**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue their final homestand of the season with the second game of a three-game Interleague series with the Cleveland Guardians tonight at Busch Stadium, Cleveland's first visit to St. Louis since 2021 when they were previously branded as the Indians ... The Redbirds are 3-2 on their Steel Corridor homestand against Pittsburgh (3-1) and Cleveland (0-1).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters today 2.0 games behind Chicago in 3rd place in the National League Central Division ... Last night's loss eliminated the Cardinals from postseason contention while moving the club back to .500 again, a mark they have held 21 times this season.

**LEAHY RECALLED:** Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals recalled RHP Kyle Leahy from Memphis (AAA) and placed RHP **Sonny Gray** on the season-ending 15-Day Injured List with right forearm flexor tendinitis (retroactive to Sept. 19).

**GAMES THAT MATTER:** Since Opening Day of 2011, the Cardinals have played 2,142 out of a possible 2,156 regular season games during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated (99.4%).

**AN ERA OF EXCELLENCE:** It has been 65 years since the Cardinals last experienced back-to-back losing campaigns in **full seasons** from 1958-59 (excluding seasons shortened by war, work stoppages, or COVID), the 2nd-longest all-time timespan by any franchise of the four major North American sports leagues (MLB, NBA, NFL, & NHL).

• The NHL's **Montreal Canadiens** hold the record of 80 years between consecutive full losing seasons occurring from 1938-39 to 1941-42 (4 seasons), and then again during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.

• The Los Angeles Dodgers have the 2nd-longest active streak, last experiencing losing seasons 37 years ago from 1986-87.

• After St. Louis suffered its first losing season since 2007 with a 71-91 record last year, the Cardinals need to finish at least 4-4 to end at .500 and 5-3 for a winning record (82-80).

**CHOK UP:** Rookie **Masyn Winn** has 74 hits with two strikes, 2nd-most in MLB this season to Cleveland's **José Ramirez** (87) and the 4th-highest single-season total by a Major League rookie since 1988, trailing **Steven Kwan** (76 in 2022), **Spencer Steer** (79 in 2023), and 2001 NL Rookie of the Year **Albert Pujols** (84).

**MASYN MILESTONES:** Rookie **Masyn Winn** tonight makes his 142nd appearance at shortstop this season, tying **Alex Grammas** (1954) for the 3rd-most games at shortstop by a Redbirds rookie behind **Charlie Gerbert** (146 in 1929) & **Ed Holly** (147 in 1907) ... 1978 Padres rookie **Ozzie Smith** holds the MLB single-season rookie record with 159 games at shortstop.

**GOING YARD AGAINST THE GUARDS:** With a home run this series, **Nolan Arenado** would become the 21st active Major Leaguer to homer against all 30 teams in his career ... Among MLB debuts since the 1998 season when MLB expanded to 30 teams, four players completed the home run circuit by going yard against Cleveland as their final team: **Mark Reynolds**, **Troy Tulowitzki**, **Josh Willingham**, and **Dexter Fowler**, who went yard with St. Louis during the COVID-shortened 2020 season.

**BACKSTOP TRIOS:** With **Iván Herrera**'s 50th start of the season at catcher tonight, St. Louis becomes only the 3rd team in MLB history to have three catchers each make 50 or more starts in the same season ... The **1962 Cardinals** are the only other team in franchise history with three different catchers appearing in 50 or more games (not starts): **Gene Oliver** (98g), **Carl Sawatski** (70g) and **Jimmie Schaffer** (69g). - *Elias*

#### CLEVELAND CONNECTIONS

**Sonny Gray** has been caught by **Stephen Vogt** (45 games) more than any other catcher in his career... were All-Star teammates in 2015 with Oakland.

**José Fermín** signed with Cleveland as an International Free Agent (July 2, 2015)...played six minor league seasons in the Guardians organization before purchased by St. Louis (Nov. 9, 2022).

**Turner Ward** played 54 games over parts of two seasons (1990-91) for Cleveland...made his MLB debut for the Indians (Sept. 10, 1990 at Cleveland Municipal Stadium)...traded by Cleveland w/ **Tom Candiotti** to the Blue Jays for **Denis Boucher**, **Glenallen Hill**, **Mark Whiten**, and cash (June 27, 1991).

**Julio Rangel** spent 11 years in the Cleveland system as a Cultural Development Coordinator (2007-08), Mental Skills Coordinator (2009-10), Lower Level Pitching Coordinator (2011-15), and Assistant Field Coordinator (2016-17).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** spent the 1991 season in Cleveland's minor league organization as a pitching coach and pitcher between Colorado Springs (AAA) and Canton-Akron (AA).

**Dean Kiekhefer** was originally selected by Cleveland in the 37th round of the 2007 MLB Draft out of Oldham High School (Ky.), but did not sign.

**Jordan Walker** was named Player of the Game at the 2019 MLB High School All-Star Game at Cleveland's Progressive Field.

**Lane Thomas** played in 84 games over parts of three seasons for the Cardinals (2019-21)...traded to Washington for **Jon Lester** (July 30, 2021).

Cleveland Sr. VP of Medical Services **Lonnie Soloff** attended St. Louis University...began his baseball career with the Cardinals in 1996 as part of the PBATS internship program.

Guardians Hitting VP **Alex Eckelman** played parts of five seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (1997-2001).

**Matt Valaika**, younger brother of Cleveland Hitting Coach **Chris Valaika**, was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2010 MLB Draft.

The Cardinals and Cleveland played in MLB's inaugural Civil Rights Game on March 31, 2007 at AutoZone Park in Memphis, Tenn.

Guardians Replay Coord. **Gunnar Wilhelmy** attended the Univ. of Missouri, earning two undergraduate degrees (2016) and a Master's of Statistics (2018)...worked for the Mizzou Baseball team for five and a half years as Student Mgr., Graduate Asst., and Mgr. of Advanced Technologies.

Cleveland AGM **Eric Binder** pitched part of the 2011 season in the Cardinals minor league organization.

**Bill Veck** was a former owner of both Cleveland (1946-49) and the St. Louis Browns (1951-53).

Cardinals Baseball Info. & Media Serv. Mgr. **Chris Tunno** graduated from Canfield (Ohio) High School.

The Cardinals & Indians played an exhibition at Cleveland's League Park during the 1936 All-Star break, a game where 17-year-old **Bob Feller** made his unofficial debut with 8 strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

The Cleveland Spiders were rivals of the St. Louis Browns in the American Association (1888-89) and National League (1892-99)...before the 1899 season, Spiders owners **Stanley** and **Frank DeHass Robison**, who also owned the St. Louis franchise, transferred Cleveland's best players (future Hall of Famers **Cy Young**, **Bobby Wallace**, & **Jesse Burkett**) to St. Louis and formed the Perfectos...the Spiders endured the worst season in pro baseball history (20-134) and were disbanded as the NL contracted to eight teams.

The Cardinals won their 10,000th regular season game as a member of the National League with a 4-0 victory over Cleveland at Busch Stadium (June 25, 2018).

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 31st start of the season and his 181st career (209th career appearance).
- Is facing Cleveland for just the 2nd time in his career. Only prior meeting was in 2014 in his 6th career start, a 2-0 loss at Cleveland's Progressive Field.
- It is his 4th consecutive start against an American League foe (NYY, SEA, TOR, CLE).
- Has logged 5th season of 30+ starts since 2018, tying **José Berríos, Gerrit Cole, Charlie Morton, Luis Castillo, Patrick Corbin & Aaron Nola** for most in MLB in that time.
- Miles is the 23rd Cardinal in franchise history to make 30+ starts in three consecutive seasons (2022-24) and the first to do so since teammate **Lance Lynn** (2013-15).
- Leads MLB in first-pitch strike percentage (71.6%) this season, while his 67.1% career first-pitch strike percentage is tied with **Phil Hughes** (1,291.0 IP) for highest in MLB history among pitchers with 1,000 career innings pitched.
- Sports the lowest Walk Pct. (4.4%) among active MLB pitchers (min. 500 innings).
- Has extensive home and road splits: 1-6 with a 6.54 ERA in 14 home starts and 7-5 with a 4.649 ERA in 16 road starts. His only home win came on June 22 vs. SF Giants.
- Seven (T-4th in NL) of his eight wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, he has winning road record (34-29), but is just 24-28 at Busch Stadium. Ran off a streak of eight straight quality starts on the road before it was snapped in his Aug. 4 start at Chicago Cubs, longest stretch of the season in MLB.
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in two of his 30 starts (101 at DET on 5/1 & 100 vs. LAD on 8/16) after ranking 7th in MLB with 12 such games in 2022.
- In his 170 starts with the Cardinals, St. Louis is 69-32 when Miles works 6.0+ IP (10-5 this season), while the Cardinals are 24-46 when he goes 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 49-7 (.875 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals are 65-16 in those 81 games, including 9-4 this season). He's just 11-53 (.172) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 28-61).
- St. Louis is 93-78 (.544) in his 171 career outings (170 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Made his 30th start of the season (3rd consecutive season doing so) last Sun. (9/15) at Toronto and took a no-decision in the 3-2 loss, allowing just three hits in his 5.0 IP. It was his 9th consecutive start without a winning decision dating to July 21 win at Atlanta.
