**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants look to earn a series split with a win in today's finale vs. the Brewers...SF currently trails 2-1 in the series, with Milwaukee outscoring the Giants 24-6.

- ▶ The Giants have lost seven of their last nine games, eight of their last 12 games, and 14 of their last 20 games dating to May 13... since May 13, SF's 6-14 (.300) record is the fourth-worst mark in MLB over that span.
- ▶ With yesterday's win, the Giants are now 24-19 (.558) vs. the Brewers since 2019, which is the best record in MLB over that span (min. 15 games vs. MIL)...they are one of three National League teams with a winning record vs. the Brewers since 2019, joining the Dodgers (23-20, .535) and the Phillies (20-18, .526).
- ▶ The Giants are batting .312 through the first six games of this road trip...the last time they hit .310 or better on a road trip of six or more games was September 6-12, 2021 (.333).

**TODAY'S STARTER:** RHP Adrian Houser looks to earn the win against his former team.

- ▶ Houser pitched the first seven years of his MLB career (2015, 2018-2023) with the Brewers, going 31-34 with a 4.00 ERA (240er, 539.1ip) in 129 games (97 starts)...his 523.2 innings pitched from 2019-2023 were third-most by a Brewers pitcher in that span behind only Corbin Burnes (671.1ip) and Brandon Woodruff (595.0ip).
- ▶ In his last outing, May 30 at COL, Houser was roughed up for four runs on eight hits over 3.2 innings...he allowed six hits (one homer) in eight at-bats that ended with his sinker.
- ▶ Even with the last outing, the righty went 2-2 with a 3.81 ERA (11er, 26.0ip), 19 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP over five starts in May.

**DON'T STOP ME NOW:** OF Jung Hoo Lee extended his hitting to 11 games yesterday, which is tied for the best mark of his career (also April 7-20, 2024)...the streak is the longest by a Giants batter since **Dominic Smith** had a 15-game streak July 18-August 12 last season.

- ▶ Over this current 11-game streak, Lee is batting .488 (20x41) with eight runs, two doubles, a triple, a homer, six RBI and a 1.159 OPS.
- ▶ The last Giants batter with 20+ hits in an 11-game span was **Brandon Crawford** (July 2-18, 2021)...the last Giants outfielder with 20+ hits in an 11-game span was **Kevin Pillar** with 21 hits from August 6-17, 2019.

**A MEMORABLE 1ST:** OF Victor Bericoto hit his first MLB home run in yesterday's 1-0 win.

- ▶ It marked the first time that SF won 1-0 where the only run was scored on a first career home run since **Darren Lewis** on August 7, 1991 at Atlanta (Lewis' was a leadoff homer).
- ▶ It was also just the third time in team history where the only run in a Giants win was scored on a first career homer (also **Bill Taylor** on June 10, 1954 vs. the Milwaukee Braves) per *Stats, LLC*.
- ▶ Bericoto's homer also went to the opposite field...it marked just the eighth time since 2000 that a Giants batter hit their first career homer to the opposite field (not counting left-center or right-center) as shown in the table above.

**WEBBY:** RHP Logan Webb threw 6.1 no-hit innings yesterday, which was the longest no-hit bid by an SF pitcher since the no-hitter by **Blake Snell** on August 2, 2024 at Cincinnati.

- ▶ He is one of four pitchers since 2023 with three or more wins in which their offense scored just one run, joining Nick Martinez (three), Luis Castillo (three) and George Kirby (four).

**THE BRYCE IS RIGHT:** IF Bryce Eldridge reached base two more times yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 10 games...over this 10-game on-base streak, Eldridge is slashing .400/.486/.700 with eight runs, six doubles, a homer, three RBI and a 1.186 OPS.

- ▶ Eldridge's 58.3% hard hit rate is fifth-best in MLB (min. 25 batted ball events).

**WHAT'S NEXT?:** Following today's game, the Giants will hit the road and head to Chicago to take on the Cubs for a three-game series this weekend.

- ▶ Tomorrow's opener vs. the Cubs kicks off the final series of a three city, 10-game road trip that first went through Colorado (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-2).
- ▶ Last season SF went 5-1 vs. the Cubs, outscoring them 40-23...SF went 2-1 in Chicago.

## THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

JUNE 4, 2009

The Giants beat the Nationals 5-1 in the first half of a doubleheader. **Randy Johnson** allowed two hits and one run in 6.0 innings to win his 300th career game. He was the first pitcher since Tom Seaver in 1985 to join the 300 win club on his first try, and the second-oldest after Phil Niekro. This milestone came on the 10th anniversary of his 150th career win, and 20th anniversary of his fifth career win.

# ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

**2026 RECORD: 2-5, 5.59 ERA**

**Height/Weight:** 6-4/227 **Bats/Throws:** R/R  
**Hometown:** Locust Grove, OK  
**Age:** 33 (February 2, 1993) **Signed Through:** 2027

**YO ADRIAN:** Is in his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason and is making his 12th start of the season tonight.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his fifth loss of the season on Saturday in Colorado after allowing four earned runs (one home run) on eight hits over 3.2 innings...struck out four batters and walked two in the start...it marked his shortest start since August 27, 2023 vs. San Diego (2.0ip).

**VS. MILWAUKEE:** Will face his former team for the first time in his career...Houser made his debut with the Brewers in 2015, spent nearly a decade in the organization and pitched in parts of seven seasons with the club from 2015-2023...Houser had a 4.00 ERA (240er, 539.1ip) in 129 games (97 starts) with Milwaukee and owns 12-16 record and a 3.61 ERA in 66 games (48 starts) at American Family field...the right-hander has faced each of the other 29 teams in MLB and will check his final club off the list today.

**MAY FLOWERS:** Went 2-2 with a 3.81 ERA (11er, 26.0ip) and .253 BAA in five starts in May...had gone just 0-3 with a 7.12 ERA (24er, 30.1ip) and .323 BAA in six starts in April.

**FAST AND FURIOUS:** Recently, Houser's approach has shifted to a heavy reliance on the hard stuff over his breaking pitches... he used his sinker and four-seam fastball as his top two pitches in May in terms of usage, which he hadn't done since May of 2025...the sinker and four-seamer were thrown a combined 65.5% of the time in May and opponents were just 16x69 (.232) against them, compared to a 54% combined usage rate in April and a .316 BAA (24x76)...he's throwing all of his offspeed pitches less, especially his changeup, which went from a 22.6% usage rate in April to a 13.8% rate May.

**MIDDLE MAN:** Has been at his best this season in the middle innings of his outings...in innings 2-4 this season, he has in 3.31 ERA with a 1.19 WHIP, which shrunk to a 2.45 ERA and a 1.09 WHIP over his starts in May...however, in innings 1 and 5 he has an ERA of 9.00 and 10.13, respectively.

**LEFT ON READ:** Lefties are slashing .356/.439/.637 with 15 doubles, a triple, seven homers and a 1.077 OPS in 135 at-bats compared to righties slashing .202/.224/.287 with two doubles, two homers and a .512 OPS in 94 at-bats...amongst pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched this season, Houser's 1.077 OPS vs. left-handed batters is second-highest in the league, behind only COL's Michael Lorenzen (1.238)...on the other hand, his .512 OPS against right-handed batters is 11th-best in the Majors.

**RAMBLIN' MAN:** Houser has been more comfortable on the road than at home this season, posting a 4.79 ERA (19er, 35.2ip) over seven road starts versus a 6.97 ERA (16er, 20.2ip) in four starts at Oracle Park.

**HAPPY DAYS:** Has found success pitching in day games this season, posting a 3.90 ERA (14er, 32.1ip) with a .250 BAA six starts...in night games, he has 7.88 ERA (21er, 24.0ip) with a .347 BAA.

**CONTACT:** Houser has a 13.6% strikeout rate this season, which is third-lowest in the Majors, ahead only of COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (13.6%) and WSH's Zack Littell (13.5%).

**2026 RECORD: 3-6, 4.45 ERA**

**TOMORROW'S STARTER**

- ▶ Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 31 at Coors Field...threw 4.0 innings, allowing three runs (one earned run) on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts in the Giants 19-6 victory over the Rockies... he received 11 runs of support in the victory...it marked his fourth consecutive start that he has not made it past the 5th inning.
- ▶ Is slated to make his eighth career start against the Cubs...has pitched very well against the Cubs over his career, posting a 3-1 record with a 2.20 ERA, 41 strikeouts and .177 opponents average against over his seven outings...has posted even better numbers at Wrigley Field, going 1-1 with a 1.88 ERA and a 0.92 WHIP in four career starts.

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Sunday (second stint with SF)...has surrendered six runs in 2.0ip in two games since his recall and has a 10.80 ERA in four appearances (5.0ip) for SF so far.
- ▶ Had gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25... left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/31 at COL; 1.2ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 8.2 scoreless innings over his last four outings...has a 0.73 ERA (1er, 12.1ip) in his last seven games.
- ▶ Has a 0.61 ERA (1er, 14.2ip) in 11 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 11 of 20 contests (4.5 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .194 (6-for-31) off his slider, .222 (10-for-45) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 6/2 at MIL; 0.1ip, r, er, 2bb (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has made nine appearances with SF, logging 8.0 innings and allowing two runs on four hits with 10 walks and nine strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-14 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 6/2 at MIL; 0.2ip, h, bb (20 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May...had allowed one run in 14.0 innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 10-for-54 (.185) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-41 (.195) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 6/3 at MIL; 0.1ip, h, bb (11 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 14 walks in his 17.2ip (7.13 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 62.2 innings pitched dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-32 (.188) off him while left-handers are 6-for-32 (.188).
- ▶ Holding opponents 2-for-23 (.087) off his slider and 5-for-32 (.156) off his sinker.

### #71 WILKIN RAMOS ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, 4-Seam FB, Curveball

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A Sacramento on Monday and made his MLB debut that night...struck out Christian Yelich in the 6th inning for his first career strikeout.
