

APRIL 22, 1991  
**Robby Thompson** of the San Francisco Giants hit for the cycle in a 7-5 loss to the San Diego Padres. Thompson tripled in the 1st inning, hit a home run in the 3rd, singled in the 6th and doubled in the 9th.

**2026 RECORD: 0-3, 7.23 ERA**

**WELCOME TO SF:** Mahle is in his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5 and is still seeking his first win of the season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his first road start of the season last Wednesday at Cincinnati...suffered the loss after matching a career-high eight earned runs over 4.0 innings of work...also matched a career-high five walks and surrendered four homers for the first time in his career...while he usually relies on his four-seam fastball and splitter (throws them 72.3% of the time), Mahle mixed up his five pitches almost evenly in the start, throwing his four-seamer (22 pitches), slider (20p), splitter (18p), cutter (17p) and sinker (12p).

**VS. LOS ANGELES-NL:** Will face the Dodgers for the eighth time in his career as he gets his first taste of the rivalry tonight...the right-hander last faced LA almost exactly a year ago, on April 20, 2025 while with the Rangers...he took a no-decision despite a stellar start, tossing 7.0 shutout innings with just two hits, three walks and four strikeouts...overall, Mahle is 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA in seven career starts vs. LA.

**STRANGER THINGS:** Mahle's rocky start to the season is due in part to a couple of odd outliers...his 6.8% home run rate this season is double his career average (3.4%) and ranks as the second-highest such rate in the Majors this season (min. 15ip), trailing only WSH's Zack Littell (7.9%)...additionally, the righty is walking batters at a rate of 13.6% this year, compared to his 8.6% career walk rate.

**STAY GROUNDED:** In contrast, the 31-year-old is averaging a 52.7% ground ball rate this year, a significant increase from last year's 38.6% mark and well above his 42.0% career rate.

**NOT SO FAST:** Mahle's main pitch, the four-seamer, has been causing him the most issues early in the season...batters are 11-for-26 (.423) off his four-seam fastball this year with six extra-base hits (2B, 3B, four HRs)...has been throwing the pitch 44.4% of the time while recording a -6 run value...last year, he held batters to a .209 (27x147) clip with the pitch with 10 total XBH.

**SPRING CLEANING:** In four Cactus League starts this spring, Mahle tossed 10.0 scoreless innings with just two hits and 13 strikeouts, going 3-0 in those starts...he also made one exhibition start on March 22 at Triple-A Sacramento, where he gave up just one run on one hit over 5.0 innings of work.

**2025 SEASON:** Spent the 2025 season with the Texas Rangers under the reins of Bruce Bochy...posted a 6-4 record over 16 starts and set career-bests in ERA (2.18), opponents' batting average (.218), opposing OPS (.593) and home runs per nine innings (0.52) (min. 10 starts)...overall, the righty tossed 86.2 innings in the 16 starts with a 1.13 WHIP.

**EARLY BIRD:** Last season, the right-hander was named the Rangers Player of the Month for March/April after going 3-0 with a 1.14 ERA and 0.98 WHIP in six starts through April...he led all American League pitchers in ERA, opponents' OPS (.465) and slugging percentage (.211) in the first month of the season.

**COMING IN HOT:** Mahle's hot start carried into May as he sported a 5-1 record with a 1.47 ERA (9er, 55.0ip) and a 0.98 WHIP over his first 10 starts of the 2025 season...he had a 1.64 ERA (12er, 66.0ip) in 12 starts through the end of May.

**THE LONG BALL:** He began his 2025 campaign by tossing a career-best 40.2 homerless innings, marking the longest homerless streak to start the season among any starter in the Majors last year...the right-hander permitted just five home runs in 86.2 innings all year (0.52 HR/9ip).

**BANANA SPLIT:** His most valuable pitch last season was his splitter, which he used 27.7% of the time...the pitch had a +5 run value, with opponents hitting just .196 off his split-finger with 25 strikeouts (24.0% whiff rate).

**IL STINT:** His impressive start to the season was interrupted by a shoulder injury that sidelined him for most of the year...was placed on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder fatigue on June 15 (retro to June 12) and transferred to the 60-day IL on July 1...missed over three months of play and was reinstated on September 18...following his return, he made another two starts, allowing one earned run over 9.2 innings (0.93 ERA). =

- ▶ Looks to try and get back on track tomorrow against the Dodgers in his sixth start of the year.
- ▶ Earned the win last time out in DC on Friday despite allowing four runs (three earned) in 6.0 innings as SF won 10-5.
- ▶ Faces LA for the 21st time in his career...went 2-2 with a 5.79 ERA in four starts against them last year...is 6-8 with a 4.47 ERA (54er, 108.2ip) in 20 career starts vs. LA.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-17 (.117) with two walks and six strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (69-for-386) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 8-for-15 with four XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/19 at WSH; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ Eight of his nine appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has issued at least one walk in six of nine contests (6.35 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-27 (.333) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-13 (.077).
- ▶ Three of his nine appearances thus far have been 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 0.2ip, bb (14 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are just 1-for-12 (.083) against him this season, and 18-for-95 in his career (.189).
- ▶ Has appeared in 11 of SF's 23 games, tossing 10.0 innings and allowing two earned runs (1.80 ERA).
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 4/18 at WSH; W, 2.0ip, bb, 2k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first MLB win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief on Saturday...stranded the free base runner in both the 11th & the 12th.
- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits in 10.0 innings with 14 strikeouts and six walks in 10 games.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

### #60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in his last five appearances dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia.
- ▶ Has appeared in nine of SF's 23 games, allowing four runs in 8.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 53.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fourth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

### #46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/17 at WSH; 1.0ip, hbp (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in five of his six outings (2er, 8.0ip) and posted a 0.75 WHIP and .192 BAA.
- ▶ Has only walked one batter in 8.0ip this season (3.6% walk rate).
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

### #74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; SV, 1.0ip, 2k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Bounced back last night to earn his second save of the season after blowing his most recent opportunity at Washington.
- ▶ Has appeared in 10 of SF's first 23 games.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB...this season it sits at 82.7 mph, which is seventh-best in the Majors.
- ▶ Batters are 3-for-18 in ABs that end with his slider and 6-for-20 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. LAD; 0.1ip, k (5 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with four holds on the season after striking out Will Smith to end the 8th inning last night.
- ▶ Nine of his 11 appearances this year have been scoreless...opponents are just 4-for-33 (.121) off him this year.
- ▶ Struck out 13 batters in 9.2 innings of work.
- ▶ Batters are just 1-for-19 with 11 K's off his splitter this season.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.
