ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (25-32) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (28-27)

JUNE 2, 2023 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #56/HOME #26

RHP JACK FLAHERTY (3-4, 4.81 ERA) vs. RHP ROANSY CONTRERAS (3-4, 4.33 ERA)

THE PIRATES...went 3-3 on their road trip to Seattle (1-2) and San Francisco (2-1)...Are one game over .500 after falling to 26-27 following their loss on 5/29 (the first time the team was under .500 since 4/2)...Won seven straight games from 4/17-23, their longest winning streak since 2018 (11 games)...Are 0.5 game behind the first place Brewers in the National League Central coming into today.

ROSTER MOVES: The Pittsburgh Pirates today traded right-handed pitcher Robert Stephenson to Tampa Bay for infielder Alika Williams, who has been assigned to Triple-A Indianapolis...Infielder Mark Mathias has been recalled from Triple-A...In addition, right-handed pitcher Duane Underwood Jr., who was designated for assignment on May 27, has cleared waivers and has accepted and outright assignment to Indianapolis.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen is just one double shy of 400 in his career (his next double will also be his 300th as a Pirate)...McCutchen ranks seventh all-time in Pirates history in doubles (Hall-of-Famer Pie Traynor is sixth with 371).

CLOSING IN ON 2000 HITS: Andrew McCutchen also comes into today just five hits shy of 2000 in his career...McCutchen has recorded 1510 of his 1995 hits with the Pirates organization...McCutchen's 1510 hits with Pittsburgh ranks 12th in team history...Hall-of-Famer Roberto Clemente is first with 3000 while Tommy Leach is 11th (1603).

CENTRAL PERK: This weekend is Pittsburgh's first series against a team from the National League Central since sweeping the Reds in four games here at PNC Park from April 20-23...The Pirates are 7-4 against the Central this year (all 11 games have come against the Reds and RedBirds)...Pittsburgh won't face Milwaukee or Chicago until the next road trip from June 13-18.

WHEN LAST WE MET: The Bucs and RedBirds split a four-game series at St. Louis from April 13-16...Each of the last two games were decided in 10 innings...The Pirates blanked the Cardinals 5-0 in the first game of the series on April 13 while being shut out 3-0 the next night.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Roansy Contreras returns to the starting rotation after tossing 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in his last appearance on May 28 at Seattle...Tonight will be Contreras' fifth career start against the Cardinals and second of this season (he had a no-decision in the team's 6-3, 10-inning win at Busch on April 15)...The Pirates are 4-0 in Contreras' four career starts against the Cardinals.

FOR STARTERS: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded 22 wins this season, which ranks fourth in MLB behind the Rangers (26), Astros (24) and Rays (24)...The 22 wins has already surpassed the starting rotation's win total (21) from all of last season.

BULLISH PEN: Pittsburgh's bullpen has tossed a combined 7.2 scoreless innings in the last two games and comes into today ranked third in the National League in ERA (3.73)...The only two teams with a lower bullpen ERA are the Padres (3.28) and Cardinals (3.54)...The Pirates are the only team with five or more relievers with ERAs of 2.25 and lower who have each pitched 18.0-plus innings.

A PROMOTION IS IN ORDER: Yesterday the Pirates organization promoted right-handed pitcher Thomas Harrington from Low-A Bradenton to High-A Greensboro...At the time of his promotion, the 21-year-old Harrington ranked second in the Florida State League in ERA (2.77), third in WHIP (1.10) and batting average against (.230), first in winning percentage (.800) and tied for fourth in wins (four)...Harrington, who is rated by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's No. 12 prospect, joins Greensboro's starting rotation that also includes Bubba Chandler (No. 7 Pirates prospect by Pipeline) and Anthony Solometo (No. 10 Pirates prospect by Pipeline).

BAE, BAE, BAE: Rookie Ji Hwan Bae is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with five doubles, three RBI and .400 OBP since May 14, reaching base safely in 13 of his 14 games...Bae's .348 average since May 14 ranks ninth among all National Leaguers during that time...That's also the fourth-highest average in that time among all rookies in MLB behind Texas' Josh Jung (.397), Cincinnati's Spencer Steer (.377) and Cincinnati's Matt McLain (.354).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 2, 1955: The Pirates beat the Cardinals 12-3 at Forbes Field. Dale Long went 3-for-5 and had five RBI with a home run, including a two-run shot in a five-run third inning. Frank Thomas also went deep while the Pirates banged out a season-high 17 hits. Max Surkont allowed three runs on 11 hits while going the distance for the Pirates.
