

# San Francisco Giants (77-77) at Los Angeles Dodgers (94-59)

RHP John Brebbia (3-1, 3.41) vs. LHP Clayton Kershaw (12-4, 2.52) Game #155/Road Game #80 • Saturday, September 23, 2023 • Dodger Stadium • 6:10 p.m. PT

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Dodgers meet tonight for game three of this four-game set...the two teams are in the midst of a stretch where they play each other seven times in their final 10 games of the year.

- Last night's 5-1 victory put SF back to .500 after spending just one day below the mark...the Giants haven't been more than two games under .500 since May 21 (22-24)
- The Giants have dropped six of eight games on this road trip to Colorado (1-3), Arizona (0-2) and Los Angeles (1-1). SF has been outscored by a 50-32 margin...the pitching staff has allowed 50 runs in that span (6.25 runs/game) but only 40 of those are earned...the bullpen has a 7.39 ERA (23er, 28.0ip)...SF's offense has averaged 4.00 runs per game.
- ▶ SF looks to win consecutive road games for the first time since winning back-to-back road contests on August 23 & 31.
- Those consecutive wins were to end one road trip and start another...the last time the Giants won road games on consecutive days was July 14-18 when they won five straight out of the All-Star break in Pittsburgh and Cincinnati.

**THE RIVALRY:** SF owns a 5-3 edge over LA this year with five more games remaining in the head-to-head matchup...both of these teams play next weekend at Oracle Park.

- The Giants have won four of their five games here at Dodger Stadium this year, outscoring LA 36-16 in the five contests.
- SF batters are averaging 7.2 runs per game here at Chavez Ravine with a .749 OPS...the pitching staff is posting a 2.54 ERA (13er, 46.0ip) here, holding LA batters to a .573 OPS.

A WILD RACE: Just eight games remain on the Giants' regular season schedule as they enter today 3.0 games behind the Cubs for the third and final Wild Card spot in the NL...the Giants also trail the Marlins by 2.0 games and the Reds by 1.5.

- ▶ The Giants had entered last Friday in the third NL Wild Card spot, but losses in six of eight games this past week have pushed the Giants to the fringes of contention.
- The Giants and Blue Jays have the second-toughest remaining strength of schedule in MLB at .569, behind only the Nationals (.635)... SF's eight remaining games come against the Dodgers (.614 winning pct.; five games) and Padres (.494, three games).
- Entering play today, FanGraphs gives the Giants a 2.2% chance of making the playoffs.

HEY! CAN WE GET THAT BALL?: Last night, OF Tyler Fitzgerald slugged his first career homer with a two-run shot off Ryan Yarbrough in the 9th inning

The rookie became the first Giant to hit his first career home run at Dodger Stadium since Brandon Belt did so on April 1, 2011...prior to Belt, **Noah Lowry** (7/8/2006) was the last to achieve the feat (Sarah Langs).

TRANQUILO CAMILO: RHP Camilo Doval recorded his 38th save of the season last night...he's the first Giant with as many saves since Santiago Casilla (2015) and first to reach the mark in just 66 games since **Brian Wilson** had 45 saves through 66 outings in 2010.

Doval's 38 saves are the most in the NL and second-most in the Majors behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (42).

HE'S JUST THE OPENER: RHP John Brebbia returns to the opener role tonight and is slated to make his first start since suffering a Grade 2 right lat strain here at Dodger Stadium on June 16 that led him to miss 69 games.

- Brebbia has served as an opener for the majority of SF's bullpen games since 2022...the right-hander has a 0.90 ERA (2er, 20.0ip) with 17 strikeouts in 19 career starts.
- The Giants are 12-7 as a team in Brebbia's starts.

NOTABLE MATCHUPS: The Dodgers are enlisting ace LHP Clayton Kershaw for tonight's contest...a couple of Giants sluggers have found success against the southpaw through their careers.

- IF J.D. Davis is 5-for-13 (.385) with three homers vs. Kershaw in his career with a 1.077 slugging percentage.
- OF Austin Slater has also homered three times off Kershaw in his career, going 6-for-22 (.273) with a .682 SLG.

THE LONG BALL: Last night's homers by Fitzgerald, IF Thairo Estrada and OF Mike Yastrzemski put the Giants at 24 this month.

- ▶ The 24 homers are SF's most in a month since May (30)... they finished June and July with 23 and had 22 in August.
- The Giants scored 43% of their runs via home run in this month, ranking 13th in MLB...their 30% figure in August ranked last.
- According to Sports Info Solutions, SF has won six of its last seven games that Yaz homered.

**ROAD WOES:** The Giants have dropped 26 of their last 32 road games since July 19...their 6-26 (.188) road record since then is the worst mark among all MLB teams and their worst stretch in any 32-game span since 1996.

- The Giants have been outscored by a 184-107 margin on the road since July 19...they've scored two runs or fewer in 18 of those 32 games.
- Giants pitchers have posted a 5.60 ERA (164er, 263.2ip), the third-highest road ERA in MLB since July 19 behind the Cardinals (5.73) and Royals (5.68).
- ▶ SF is plating just 3.34 runs per game in these last 32 road contests, second-fewest in MLB and ahead only of the Dbacks (3.29).
- The Giants would need to win today and tomorrow to clinch their first road series win since they were at Pittsburgh right after the All-Star Break, July 14-16 (three-game sweep).

## #54 SCOTT ALEXANDER ► LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 9/21 at LAD; 1.0ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, k (20 pitches)

- Has allowed 16 runs (14er) over his last 17 outings (8.40 ERA).
- Stranded 24 of his 30 inherited runners this season.
- ► Lefties are 17-for-79 (.215) off him with five XBH.
- ► His 14.9 strikeout rate is in the bottom 5% of MLB.
- Has struck out just 31 of the 208 batters he's faced this year.
- Alexander is 7-0 as a reliever in 2023...according to Stats, LLC, his record would tie for the most wins without a loss in a single season by a Giant out of the bullpen in the modern era.

## #43 TRISTAN BECK > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Changeup Last Game: 9/4 at CHC; 1.1ip, 1h, 2h, 1bb (27 pitches)

- Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento Thursday.
- This marks the fifth time he's been recalled this season.
- Last pitched Sunday vs. Sugar Land and threw 4.0 innings, allowing four runs on four hits in what was his sixth start for Sac this year.
- ► In his first MLB season...he's 3-3 with a 4.04 ERA in 31 games.

## #59 JOHN BREBBIA > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

- Last Game: 9/21 at LAD; L, 0.2ip, h, r, er, k (13 pitches)
   Returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-
- day Injured List on Sept. 5 (right lat strain)...missed 69 games. ▶ Has worked in seven games since being reinstated from the IL.
- Has worked in seven games since being reinstated from the fL.
   Has bounced back and forth from the bullpen to being used as an "opener" this season...will open today's bullpen game to make his first start since June 16.
- ▶ Has a 0.90 ERA (2er, 20.0ip) with 17 strikeouts in 19 career starts.

## #75 CAMILO DOVAL > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Cutter, Sinker Last Game: 9/22 at LAD; SV, 1.1ip, 2k (20 pitches)

- His 38 SVs are most by a Giant since Santiago Casilla (38 in 2015).
   The 38 saves are second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel
- Clase (42).
- Named to the NL All-Star team, his first career selection.
   Has struck out 85 batters over 65.1 innings of work (11.71 SO/9)... his 31.3% strikeout rate ranks in the top 8% of the league.
- Batters are 15-for-93 (.161) off his slider with 46 strikeouts.
- The closer has worked multiple innings 10 times this season...hasn't allowed an earned run in any of those outings and has gone 4-1-4 in those games with 17 strikeouts (14.0ip).

## #77 LUKE JACKSON ► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

- Last Game: 9/21 at LAD; 1.0ip, h, 2r, er, k (13 pitches)
- ▶ Has struck out 41 batters in 31.2 innings of work (11.65 SO/9).
- 31 of his 41 strikeouts have come on his slider.
- Reinstated from the 60-day IL on May 30 and made his Giants debut on May 31...missed the entire 2022 season after undergoing TJ surgery.
- Also missed 21 games with a low back strain from June 25-July 22.

## #34 JAKOB JUNIS► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Changeup, Four-Seam Fastball

Last Game: 9/16 at COL (G2); 4.0ip, 4h, 2r, er, bb, 5k (57 pitches)

- Has allowed seven runs (six ER) on 11 hits in 14.0 innings over his last five relief apperances.
- Has made 35 appearances out of SF's bullpen...served mainly as a long reliever with his season-high being 4.0ip.
- Also made four starts for SF and allowed just two runs (unearned) on five hits with 14 strikeouts (12.2ip).

## #33 TAYLOR ROGERS > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

- Last Game: 9/17 at COL; SV, 0.1ip (2 pitches)
- Is 6-2-2 with a 1.96 ERA (10er, 46.0ip), 58 strikeouts, a 1.02 WHIP and a .182 opp avg in his last 51 games since April 19.
- Has a 0.82 ERA (2er, 22.0ip) on the road this season with 30 strikeouts...his 0.82 road ERA is second-best in MLB (min. 20.0ip).
- ▶ Lefties are 7-for-83 (.084) with two doubles vs. Rogers.
- ▶ Righties have a .922 OPS and five HRs against him.

## #71 TYLER ROGERS ► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

- Last Game: 9/22 at LAD; 0.2ip, 2h, r, bb, k (33 pitches)
- ▶ His 65 appearances are the second-most on the team (Doval, 66).
- Opponents are batting .417 (15-for-36) off him on the first pitch.
- ▶ His 84.2 mph average exit velocity is second-best in MLB.
- Rogers' 27.4% opposing hard hit rate is in the top 2% of MLB.

## #48 ROSS STRIPLING > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider, Curve, Sinker Last Game: 9/16 at COL (G1); 3.1ip, 4h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 3k (66 pitches)

- Returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on Sept 15...missed 25 games with a mid-back strain.
- Walked his first batter faced last in his return, snapping a streak of having not issued a walk to 169 consecutive batters, the longest such streak by a Giants pitcher since 1974.
- ▶ His 3.7 BB% is in the top 2% of the league.
- ▶ Has given up 20 HRs in 81.2 innings this season.
- ▶ His 2.20 HR/9 is the highest of his career since 2020 (2.37 HR/9).

## #74 RYAN WALKER > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 9/20 at ARI; 0.2ip, 3h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 2k, 2hr (30 pitches)

Has allowed seven runs on five hits and four walks in last two gms.

- ▶ Throws his slider 50.5% of the time and sinker 49.4% of time.
- Has posted a 11.3 K/9ip ratio w/SF (71 strikeouts in 56.1 innings).

## #57 ALEX WOOD > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 9/19 at ARI; 5.0ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, bb, hb, 2k (82 pitches)

- ▶ Has logged a 6.08 ERA (32er, 47.1ip) in 12 starts this year.
- ▶ Has a 3.02 ERA (15er, 44.2ip) in 15 relief outings.
- 64 of his 79 appearances have been as a starter w/SF since 2021.
   Has 3.82 BB/9ip ratio this year, nearly double last year (2.1) and well above career average (2.6)...has walked 39 batters in 92.0ip.
- Has a 16.8% K rate this season, his lowest since 2015 (17.4).
