**AT A GLANCE:** The Yankees continue their nine-game road trip tonight with the second game of the Subway Series at Citi Field (1-0 thus far)...are 2-5 on their current road trip after being swept by Milwaukee in a three-game series, dropping two-of-three games at Baltimore and winning their series opener at the Mets...following this series, will return home for a seven-game homestand, featuring a four-game series vs. Toronto (Mon.-Thurs.) and a three-game set vs. Tampa Bay (5/22-24).

- **Their 28-17 (.622) record is the second-best in the American League and the fourth-best record in the Majors**, trailing only Atlanta (31-14, .689), Tampa Bay (29-14, .674) and Chicago-NL (29-16, .644).
- The Yankees have won two of their last three games (since 5/12) after losing their previous four games (5/8-11)...**are 18-8 in their last 26 games (since 4/17), 19-9 in their last 28 games (since 4/15) and 20-10 in their last 30 games (since 4/13).**
- Have won seven of their last nine completed series (6-2-1)...have won or split 10 of their 14 completed series this season (9-4-1).
- The Yankees'+72 run differential this season is the best in the AL and tied with Los Angeles-NL for the second-best in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta (+92).
- The Yankees are 23-6 this season when scoring first.

**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Yankees defeated the Mets, 5-2, in their series opener on Friday at Citi Field...**RHP Cam Schiltler** (6.2IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 9K, 1HR) started and earned his sixth win of the season after allowing only 1R/ER in 6.2IP...**LF Cody Bellinger** (1-for-5, 1R, 1 double, 1RBI) hit a go-ahead RBI double in the third inning...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (3-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 2RBI, 1BB, 1SB) recorded a season-high-tying 3H and hit a two-run double in the third inning...**DH Spencer Jones** (2-for-4, 1RBI) hit an RBI single in the fifth inning...**1B Ben Rice** (3-for-5, 2R, 1HR, 1RBI) recorded a season-high-tying 3H and hit his 14th home run of the season with a solo shot in the ninth inning...**SS Anthony Volpe** (0-for-1, 3BB) recorded a career-high-tying 3BB...**RHP Fernando Cruz** (1.1IP, 1H, 1K, 1WP) tossed 1.1 scoreless innings of relief...**RHP David Bednar** (1.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1BB) allowed 1R/ER in the ninth inning.

**DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (16HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (14HR) are only the second pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 14HR in the club's first 45 games of a season, joining Roger Maris (15HR) and Mickey Mantle (14HR) in 1961...**...are only the second pair of Major League teammates in the last 19 seasons (since 2008) to accomplish the feat, joining Houston's George Springer (17HR) and Alex Bregman (14HR) in 2019.

**RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice** recorded a season-high-tying 3H and hit his 14th home run of the season with a solo shot in the ninth inning on Friday at the Mets...**has hit 10HR in his last 23 games (since 4/16).**

- Has hit .314/.418/.686 (43-for-137) with 33R, 9 doubles, 14HR, 30RBI, 25BB/2IBB, 1HP, 25F and 25B in 40 games this season...23 of his 43H this season have gone for extra bases (9 doubles, 14HR)...has reached base safely in 30-of-36 starts.
- Has hit 6HR in his last 13 Interleague games (since 8/16/25).

**FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.09 ERA (247.1IP, 85ER) and 249K in 45 starts this season...marks the third-best ERA in the Majors**, trailing only Atlanta (2.93) and Tampa Bay (3.01)...have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 23 of their last 26 starts (since 4/17), including 2ER-or-fewer in 19 of those starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 13 starts...have posted a 2.88 ERA (144.0IP, 46ER) over that span.

- **Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 38 of their 45 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most starts in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 45 games of a season**, trailing only their 41 starts in 2022.
- **Have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 27 of their 45 starts, matching their third-most through their first 45 games of a season in franchise history**, trailing only their 33 starts in 2022 and 28 starts in 2019.
- **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.316), opponents' OPS (.594) and HR/9.0IP (0.76)**, rank second in opponents' BA (.207, first in AL) and opponents' OBP (.278, second in AL), third in ERA (3.09, second in AL), strikeouts (249, second in AL), strikeout rate (24.9%, second in AL) and WHIP (1.08, second in AL), fifth in innings pitched (247.1, third in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.07, third in AL) and K/9.0IP (9.06, third in AL), seventh in BB/9.0IP (2.95, third in AL) and 10th in walk rate (8.1%, sixth in AL).

**ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge** has reached base in 36 of his last 39 games (since 4/3), batting .292/.436/.650 (40-for-137) with 35R, 7 doubles, 14HR, 27RBI, 33BB/5IBB, 2HP and 55B over that span.

- Has reached base multiple times in eight of his last 14 games (since 5/1) and 15 of his last 23 games (since 4/21), hitting .304/.466/.620 (24-for-79) with 19R, 4 doubles, 7HR, 14RBI, 23BB/5IBB, 1HP and 15B over that 23-game span.
- 23 of his 43H this season have been XBH (7 doubles, 16HR).
- **Has hit .333/.538/.778 (9-for-27) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/5IBB and 1HP with RISP this season.**
- Has hit .298/.388/.711 (34-for-114) with 23R, 5 doubles, 14HR, 26RBI, 15BB/2IBB, 3HP, 25F and 15B in 32 career games vs. the Mets...**has 9HR in his last 17 games against New York-NL** (since 9/11/21)...**has hit 9HR in 18 career games at Citi Field against the Mets, including 7HR in his last 10 games at the venue** (since 9/11/21).

**SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger** hit a go-ahead RBI double in the third inning on Friday at the Mets...**his nine go-ahead RBI this season are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors.**

- **Has hit .368/.438/.579 (14-for-38) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 20RBI, 7BB and 35F with RISP this season.**
- **Has hit .444/.524/.861 (16-for-36) with 8R, 6 doubles, 3HR, 11RBI and 6BB in his last 10 games vs. the Mets (since 6/21/24)**...in 46 career games vs. New York-NL, has batted .290/.351/.657 (49-for-169) with 31R, 12 doubles, 1 triple, 16HR, 42RBI, 16BB/3IBB and 25B.

**ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** recorded a season-high-tying 3H and hit a two-run double in the third inning on Friday at the Mets...has recorded a hit in 10 of his last 13 starts (since 5/1).

- His 12SB are tied for the fifth-most in the AL and tied for the eighth-most in the Majors this year.

**RISPY BUSINESS: Yankees batters** have hit .332/.410/.568 (63-for-190) with 12 doubles, 3 triples, 9HR, 90RBI, 31BB and 85F with RISP over their last 25 games (since 4/18).

**WALK IT OUT: Yankees batters** have walked an AL-best 204 times this season, their most walks through their first 45 games of a season in the last 22 seasons (since 2005) and most since recording 207BB in 2004.

**FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners** have recorded 41 stolen bases this year, their most through their first 45 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 51SB in 2001.

**SCHLITZ'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schiltler** earned his sixth win of the year on Friday at the Mets after allowing only 1R/ER in 6.2IP (2H, 2BB, 9K, 1HR)...**has gone 6-1 with a Major League-best 1.35 ERA (60.0IP, 9ER) and 68K in 10 starts this season, holding opponents to a .168/.209/.234 (36-for-214) slash line.**

- **His 1.35 ERA is tied with Jack Quinn's 1.35 ERA in 1919 for the fifth-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through his first 10 starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Phil Niekro (1.20 ERA in first 10GS in 1984), Max Fried (1.29 ERA in first 10GS in 2025), Allie Reynolds (1.31 ERA in first 10GS in 1952) and Rob Gardner (1.32 ERA in first 10GS in 1972).
- **Has posted a Major League-best 1.35 ERA and his 2.5 WAR (FanGraphs) is the highest among Major League pitchers**...also ranks first in the Majors on opponents' SLG (.234), tied for first in starts (10, tied for first in AL), second in opponents' OBP (.209, first in AL), opponents' OPS (.443, first in AL) and WHIP (0.78, first in AL), tied for second in wins (six, tied for first in AL), third in opponents' BA (.168, first in AL), strikeouts (68, second in AL) and K/BB (6.18, second in AL), fourth in HR/9.0IP (0.30, fourth in AL) and BB/9.0IP (1.65, third in AL), and sixth in walk rate (4.9%, fifth in AL) and strikeout rate (30.1%, third in AL).
- **The Yankees have gone 8-2 in his starts this season**...his eight team wins are tied for the most in the Majors this season.
- **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in each of his last six starts (since 4/17), going 4-0 with a 0.70 ERA (38.1IP, 3ER) and 38K.**
- His eight starts of 1ER-or-fewer this year are the most in the Majors.
- **Over his last 18 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 9-2 with a 1.74 ERA (103.1IP, 20ER) and 122K**...the Yankees are 15-3 in those starts...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 11 of those starts.

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP CARLOS RODÓN (0-0, 6.23 ERA)

**LHP Carlos Rodón** will make his second start of the season in tonight's game at New York-NL... the 33-year-old will make the start on extended five days' rest due to Thursday's team off day...made his season debut on Sunday at Milwaukee, allowing 3R/ER in 4.1IP without recording a decision (2H, 5BB, 4K, 0HR, 1HP, 1WP)...missed the first 40 team games of the season...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 5/10...made three rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, posting a 3.38 ERA (16.0IP, 13H, 7R/6ER, 3BB, 16K, 3HR)...was placed on the 15-day injured list on 3/25 (retroactive to 3/22) recovering from left elbow surgery...underwent a left elbow arthroscopy procedure on 10/15/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at the Kerlan-Jobe Surgery Center in Los Angeles, Calif...went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts last season...set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco)...opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR)...recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...since 2021, ranks fifth in the Majors with an 10.66 K/9.0IP ratio...is also tied for seventh in double-digit strikeout games (21) over that span, trailing only Dylan Cease (27), Kevin Gausman (25), Blake Snell (25), Gerrit Cole (24), Zack Wheeler (23) and Corbin Burnes (22)...has recorded at least 10K and 0BB in nine games, tied for the fourth-most such games in the Majors during that stretch, trailing only Wheeler (13), Gausman (12) and Jacob deGrom (11)...has pitched over parts of 12 Major League seasons with the Chicago White Sox (2015-21), San Francisco Giants (2022) and Yankees (2023-26)...has finished in the top-six of Cy Young voting three times (fifth in 2021 and sixth in 2022 and '25)...is a three-time All-Star (2021-22, '25)...has made six Opening Day rosters (2016, '19-22, '24-25)...began the 2017, 2018, 2023 and 2026 seasons on the injured list...was originally selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 16th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play three seasons at North Carolina State University (2012-14)...was selected by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (third overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft...signed a six-year Major League contract with the Yankees extending through the 2028 season on 12/21/22.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his season debut on Sunday at Milwaukee, allowing 3R/ER in 4.1IP without recording a decision (2H, 5BB, 4K, 0HR, 1HP, 1WP)...marked his first start since 9/25/25 vs. Chicago-AL.

**ROAD RULES:** Will make his second road start of the season...made his first road start on Sunday at Milwaukee, allowing 3R/ER in 4.1IP without recording a decision (2H, 5BB, 4K, 0HR, 1HP, 1WP).

- ✦ As a Yankee (since 2023), has gone 17-16 with a 4.43 ERA (233.2IP, 115ER) and 257K in 44 road starts.
- ✦ Made 18 starts on the road in 2025, going 8-5 with a 3.18 ERA (104.2IP, 84H, 44R/37ER, 41BB, 110K, 9HR)...tossed at least 6.0IP in 12 of those starts...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 13 of those starts...went 4-1 with a 2.25 ERA (36.0IP, 30H, 10R/9ER, 12BB, 28K, 2HR) over his last six road starts (8/6-9/20)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in all six starts.

**VS. NEW YORK-NL/INTERLEAGUE:** Has made four career starts vs. the Mets, going 3-1 with a 3.48 ERA (20.2IP, 14H, 9R/8ER, 12BB, 21K, 2HR).

- ✦ Made two starts vs. New York-NL last season, going 1-1 with a 6.30 ERA (10.0IP, 7ER) and 9K.
- ✦ Has made two career starts at Citi Field, going 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (10.0IP, 6ER) and 12K.
- ✦ In 10 Interleague starts last season, went 4-3 with a 3.59 ERA (57.2IP, 23ER) and 64K...allowed 1ER-or-fewer in five of those starts.
- ✦ Since 2021, has gone 17-12 with a 3.15 ERA (202.2IP, 71ER) and 213K in 36 Interleague starts over that span.

**ALL THAT'S LEFT:** In his career, left-handed batters have hit just .213/.287/.327 (211-for-991)...has also surrendered just 24HR.

- ✦ His 9.89 K/9.0IP ratio since his Major League debut in 2015 ranks fourth among left-handed pitchers in that span (min. 1,000.0IP), trailing only Chris Sale (11.71), Blake Snell (11.20) and Robbie Ray (10.85).
- ✦ Since 2015, his 1,413K are the fifth-most among active left-handed pitchers...his 28 double-digit strikeout games over that stretch among lefties are the fifth-most in the Majors, trailing only Sale (74), Ray (40), Clayton Kershaw (39) and Snell (38).

**2025:** Went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts...**set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched**...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco).

- ✦ Opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR).
- ✦ Finished sixth in the AL Cy Young Award voting.
- ✦ Recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...became the 17th pitcher (22nd time) in franchise history to record at least 200K in a single season...his 203K were the sixth-most by a left-handed pitcher in franchise history, trailing only Ron Guidry (248K in 1978), CC Sabathia (230K in 2011), Al Downing (217K in 1964), Randy Johnson (211K in 2005) and Whitey Ford (209K in 1961).
- ✦ Ranked second in opponents' BA (.188, first in AL), was tied for second in wins (tied for second in AL) and games started (tied for first in AL), tied for fourth in innings pitched (tied for second in AL), sixth in opponents' SLG (.321, third in AL) and opponents' OPS (.593, third in AL), and 10th in strikeouts (fourth in AL) and opponents' OBP (.272, seventh in AL)...also ranked seventh in the AL in strikeout rate (25.7%) and WHIP (1.05), eighth in ERA, ninth in K/9.0IP (9.35) and 10th in HR/9.0IP (1.01).
- ✦ Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 22 of his 33 starts and one-or-zero ER in 14 starts...his 22 starts of 2ER-or-fewer were tied for the seventh-most in the Majors (tied for fourth in AL)...made six scoreless starts.
- ✦ Became the first pitcher in franchise history to eclipse 200K while surrendering less than 140H in a single season.
