THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4 (2-1 vs. Boston and 0-3 vs. the Reds), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games in New York against the Mets...tonight, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against the Mets at Citi Field...after tonight's game, the Twins will travel to Tampa Bay to play the Rays at Tropicana Field for three games over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 1-4 in IL Play this season (1-1 at NYM, 0-3 vs. CIN)...their next opponent in IL Play will be the Nationals in D.C. from May 5-7...last season, they went 20-28 vs. the NL.

☞ Twins have gone 1-2 in rubber games this season...their one win was April 12 at Toronto...their two losses were March 29 at Baltimore and April 5 vs. Tampa Bay.

NEW YUCK: The Twins lost to the Mets last night at Citi Field by a score of 3-2...Connor Prielipp made his major league debut in the start and allowed two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Kendry Rojas made his debut in relief of Prielipp and pitched 2.0 scoreless innings with two hits and three walks...the offense recorded seven hits, including a home run from Byron Buxton, his fifth of the season...Minnesota also went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position and left eight men on base.

☞ With Prielipp and Rojas both debuting it marked the first time for multiple pitchers to make their MLB debuts in the same game for the Twins since April 7, 1999, when Dan Perkins, Mike Lincoln and Joe Mays all did it vs. Toronto (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

AMAZIN' MATCHUP: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 34th time in their history tonight...Minnesota is 14-19 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 4-9 at Citi Field and 4-7 at Target Field.

☞ Twins are just 3-8 in their last 11 at Citi Field and have never won a series in this ballpark in four chances.

☞ Byron Buxton now has four home runs in 13 career games vs. the Mets, tied with Mitch Garver for the most in Twins history against New York-NL.

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton hit his fifth home run of the season last night and second of the series...after going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Buck has homered five times in his last eight games (38 PA), since April 13...since that date, only four other players in baseball have hit as many home runs (Trout - 6, Murakami - 6, Alvarez - 5 and Judge - 5).

MAJORITY REPORT: With a victory tonight, the Twins will earn their fourth series win of the season...they have gone 3-4-0 in series play (series results in the right margin)...they have gone 2-2-0 at home and 1-2-0 on the road.

☞ Twins won their last series against the Mets, taking two of three at Target Field from April 14-16, 2025...they have never won a series at Citi Field...they have won just one series in Queens in six chances, that coming June 18-20, 2007 at Shea Stadium.

☞ The last series the Twins won over a National League opponent was August 29-31, 2025, taking two of three vs. San Diego at Target Field.

MINNESOTA LUMBER CO: Twins have scored 119 runs on the season, third-most in the AL, trailing Houston (137) and Los Angeles (126).

☞ 46 of their 119 runs scored (39%) on the season have come via the home run...they have hit 28 home runs this season, fifth-most in the AL.

LARN TO FLY: Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in nine-straight games, posting a .424 on-base percentage in that span...his career-high is 16, done from August 17-September 5, 2025.

☞ This season, against right-handed pitching, he is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with three doubles, four RBI, 11 walks, a .488 on-base percentage and an .895 OPS.

AUSTIN POWER: Austin Martin has reached base safely in 14-straight games with a plate appearance and in 17 of 19 games with a plate appearance...the 14-straight is tied for seventh-longest active streak in baseball (Turang is the leader with 21)...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Martin's own 16-game on-base streak from September 2-20, 2025.

☞ Martin currently leads the club with 15 walks...he has posted a .492 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 60 plate appearances.

☞ Martin on MLB Savant's 2026 MLB Percentile Rankings: 89th in batting run value (6), 88th in xwOBA (.394), 100th in chase % (10.8%), 94th in whiff % (14.9%), 99th in walk % (23.8%).

☞ Dating back to September 4, 2025, he is hitting .306 (38-for-124) with nine doubles, 10 RBI, 23 runs scored, 25 walks, a .431 on-base percentage and an .835 OPS.

☞ In 10 road games this season, Martin is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with eight walks a .577 on-base percentage and a .989 OPS...he leads baseball in road OBP (min. 25 PA).

JEFF YEA: Over his last 10 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with one triple, two home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, a .459 on-base percentage, a .586 slugging percentage and a 1.046 OPS...additionally, he has reached base safely in all eight road games this season.

GO STRAIGHT THEN HANG A LEFT: Despite going 8-for-47 (.170) with runners in scoring position in their last five games, the Twins rank fourth in baseball in batting average with RISP at .281 (57-for-203), trailing Milwaukee (.299), Atlanta (.299) and Detroit (.297).

☞ Twins hit .238 (309-for-1301) with RISP last season, fourth worst in the AL and 25th in MLB.

☞ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .500 (7-for-15)...Josh Bell is hitting .429 (9-for-21)...Brooks Lee is hitting .421 (8-for-19)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .400 (10-for-25)...Tristan Gray is hitting .333 (4-for-12)...Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (4-for-12)...Victor Caratini is hitting .294 (5-for-17).

☞ Twins are hitting .333 (14-for-42) with 36 RBI with the bases loaded this season...both their hits and RBI lead baseball.

FUN(DY) SIZED: Kody and his wife, Alicia, had their first child on Monday, a baby girl named Murphy Jo, measuring at six pounds, 13 oz — 21 inches.

NOT JUST SOME TV GUY: Twins.TV analyst Denard Span played in 51 career games against the Mets, hitting .319 (65-for-204) with an .860 OPS and three different four-hit games...in one stretch he hit safely in 13-straight games against the Mets, from July 27, 2013-May 16, 2014...additionally, he hit six career home runs against New York, tied with Philadelphia for his most against any opponent...three of those homers came at Citi Field, including his first game in this ballpark on June 25, 2010, a leadoff homer off Mike Pelfrey.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1980, Angels pitcher Bruce Kison settled for a one-hitter when Minnesota's Ken Landreaux hit a ninth-inning double in a California 17-0 win...for Landreaux, the hit marked the beginning of a 31-game hitting streak, the longest in Twins history.

- ☞ Making his sixth start of 2026 and 120th start (121st game) of his career.
- ☞ Is 0-0 with a 1.80 ERA (5.0 IP, 1 ER), two walks, eight strikeouts and a .167 (3-for-18) BAA in one career start against New York-NL.
- ☞ Took the loss his last time out on April 17 vs. Cincinnati, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits with no walks and six strikeouts across 6.0 innings of work in a 2-1 Twins defeat.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his fifth start of the season on April 17 vs. Cincinnati opposite left-hander Brandon Williamson...took the loss, his second of the season; marked his second consecutive loss against an Interleague opponent dating back to September 26, 2025 at Philadelphia...despite the loss, made his second-straight quality start of the season, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits across 6.0 innings of work with no walks and six strikeouts.

- ☞ First time recording a quality start in consecutive outings since doing so on July 1, 2025 at Miami and then on July 6 vs. Tampa Bay; the Twins lost both of those games.
- ☞ Made his 43rd career start in Interleague Play, tying Brad Radke for the most such starts in Twins history, since the dawn of Interleague play in 1997.
- ☞ Was his 18th career start of six-or-more strikeouts without allowing a walk, tying Johan Santana for the fourth most such starts in Twins club history (1961-).

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan toed the rubber for the fourth time this season on April 11 at Toronto opposite left-hander Eric Lauer...earned the win, his second of the season and first time recording back-to-back wins in consecutive outings since he defeated Kansas City at Target Field on August 8, 2025, and then followed with a win at Yankee Stadium against New York-AL on August 13...made his first quality start of the season, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) across 7.0 innings of work with one walk and five strikeouts.

- ☞ Snapped a seven-start stretch without recording a quality start spanning from September 6, 2025-April 6, 2026, tied for the longest such streak of his career (also 7 from July 6-August 15, 2022.)
- ☞ Surrendered his first home run of the season, a two-run, first-inning blast off the bat of Blue Jays outfielder Daulton Varsho.
- ☞ After allowing his first two batters to reach base (George Springer walk, Daulton Varsho home run), Ryan went on to retire 20 of his remaining 22 batters faced, with his only blemishes being a hit batter (Nathan Lukes) in the second inning and a leadoff single (Vladimir Guerrero Jr.) in the fourth inning.

HELLO, NEW YORK: In his career, Ryan has faced New York-NL one time; the Mets are one of four teams that he has not made multiple starts against in his career (also Los Angeles-NL, Miami and Philadelphia)...in his lone start against the Mets on April 14, 2025, Joe surrendered one run on three hits with two walks and eight strikeouts at Target Field, as the Twins fell 5-1; he did not factor in the decision.

- ☞ Ryan exited the game with the score tied 1-1 after five innings, but back-to-back, two-run frames by the Mets in the sixth and seventh innings off Justin Topa and Jorge Alcala sealed the Twins' fate.

NATIONAL TREASURE: Ryan is set to make his 34th start vs. a National League opponent, surpassing Brad Radke for the most Interleague starts in Twins history, since the beginning of Interleague Play in 1997...below are some more of his numbers against the National League, compared to other pitchers in Twins history since 1997:

- ☞ Is 11-14 with a 4.46 ERA (175.2 IP, 87 ER), 40 walks, 199 strikeouts, a 1.14 WHIP and a .238 (161-for-677) BAA in 33 career starts against the National League.
- ☞ In 2025, went 5-5 with a 2.74 ERA (72.1 IP, 22 ER), 14 walks and 87 strikeouts (6.21 K/BB) against National League opponents.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 59 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.92 ERA (325.2 IP, 142 ER), 72 walks and 344 strikeouts, compared to 27-18 with a 3.62 ERA (343.0 IP, 138 ER), 82 walks and 403 strikeouts in 61 home appearances (60 starts).

- ☞ Since the start of the 2025 season, Ryan is 7-6 with a 3.44 ERA (102.0 IP, 39 ER), 21 walks, 106 strikeouts, a 0.99 WHIP and a .214 (80-for-374) BAA in 18 starts away from Target Field; 10 of those 18 starts have been quality starts, accounting for 55.6% of his road starts during that span.
- ☞ His 5.05 K/BB in road starts since the start of the 2025 season ranks ninth among all starters in Major League Baseball and fifth most in the American League during that span.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .231/.259/.404 (12-for-52) with six doubles, one home run, no walks and 12 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .130/.226/.152 (6-for-46) with one double, six walks and 16 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .217/.275/.387 (265-for-1,223) with 83 walks and 305 strikeouts (3.67 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .224/.272/.413 (287-for-1,282) with 71 walks and 442 strikeouts (6.23 K/BB).

- ☞ Ryan's .130 (6-for-46) opponent batting average this season against righties is the fifth lowest in Major League Baseball (min. 40 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ryan's curveball ranks second among Major League pitchers with a .048 (1-for-21) BAA and ranks third in the league with a 52.4 strikeout percentage (minimum 20 plate appearances).
- ☞ His curveball is tied for the third highest run value (3) in Major League Baseball, trailing Braxton Ashcraft and Landen Roup (4).
- ☞ Has thrown 215 four-seam fastballs, the fourth most by an American League pitcher this season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP TAJ BRADLEY (2026: 3-0, 1.63 ERA // CAREER: 22-27, 4.64 ERA)

Right-hander Taj Bradley is slated to start tomorrow's series opener against his former team, the Tampa Bay Rays at Tropicana Field...his 1.63 ERA (27.2 IP, 5 ER) ranks sixth among qualified pitchers in Major League Baseball...in his most recent start on April 18 vs. Cincinnati, Taj made his team-leading third quality start of the season, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched with two walks and five strikeouts...his ERA is the lowest by a Twins starting pitcher through their first five starts of the season since Sonny Gray's 0.62 ERA through his first five starts in 2023; Gray finished second in American League Cy Young voting that season...will mark his first career start against his former squad; was traded from Tampa Bay to Minnesota in exchange for right-hander Griffin Jax on July 31, 2025.

- In 2026, was invited to participate in the World Baseball Classic as a member of Team USA.
- In 2025, made first career MLB All-Star Game appearance, throwing a 10-pitch perfect fourth inning with two strikeouts (SD Manny Machado and CHC Kyle Tucker).
- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive year in the Twins' season-opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
