**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Birds open a six-day, six-game road trip tonight against the Mariners (3 to play) and Athletics (3 to play)...The O's have won six of their last eight games after going 3-16 in their previous 19...Eight of Baltimore's last nine games have been decided by three runs or fewer, the lone exception being a 5-1 win on May 25 at Boston.

🦅 The Orioles have won a season-high-tying three straight games (also 5/24[G2]-5/26), looking to earn a fourth tonight for the first time since June 26-29, 2024.

🦅 The Birds completed their three-game sweep of the White Sox despite scoring four runs or fewer in each contest, marking their first three-game sweep without scoring more than four runs in a game since April 4-7, 2016 vs. the Twins (*Stats Perform*).

🦅 Baltimore has allowed two runs or fewer in a season-high-tying three straight games (also 5/24[G2]-26)...The Birds last single-season streak of allowing two or fewer runs in four consecutive games came from June 8-12, 2024 (5 G).

🦅 O's pitchers have recorded nine or more strikeouts in a season-best six straight games, their longest run since a seven-game stretch from September 15-22, 2024...Prior to the current streak, they did not strike out more than eight batters in each of the previous seven games from May 19-25.

🦅 Baltimore has stolen 25 bases since May 11, fourth most in the majors during that period behind Tampa Bay (35 SB), Milwaukee (33 SB), and Chicago-NL (27 SB)...**Jorge Mateo** is responsible for nine of the steals, followed by **Gunnar Henderson**, **Jackson Holliday** and **Cedric Mullins** (each 3 SB).

🦅 The Orioles have drawn at least one walk in 136 straight games since July 2, 2024, the longest active stretch in the majors ahead of the Braves (80 G) and Blue Jays (69 G)...It's the second-longest such streak in franchise history behind a 155-game stretch from June 23, 1955-June 24 (G1), 1956.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Yesterday, Baltimore reinstated outfielder **Colton Cowser** (left thumb fracture) from the 60-day Injured List and designated utility man **Cooper Hummel** for assignment...Cowser went 8-for-20 (.400) with four doubles, one home run, four RBI, four walks, and one steal in six rehab appearances between High-A Aberdeen (3 G) and Triple-A Norfolk (3 G).

🦅 Earlier today, catcher **Chadwick Tromp** elected free agency in lieu of accepting an outright assignment to Norfolk.

**STREAKING SUGANO:** **Tomoyuki Sugano** has allowed two walks or fewer in each of his first 11 starts, tied with **Mark Williamson** (11 GS, 1987-88) for the third-longest career-opening run by an Oriole starter in team history behind **Josh Towers** (23 GS, 2001-02) and **Tyler Wells** (13 GS, 2022).

🦅 Sugano has also allowed four runs or fewer in each start, joining MIN's Pablo López (10 GS, active) as the only MLB starters to have allowed four runs or less and walk two batters or fewer in each of their first 10 outings of the season.

**A MAY TO REMEMBER:** **Ryan O'Hearn** slashed .365/.450/.542 (35-for-96) with five doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, and 13 walks in 26 games last month, ranking among MLB leaders in batting average (5<sup>th</sup>) and on-base percentage (7<sup>th</sup>), while his .992 OPS ranked sixth in the AL...His .365 batting average and .450 on-base percentage were each the highest marks by an Oriole in the month of May (min. 100 PA) since **Brian Roberts** (.385, .485) in 2007.

🦅 His career-best and active 18-game on-base streak is tied for the third-longest active run in the majors and one game shy of **Gunnar Henderson** (19 G, 4/23-5/14) for the longest streak by an Oriole this season.

🦅 O'Hearn has an MLB-best four games with 3+ hits since May 21, outpacing CLE's Steven Kwan, ATH's Brent Rooker, and ATH's Jacob Wilson (each 3 G)...He has five such performances overall in 49 games this year after having two across 142 games in 2024.

**START ME UP:** In 12 games since May 20, Baltimore starters have gone 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (18 ER/64.1 IP), the fifth-lowest ERA by any starting staff in the majors during that period...The O's rotation entered that stretch with a 6.03 ERA (175 ER/226.2 IP), second highest in MLB ahead of the Rockies (6.95).

🦅 Orioles starters have made three straight quality starts for the first time since September 10-14, 2024 (Suárez, Kremer, Eflin, Burnes).

🦅 Overall, Baltimore pitching owns a 4.41 ERA (57 ER/116.1IP) since May 19, ranking 25<sup>th</sup> in the majors...Removing infielder **Emmanuel Rivera's** outing (1.0 IP, 8 ER) on May 23 at Boston, however, the collective ERA falls to 3.83, which would rank 15<sup>th</sup> in MLB.

**HOLLIDAY HEATING UP:** In 34 games since April 23, **Jackson Holliday** is hitting .295/.340/.477 (39-for-132) with seven doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBI, four steals, and an .818 OPS...He opened the season hitting .213 (13-for-61) with one double, one triple, two homers, eight RBI, one steal, and a .633 OPS across 18 games.

🦅 During the current 34-game stretch, Holliday is hitting .314/.368/.486 (22-for-70) with one double, one triple, and three home runs off fastballs (4-seam, sinker, cutter), improving from .156/.250/.281 (5-for-32) with one double and one homer to open the year.

🦅 Holliday is 35-for-125 (.280) with 12 extra-base hits (5 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR) when facing a pitcher the first time in the game and 17-for-48 (.354) with five extra-base hits (3 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR) a second time...When facing the pitcher for a third time, however, he is 0-for-20.

**NOT SO PITCH PERFECT:** The Birds have permitted 88 home runs, the second highest mark in the majors behind the Athletics (91 HR)...Over their last eight games, however, they have only allowed six long balls after allowing 26 over their previous 13 games.

**EMERALD CITY CLASH:** The Orioles and Mariners open a six-game season set tonight in Seattle...The clubs will meet for a three-game series at Oriole Park at Camden Yards from August 12-14...**Colton Cowser** has reached base safely in all six career games opposite Seattle, going 7-for-16 (.438) with two doubles, three RBI, and seven walks.

🦅 **Andrew Kittredge** was born in Spokane, roughly four hours from Seattle, and attended the University of Washington...Was originally selected by the Mariners in the 45<sup>th</sup> round of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign, later signing with them as a non-drafted free agent in 2011.

🦅 O's First Base Coach **Anthony Sanders** played in 10 games with Seattle from 2000-01.

🦅 Michael Plassmeyer, the younger brother of Assistant Pitching Coach/Interim Bullpen Coach **Mitch Plassmeyer**, was selected by the Mariners in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his 12<sup>th</sup> career MLB start...Is the third-ever Japanese player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers Shintaro Fujinami (2023) and Koji Uehara (2009-11)...In his March 30 debut at Toronto, at 35 years, 170 days old, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since NYM's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision on May 27 vs. St. Louis after tossing 5.1 innings, allowing three runs on a career-high-tying eight hits (also 4/12 at TOR) and one home run with no walks and three strikeouts.

⚡ Allowed one run on four hits in the opening frame, including an RBI single to Willson Contreras...Surrendered a two-run shot to Lars Nootbaar in the second... Alec Burleson led off the sixth with a double and advanced to third on a Nolan Arenado fly out before Sugano departed...Gregory Soto stranded Burleson, maintaining a 4-3 Baltimore lead.

**STREAKING SUGANO:** He has allowed four runs or fewer in each of his first 11 starts, the fifth-longest career-opening streak by an Oriole starter in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Jim Hardin** (19 GS, 1967-68), **Tyler Wells** (18 GS, 2022), **Storm Davis** (15 GS, 1982-83), and **Frank Bertaina** (12 GS, 1964-66).

⚡ He has allowed two walks or fewer in each of his first 11 starts, tied with **Mark Williamson** (11 GS, 1987-88) for the third-longest career-opening run by an Oriole starter in team history behind **Josh Towers** (23 GS, 2001-02) and **Tyler Wells** (13 GS, 2022).

**IN CONTROL:** Sugano owns a 3.9 percent walk rate, the fifth-lowest mark among all AL starters and sixth in MLB behind DET's Tarik Skubal (2.5%), SEA's Bryan Woo (3.3%), STL's Matthew Liberatore (3.5%), TB's Zack Littell (3.7%), and TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (3.8%).

**WISE BEYOND HIS YEARS:** He ranks among qualified AL rookies in WHIP (1<sup>st</sup>, 1.06) innings (1<sup>st</sup>, 64.0), wins (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 4), opponent average (T-4<sup>th</sup>, .238), ERA (5<sup>th</sup>, 3.23), and strikeouts (8<sup>th</sup>, 35).

⚡ Since 2000, only four Oriole starters have had a lower ERA through their first 12 career outings: **John Means**: 2.79, **Zack Britton**: 2.93, **Josh Towers**: 3.18, and **Daniel Cabrera** (3.23, by percentage points).

⚡ Sugano has made three starts of at least 7.0 innings, while only six other rookies have done so once (SEA's Logan Evans, TEX's Jack Leiter, ATH's Jacob Lopez, TEX's Kumar Rocker, ATL's AJ Smith-Shawver, and NYY's Will Warren).

**GONE FISHIN':** In his first five starts, Sugano produced a total of 30 swings and misses, but has induced 50 whiffs in his last six starts, including 25 on his splitter.

⚡ In eight starts since April 17, he has limited the opposition to a .130 (7-for-54) clip with 17 strikeouts off his splitter...In his first three starts, opponents hit .333 (6-for-18) with two strikeouts on the offering.

**HOME RUN HOMEWORK:** Despite allowing 11 home runs, eight of the long balls have been solo shots, while the other three were two-run homers...Four have been hit on the first pitch of an at-bat...Eight of the 11 have been hit from innings 1-3, while four have been hit by opponents hitting in the bottom third of the lineup...Seven of the 11 homers have been hit at home.

**BUCKLE DOWN:** Sugano has limited the opposition to a .200 (8-for-40) clip with runners in scoring position, including 2-for-16 (.125) with RISP/2 outs...Opponents are slashing .178/.221/.247 (13-for-73) and one homer against him with two outs, compared to a combined .263/.296/.491 (45-for-171) and 10 homers with zero and
