TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to both snap their current three-game losing streak, while also extending their four-game winning streak over the Cardinals in tonight's series-opener.

- ▶ SF needs to win just one of its final 12 games to avoid the second 100-loss season in team history (the club went 62-100 in 1985).

VS. ST. LOUIS: The Giants will again take on the Cardinals after sweeping them back in SF a week ago (3-0).

- ▶ The sweep snapped a run of four straight series defeats to the Cardinals dating to the start of the 2024 season.
- ▶ Only three position players on SF's active roster have played a game at Busch Stadium...**OF Jung Hoo Lee** and **OF Drew Gilbert** both have played three games here in STL while **C Andrew Knizner** has played 126 games (the majority coming as a Cardinals catcher from 2019-2023).

WELCOME BACK TONY: This series marks the return of **MGR Tony Vitello** to his hometown after growing up in St. Louis...Vitello expects to have a significant contingent of family and friends on hand for this series...Vitello attended De Smet High School where he played baseball for his father, Greg, who also coached high school soccer for the Spartans...Greg is a member of the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame for his 46 years of coaching high school baseball and soccer in the St. Louis area.

TODAY'S STARTER: **RHP Landen Roupp** will make his second straight start against the Cardinals (both opposed by Quinn Mathews).

- ▶ Roupp earned the win last time out over STL with 6.0 shutout innings on Sept. 8 at Oracle Park...per *Stats, LLC*, the last SF pitcher to log two consecutive starts of 6.0+ scoreless innings, both vs. the same opponent, was **Ryan Jensen** in April of 2002 vs. LAD.
- ▶ The righty's curveball is his best breaking ball with a 24.2% putaway rate and 34.4.% whiff rate...the Cardinals' 714 OPS vs. curveballs is fourth-best in MLB this season.

ROAD STRUGGLES: SF enters tonight's game with a 26-49 record on the road this season.

- ▶ The last time SF lost 50 games on the road in a season was 2018 (31-50)...the Giants have lost 50+ road games in a season just six times in the SF era (since 1958), doing so in 2018 (31-50), 2017 (26-55), 1996 (30-50), 1992 (30-51), 1985 (24-57) and 1984 (31-50).
- ▶ SF pitchers have a 4.75 ERA on the road, the seventh-highest road ERA in MLB.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: **OF Scott Bandura** made his MLB debut yesterday, recording his first MLB hit (a single in the 6th)...he became the 16th SF player to make his MLB debut this season, tying a franchise record from 2008...the 16 debuts are also most in MLB in 2026.

- ▶ Bandura also became the 67th Giant to appear in a game this season, which is a franchise record (previous: 66 in 2022)...the 67 players used by SF is tied with 2019 Seattle for the sixth-most players used in a single season in MLB history (*Stats, LLC*).

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: **IF Bryce Eldridge** added two hits and an RBI in yesterday's game...he is batting .301 (41x136) with 13 runs, eight doubles, five homers, 28 RBI and an .849 OPS since the start of August (36 games).

- ▶ His 54 RBI this season are the most by a Giants rookie since **Mike Yastrzemski** had 55 RBI in 2019, while his 22 doubles are tied with Yastrzemski's 22 doubles in 2019 for most by a Giants rookie since **Matt Duffy** had 28 doubles in 2015.
- ▶ Overall, Giants rookies have 30 homers and a .717 OPS this season...the 30 rookie homers are the most by SF rookies since 2023 (33 homers) and the .717 OPS by rookies this season is the best by the Giants since 2015 (.734 OPS).

CONGRATS, WEBBY: **RHP Logan Webb** was named SF's nominee for the 2026 Roberto Clemente Award...the Roberto Clemente Award is the annual recognition of a Major League player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field.

PLAYOFFS?: Two Giants Minor League affiliates are still in Postseason play in Single-A San Jose and Double-A Richmond...San Jose dropped its series opener in Lake Elsinore yesterday 12-1 in what was Game 1 of the CAL League Championship Series...Game 2 will be played tomorrow in San Jose...Richmond wrapped its regular season yesterday and will begin its Eastern League Divisional best-of-three series tomorrow at Erie.

ROUPPER: Roupp is in his third season with the Giants...the newly-minted 28-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

ON A HEATER: He is 2-0 with a 1.13 ERA (2er, 16.0ip), nine strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP over his last three starts.

VS. ST. LOUIS: Will be making his second straight start against the Cardinals...earned the win at home on September 8 after allowing two hits and four walks while striking out two across 6.0 shutout innings...he also faced them in September of 2024, allowing six runs on nine hits (one homer) and two walks while striking out four over 3.2 innings at Oracle Park...has yet to pitch at St. Louis.

HIT-OR-MISS: The Giants are 10-18 this season in games started by Roupp...he's taken a decision in 22 of his 28 starts (9-13)...when looking at team results, Roupp has a 5.97 ERA (59er, 89.0ip) in his 18 starts when the Giants lose compared to a 1.17 ERA (8er, 61.2ip) in all 10 Giants wins.

CALLING CARD: Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, his curve has a whiff rate of 34.4%, a putaway rate of 24.2% and a run value of +6...his 57 strikeouts with a curveball this season are T-9th most in MLB.

CHANGE IT UP: His changeup usage spiked back up to 17 total times thrown last start after he used it just six total times in the previous start...the offspeed pitch has been one of his better pitches this season (+6 run value)...opponents are batting .143 (9x63) with 11 strikeouts and two extra-base hits off his changeup since July 6.

LET THAT SINK IN: His sinker has not generated much swing and miss...it has a whiff rate of 8.1%, which is lowest in MLB (min. 300 total swings)...he has just one strikeout with his sinker over his last 12 games, and 21 total strikeouts with his sinker on the season.

CUTT TO THE CHASE: With his sinker troubles, Roupp's cutter has gained importance...since July 22, opponents are batting .059 (1-for-17) vs. his cutter with four strikeouts and zero extra-base hits.

WHAT'S THE COUNT?: Roupp's 174 plate appearances this year in which the count reached three balls are third-most in MLB behind Robbie Ray (178) and Dylan Cease (179)...Roupp's 4.12 pitches per batter faced is the second-highest in MLB (min. 150.0ip) behind only TOR's Dylan Cease (4.22) while his 17.4 pitches per inning pitched is third-highest.

NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED: The righty's 29.2% hard hit rate this season is the lowest in MLB (min. 350 batted ball events) while his 3.1% barrels per plate appearance is second-lowest behind Dylan Cease's 2.8% mark...his 50.8% ground ball rate is fifth-highest in MLB among qualified pitchers.

AFRAID OF THE DARK: The majority of Roupp's struggles have come in night games...he is 7-9 with a 4.36 ERA (48er, 99.0ip) in 19 night games...comparatively, is 2-4 with a 3.31 ERA (19er, 51.2ip) in nine day games.

HOMESICK: He is 5-7 with a 3.69 ERA (29er, 70.2ip) in 13 home games...in 15 road games, he is 4-6 with a 4.28 ERA (38er, 80.0ip).

SUCH GREAT HEIGHTS: Roupp's 150.2 innings, 139 strikeouts, 28 games/starts, nine wins and 1.28 WHIP are all career bests.
